## Cardigan

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## Sizes

XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL), {3XL, 4XL, 5XL, 6XL}; to fit bust 28-30 (32-34, 36-38, 40-42, 44-46, 48-50), {52-54, 56-58, 60-62, 64-66}"/70-75 (80-85, 90-95, 100-105, 110-115, 120-125), {130-135, 140-145, 150-155, 160-165} cm.

## Finished Measurements

41½ (44½, 49, 53¼, 58, 61), {66½, 70, 74¼, 78}"/104 (111.5, 122.5, 133, 145, 152.5), {166.5, 166.5, 185.5, 195} cm bust circumference.

Shown in size M (49"/122.5 cm) on 38"/95 cm bust with 11"/27.5 cm of positive ease.

## Yarn

Sport weight yarn (approximate amounts): 1000 (1090, 1200, 1310, 1440, 1510), {1640, 1720, 1840, 1930} yds/ 910 (992, 1092, 1192, 1310, 1374), {1492, 1565, 1674, 1756} m.

Miss Babs Laurel Falls (100% Superwash Shaniko Merino Wool; 300 yards/275 m in 3.5 oz/100 g), Mustard Seed: 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5), {6, 6, 7, 7} skeins.

## Needles

Sizes US 4/3.5 mm: 24-32"/60-80 cm circular.

Size US 3/3.25 mm: 24-32"/60-80 cm circular and set of double-pointed.

Optional: second US 3/3.25 mm 24-32"/60-80 cm circular for the Tubular Bind Off.

Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain gauge.

## Notions

Stitch markers, waste yarn, tapestry needle, 7 (7, 7, 7, 6, 6), {6, 6, 6, 6} buttons 5/8"/15 mm in diameter.

## Gauge

23 stitches and 32 rows = 4"/10 cm in Stockinette Stitch on size US 4/3.5 mm needle, after blocking.

21 stitches and 32 rows = 4"/10 cm in charted pattern on size US 4/3.5 mm needle, after blocking.

## Notes

- This cardigan is worked from the top down in one piece. The back and the fronts are worked separately down to the armholes and then joined.
- Stitches for sleeves are picked up around the armholes and sleeves are worked in the round from the top down.
- The German Short-Row method is used in this pattern. Knitters may substitute for the preferred short-row method.
- Circular needles are used for accommodating the large number of stitches.
- Read RS (odd-numbered) chart rows from right to left; read WS (even-numbered) chart rows from left to right.
- The "right" or "left" directions always refer to wearer's right or left, rather than the piece in relation to you when are knitting.

## Stitch Guide

### Stockinette stitch

RS rows and all rounds: Knit.

WS rows: Purl.

**Inv-R (Invisible Increase Right):** Insert tip of right needle into right leg of stitch below first stitch on left needle from back to front, lifting this stitch up onto left needle tip. Knit the lifted stitch, then slip the original stitch purlwise with yarn in back – 1 right-leaning stitch increased.

**Inv-L (Invisible Increase Left):** Slip stitch purlwise with yarn in back, insert tip of left needle into the left leg of stitch in the row below the stitch just slipped to right needle, from back to front, lifting this stitch up onto left needle tip (the lifted stitch will sit on left needle in the wrong orientation). Knit the lifted stitch through the back loop – 1 left-leaning stitch increased.

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## Glossary

<b>K</b>	Knit	<b>RS</b>	Right Side
<b>K2TOG</b>	Knit 2 stitches together. (1 stitch decreased with right slant)	<b>SSK</b>	Slip 1 stitch knitwise, slip 1 stitch knitwise, return 2 slipped stitches back to left needle and knit them through back loops. (1 stitch decreased with left slant)
<b>P</b>	Purl	<b>WS</b>	Wrong side
<b>P2TOG</b>	Purl 2 stitches together. (1 stitch decreased)	<b>YO</b>	Yarn over

# DIRECTIONS

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## 01 BACK

With US 4/3.5 mm circular needle, cast on 40 (42, 48, 54, 58, 62), {70, 72, 78, 82} stitches for left shoulder, place marker, cast on 34 (40, 40, 40, 46, 46), {46, 52, 52, 52} stitches for back neck, place marker, cast on 40 (42, 48, 54, 58, 62), {70, 72, 78, 82} stitches for right shoulder.

[114 (124, 136, 148, 162, 170), {186, 196, 208, 216} stitches total]

**Short-Row 1 (RS):** K40 (42, 48, 54, 58, 62), {70, 72, 78, 82}, slip marker, k34 (40, 40, 40, 46, 46), {46, 52, 52, 52}, slip marker, k4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 2 (WS):** Make double stitch, [purl to marker, slip marker] 2 times, p4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 3 (RS):** Make double stitch, knit to double stitch and work it as a knit stitch, k4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 4 (WS):** Make double stitch, purl to double stitch and work it as a purl stitch, p4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Rows 5-16:** Repeat Short-rows 3 and 4 another 6 times.

**Short-Row 17 (RS):** Make double stitch, knit to double stitch and work it as a knit stitch, knit to the end of row.

**Next Row (WS):** Purl to the end of row, working double stitch as a purl stitch and removing all markers.

Continue working in Stockinette stitch even until Back measures 3"/7.5 cm from cast-on edge, measured along the armhole edge, ending with RS row.

**Size XS only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P10, place marker, p4, [P2TOG, k9] 2 times, [P2TOG, p8] 4 times, [P2TOG, p9] 2 times, P2TOG, p4, place marker, p10. [105 stitches]

**Size S only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P16, place marker, p6, [P2TOG, k11] 6 times, [P2TOG, p6, place marker, p16]. [117 stitches]

**Sizes M and L only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P14 (20), place marker, p7, [P2TOG, p13] 2 times, [P2TOG, p14] 2 times, [P2TOG, k13] 2 times, P2TOG, p7, place marker, p14 (20). [129 (141) stitches]

**Size XL only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P16, place marker, p4, [P2TOG, k8] 12 times, P2TOG, p4, place marker, p16. [149 stitches]

**Size 2XL only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P14, place marker, p7, P2TOG, p13, [P2TOG, p14] 6 times, P2TOG, p13, P2TOG, p7, place marker, p14. [161 stitches]

**Size 3XL only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P20, place marker, p5, [P2TOG, p9] 5 times, [P2TOG, p10] 2 times, [P2TOG, p9] 5 times, P2TOG, p5, place marker, p20. [173 stitches]

**Size 4XL only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P16, place marker, p4, [P2TOG, p9] 7 times, [P2TOG, p9] 7 times, P2TOG, p4, place marker, p16. [181 stitches]

**Size 5XL only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P22, place marker, p5, [P2TOG, p8] 6 times, [P2TOG, p9] 3 times, [P2TOG, p8] 6 times, P2TOG, p4, place marker, p22. [193 stitches]

**Size 6XL only:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P18, place marker, p5, [P2TOG, p10] 14 times, P2TOG, p5, place marker, p18. [201 stitches]

**All sizes:**

**Chart Set-Up Row 1 (RS):** K10 (16, 14, 20, 16, 14), {20, 16, 22, 18}, slip marker, work Row 1 of Lace Chart, working 16-stitch pattern repeat 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 7), {7, 8, 8, 9} times, over 85 (85, 101, 101, 117, 133), {133, 149, 148, 165} stitches, slip marker, k10 (16, 14, 20, 16, 14), {20, 16, 22, 18}.

**Chart Set-Up Row 2 (WS):** Purl to marker, slip marker, work Row 2 of Lace Chart to marker, slip marker, p10 (16, 14, 20, 16, 14), {20, 16, 22, 18}.

Continue working in established pattern, slipping markers and follow the Lace Chart through Row 28, then work Rows 1-12 (1-14, 1-16, 1-16, 1-22, 1-22), {1-26, 1-28, 1-28, 1-28}.

Sizes \_ ( \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ ), { \_ , 4XL, 5XL, 6XL } only:

Continue working in established pattern, slipping markers and work Rows \_ ( \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ ), { \_ , 1-2, 1-2, 1-10 } of Lace Chart.

All sizes:

Back measures approx. 7¾ (8¼, 8½, 8½, 9¼, 9¼), {9¾, 10¼, 10¼, 11}"/cm, measured along the armhole edge, ending with WS row.

Break yarn and place all Back stitches on hold.

## 02 RIGHT FRONT

With US 4/3.5 mm circular needle, with the RS facing, starting at the armhole edge, pick up and knit 40 (42, 48, 54, 58, 62), {70, 72, 78, 82} stitches along the cast on edge of right shoulder.

Shape shoulder

**Short-Row 1 (WS):** P4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 2 (RS):** Make double stitch, knit to end.

**Short-Row 3 (WS):** Purl to double stitch and work it as a purl stitch, p4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 4 (RS):** Make double stitch, knit to end.

**Short-Rows 5-16:** Repeat the last 2 Short-Rows 6 more times.

**Next Row (WS):** Purl to the end of row, working the double stitch as a purl stitch.

Shape neckline

**Neck Increase Row (RS):** Knit to last 3 stitches, Inv-R (see Stitch Guide), k2. [41 (43, 49, 55, 59, 63), {71, 73, 79, 83} stitches]

Work 3 rows in Stockinette stitch without increases.

Repeat last 4 rows 4 times more. [45 (47, 53, 59, 63, 67), {75, 77, 83, 87} stitches]

Work Neck Increase Row once more. [46 (48, 54, 60, 64, 68), {76, 78, 84, 88} stitches]

At this point Right Front measures approx. 3"/7.5 cm from cast-on edge, measured along the armhole edge.

Sizes XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL), { \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ }:

**Decrease Row (WS):** P3 (3, 4, 6, 8, 10), { \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ }, place marker, p6, P2TOG, p11, P2TOG, p11, P2TOG, p6, place marker, p3 (5, 10, 14, 16, 18), { \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ } to end. [43 (45, 51, 57, 61, 65), { \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ } stitches]

Sizes \_ ( \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ ), {3XL, 4XL, 5XL, 6XL}:

**Decrease Row (WS):** P\_ ( \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ ), {6, 6, 8, 10}, place marker, p5, P2TOG, p9, [P2TOG, p10] 2 times, P2TOG, p9, P2TOG, p5, place marker, p\_ ( \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ ), {12, 14, 18, 20} to end. [ \_ ( \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ , \_ ), {71, 73, 79, 83} stitches]

All sizes:

**Chart Set-Up Row 1 (RS):** K3 (5, 10, 14, 16, 18), {12, 14, 18, 20}, slip marker, work Row 1 of Lace Chart, working 16-stitch pattern repeat 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1), {2, 2, 2, 2} time(s), over 37 (37, 37, 37, 37, 37), {58, 58, 58, 58} stitches, slip marker, k3 (3, 4, 6, 8, 10), {6, 6, 8, 10}.

**Chart Set-Up Row 2 (WS):** Purl to marker, slip marker, work Row 2 of Lace Chart to marker, slip marker, purl to end.

*NOTE: While working on the Front, follow the Lace Chart through Row 28, then repeat Rows 1-28 throughout.*

**Neck Increase Row (RS):** Work in established pattern to last 3 stitches, Inv-R, k2. [44 (46, 52, 58, 62, 66), {72, 74, 80, 84} stitches]

Work 3 rows in established pattern without increases.

Repeat last 4 rows 7 (9, 9, 9, 11, 11), {11, 13, 13, 15} times more. [51 (55, 61, 67, 73, 77), {83, 87, 93, 99} stitches]  
Work 6 (0, 2, 2, 0, 0), {4, 0, 0, 0} rows in established pattern without increases.

Right Front measures approx. 7¾ (8¼, 8½, 8½, 9¼, 9¼), {9¾, 10¼, 10¼, 11}"/19.5 (20.5, 21.5, 21.5, 23, 23), {24.5, 25.5, 25.5, 27.5} cm from cast-on edge, measured along the armhole edge. Chart Row 12 (14, 16, 16, 22, 22), {26, 28, 28, 28} is complete.

Break yarn, place all stitches on hold.

## 03 LEFT FRONT

With US 4/3.5 mm circular needle, starting at the neck edge, with the RS facing, pick up and knit last 40 (42, 48, 54, 58, 62), {70, 72, 78, 82} stitches of the cast-on row, ending with the armhole edge.

**Next Row (WS):** Purl to end.

Shape shoulder

**Short-Row 1 (RS):** K4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 2 (WS):** Make double stitch, purl to end.

**Short-Row 3 (RS):** Knit to double stitch and work it as a knit stitch, k4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6), {7, 8, 8, 9}, turn work.

**Short-Row 4 (WS):** Make double stitch, purl to end.  
**Short-Rows 5-16:** Repeat the last 2 Short-Rows 6 more times.

**Next Row (RS):** Knit to the end of row, working the double stitch as a knit stitch.

**Next Row (WS):** Purl to the end of the row.

#### Shape neckline

**Neck Increase Row (RS):** K2, Inv-L (see Stitch Guide), knit to end. [41 (43, 49, 55, 59, 63), {71, 73, 79, 83} stitches]

Work 3 rows in Stockinette Stitch without increases.

Repeat last 4 rows 4 times more.

[45 (47, 53, 59, 63, 67), {75, 77, 83, 87} stitches]

Work Neck Increase Row once more. [46 (48, 54, 60, 64, 68), {76, 78, 84, 88} stitches]

At this point Left Front measures approx. 3"/7.5 cm from cast-on edge, measured along the armhole edge.

**Sizes XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL), {\_, \_, \_, \_}:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P3 (5, 10, 14, 16, 18), {\_, \_, \_, \_}, place marker, p6, P2TOG, p11, P2TOG, p11, P2TOG, p6 place marker, p3 (3, 4, 6, 8, 10), {\_, \_, \_, \_} to end. [43 (45, 51, 57, 61, 65), {\_, \_, \_, \_} stitches]

**Sizes \_ (\_, \_, \_, \_), {3XL, 4XL, 5XL, 6XL}:**

**Decrease Row (WS):** P\_ (\_, \_, \_, \_), {12, 14, 18, 20}, place marker, p5, P2TOG, p9, [P2TOG, p10] 2 times, P2TOG, p9, P2TOG, p5, place marker, p\_ (\_, \_, \_, \_), {6, 6, 8, 10} to end. [\_, (\_, \_, \_, \_), {71, 73, 79, 83} stitches]

**All sizes:**

**Chart Set-Up Row 1 (RS):** K3 (3, 4, 6, 8, 10), {6, 6, 8, 10}, slip marker, work Row 1 of Lace Chart, working 16-stitch pattern repeat 1 (1, 1, 1, 1), {2, 2, 2, 2} time(s), over 37 (37, 37, 37, 37), {58, 58, 58, 58} stitches, slip marker, k3 (5, 10, 14, 16, 18), {12, 14, 18, 20} to end.

**Chart Set-Up Row 2 (WS):** Purl to marker, slip marker, work Row 2 of Lace Chart to marker, slip marker, purl to end.

*NOTE: While working on the Front, follow the Lace Chart through Row 28, then repeat Rows 1-28 throughout.*

**Neck Increase Row (RS):** K2, Inv-L, work in established pattern to end.

[44 (46, 52, 58, 62, 66), {72, 74, 80, 84} stitches]

Work 3 rows in established pattern without increases. Repeat last 4 rows 7 (9, 9, 9, 11, 11), {11, 13, 13, 15} times more. [51 (55, 61, 67, 73, 77), {83, 87, 93, 99} stitches]

Work 6 (0, 2, 2, 0, 0), {4, 0, 0, 0} rows in established pattern without increases.

Back measures approx. 7¾ (8¼, 8½, 8½, 9¼, 9¼), {9¾, 10¼, 10¼, 11}"/cm, from cast-on edge, measured along the armhole edge. Lace Chart Row 12 (14, 16, 16, 22, 22), {26, 28, 28, 28} is complete.

Do not break yarn.

#### Join Fronts and Back

**Joining Row (RS):** Working next row of Lace Chart, work in established pattern 51 (55, 61, 67, 73, 77), {83, 87, 93, 99} Left Front Stitches, place side marker, with same yarn work 105 (117, 129, 141, 149, 161), {173, 181, 193, 201} held Back stitches, place side marker, work 51 (55, 61, 67, 73, 77), {83, 87, 93, 99} held Right Front Stitches. [105 (117, 129, 141, 149, 161), {173, 181, 193, 201} stitches]

#### 04 BODY

Work in established pattern on Body stitches, until piece measures 10 (10, 10, 11, 11, 11), {12, 12, 12, 12}"/25 (25, 25, 27.5, 27.5, 27.5), {30, 30, 30, 30} cm from the underarm, ending with RS row.

**Next Row (WS):** Work in established pattern approx. to the center of the Back, P2TOG, work to end. [104 (116, 128, 140, 148, 160), {172, 180, 192, 200} stitches]

Change to US 3/3.25 mm circular needle.

**Ribbing Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*k2, p2; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, k3.

**Ribbing Row 2 (WS):** P3, \*k2, p2; repeat from \* to last stitch, p1.

Repeat last 2 rows until ribbing measures 2"/5 cm, ending with RS row.

Bind off all stitches in pattern or using Tubular Bind Off method for k2, p2 rib in rows (see Special Techniques, page 7).

## 05 SLEEVES

With US 4/3.5 mm circular needle 16"/40 cm long, with RS facing, beginning at the underarm, pick up and knit 92 (92, 98, 98, 102, 102), {110, 114, 114, 126} stitches around the armhole. Join for working in the round, place beginning-of-the round marker.

**Next Round:** Knit.

**Decrease Round:** K1, K2TOG, knit to last 3 stitches, SSK, k1. [2 stitches decreased]

Repeat Decrease Round another 17 (15, 16, 16, 16), {20, 22, 20, 26} times in every 5th (5th, 5th, 5th, 4th, 4th), {4th, 4th, 4th, 3rd} round.

[56 (60, 64, 64, 68, 68), {68, 68, 72, 72} stitches]

Work even in Stockinette stitch in the round until Sleeve measures 11"/27.5 cm from underarm.

Change to size US 3/3.25 mm circular needle 16"/40 cm.

**Ribbing Round:** K1, \*p2, k2; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, p2, k1.

Repeat Ribbing Round until ribbing measures 1"/2.5 cm.

Bind off all stitches in pattern or using Tubular bind off method for k2, p2 rib in rounds (see Special Techniques, page 7).

## 06 FINISHING

### Collar and Front Bands

*NOTE: The ribbing pick-up ratio is approx. 5 stitches per 6 rows. If you're changing the number of pick-up stitches, make sure that the total number of stitches is divisible by 4.*

With US 3/3.25 mm 24-32"/60-80 cm circular needle and RS facing, beginning at hem edge, pick up and knit 78 (78, 78, 78, 86, 86), {86, 88, 88, 88} stitches to the end of the neckline increases, pick up and knit 64 (64, 68, 68, 72, 72), {76, 80, 80, 88} stitches along the neckline to the shoulder seam, 32 (36, 36, 36, 44, 44), {44, 48, 48, 48} stitches across back neck, 64 (64, 68, 68, 72, 72), {76, 80, 80, 88} stitches down the neckline to the end of the neckline increases, 78 (78, 78, 78, 86, 86), {86, 88, 88, 88} stitches down the left front edge. [316 (320, 328, 328, 360, 368), {384, 384, 384, 400} stitches]

**Next Row (WS):** P3, \*k2, p2; repeat from \* to last stitch, p1.

**Next Row (RS):** Slip 1 purlwise wyib, k2, \*p2, k2; repeat from \* to last stitch, k1.

**Next Row (WS):** Slip 1 purlwise wyif, p2, \*k2, p2; repeat from \* to last stitch, p1.

Repeat the last two rows one more time.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** Work 6 stitches as established, SSK, YO, \*work 10 (10, 10, 10, 14, 14), {14, 14, 14, 14} stitches as established, SSK, YO; repeat from \* 5 (5, 5, 5, 4, 4), {4, 4, 4, 4} more times, work in pattern to end.

**Next Row (WS):** [Work in pattern to YO, knit 1] 7 (7, 7, 7, 6, 6), {6, 6, 6, 6} times, work to end.

Work 4 rows even in rib pattern.

If you do not wish to work a Tubular Bind Off, bind off all stitches in pattern now using your preferred stretchy bind off method.

Bind off all stitches in pattern or using the Tubular Bind Off for k2, p2 ribbing in rows.

# SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

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## **GERMAN SHORT-ROWS**

Work to the stitch specified in your pattern. Turn the work so the wrong side is facing.

With yarn in front, slip 1 stitch purlwise from left needle to right needle. Pull yarn to back of work over needle until both legs of st in row below are on top of needle, creating a “double stitch” on both sides of needle.

Continue to work in pattern as established.

When working the double stitch, work it as a single stitch.

## **TUBULAR BIND OFF FOR K2, P2 RIBBING IN ROUNDS**

Using the two circular needles, divide the knit and purl stitches as follows: Slip first stitch onto first (front) needle, \*slip the next 2 (purl) stitches to back needle, slip the next 2 (knit) stitches to front needle; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, slip the next 2 purl stitches to back needle, slip the final stitch to front needle.

With tail threaded on a tapestry needle, graft stitches together using Kitchener stitch.

## **TUBULAR BIND OFF FOR K2, P2 RIBBING IN ROWS (starts and ends with 3 knit stitches)**

Using the two circular needles, divide the knit and purl stitches as follows: Slip first (knit) stitch onto back needle, \*slip the next 2 (knit) stitches to front needle, slip the next 2 (purl) stitches to back needle; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, slip the next 2 knit stitches to front needle, slip the final (knit) stitch to back needle.

With tail threaded on a tapestry needle, graft stitches together using Kitchener stitch.

## **KITCHENER STITCH (GRAFTING)**

Kitchener stitch is a technique for invisibly weaving together live stitches.

**Step 1:** Thread a tapestry needle with the same yarn you used to work your project. Hold the needles with the live stitches parallel in your left hand. Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch on the front needle as if to PURL. Pull the yarn through, leaving a tail that you will weave in later. Leave the stitch on the front needle.

**Step 2:** Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch on the back needle as if to KNIT, pull the yarn through, leaving the stitch on the back needle.

**Step 3:** Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch on the front needle as if to KNIT, pull the yarn through, removing the stitch from the front needle.

**Step 4:** Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch on the front needle as if to PURL, pull the yarn through, leaving the stitch on the front needle.

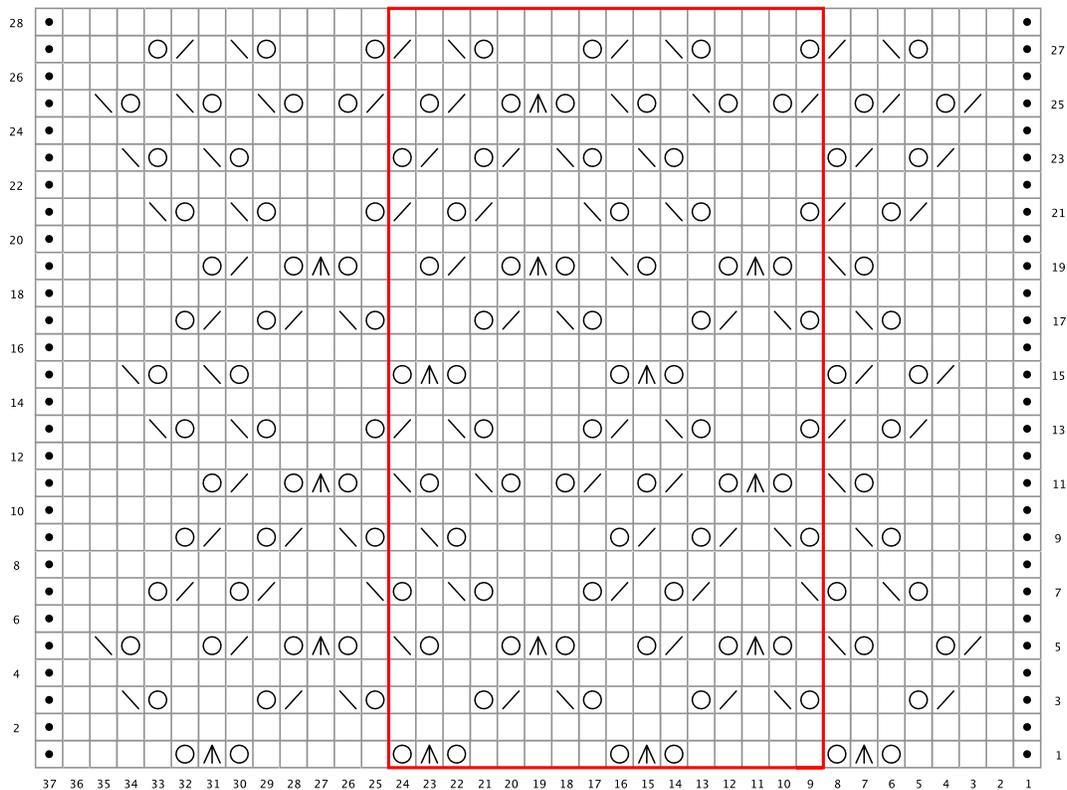
**Step 5:** Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch on the back needle as if to PURL, pull the yarn through, removing the stitch on the back needle.

**Step 6:** Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch on the back needle as if to KNIT, pull the yarn through, leaving the stitch on the back needle.

Repeat Steps 3 – 6 until all stitches have been worked. Every few stitches, adjust the tension of your work, making sure not to pull too tightly. Remember, you are making an extra row of knitting rather than sewing together a seam.

# CHARTS

## LACE CHART



## Legend

- K: Knit stitch on RS; purl stitch on WS
- P: Purl stitch on RS; knit stitch on WS
- YO: Yarn over
- K2TOG: Knit 2 stitches together – 1 stitch decreased with right slant.
- SSK: Slip 1 stitch knitwise, slip 1 stitch knitwise, return 2 slipped stitches back to left needle and knit them together through back loops – 1 stitch decreased with left slant
- CDD (central double decrease): Slip 2 stitches as if to K2TOG, k1, pass 2 slipped stitches over knit stitch – 2 stitches decreased.
- Pattern repeat

**Row 5 (RS):** P1, k1, K2TOG, YO, k2, YO, SSK, \*k1, YO, CDD, YO, k1, K2TOG, YO, k2, YO, CDD, YO, k2, YO, SSK\*, k1, YO, CDD, YO, k1, K2TOG, YO, k2, YO, SSK, k1, p1.

**Row 7 (RS):** P1, k3, YO, SSK, k1, YO, \*SSK, k3, K2TOG, YO, k1, K2TOG, YO, k3, YO, SSK, k1, YO\*, SSK, k3, K2TOG, YO, k1, K2TOG, YO, k3, p1.

**Row 9 (RS):** P1, k4, YO, SSK, k1, \*YO, SSK, [k1, K2TOG, YO] 2 times, k5, YO, SSK, k1\*, YO, SSK, [k1, K2TOG, YO] 2 times, k4, p1.

**Row 11 (RS):** P1, k5, YO, SSK, \*k1, YO, CDD, [YO, k1, K2TOG] 2 times, YO, [k1, YO, SSK] 2 times\*, k1, YO, CDD, YO, k1, K2TOG, YO, k5, p1.

**Row 13 (RS):** P1, k3, K2TOG, YO, k1, K2TOG, \*[YO, k3, YO, SSK, k1, K2TOG] 2 times\*, YO, k3, YO, SSK, k1, YO, SSK, k3, p1.

**Row 15 (RS):** P1, k2, K2TOG, YO, k1, K2TOG, YO, \*[k5, YO, CDD, YO] 2 times\*, k5, YO, SSK, k1, YO, SSK, k2, p1.

**Row 17 (RS):** P1, k4, YO, SSK, k1, \*[YO, SSK, k1, K2TOG, YO, k3] 2 times\*, YO, SSK, [k1, K2TOG, YO] 2 times, k4, p1.

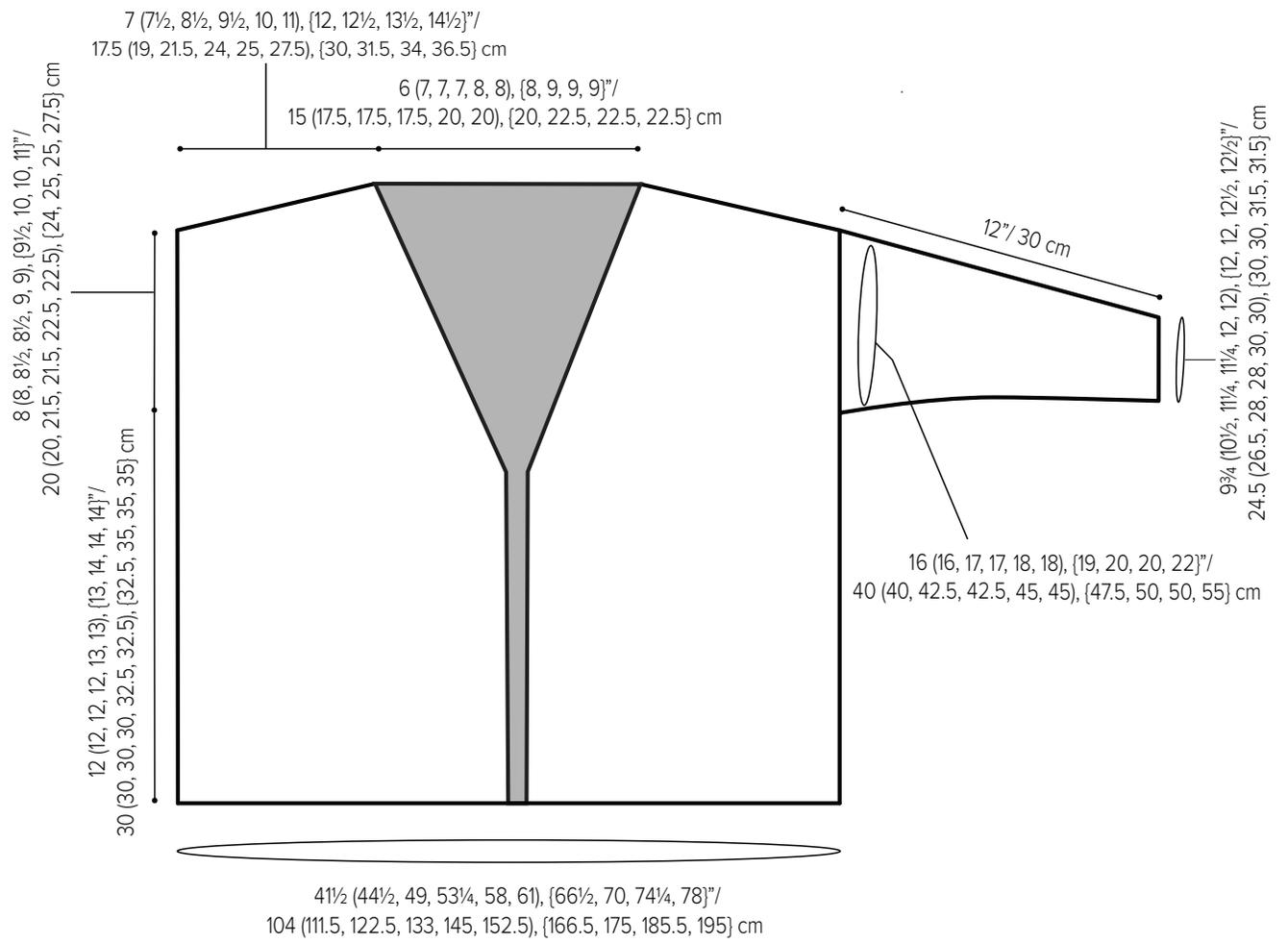
