

BAKER SWEATER



This sweater is for your working time sweater (of course you can wear it anytime you want!), which I got an idea from my favorite bakery. I designed it for easy moving your body when you're at work time.

First you will start knitting at the Front neck to armhole back and forth using short rows. Next, knit the Back neck (also using short rows) and after finishing the Back neck, join the Back to the Front and continue to knit the Back as it is. When you finish knitting the Back to armhole, join the Front and you will work in round from here. The hem, you will separate Front and Back again and work back and forth.

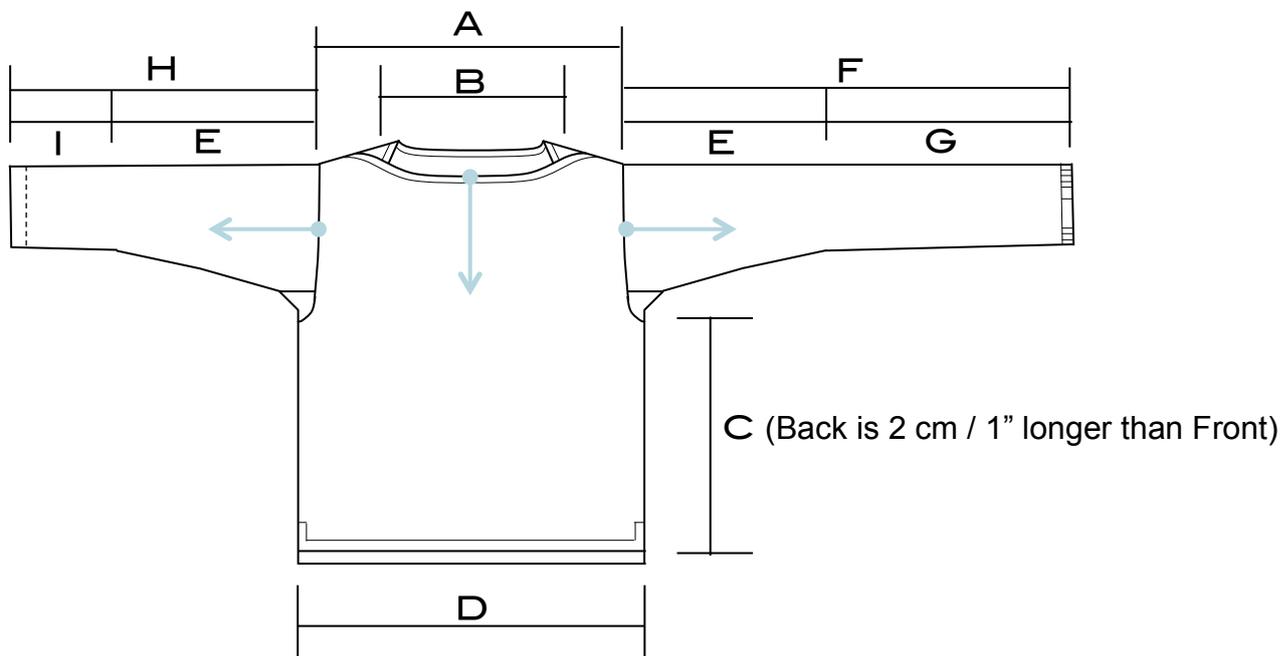
Then pick up the stitches of the sleeve from the Body. In the armpit, knit the gusset using short rows to be able to move your arm easily. Continue knitting in the round to the elbow with some decreasing row, then knit straight to cuff. The length of the sleeve and the Cuff --- you can choose 2 options. Type-A / long sleeve: ultimately simple and has ribbed cuff. Type-B / three-quarter sleeve: also simple but has slit in the double cuff. I hope you find your favorite!

Sizes / XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL)

Finished Bust: 86 (94, 98, 106, 113, 118) cm / 34 (36.75, 38.5, 42, 44.5, 46.25)"

Suggested ease: 15 cm / 6"

MATERIALS

Yarn

1000 (1120, 1200, 1500, 1730, 1910) m / 1090 (1225, 1320, 1640, 1890, 2090) yards of Sport weight yarn.

The sample is shown in Lilou Merino Sport (300 m / 328 yards per 100 g / 3.53 ounces 100 % Merino Wool), 4 (4, 4, 5, 6, 7) skeins, color Koi.

Needles

One each 80 cm / 32" and 40 cm / 16" circular needle in size US 4 / 3.5 mm, US 3 / 3.25 mm.

Adjust needle size if necessary to get gauge.

Notions Stitch markers, tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn.



Gauge

25 stitches and 38 rounds – 10 cm / 4" in pattern with size US 4 / 3.5 mm needle (after blocking).

Abbreviations

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

dec('d): decrease(d)

DS: double stitch

inc('d): increase(d)

k: knit

k tbl: knit through back loop

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

MM: main marker. This marker shows the beginning of the round.

M1L: Make 1 left increase

M1Lp: Make 1 left purl increase

M1R: make 1 right increase

p: purl

patt: pattern

PM: place marker

p tbl: purl through back loop

RM: remove marker

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

slM: slip marker

ssk: slip, slip, knit

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

wyif: with yarn in front

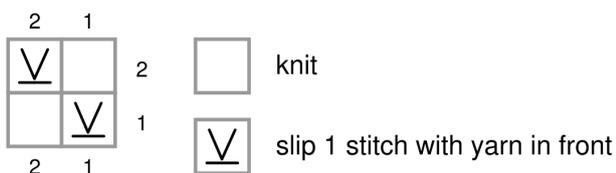

INSTRUCTIONS

Front Neck

With 40 cm / 16" size US 3 / 3.25 mm circular needle, CO 71 (75, 81, 87, 91, 97) sts using long-tail method.

Row 1 (RS): (k tbl, p1) to last st, k tbl.

Right shoulder

Row 1 (RS): CO 1 st using the Knitted Cast On, k tbl, M1L, k3, turn.

Row 2 (WS): make DS, PM, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): CO 1 st using the Knitted Cast On,



Row 2 (WS): (p tbl, k1) to last st, p tbl.

Repeat last 2 rows 2 more times.

Change needles to size US 4 / 3.5 mm.

k tbl, M1L, k to M, RM, work DS, k3, turn.

Row 4 (WS): as Row 2.

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3) more times. 6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts inc'd, 77 (83, 89, 95, 101,

107) sts.

Next

Row 1 (RS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, k tbl, **M1L**, k to M, **RM**, work DS, k5, turn.

Row 2 (WS): make DS, **PM**, p to end.

Left shoulder

Set-up row (WS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, p tbl, **M1Lp**, p3, turn.

Row 1 (RS): make DS, **PM**, k to end.

Row 2 (WS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, p tbl, **M1Lp**, p to M, **RM**, work DS, p3, turn.

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3) more times. 8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12) sts inc'd, 89 (97, 103, 111, 119, 125) sts.

Next

Row 1 (RS): make DS, **PM**, k to end.

Row 2 (WS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, p tbl, **M1Lp**, p to M, **RM**, work DS, p5, turn.

Armhole increases

Row 1 (RS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, k to end.

Row 2 (WS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Back Neck

With 40 cm / 16" size US 3 / 3.25 mm circular needle, CO 67 (71, 75, 81, 85, 89) sts using long-tail method.

Row 1 (RS): (k tbl, p1) to last st, k tbl.

Row 2 (WS): (p tbl, k1) to last st, p tbl.

Repeat last 2 rows 2 more times.

Change needles to size US 4 / 3.5 mm.

Row 1 (RS): k3, turn.

Row 2 (WS): make DS, **PM**, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): k to M, **RM**, work DS, k4, turn.

Row 4 (RS): as Row 2.

Repeat last 2 rows 4 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6) more times.

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2) more times. 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts inc'd, 81 (87, 93, 101, 107, 113) sts.

Next row (RS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, k tbl, **M1L**, k to M, **RM**, work DS, k to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2) more times. 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts inc'd, 93 (101, 107, 117, 125, 131) sts.

Next

Row 1 (RS): make DS, **PM**, k to end.

Row 2 (WS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, p tbl, **M1Lp**, p to M, **RM**, work DS, p to end. 2 sts inc'd, 95 (103, 109, 119, 127, 133) sts.

Row 3 (RS): k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 25 (27, 29, 32, 35, 38) more times.

Repeat last 4 rows once more, then repeat Rows [1-2] 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2) more times. 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts inc'd, 101 (109, 115, 127, 135, 141) sts. Place these 101 (109, 115, 127, 135, 141) Front sts to the stitch holder or a waste yarn, or an extra cable.

Next

Row 1 (RS): k to M, **RM**, work DS, k to end.

Row 2 (WS): p3, turn.

Row 3 (RS): make DS, **PM**, k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to M, **RM**, work DS, p4, turn.

Repeat last 2 rows 4 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6) more times, then repeat Row 3 once more.

Next-row (WS): p to M, **RM**, work DS, p to end.

Next

Row 1 (RS): k to end.

Row 2 (WS): p to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3) more times.
 Next
 Row 1 (RS): k1, **M1L**, k to last st, **M1R**, k1.

Row 2 (WS): p to end. Cut yarn. 69 (73, 77, 83, 87, 91) sts.

Picking up the shoulder stitches

Note: In the set-up row, pick up sts from Front Left Shoulder (see figure 1, a), then work some of the sts picked up from Front and Back sts together (in this case, **ssk**)(b), work Back sts leaving a few sts at end (c), work the left Back sts and sts picked up from Front Right Shoulder together (**k2tog**), and lastly pick up more sts from Front Right Shoulder.

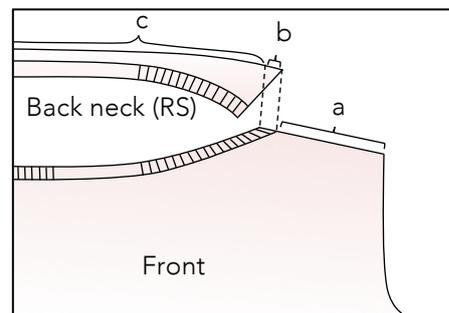

With RS (of the Front) facing and live sts downward, attach new yarn to the right side (armhole side of Left Shoulder).

Set-up row 1 (RS): pick up 14 (16, 16, 18, 20, 20) sts from the left shoulder, (pick up 1 st from Front rib and work **ssk** with 1 back st) 4 times, k the Back to the last 4 sts, (slip 1 Back st, pick up 1 st from Front rib, move the slipped st back to left needle, **k2tog**) 4 times from the Front rib, and then pick up 14 (16, 16, 18, 20, 20) sts from the right shoulder. 97 (105, 109, 119, 127, 131) sts.

Set-up row 2 (WS): p 87 (93, 95, 103, 109, 111), turn.

Row 1 (RS): make DS, **PM**, k 77 (81, 81, 87, 91), turn.

Row 2 (WS): make DS, **PM**, p to M, **RM**, work DS, p2, turn.

Row 3 (RS): make DS, **PM**, k to M, **RM**, work DS, k2, turn.

Row 4 (WS): as Row 2.

Repeat last 2 rows 2 (3, 4, 5, 6, 7) more times,

then repeat Row 3 once more.

Next row 1 (WS): make DS, **PM**, p to M, **RM**, work DS, p to end.

Next row 2 (RS): k to M, **RM**, work DS, k to end.

Next row 3 (WS): p to end.

St st section

Row 1 (RS): k to end.

Row 2 (WS): p to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 25 (27, 29, 32, 35, 38) more times.

Increase section

Row 1 (RS): k1, **M1L**, k to last st, **M1R**, k1.

Row 2 (WS): p to end.

Row 3 (RS): k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Repeat last 4 rows twice more.

Row 13 (RS): **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast On, k1, **M1L**, k to last st, **M1R**, k1, **CO 1 st** using the Knitted Cast on.

Row 14 (WS): p to end. Do not cut yarn. 107 (115, 119, 129, 137, 141) sts.



Join to the round

Set-up rnd: k all the sts of the Back, **CO 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts** using Backward Loop Cast On, **PMM**, **CO 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts** using Backward Loop Cast On, k all the sts of the Front (from the stitch holder or a waste yarn), **CO 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts** using Backward Loop Cast On, **PM**, **CO 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts** using Backward Loop Cast On, k to MM. 216 (234, 244, 270, 286,

Hem

Set-up rnd 1: slMM, p1, k tbl, p1, k3, **PM**, k to 6 st before M, **PM**, k3, p1, k tbl, p1, **RM**, k3, **PM**, k to 3 sts before MM, **place new Main Marker**.

Set-up rnd 2: slMM (new), repeat rnd 1 of Half-linen stitch 4 times while removing MM (old), sl 1 wyif, slM, k to M, slM, repeat rnd 1 of Half-linenstitch 4 times, sl 1 wyif, k to MM.

Rnd 1: slMM, * work next rnd of Half-linen stitch to M, slM, k to M **, repeat * to ** once

Separate Front and Back.

Row 1 (RS): slMM, work row 1 of Half-linen stitch to M, slM, k to M, slM, work row 1 of half-linen stitch to 5 sts before M, **turn**.

Front

Row 1 (RS): work row 2 of Half-linen stitch to M, slM, k to M, slM, work row 2 of half-linen stitch to end.

Row 2 (WS): (p to M, slM) twice, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): work row 1 of Half-linen stitch to M, slM, k to M, slM, work row 1 of half-linen stitch to end.

Row 4 (WS): as Row 2.

Repeat last 4 rows **once** more, then repeat Row 1 once more.

Row 10 (WS): (p to M, **RM**) twice, p to end.

298) sts.

Rnd 1: slMM, p1, k tbl, p1, k to 3 st before M, p1, k tbl, p1, slM, k to MM.

Rnd 2: slMM, k1, k tbl, k to 2 sts before M, k tbl, k1, slM, k to MM.

Repeat last 2 rnds 38 (40, 44, 48, 54, 57) more times (or to your desired length).



more.

Repeat last rnd 4 more times.

Row 2 (WS): (p to M, slM) twice, p4, **turn**. Place and hold Back stitches to the cable as it is.

Row 11 (RS): work row 1 of Half-linen stitch to end.

Row 12 (WS): p to end.

Row 13 (RS): work row 2 of Half-linen stitch to end.

Row 14 (WS): p to end.

Repeat last 4 rows once more, then repeat Row 11 once more.

Row 20 (WS): BO all stitches as if to k. Cut yarn.

Back

Join yarn to the Back with RS facing.

Row 1 (RS): work row 2 of Half-linen stitch to M, s1M, k to M, s1M, work row 2 of half-linen stitch to end.

Row 2 (WS): (p to M, s1M) twice, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): work row 1 of Half-linen stitch to M, s1M, k to M, s1M, work row 1 of half-linen stitch to end.

Row 4 (WS): as Row 2.

Repeat last 4 rows **twice** more, then repeat Row 1 once more.

Row 14 (WS): (p to M, **RM**) twice, p to end.

Row 15 (RS): work row 1 of Half-linen stitch to end.

Row 16 (WS): p to end.

Row 17 (RS): work row 2 of Half-linen stitch to end.

Row 18 (WS): p to end.

Repeat last 4 rows once more, then repeat Row 15 once more.

Row 24 (WS): BO all stitches as if to k. Cut yarn.

Left sleeve

Join yarn to the center of the left underarm. Pick up 44 (47, 50, 56, 60, 65) sts from the Front, 48 (51, 54, 59, 63, 68) sts from the Back, PMM and join in the round. 92 (98, 104, 115, 123, 133) sts.

Note: you will work short-rows to make the gusset of the underarm from now. The stitches of the gusset are garter stitches.

Short row 1 (RS): s1M, k5, turn.

Short row 2 (WS): make DS, k to MM, s1MM, k6, turn.

Short row 3 (RS): make DS, k to MM, s1MM, k to DS, work DS, k1, turn.

Short row 4 (WS): as last row (Short row 3).

Repeat last 2 rows 2 (2, 2, 2, 4, 4) more times.

Next-1

Short row 1 (RS): make DS, k to MM, s1MM, k to DS, work DS, k2, turn.

Short row 2 (WS): as last row (Short row 1 of Next-1).

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2) more times.

Next-2*

Rnd 1: make DS, k to MM, **RMM**, k to DS, work DS, **PM**, k to DS, **PMM**.

Rnd 2: s1MM, work DS as if to p, p to M, s1M, k to MM.

Rnd 3: s1MM, **k2tog**, k to 2 sts before M, **ssk**, s1M, k to MM.



Rnd 4: s1MM, p to M, s1M, k to MM.

Repeat last 2 rnds until you have 3 sts between MM and M. 22 (22, 22, 26, 30, 30) sts dec'd. 70 (76, 82, 89, 93, 103) sts.

Next-3

From now, you will work k and p alternately at under sleeve.

Rnd 1: **RMM**, **ssk**, **PMM**, k1, **k2tog**, k to MM.

Rnd 2: s1MM, p1 (or k1), k to MM.

Repeat last rnd 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) times.

Next rnd: s1MM, p1 (or k1), **k2tog**, k to 2 sts before MM, **ssk**.

Repeat last 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) rnds 7 (8, 8, 8, 9, 9) more times. 18 (20, 20, 20, 22, 22) sts dec'd. 52 (56, 62, 69, 71, 81) sts.

Next-4

Rnd 1: s1MM, p1 (or k1), k to MM.

Repeat last rnd 5 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) times.

Next rnd: s1MM, p1 (or k1), **k2tog**, k to 2 sts before MM, **ssk**.

Repeat last 7 (8, 8, 10, 10, 10) rnds 2 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3) more times. 6 (6, 6, 6, 8, 8) sts dec'd. 46 (50, 56, 63, 63, 73) sts.

Long sleeve version

Rnd 1: slMM, p1 (or k1), k to MM.

Repeat last rnd until the sleeve length reaches 41 (42, 44, 47, 50, 53) cm / 16 (16.5, 17.25, 18.5, 19.75, 21)" or to your desired length.

Rib

Note: (mainly sizes L, XL, XXL) if the sts of the sleeve now you knit is odd, please make the number of sts to even.



For sizes XS, S, M only

Rnd 1: slMM, (p1, k tbl) to MM.

All sizes

Rnd 2: slMM, (p1, k tbl) to MM.

Repeat Rnd 2 five times. BO all stitches with ordinary BO method.

For sizes L, XL, XXL only

Rnd 1: slMM, p2tog, k tbl, (p1, k tbl) to MM.

Three quarter sleeve version

Rnd 1: slMM, p1 (or k1), k to MM.

Repeat last rnd for additional 4 (4.5, 5, 6, 7, 8) cm / 1.5 (1.75, 2, 2.25, 2.75, 3)" or until your desired length.

Note: (mainly sizes L, XL, XXL) if the sts of the sleeve now you knit is odd, please make the number of sts to even.



For sizes XS, S, M

Rnd 1: slMM, (k1, sl 1 wyif) to MM.

All sizes

Row 1 (RS): RMM, BO 1 st, k to end. Turn.

Row 2 (WS): CO 1 st using the Knitted Cast on, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): CO 1 st using the Knitted Cast on, k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

For sizes L, XL, XXL

Rnd 1: slMM, k2tog, sl 1 wyif, (k1, sl 1 wyif) to MM.

Row 5 (RS): k to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 9 more times. BO all stitches in pattern.

Sew and finish the cuff. (See these pics below.)

Pic 1: Fold back the cuff **to outside**.



Pic 3: Turn over the cuff **to inside**.



Pic 5: Sew bar tack at the bottom of the cuff.



Pic 2: Sew up each side of the slit.



Pic 4: Hemming using blind stitch.



Make another sleeve in the same manner but symmetrically back and forth.

Right sleeve

Join yarn to the center of the right underarm.

Pick up 48 (51, 54, 59, 63, 68) sts from the Back,

Row 1 (RS): s1M, k6, turn.

Row 2 (WS): make DS, k to MM, s1MM, k5, turn.

Row 3 (RS): make DS, k to MM, s1MM, k to DS, work DS, k1, turn.

Row 4 (WS): as Row3.

Repeat last 2 rows 2 (2, 2, 2, 4, 4) more times.

44 (47, 50, 56, 60, 65) sts from the Front, PMM.

92 (98, 104, 115, 123, 133) sts.

Next

Row 1 (RS): make DS, k to MM, s1MM, k to DS, work DS, k2, turn.

Row 2 (WS): as Row 1.

Repeat last 2 rows 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2) more times.

Repeat the instruction from Next-2* of Left sleeve (see page 6).

Finishing

Sew up each side of Back collar to the reverse side of bottom of the Front rib.

Weave in ends, block to measurements.
