

# KnitVik

## Bellis tee



Sizes: 2XS (XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL) 4XL (5XL).

Measurements: Circumference 85 (90) 95 (100) 105 (113) 125 (137) 145 (155) cm.



Length: 48 (50) 52 (54) 56 (59) 61 (63) 64 (66) cm measured mid-back including folded edge.



Recommended needle size: 3 mm circular needles (40, 60 or 80 cm).  
3 mm DPNs.



Yarn: 200(200)300(300)300(400)400(400)400(500) g Sock from UnikGarn (100 g = 425 m) **or**  
200(200)300(300)300(400)400(400)400(500) g Glitter sock from UnikGarn (100 g = 400 m).



Gauge: 28 stitches x 40 rows in stockinette on 3 mm needles = 10 cm x 10 cm.

## About the pattern:

Bellis Tee is worked from the top to bottom. The neckline is folded down and knitted (or sewn down to the wrong side at the end). The yoke is worked in the round in the bellis pattern with increases along the way. The body and sleeves are worked in stockinette, and both are finished with a folded edge.

## Increases:

Increases are worked alternating between leaning towards the right (M1R) or leaning towards the left (M1L).

**M1L:** Insert the left needle under the strand between 2 stitches from the front and knit it through the back loop. Knitted through the back loop means that instead of knitting a stitch normally in the front leg, the back leg is knit instead.

**M1R:** Insert the left needle under the strand between 2 sts from the back and knit it.

## Sizing guide:

Bellis Tee should have a positive ease of about 5-10 cm in relation to your chest circumference. The sizes 2XS (XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL) 4XL (5XL) correspond to a chest circumference of your own body's measurements: 75-80 (80-85) 85-90 (90-95) 95-100 (100-110) 110-120 (120-130) 130-140 (140-150) cm.

## Yoke:

Cast 112 (112) 120 (120) 128 (128) 136 (136) 144 (144) sts onto 3 mm circular needles (40 cm). Insert a SM at the BOR. Change to longer needles along the way, if necessary.

Work stockinette in the rnd for 10 rnds.

Purl 1 rnd (to create the folded edge).

Work stockinette in the rnd for 10 rnds.

The next rnd knits the casted-on sts together with the live sts. With the right needle, lift sts up from the cast-on edge onto the left needle. This st, plus the next st on the left needle, are knit together. Repeat this for the whole rnd.

Be careful to use the corresponding cast-on st, so the st from the cast-on edge is from the same row as the live st on the needle. This will avoid twisting the neckline.

Work the bellis pattern as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

2nd rnd: \*k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k1, p1, then 3 sts (2 y/os + st) are knit tog to create 3 new sts by knitting the 3 sts tog but do not slip them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k1, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the slipped st back on the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

Now work the bellis pattern at the same as making increases along the way. Increases will be made on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern.

**See the section about increases.**

Work 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern, as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, new sts are worked as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k2, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but do not slip them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k2, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back on the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 2 times and increases are made once. There are now 140 (140) 150 (150) 160 (160) 170 (170) 180 (180) sts in total. The work measures approx. 4.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds again 1 more time, but without making more increases, and where the new sts from the last increases are worked knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern, as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1R**, k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k3, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k3, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 4 times and increases are worked twice. There are now 168 (168) 180 (180) 192 (192) 204 (204) 216 (216) sts in total. The piece measures 6.5 cm, including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds again 1 more time, but without making more increases, and where the new sts from the last increases are worked knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern, as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, k2, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k2, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k4, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k4, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 6 times and increases are made 3 times. There are now 196 (196) 210 (210) 224 (224) 238 (238) 252 (252) sts in total. The piece measures 8.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds 1 time, but without increases, and where there are new sts from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern as follows:

1st rnd: \*k3, **M1R**, k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k3, **knit the new st**, k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k5, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k5, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 8 times and increases are made 4 times. There are now 224 (224) 240 (240) 256 (256) 272 (272) 288 (288) sts in total. The piece measures 10.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds 1 time, but without increases, and where there are new sts from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, k4, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k4, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k6, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k6, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 10 times and increases are made 5 times. There are now 252 (252) 270 (270) 288 (288) 306 (306) 324 (324) sts in total. The piece measures 12.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds 1 time, but without increases, and where there are new sts from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern as follows:

1st rnd: \*k5, **M1R**, k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k5, **knit the new st**, k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3. Omg: \*k7, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k7, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 12 times and increases are made 6 times. There are now 280 (280) 300 (300) 320 (320) 340 (340) 360 (360) sts in total. The piece measures 14.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds 1 time, but without increases, and where there are new sts from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, k6, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k6, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o +st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k8, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k8, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 14 times and increases are made 7 times. There are now 308 (308) 330 (330) 352 (352) 374 (374) 396 (396) sts in total. The piece measures 16.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds 1 time, but without increases, and where there are new sts from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

Work now 1 rnd with increases on the 1st rnd of the bellis pattern as follows:

1st rnd: \*k7, **M1R**, k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k7, **knit the new st**, k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\* repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k9, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k9, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 16 times and increases are made 8 times. There are now 336 (336) 360 (360) 384 (384) 408 (408) 432 (432) sts in total. The piece measures 18.5 cm, including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds again a total of 2 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) times, but without increases, and where the new sts from the last increases are worked knit-wise.

The yoke for size 2XS is now finished, and you can continue onto the “Body” section.

For sizes XS-5XL, work 1 rnd with increases as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, k8, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k8, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o+ st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k10, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k10, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 18 times and increases are made 8 (9) 9 (9) 9 (9) 9 (9) 9 (9) times. There are now 336 (364) 390 (390) 416 (416) 442 (442) 468 (468) sts in total. The piece measures 20.5 cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds again a total of 0 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) times, but without increases, and where the new sts from the last increases are worked knit-wise (if “0” is there for your size, then hop over this section).

The yoke for sizes XS and S are now finished and you can continue onto the “Body” section.

For sizes M-5XL, work 1 rnd with increases as follows:

1st rnd: \*k9, **M1R**, k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k9, **knit the new st**, k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k11, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k11, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 18 (19) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) times and increases are made 8 (9) 9 (10) 10 (10) 10 (10) 10 (10) times. There are now 336 (364) 390 (420) 448 (448) 476 (476) 504 (504) sts in total. The piece measures approx. 20.5 (21.5) 22.5 (22.5) 22.5 (22.5) 22.5 (22.5) cm including the neckline.

Work the above 4 rnds again a total of 0 (0) 0 (1) 2 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) times, but without increases, and where the new sts from the last increases are worked knit-wise.

The yoke for sizes M and L are now finished and you can continue onto the “Body” section.

For sizes XL-5XL, work 1 rnd with increases as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, k10, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k10, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o + st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k12, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k12, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 18 (19) 20 (21) 22 (22) 22 (22) 22 (22) times and increases are made 8 (9) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 (11) 11 (11) times. There are now 336 (364) 390 (420) 448 (480) 510 (510) 540 (540) sts in total. The piece measures approx. 20.5 (21.5) 22.5 (23.5) 24.5 (24.5) 24.5 (24.5) 24.5 (24.5) cm.

Work the above 4 rnds again 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (1) 2 (1) 1 (1) times, but without increases, and where the new sts are from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

The yoke for sizes XL and 2XL are now finished, and you can continue onto the “Body” section.

For sizes 3XL-5XL, work 1 rnd with increases as follows:

1st rnd: \*k11, **M1R**, k1, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\* repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k11, **knit the new st**, k1, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o+ st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k13, p1, then k3tog (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k13, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

The bellis pattern is now worked 18 (19) 20 (21) 22 (23) 24 (24) 24 (24) times and increases are made 8 (9) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 (12) 12 (12) times. There are now 336 (364) 390 (420) 448 (480) 510 (544) 576 (576) sts in total. The piece measures approx. 20.5 (21.5) 22.5 (23.5) 24.5 (25.5) 26.5 (26.5) 26.5 (26.5) cm.

Work the above 4 rnds again 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (1) 2 (1) times, but without increases, and where there are new sts from the last increases, work them knit-wise.

The yoke for sizes 3XL and 4XL are now finished, and you can continue onto the “Body” section.

For size 5XL, work 1 rnd with increases as follows:

1st rnd: \*k1, **M1L**, k12, p1, y/o, sl1pw, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

In the following 3 rnds of the bellis pattern, work the new sts as follows:

2nd rnd: \*k1, **knit the new st**, k12, p1, y/o, sl2pw (y/o+ st from previous rnd), p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

3rd rnd: \*k14, p1, then k3tog 3 (2 y/os + st) to create 3 new sts by knitting them tog, but not taking them off the left needle yet, y/o, and k3tog in the same st, before finally slipping them off the left needle, p1\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

4th rnd: \*k14, k2tog, k1, sl1kw, place the st back to the left needle, k2togtbl\*, repeat from \*-\* the whole rnd.

There are now increases made 8 (9) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 (12) 12 (13) times, and there are 336 (364) 390 (420) 448 (480) 510 (544) 576 (612) sts in total.

Work the above 4 rnds 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (0) 0 (1) times, but without making increases, and where the new sts that were made from the last increases are worked knit-wise.

The yoke is now finished for all sizes. The body and sleeves are worked separately.

### Body:

The bellis pattern is now worked 18 (19) 20 (21) 22 (23) 24 (25) 26 (27) times in total and measures approx. 20.5 (21.5) 22.5 (23.5) 24.5 (25.5) 26.5 (27.5) 28.5 (29.5) cm.

For sizes 2XS, XS, L, XL, 2XL, and 4XL knit across to the next purl st, before dividing for the body and sleeves (the division starts with the 3 sts from the bellis pattern).

Now divide sts for the sleeves and body, and sts are cast on for armholes, as follows:

Place 63 (68) 75 (81) 87 (93) 93 (93) 99 (105) sts to rest (right sleeve), cast on 14 (12) 13 (11) 10 (12) 13 (13) 14 (16) sts with backwards loop cast on, slip the BOR SM to the middle of the newly casted-on sts, knit across 105 (114) 120 (129) 137 (147) 162 (179) 189 (201) sts (front), place 63 (68) 75 (81) 87 (93) 93 (93) 99 (105) sts to rest (left sleeve) cast on 14 (12) 13 (11) 10 (12) 13 (13) 14 (16) sts with backwards loop cast on, knit across 105 (114) 120 (129) 137 (147) 162 (179) 189 (201) sts (back).

The body now has 238 (252) 266 (280) 294 (318) 350 (384) 406 (434) sts in total.



Work stockinette in the rnd until the piece measures 48 (50) 52 (54) 56 (59) 61 (63) 64 (66) cm, measured from mid-back.

Purl 1 rnd (creates the folded edge).

Knit 10 rnds.

Bind off loosely.

**Sleeves:**

Place the resting 63 (68) 75 (81) 87 (93) 93 (93) 99 (105) sleeve sts onto 3 mm DPNs (or long 3 mm circular needles, if you want to use Magic Loop).

Pick up 16 (14) 15 (13) 12 (14) 15 (15) 16 (18) sts around the armhole (1 st in each of the casted-on sts from the body and 1 extra on each side) = 79 (82) 90 (94) 99 (107) 108 (108) 115 (123) sts.

BOR is after the 6th picked-up st.

Work stockinette until the sleeve measures 14 cm from the armhole, while also making 2 decreases every 8th rnd by: k2tog after the first st of the rnd, and k2togtbl before the last st of the rnd, in total 4 times = 71 (74) 82 (86) 91 (99) 100 (100) 107 (115) sts in total.

Purl 1 rnd (to shape the folded edge).

Knit 10 rnds.

Bind off loosely.

Repeat this for the other sleeve.

**Assembly:**

Fold the edges along the purl rnd, to shape the folded edge for the neckline, sleeves and lower body. Sew the bound-off edge with loose sts to the WS (so the edge becomes stretchy).

Weave in all ends.

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
