WEEK TWO

SNOWFLAKES and REINDEERS

So far, you've completed 2 bands of patterning – the Christmas Trees and the Gingerbread Men.

Now to work the next sections ...

ABBREVIATIONS

cont = continue; **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **patt** = pattern;
rep = repeat; **RS** = right side; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
WS = wrong side.



CHART THREE – SNOWFLAKES



36 st patt repeat




CHART FOUR – REINDEERS AND SANTAS

KNITTING FLAT

With RS facing, rejoin yarn A to the sts on your needle and cont as folls:

Snowflakes (chart three)

Working backwards and forwards in rows, joining in and breaking off colours as required and stranding yarn not in use loosely across WS of work, weaving it in every 3–4 sts, now work in patt from chart three (Snowflakes) as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Work all 36 sts of the patt rep 6 times, and then work the end st as shown – work all odd numbered rows of chart as **knit** rows, reading chart from **right to left**.

Row 2: Work the end st as shown on chart, then work all 36 sts of the patt rep 6 times – work all even numbered rows of chart as **purl** rows, reading chart from **left to right**.

Cont in this way until all 42 rows of chart three have been completed.

Reindeers (chart four)

Now following chart four (Reindeers and Santas), work first 30 rows **only** of this chart in exactly the same way as for the Snowflakes.

You have now completed charts three and the first 30 rows of chart four, in addition to charts one and two, and 148 rows in total. Your work should measure 55 cm (21¾ in) from the cast-on edge.

Leave sts on the needle, ready for the next sections.

WEEK TWO

KNITTING IN THE ROUND (FOR STEEKING)

Rejoin yarn A to the sts on your needle and cont as folls:

Keeping the marker on the last st of every round (to denote the steek line) work in rounds as folls:

Snowflakes

(chart three)

Joining in and breaking off colours as required and stranding yarn not in use loosely across WS of work, weaving it in every 3–4 sts, now work in patt from chart three (Snowflakes) as folls:

Round 1 (RS): Using yarn A K3, work all 36 sts of the patt rep 6 times, and then work the end st as shown on chart, using yarn A K4.

Remember that the first 3 and last 4 sts of every round are the steek sts, and that the steek sts should be worked in the main shade used for the round.

Cont in this way until all 42 rows of chart three have been completed.

Reindeers

(chart four)

Now following chart four (Reindeers and Santas), work first 30 rows only of this chart in exactly the same way.

You have now completed charts three and the first 30 rows of chart four, in addition to charts one and two, and 148 rounds in

total. Your work should measure 55 cm (21¾ in) from the cast-on edge.

Leave sts on the needle, ready for the next sections.



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
