GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller needles in stocking st.

Sizes 6 mm (U.S. 10) and 6.5 mm (U.S. 10½) circular knitting needles 40" (100 cm) long.
 Size 6 mm (U.S. 10) circular knitting needle 24" (60 cm) long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

SIZES

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

BODY

Note: When working from charts, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work, but never over more than 5 sts. When it must pass over more than 5 sts, weave it loosely over and under color in use on WS.

With larger circular needle and MC, cast on **180 (228-264)** sts. Join in rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker on first st for beg of rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing until work from beg measures 3" [7.5 cm].

Change to smaller circular needle.

Knit 1 rnd.

Knit Chart I to end of chart, reading rows from **right** to left, noting 12-st rep will be worked **15 (19-22)** times.

Chart I is shown below

Next rnd: With MC, knit.

Next rnd: *K**13 (17-20)**. K2tog. Rep from * around. **168 (216-252)** sts.

Knit Chart II to end of chart, reading rows from **right** to left, noting 12-st rep will be worked **14 (18-21)** times.

Chart II is shown below.

Next rnd: With MC, knit.

Next rnd: *K**12 (16-19)**. K2tog. Rep from * around. **156 (204-240)** sts.

Next 3 rnds: With B, knit.

Next rnd: *K**11 (15-18)**. K2tog. Rep from * around. **144 (192-228)** sts.

Next rnd: Knit.

Knit Chart III to end of chart, reading rows from **right** to left, noting 12-st will be worked **12 (16-19)** times. **72 (96-114)** sts.

Chart III is shown below.

Sizes L/2XL and 3/5XL only: **Next rnd:** With MC, *K2tog. K(**10-17**). Rep from * around. **(88-108)** sts.

Knit **(1-2)** rnd(s).

Next rnd: *K2tog. K(**20-7**). Rep from * around. **(84-96)** sts.

All sizes: Change to shorter needle and with MC, work in (K3. P3) ribbing for 7" [18 cm]. Cast off in ribbing. **BERNAT**

Note: When working from charts, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work, but never over more than 5 sts. When it must pass over more than 5 sts, weave it loosely over and under color in use on WS.

BACK

With MC and smaller needles, cast on **69 (75-81-93-99-117)** sts.

1st row: (RS). K3. *P3. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P3. *K3. P3. Rep from * to end of row. Rep last 2 rows of (K3. P3) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row and inc **2 (2-4-0-4-2)** sts evenly across last row. **71 (77-85-93-103-119)** sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st for 2 rows.

Work Chart I in stocking st, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right until row 74 of chart is complete.

Chart I is shown on page 5.

Shape raglans: Keeping cont of chart, cast off **2 (2-3-3-4-4)** sts beg next 2 rows. **67 (73-79-87-95-111)** sts.

Size 4/5XL only: Dec 1 st each end of next 16 rows. 79 sts. Chart I is complete.

Sizes XS/S, M, L, XL and 2/3XL only: Dec 1 st each end of next 3 rows. Work 1 row even from chart. Rep last 4 rows **1 (3-3-3-3)** time(s) more. **55 (49-55-63-71)** sts.

Sizes M, L, XL and 2/3XL only: Chart I is complete.

Size XS/S only: Dec 1 st each end of next row and following alt rows 3 times more. 47 sts. Chart I is complete.

All sizes: Cont in Stripe Pat (4 rows with C, 4 rows with MC) to end of work as follows:

Size L only: Dec 1 st each end of next 2 rows. 51 sts.

Sizes XL and 2/3XL only: Dec 1 st each end of next 3 rows.

Work 1 row even.

Rep last 4 rows **(3-6)** times more. **(39-29)** sts.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Dec 1 st each end of next and every following alt row **10 (11-11-5)** times more. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem **25 (25-27-27)** sts.

Size 4/5XL only: Dec 1 st each end of next 15 rows. 49 sts.

Work 1 row even.

Dec 1 st each end of next 3 rows.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. 31 sts.

Work 1 row even.

Dec 1 st each end of next row. 29 sts.

Work 1 row even.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Cast off rem 29 sts.

LEFT FRONT

With MC and smaller needles, cast on **33 (39-45-45-51-57) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K3. P3. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

2nd row: P3. *K3. P3. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K3. P3) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row and inc **2 (dec 1-dec 3-inc 1-inc 0-inc 2)** st(s) evenly across last row. **35 (38-42-46-51-59)** sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st for 2 rows.**

Work Chart I in stocking st, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right until row 74 of chart is complete.

Shape raglan: Keeping cont of chart, cast off **2 (2-3-3-4-4)** sts beg next row. **33 (36-39-43-47-55)** sts.

Wok 1 row even from chart.

Size 4/5XL only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge of next 16 rows. 39 sts. Chart I is complete.

Sizes XS/S, M, L, XL and 2/3XL only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 3 rows.

Work 1 row even from chart.

Rep last 4 rows **1 (3-3-3-3)** time(s) more. **27 (24-27-31-35)** sts.

Sizes M, L, XL and 2/3XL only: Chart I is complete.

Size XS/S only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge of next row.

Work 1 row even from chart.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. 23 sts.

Chart I is complete.

All sizes: Cont in Stripe Pat (4 rows with C, 4 rows with MC) to end of work as follows:

Sizes XL and 2/3XL: Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next 3 rows.

Work 1 row even.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. **(22-26)** sts.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 2 rows. **(20-24)** sts.

Size L only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge only on next 2 rows. 25 sts.

Sizes XS/S, M and L only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next and every following alt row **3 (3-4)** times more. **19 (19-20)** sts.

Work 1 row even.

Size 4/5XL only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 14 rows. 25 sts.

All sizes: Shape neck edge: Next row: (RS). Work 2tog. Knit to last 6 (6-7-7-8-8) sts. Cast off rem 6 (6-7-7-8-8) sts.
Rejoin yarn to rem sts and purl 1 row.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: 1st row: (RS). Work 2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. 4 sts.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge only on next and following alt row. 2 sts.

Next row: P2.

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). Work 2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

2nd row: Purl to last 2 sts. Work 2tog.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows once more. (5-6) sts.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge only on next 3 rows. (2-3) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Size 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). Work 2tog. K1.

2nd row: P2.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Left Front.

Work Chart I in stocking st, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right until row 75 of chart is complete.

Shape raglan: Keeping cont of chart, cast off 2 (2-3-3-4-4) sts beg next row. 33 (36-39-43-47-55) sts.

Size 4/5XL only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge of next 16 rows. 39 sts.

Chart I is complete.

Sizes XS/S, M, L, XL and 2/3XL only:

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 3 rows.

Work 1 row even from chart.

Rep last 4 rows 1 (3-3-3-3) time(s) more.

27 (24-27-31-35) sts.

Sizes M, L, XL and 2/3XL only: Chart I is complete.

Size XS/S only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge of next row.

Work 1 row even from chart.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. 23 sts. Chart I is complete.

All sizes: Cont in Stripe Pat (4 rows with C, 4 rows with MC) to end of work as follows:

Sizes XL and 2/3XL only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 3 rows.

Work 1 row even.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. (22-26) sts.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 2 rows. (20-24) sts.

Sizes XS/S, M and L only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge of next and every following alt row 3 (4-4) times more. Work 1 row even. 19 (19-20) sts.

Size 4/5XL only: Dec 1 st at raglan edge on next 14 rows. 25 sts.

All sizes: Shape neck edge:

Next row: (RS). Cast off 6 (6-7-7-8-8) sts. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Purl 1 row.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: 1st row: (RS). Work 2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. 4 sts.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge only on next and following alt row. 2 sts.

Next row: P2.

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS).

Work 2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

2nd row: P2tog. Purl to end of row.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows once more. (5-6) sts.

Dec 1 st at raglan edge only on next 3 rows. (2-3) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Size 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). K1. K2tog.

2nd row: P2.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

With MC and smaller needles, cast on 39 (39-39-45-45-45) sts.

Work 3" [7.5 cm] in (K3. P3) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a 2nd row and inc 4 (4-6-2-4-4) sts evenly across last row. 43 (43-45-47-49-49) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st for 2 rows.

Work Chart II in stocking st, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right and noting side incs on every following 11th (9th-7th-7th-5th-5th) row 3 (4-1-1-2-5) time(s) more, then every following 12th (10th-8th-8th-6th-6th) row from previous inc 2 (2-6-6-8-6) times more. 55 (57-61-63-71-73) sts.

Chart II is shown on page 6.

Cont working even from Chart II until row 74 of chart is complete.

Shape raglans: Keeping cont of chart, cast off **2 (2-3-3-4-4)** sts beg next 2 rows. **51 (53-55-57-63-65)** sts.

Dec 1 st each end of next 3 rows.

Work 1 row even from chart.

Rep last 4 rows **2 (2-2-1-1-1)** time(s) more. **33 (35-37-45-51-53)** sts.

Dec 1 st each end of next row.

Work 1 row even from chart.

Rep last 2 rows **1 (1-1-3-3-3)** time(s) more. **29 (31-33-37-43-45)** sts. Chart II is complete.

Cont in Stripe Pat to end of work (4 rows C, 4 rows MC), dec 1 st each end of next row and every following alt row **10 (11-12-13-14-14)** times more. Cast off rem **7 (7-7-9-13-15)** sts.

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Sew raglan seams.

Front Edging: With RS facing, smaller needles and MC, pick up and knit **76 (78-80-82-82-84)** sts evenly up front edge from cast on edge to beg of neck shaping. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep on opposite side.

Collar: With smaller needles and MC, cast on **6 (6-7-7-8-8)** sts.

Work in garter st (knit every row), inc 1 st each end of next and every following alt row 4 times more and noting 1st row is WS. **16 (16-17-17-18-18)** sts.

Inc 1 st at beg only (outer edge) of next row and every following alt row 7 times more. **24 (24-25-25-26-26)** sts.


Cont even in garter st until Collar (when slightly stretched) measures **16 (16-16½-16½-17-17)" [40.5 (40.5-42-42-43-43) cm]**.

Dec 1 st at outer edge only on next row and every following alt row 7 times more. **16 (16-17-17-18-18)** sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next row and every following alt row 4 times more. Cast off rem **6 (6-7-7-8-8)** sts.

Sew inner edge of Collar to neck edge, having cast on and cast off edges of Collar along cast off sts of Fronts.

Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew zipper in position under front edge. **BERNAT**






SIZES

Hat: One size to fit average lady's head.

Scarf: Approx 6" x 60" [15 x 152.5 cm] excluding fringe.

GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with 6 mm (U.S. 10) needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: When working from chart, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work but never over more than 5 sts. When it must pass over more than 5 sts, weave it loosely over and under color in use on WS.

HAT

With B and set of 4 smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 72 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 3 needles. Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.

1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: *K1below. P1. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: *K1. P1below. Rep from * around. Rep last 2 rnds until work from beg measures 2" [5 cm], ending on a 3rd rnd.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

Knit Chart to end of chart, reading rows from **right** to left, noting 12-st rep will be worked 6 times.

Chart is shown on page 2.

Hat: Set of 4 sizes 5.5 mm (U.S. 9) and 6 mm (U.S. 10) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Scarf: Size 6 mm (U.S. 10) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Shape top: 1st rnd: With A, *K2tog. K14. ssk. Rep from * around. 64 sts.
2nd rnd: With C, knit.
3rd rnd: With C, *K2tog. K12. ssk. Rep from * around. 56 sts.
4th rnd: With A, knit.
5th rnd: With A, *K2tog. K10. ssk. Rep from * around. 48 sts.
6th rnd: With C, knit.
7th rnd: With C, *K2tog. K8. ssk. Rep from * around. 40 sts.
8th rnd: With MC, knit.
9th rnd: With B, *K2tog. K6. ssk. Rep from * around. 32 sts.
10th rnd: With MC, knit.
11th rnd: With B, *K2tog. K4. ssk. Rep from * around. 24 sts.
12th rnd: With MC, knit.
13th rnd: With B, *K2tog. K2. ssk. Rep from * around. 16 sts.
 Break B, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts and fasten securely.

SCARF


Note: Do not break MC, carry along side of Scarf.

With pair of needles and MC, cast on 24 sts.
1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: *K1 below. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd and 4th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows once more.
5th to 8th rows: With B, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more. Break B.
9th to 12th rows: With MC, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more.
13th to 16th rows: With A, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more. Break A.
17th to 20th rows: With MC, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more.
21st to 24th rows: With C, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more. Break C.
 These 1st to 24th rows form Stripe Pat.


Cont in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx 60" [152.5 cm], ending with 4 rows of MC. Cast off in ribbing.

Fringe: Cut lengths of A, B and C 15" [38 cm] long. Taking 3 strands each of A, B and C tog, knot into fringe across ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly. **BERNAT**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: When working from charts, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work but never more than over 5 sts. When it must pass over more than 5 sts, weave it under and over color in use.

BODY

Note: Body is worked in one piece to armholes. With MC and smaller circular needle, cast on **150** (162-174-194-218-242) sts. **Do not join.** Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2. Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2½" [6 cm], ending on a 2nd row and inc **1** (1-3-1-1-3) st(s) evenly across last row. **151** (163-177-195-219-245) sts.

Change to larger circular needle and work 4 rows stocking st, inc 12 sts evenly across last WS row. **163** (175-189-207-231-257) sts.

Work Chart I in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, noting 6-st rep will be worked **26** (28-31-34-38-42) times.

Chart I is shown on page 5.

Next row: (WS). With MC, purl dec 12 sts evenly across. **151** (163-177-195-219-245) sts.

Work a further 30 rows in stocking st, inc **13** (14-13-14-14-14) sts evenly across last WS row. **164** (177-190-209-233-259) sts.

Work Chart II in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, noting 13-st rep will be worked **12** (13-14-15-17-19) times.

Chart II is shown on page 5.

With MC, purl 1 row, dec 13 sts evenly across last WS row. **151** (164-177-196-220-246) sts.

Divide for armholes: Next row: (RS). With MC, **K32** (34-36-39-47-51). Cast off next **12** (14-16-20-16-20) sts. **K63** (68-73-78-94-104) (including st on needle after cast off). Cast off next **12** (14-16-20-16-20) sts. **K32** (34-36-39-47-51) (including st on needle after cast off).

Left Front: Cont on last **32** (34-36-39-47-51) sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Purl 1 row.

Next row: Cast off (8-10) sts. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog (front edge). (38-40) sts.

All sizes: Beg with a **purl** row, work Chart III in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, working decs as follows:

Chart III is shown on page 5.

Dec row: K2. K2tog (armhole edge). Work chart to last 2 sts. K2tog (front edge).

20 (21-22-25-25-26) sts rem at end of chart.

Next row: (WS). With MC, purl.

Sizes XS/S, M and L only: **Next row:** K2. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows once more. **18** (19-20) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: **Next row:** K2. K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows (1-1-0) time(s) more. (21-21-24) sts.

All sizes: Dec 1 st at front edge only on following 4th rows until **14** (14-15-16-16-20) sts rem.

Cont even until armhole measures **8½** (9-9-9½-9½-10) " [21.5 (23-23-24-24-25.5) cm], ending with a purl row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **7** (7-7-8-8-10) sts beg next row. Purl 1 row. Cast off rem **7** (7-8-8-8-10) sts.

Back: With WS facing, join MC to **63** (68-73-78-94-104) sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: **Next row:** Cast off (8-10) sts. Purl to end of row. (86-94) sts.

Next row: Cast off (8-10) sts. Knit to end of row. (78-84) sts.

All sizes: Beg with a **purl** row, work Chart IV in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, dec **0** (1-0-1-1-1) st in center of first row and working decs as follows:

Chart IV is shown on page 5.

Dec row: K2. K2tog (armhole edge). Work chart to last 4 sts. ssk. K2 (armhole edge). **53** (55-59-63-63-69) sts rem at end of chart.

Next row: (WS). With MC, purl.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: **Next row:** K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows (1-1-0) time(s) more. (59-59-67) sts.

All sizes: Cont even until armhole measures same length as Left Front to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with a purl row.

Shape shoulders: Cast off **7** (7-7-8-8-10) sts beg next 2 rows, then **7** (7-8-8-8-10) sts beg following 2 rows. Cast off rem **25** (27-29-27-27-27) sts.

Right Front: Cont on last **32 (34-36-39-47-51)** sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Next row: Cast off **(8-10)** sts. Purl to end of row.

Next row: K2tog (front edge). Knit to end of row. **(38-40)** sts.

Change to larger needles and work 4 rows in stocking st, inc 6 sts evenly across last WS row. **49 (51-51-53-53-55)** sts.

Work Chart VI in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, noting 6-st rep will be worked 8 times and working inc at each end of 5th row. **51 (53-53-55-55-57)** sts.

Chart VI is shown on page 6.

Next row: (WS). With MC, purl, dec 6 sts evenly across. **45 (47-47-49-49-51)** sts.

Work **2 (2-2-0-0-0)** row(s) in stocking st.

Inc 1 st each end of next and every following **12th (12th-12th-10th-10th-8th)** row until there are **51 (53-53-57-57-59)** sts.

Beg with a purl row, work **9 (9-9-3-3-5)** rows even, inc 6 sts evenly across last WS row. **57 (59-59-63-63-65)** sts.

Work Chart VII in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, noting 13-st rep will be worked 4 times.

Chart VII is shown on page 6.

Next row: With MC, purl dec **4 (4-4-4-4-2)** sts evenly across. **53 (55-55-59-59-63)** sts.

Shape top: Cast off **3 (4-4-5-5-5)** sts beg next 2 rows. **47 (47-47-49-49-53)** sts.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Next row: Knit.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Next row: K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2. **(47-51)** sts.

All sizes: Beg with a **purl** row, work Chart VIII in stocking st to end of chart, reading **knit** rows from **right** to left and **purl** rows from **left** to right, noting 6-st rep will be worked 5 times and working decs as follows:

Chart VIII is shown on page 6.

Dec row: K2. K2tog (armhole edge). Work chart to last 4 sts. ssk. K2 (armhole edge). **33 (33-33-35-33-37)** sts rem at end of chart.

Next row: (WS). With MC, purl.

Next row: K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2. Rep last 2 rows **4 (6-6-7-6-6)** times more. **23 (19-19-19-19-23)** sts rem.

Next row: (WS). P2. P2togtbl. Purl to last 4 sts. P2tog. P2.

Next row: K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2. Rep last 2 rows **2 (1-1-1-1-2)** time(s) more. 11 sts rem. Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Button Band and Collar: With MC and smaller circular needle, cast on 26 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2. Keeping cont of (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 1 st each end of next 20 rows, taking inc sts into ribbing. 66 sts.

Next row: Inc 1 st in first st. Rib across 14 sts. (K1. M1. K1. P2) 8 times. K1. M1. K1. Rib to last st. Inc 1 st in last st. 77 sts.

Cont in ribbing, inc 1 st each each end of next 4 rows. 85 sts.

Cast on 3 sts beg next 8 rows. 109 sts. Place markers at each end of last row.




With MC and smaller circular needle, cast on **162** (174-192-204-234-258) sts. Join in rnd, placing a marker on first st.

1st rnd: *K3. P3. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd twice more, dec **8** (6-10-8-10-6) sts evenly around last rnd. **154** (168-182-196-224-252) sts.

Change to larger circular needle and proceed as follows:

Work Chart III in stocking st to end of chart, reading rows from **right** to left and noting 14-st rep will be worked **11** (12-13-14-16-18) times.

Chart III is shown on page 4.

Next rnd: With MC, *ssk. K**73** (80-87-94-108-122). K2tog. Rep from * once more. **150** (164-178-192-220-248) sts.

Knit **24** (24-24-24-42-42) rnds.

Next rnd: *ssk. K**71** (78-85-92-106-120). K2tog. Rep from * once more. **146** (160-174-188-216-244) sts.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Knit 24 rnds.

Sizes XS/S and M only: **Next rnd:** *ssk. K**69** (76). K2tog. Rep from * once more. **142** (156) sts.

Sizes L and XL only: ssk. K(85-92). K2tog. Knit to end of rnd. (172-186) sts.

All sizes: **142** (156-172-186-216-244) sts. Cont even until work from beg measures 18" [45.5 cm].

Next rnd: K6 (6-6-8-8-10). Slip these 6 (6-6-8-8-10) sts onto a st holder. K71 (78-86-93-108-122). Slip last 6 (6-6-8-8-10) sts just knit onto a st holder. Knit to end of rnd. Leave sts on a spare needle.

SLEEVES

Cuff: With MC and set of 4 smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 48 (48-54-54-60-60) sts. Join in rnd, placing a marker on first st. Work 3 rnds in (K3. P3) ribbing as given for Body.

Change to larger set of double-pointed needles and proceed as follows:

Next rnd: With A, knit.

Next rnd: With MC, knit.

Work Chart IV in stocking st to end of chart, reading rows from **right** to left, noting 6-st rep will be worked 8 (8-9-9-10-10) times.

Chart IV is shown on page 4.

Next rnd: With MC, knit.

Next rnd: With A, knit.

Next rnd: With MC, knit.

Next rnd: (folding rnd). With MC, purl.

Push work inside out to reverse RS and WS for cuff turnback.

With MC, knit in rnds, inc 1 st each end of rnd on 4th and every following 14th (14th-12th-12th-10th-10th) rnd until there are 56 (56-64-64-72-72) sts.

Cont even until work from folding rnd measures 16" [40.5 cm].

Next rnd: K3 (3-3-4-4-5). Slip these 3 (3-3-4-4-5) sts onto a st holder. Knit to end of rnd. Slip last 3 (3-3-4-4-5) sts just knit onto first st holder. 6 (6-6-8-8-10) sts on st holder. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Rep last 2 rnds for "Mistake" Ribbing Pat for 3" [7.5 cm].

Next rnd: Knit, inc 2 sts evenly around. 34 sts.**

Change to 5 mm (U.S. 8) double-pointed needles and work Chart I, reading rnds from **right** to left until 6th row of chart is complete. *Chart I is shown on page 3.*

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: Work 7th row of chart across first 18 sts. Pm. Inc 1 st in each of next 2 sts. Pm. Work chart to end of rnd.

2nd rnd: Work Chart I to first marker. Slm. Work 1st row of Chart II. Slm. Work Chart I to end of rnd.

3rd rnd: Work Chart I to first marker. Slm. Inc 1 st in next st. Work 2nd row of Chart II. Inc 1 st in next st. Slm. Work Chart I to end of rnd. *Chart II is shown on page 3.*

4th rnd: Work even in pat.

Keeping cont of charts, rep last 2 rnds to 10 sts between markers.



3rd rnd: Work Chart III to first marker. Slm. Inc 1 st in next st. Work 2nd row of Chart II. Inc 1 st in next st. Slm. Work Chart III to end of rnd.

Charts II and III are now in position.

4th rnd: Work even in pat.

Keeping cont of charts, rep last 2 rnds to 10 sts between markers.

HAT

With MC and set of four size 5.5 mm (U.S. 9) smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 72 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 3 needles. Join in rnd, placing marker at first st.

1st rnd: *K1. P2. K1. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: *P2. K2. Rep from * around.

Rep last 2 rnds for "Mistake" Ribbing Pat for 5" [12.5 cm].

Change to 6 mm (U.S. 10) double-pointed needles and knit in rnds for 3" [7.5 cm], inc 3 sts evenly across last rnd. 75 sts.

Knit Chart IV to end of chart, reading rnds from **right** to left and noting 15-st rep will be worked 5 times. Break A and B.

Chart IV is shown on page 3.

Next rnd: With MC, knit, dec 3 sts evenly around. 72 sts.

Shape top: 1st rnd: *K2tog. K14. ssk. Rep from * around. 64 sts.

Knit 2 rnds even.

Next rnd: *K2tog. K12. ssk. Rep from * around. 56 sts.

Knit 2 rnds even.

Next rnd: *K2tog. K10. ssk. Rep from * around. 48 sts.

Knit 2 rnds even.

Next rnd: *K2tog. K8. ssk. Rep from * around. 40 sts.

Knit 2 rnds even.

Next rnd: *K2tog. K6. ssk. Rep from * around. 32 sts.

Knit 2 rnds even.

Next rnd: *K2tog, K4, ssk. Rep from * around.
24 sts.



INSTRUCTIONS**CARDIGAN**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

BACK

With smaller needle, cast on **72 (79-86-93-100-121)** sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). P2. *K5. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: K2. *P5. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K5. P2) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row.

Next row: (RS). P2. *K2. M1. K3. P2. Rep from * to end of row. **82 (90-98-106-114-138)** sts.

Next row: K2. *(P1. K1) 3 times. K2. P6. K2. Rep from * to last **0 (8-0-8-0-8)** sts. (K1. P1) **0 (3-0-3-0-3)** times. **K0 (2-0-2-0-2)**.

Change to larger needle and proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). P2. *C6B. P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. P2. Rep from * to last **0 (8-0-8-0-8)** sts. (C6B. P2) **0 (1-0-1-0-1)** time.

2nd row: **K0 (2-0-2-0-2)**. **P0 (6-0-6-0-6)** K2. *(P1. K1) 3 times. K2. P6. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: P2. *K6. P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. K2. Rep from * to last **0 (8-0-8-0-8)** sts. (K6. P2) **0 (1-0-1-0-1)** time.

4th to 11th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times more.

12th row: As 2nd row.

13th row: P2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. P2. C6B. P2. Rep from * last **0 (8-0-8-0-8)** sts. (K1. P1) **0 (3-0-3-0-3)** times. **P0 (2-0-2-0-2)**.

14th row: **K0 (2-0-2-0-2)**. **P0 (6-0-6-0-6)** K2. *P6. K2. (P1. K1) 3 times. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

15th row: P2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. P2. K6. P2. Rep from * to last **0 (8-0-8-0-8)** sts. (K1. P1) **0 (3-0-3-0-3)** times. **P0 (2-0-2-0-2)**.

16th to 23rd rows: As 14th and 15th rows 4 times more.

24th row: As 14th row.

Rep 1st to 24th rows for pat until work from beg measures 14" [35.5 cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape sleeves: Cont in pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on next 7 rows, then every following alt row 3 times more, taking inc sts into pat. **102 (110-118-126-134-158)** sts.

Next row: (WS). Work even in pat.

Cast on **9 (11-11-11-11-7)** sts beg next 4 rows, taking inc sts into pat. **138 (154-162-170-178-186)** sts. Place mark at end of row.

Cont even in pat until work from marked row measures **8 (8 ½-8 ½-9-9-10)" [20.5 (21.5-21.5-23-23-25.5) cm]**, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders: Cast off **17 (19-21-21-23-24)** sts beg next 4 rows, then **17 (18-21-22-23-23)** sts beg following 2 rows.

Leave rem **36 (42-36-42-40-44)** sts on a st holder.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller needle, cast on **37 (37-44-44-51-58) sts.

1st row: (RS). P2. *K5. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: K2. *P5. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K7. P2) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row.

Next row: (RS). P2. *K2. M1. K3. P2. Rep from * to end of row. **42 (42-50-50-58-66)** sts.**

Next row: K2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. K2. P6. K2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. (K1. P1)

3 (3-0-0-3-0) times. **K2 (2-0-0-2-0)**.

Change to larger needle and proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). P2 (**2-0-0-2-0**). (K1. P1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. P2. *C6B. P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: K2. *(P1. K1) 3 times. K2. P6. K2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. (P1. K1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. **K2 (2-0-0-2-0)**.

3rd row: P2 (**2-0-0-2-0**). (K1. P1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. P2. *K6. P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. P2.

Rep from * to end of row.

4th to 11th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times more.

12th row: As 2nd row.

13th row: P2 (**2-0-0-2-0**). (C6B) **1 (1-0-0-1-0)** time. P2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. P2. C6B. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

14th row: K2. *P6. K2. (P1. K1) 3 times. K2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. **P6 (6-0-0-6-0)**. **K2 (2-0-0-2-0)**.

15th row: P2 (**2-0-0-2-0**). **K6 (6-0-0-6-0)**. P2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. P2. K6. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

16th to 23rd rows: As 14th and 15th rows 4 times more.

24th row: As 14th row.

Rep 1st to 24th rows for pat until work from beg measures 14" [35.5 cm], ending with a RS row.

Shape front placket: 1st row: (WS). Cast off 16 sts. Pat to end of row. **26 (26-34-34-42-50)** sts.

Shape neck edge and sleeve: Cont in pat, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Inc 1 st in first st. Pat to end of row.

2nd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. **32 (32-40-40-48-56)** sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Inc 1 st in first st. Pat to end of row.

2nd row: Work even in pat.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. **36 (36-44-44-52-60)** sts.

Next row: (RS). Cast on **9 (11-11-11-11-7)** sts. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Work even in pat.

Rep last 2 rows once more. **54 (58-66-66-74-74)** sts. Place marker at end of last row.

Next row: (RS). Pat to last 3 sts. Work 2tog. K1.

Work **12 (16-12-16-6-12)** rows even in pat.

Rep last **14 (18-14-18-8-14)** rows **2 (1-2-1-4-2)** time(s) more. **51 (56-63-64-69-71)** sts.

Cont even in pat until work from marked row measures **8 (8½-8½-9-9-10)**" [20.5 (21.5-21.5-23-23-25.5) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **17 (19-21-21-23-24)** sts beg of next and following alt row.

Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem **17 (18-21-22-23-23)** sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Left Front.

Next row: K2 (2-0-0-2-0). (K1. P1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. K2. *P6. K2. (K1. P1) 3 times. K2.

Rep from * to end of row.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). P2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. P2. C6B. P2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. (K1. P1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. P2 (2-0-0-2-0).

2nd row: K2 (2-0-0-2-0). (P1. K1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. K2. *P6. K2. (P1. K1) 3 times. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: P2. *(K1. P1) 3 times. P2. K6. P2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. (K1. P1) **3 (3-0-0-3-0)** times. P2 (2-0-0-2-0).

4th to 11th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times more.

12th row: As 2nd row.

13th row: P2. *C6B. P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. P2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. (C6B) **1 (1-0-0-1-0)** time. P2 (2-0-0-2-0).

14th row: K2 (2-0-0-2-0). P6 (6-0-0-6-0). K2. *(P1. K1) 3 times. K2. P6. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

15th row: P2. *K6. P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. P2. Rep from * to last **8 (8-0-0-8-0)** sts. K6 (0-0-0-6-0). P2 (2-0-0-2-0).

16th to 23rd rows: As 14th and 15th rows 4 times more.

24th row: As 14th row.

Rep 1st to 24th rows for pat until work from beg measures 14" [35.5 cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape front placket: 1st row: (RS). Cast off 16 sts. Pat to end of row. **26 (26-34-34-42-50)** sts.

Work 1 row even.

Shape neck edge and sleeve: Cont in pat, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Pat to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.

2nd row: Inc 1 st in first st. Pat to end of row. Rep last 2 rows twice more. **32 (32-40-40-48-56)** sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Pat to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.

2nd row: Work even in pat.

Rep last 2 rows twice more, then 1st row once. **36 (36-44-44-52-60)** sts.

Next row: (WS). Cast on **9 (11-11-11-11-7)** sts. Pat to end of row.

Next row: Work even in pat.

Rep last 2 rows once more. **54 (58-66-66-74-74)** sts.

Work 1 row even. Place marker at end of last row.

Next row: (RS). K1. Work 2tog. Pat to end of row.

Work **12 (16-12-16-6-12)** rows even in pat.

Rep last 2 rows **14 (18-14-18-8-14)** rows **2 (1-2-1-4-2)** time(s) more. **51 (56-63-64-69-71)** sts.

Cont even in pat until work from marked row measures **8 (8½-8½-9-9-10)**" [20.5 (21.5-21.5-23-23-22.5) cm], ending with a RS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **17 (19-21-21-23-24)** sts beg of next and following alt row.

Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem **17 (18-21-22-23-23)** sts.

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sleeve bands: Sew shoulder seams. With RS facing and smaller needle, pick up and knit **63 (69-69-75-75-81)** sts across side edge between markers.

1st row: (RS). K3. *P3. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P3. *K3. P3. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K3. P3) ribbing for 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row. Cast off in rib.

Collar: With RS facing and smaller needle, beg at front placket cast off, pick up and knit **47 (48-50-51-51-53)** sts up right front neck edge. K**36 (42-36-42-40-44)** from back st holder, dec **1 (3-1-3-1-3)** st(s) evenly across. Pick up and knit **47 (48-50-51-51-53)** sts down left front neck edge to front placket cast off. **129 (135-135-141-141-147)** sts.

Work in (K3. P3) ribbing as given for Sleeve Bands until work measures same length as cast off edge of front placket, ending on a 2nd row. Leave sts on a spare needle.

Sew side edges of Collar and cast off edges of fronts tog. Cont as follows:

Front and Collar edging: With RS facing and smaller needle, pick up and knit 72 sts up right front edge. Rib **129 (135-135-141-141-147)** Collar sts. Pick up and knit 72 sts down left front edge. **273 (279-279-285-285-291)** sts.

Work in (K3, P3) ribbing as given for Sleeve Bands for 1½" [4 cm], ending on a 2nd row. Cast off in rib.

Belt: With smaller needle, cast on 9 sts.

1st row: (RS). (K1, P1) 4 times. K1.

2nd row: K2. (P1, K1) 3 times. K1.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 65" [165 cm], ending on a 2nd row. Cast off in rib.

Belt loops: (make 2). With smaller needle, cast on 12 sts. Cast off.

Try on Cardigan. Tie belt. Sew belt loops in position.

BERET

With set of 4 smaller needles, cast on 64 sts. Join in rnd, placing marker at first st.

1st rnd: *K2, P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K2, P2) ribbing for 1½" [4 cm].

Next rnd: *K2, M1, P2, M1. Rep from * around. 96 sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

Chart is shown on page 5.

1st rnd: *P2, C6B, P2, (K1, P1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: *P2, K6, P2, (P1, K1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: *P2, K6, P2, (K1, P1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

4th to 9th rnds: As 2nd and 3rd rnds 3 times more.

10th rnd: As 2nd rnd.



11th rnd: *P2, (P1, K1) 3 times, P2, C6B. Rep from * around.

12th rnd: *P2, (K1, P1) 3 times, P2, K6. Rep from * around.

13th rnd: *P2, (P1, K1) 3 times, P2, K6. Rep from * around.

14th to 19th rnds: As 12th and 13th rnds 3 times more.

20th rnd: As 12th rnd.

21st to 29th rnds: As 1st to 9th rnds once more.

Shape top: 1st rnd: *P2, ssk, K2, K2tog, P2, (P1, K1) 3 times. Rep from * around. 84 sts.

2nd rnd: *P2, (P1, K1) twice, P2, C6B. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: *P2, (K1, P1) twice, P2, K6. Rep from * around.

4th rnd: *P2, (P1, K1) twice, P2, ssk, K2, K2tog. Rep from * around. 72 sts.

5th rnd: *P2, (K1, P1) twice, P2, K4. Rep from * around.

6th rnd: *P2, (P1, K1) twice, P2, K4. Rep from * around.

7th rnd: *P2tog, (K1, P1) twice, P2tog, K4. Rep from * around. 60 sts.

8th rnd: *P1, (P1, K1) twice, P1, K4. Rep from * around.

9th rnd: *P1, (K1, P1) twice, P1, K4. Rep from * around.

10th rnd: *P2, K1, P2tog, P1, K2, K2tog. Rep from * around. 48 sts.

11th rnd: *(P1, K1) twice, P1, K3. Rep from * around.

12th rnd: *C4B, (P1, K1) twice. Rep from * around.

13th rnd: *ssk, K2, P2tog, K1, P1. Rep from * around. 36 sts.



14th rnd: *K4, P1, K1. Rep from * around.

15th rnd: *K3, P1, K1, P1. Rep from * around.


16th rnd: *ssk, K1, P2tog, K1. Rep from * around. 24 sts.

17th rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 12 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long tail. Draw tail through rem sts and fasten securely.

Pom-pom: Wind yarn around piece of cardboard 5" [12.5 cm] wide 100 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to Beret. Cut loops at both ends and trim to smooth round shape. Sew to center of Beret. **BERNAT**
