## WEEK THREE

### GNOMES and MORE CHRISTMAS TREES

So far, you've completed 4 bands of patterning – Christmas Trees, Gingerbread Men, Snowflakes and Reindeer.

Now to work the next sections ...

#### ABBREVIATIONS

**cont** = continue; **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **patt** = pattern;  
**rep** = repeat; **RS** = right side; **st(s)** = stitch(es);  
**WS** = wrong side.

36 st patt repeat




CHART FOUR – REINDEERS AND GNOMES

### CHART ONE – CHRISTMAS TREES




CHART ONE – CHRISTMAS TREES

### KNITTING FLAT

With RS facing, rejoin yarn B to the sts on your needle and cont as follows:

#### Gnomes (chart four)

Working backwards and forwards in rows, joining in and breaking off colours as required and stranding yarn not in use loosely across WS of work, weaving it in every 3–4 sts, now work in patt from chart four (Reindeers and Gnomes) **beg with chart row 31** as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** Work all 36 sts of the patt rep 6 times, and then work the end st as shown – work all odd numbered rows of chart as **knit** rows, reading chart from **right to left**.

**Row 2:** Work the end st as shown on chart, then work all 36 sts of the patt rep 6 times – work all even numbered rows of chart as **purl** rows, reading chart from **left to right**.

Cont in this way until rows 31 to 66 of chart four have been completed.

#### Christmas Trees (chart one)

Now following chart one (Christmas Trees), work all 34 rows of this chart again, in exactly the same way as previously.

You have now completed chart four and chart one for a second time and 218 rows in total. Your work should measure 80.5 cm (31¾ in) from the cast-on edge.

Leave sts on the needle, ready for the next sections.

### KNITTING IN THE ROUND (FOR STEEKING)

Rejoin yarn B to the sts on your needle and cont as follows:

Keeping the marker on the last st of every round (to denote the steek line) work in rounds as follows:

#### Gnomes (chart four)

Joining in and breaking off colours as required and stranding yarn not in use loosely across WS of work, weaving it in every 3–4 sts, now work in patt from chart four (Reindeers and Gnomes) **beg with chart row 31** as follows:

**Round 1 (RS):** Using yarn B K3, work all 36 sts of the patt rep 6 times, and then work the end st as shown on chart, using yarn B K4.

Remember that the first 3 and last 4 sts of every round are the steek sts, and that the steek sts should be worked in the main shade used for the round.

Cont in this way until rows 31 to 66 rows of chart four have been completed.

## WEEK THREE

### Christmas Trees *(chart one)*

Now following chart one (Christmas Trees), work all 34 rows of this chart again, in exactly the same way as previously.

You have now completed chart four and chart one for a second

time and 218 rounds in total. Your work should measure 80.5 cm (31¾ in) from the cast-on edge.

Leave sts on the needle, ready for the next sections.



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
