

GAUGE


12 sts and 12 rows (cluster, sc) in 10 cm (4 inches)



(YO, insert hook in stitch & draw up a loop, YO & draw through 2 loops on hook) repeat 3 more times into the same stitch (you should end up with 5 loops on the hook), YO & draw through all loops on hook.



Abbreviation:

Chain – ch

Single crochet – sc

Cluster – cl

Repeat – rep

Wrong Side – WS

Right Side – RS

MAIN PART – 2PCS (FRONT AND BACK)

Row 1 (WS): Make chain of **35** stitches. Starting from the second chain stitch crochet by single crochet. Totally you should receive **34** stitches, turn

Row 2 (RS): ch1 (hereandafter used to start the row), all single crochet (sc), turn -**34** sts

Row 3 (WS): ch1, 3sc, *1 cluster, 2sc* repeat from * to * till the last stitch, 1sc. turn – **34** sts

Rows 4-6: ch1, all single crochet (sc), turn - **34** sts

Repeat Rows 3-6 8 more times

Row 39 (WS): ch1, 3sc, *1 cluster, 2sc* repeat from * to * till the last stitch, 1sc. turn – **34** sts

Rows 40-41: ch1, all single crochet (sc), turn - **34** sts



MAIN PART FINISHING

Round 1 (RS): ch1, 34sl st into the side 1, 40sl st into side 2 leaving last row without stitch, starting from the second stitch and leaving the last stitch without crocheting make 32sl st on side 3, starting from the second row make 40sl st into the side 4 (last stitch should be made into the first stitch of the side 1, make 42ch (handle), sl st into the last sl st of the side 1



Round 2 (RS) (crocheting around sides 2, 3, 4 and handle part making sc into sl stitches, inc means you should make 2 sc into 1 st!): ch1, 37sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 26sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 37sc, 42sc, sl st into ch1 at the beginning of the round, turn - totally 158 sts



Round 3 (WS) (crocheting around sides 2, 3, 4 and handle part): ch1, 158sc, sl st into ch1 to close the round, turn

Round 4 (RS) (crocheting around sides 2, 3, 4 and handle part): ch1, 158sc, sl st into ch1 to close the round, turn



Round 5 (WS) (crocheting around sides 2, 3, 4 and handle part): ch1, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* till the end, sl st into ch1 to close the round

Round 4 (RS) (crocheting around sides 2, 3, 4 and handle part): ch1, 158sc, sl st into ch1 to close the round, turn



Make the second piece by the same way!

SIDE PART - 2PCS

Row 1 (WS): Make chain of 2 stitches. Starting from the second chain stitch make 1inc, turn – totally 2 sts

Row 2 (RS): ch1 (hereandafter used to start the row), 2inc, turn – totally 4 sts

Row 3 (WS): ch1, 1sc, 1cl, 1sc, 1sc, turn – totally 4sts

Row 4 (RS): ch1, 4sc, turn – totally 4 sts

Row 5 (WS): ch1, 1sc, 1cl, 1sc, 1sc, turn – totally 4sts

Row 6 (RS): ch1, 1inc, 2sc, 1inc, turn – totally 6 sts

Row 7 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 1 more time, 1sc, turn – totally 6 sts

Row 8 (RS): ch1, 6sc, turn – totally 6 sts

Row 9 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 1 more time, 1sc, turn – totally 6 sts

Row 10 (RS): ch1, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, turn – totally 8 sts

Row 11 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 2 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 8 sts

Row 12 (RS): ch1, 8sc, turn – totally 8 sts

Row 13 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 2 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 8 sts

Row 14 (RS): ch1, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, turn – totally 10 sts

Row 15 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 3 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 10 sts

Row 16 (RS): ch1, 10sc, turn – totally 10 sts

Row 17 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 3 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 10 sts

Row 18 (RS): ch1, 1inc, 8sc, 1inc, turn – totally 12 sts

Row 19 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 4 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 12 sts

Row 20 (RS): ch1, 12sc, turn – totally 12 sts

Row 21 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 4 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 12 sts

Row 22 (RS): ch1, 1inc, 10sc, 1inc, turn – totally 14 sts

Row 23 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 5 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 14 sts

Row 24 (RS): ch1, 14sc, turn – totally 14 sts

Row 25 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 5 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 14 sts

Row 26 (RS): ch1, 1inc, 12sc, 1inc, turn – totally 16 sts

Row 27 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 6 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 16 sts

Row 28 (RS): ch1, 16sc, turn – totally 16 sts

Row 29 (WS): ch1, 1sc, *1cl, 1sc*, rep from *to* 6 more times, 1sc, turn – totally 16 sts

Row 30 (RS): ch1, 16sc, turn – totally 16 sts

Repeat Rows 29-30 24 more times

(To check yourself you should get totally 37 bobble rows!)



ASSEMBLING

1. Join one side part to 2 main parts starting from the middle of the bottom of main part. (Joining from the wrong side by sl st!)
2. Join the second side part to 2 main parts starting from the middle of the bottom of main part (Joining from the wrong side by sl st!)



3. Close the remaining hole on the handle from the wrong side by sl st





4. Join 14 middle sts of the handle from 2 sides by sl st, crocheting from right side



5. Join 2 sides of the bottom by sl st, crocheting from wrong side



Attach magnetic closure or snap button.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Width 39 cm (15,5")
- Height till the handle 27 cm (10,5")
- Depth 12 cm (5")
- Handle length 42 cm (16,5")

MATERIALS

Crochet hook: 6 mm (US J-10)

USED Yarn:

Name and weight: Super Bulky (5-6 wpi) HOOKED RIBBONXL

Colour: SANDY ECRU

Meterage: 131 yards (120 meters)

Unit weight: 250 grams (8.82 ounces)

Quantity: 3 balls


* You can use the yarn of other producers with the same characteristics.

GAUGE:


11 stitches and 12 rows = 4 inches (10cm) in single crochet

STITCH CLOSSARY AND SYMBOLS

1. ○ Chain



2. † Single crochet USA (in UK double crochet)



3. Cluster (in UK Treble Cluster)

YO, insert hook in stitch & draw up a loop, YO & draw through 2 loops on hook repeat 3 times into the same stitch (you should end up with 5 loops on the hook), YO & draw through all loops on hook.

4. **Bobble** – to make the bobble make cluster into one stitch and single crochet into the next stitch

Single crochet – sc

Bobble - bob

Repeat – rep

Chain – ch

RS – right side

WS – wrong side

FRONT AND BACK PARTS

Row 1(RS): make chain of 31 sts, starting from the second chain make 30 sc, turn

Rows 2-28: ch1, 30 sc, turn

Finished crocheting fix the last stitch pathing the yarn tail through it.

Make the second piece by the same way!



BOTTOM SIDES AND HANDLES PART

The Bottom, sides and handles part are crocheted as one piece.

Starts from the half of the bottom, coming to one side, after this coming to handle, after this coming to second side and at the end the second half of the bottom!

Starts with the first half of the bottom and 1 side!

Row 2: ch1, 1sc, bob, 6sc, bob, 1sc, turn

Row 3: ch1, 12sc, turn

Row 4: ch1, 3sc, bob, 2sc, bob, 3sc, turn

Row 5: ch1, 12sc, turn

Row 6: ch1, 5sc, bob, 5sc, turn

Row 1-43: ch1, 5sc, turn

Finished crocheting fix the last stitch pathing the yarn tail through it.



Attach yarn to the fifth stitch counted from the other side and start crocheting the second part of the handle. First Row should be made from the Right Side!

Row 1-43: ch1, 5sc, turn

Finished crocheting DON'T FIX the last and leave it free as the next row will starts from it!



Next Row should be crocheted from the Wrong side!

Row 44: ch 1, 5sc, 2ch, 5sc into thr second part of the handle, turn



Finish with the second side and second half of the bottom!

To make assembling more easy mark the joining points

Put the markers into each angle of the front and back parts and put the markers into 2 middle stitches of the bottom of front and back parts!



Put the markers to each side of the Bottom, Sides, Handle Part

One marker to the angle, one marker to the 15th joining point (row) counting the marker as the first and the second marker to the 29th joining point (row) counting second marker as the first one



Start joining the parts from the top angle of the front part and the third marker of the Bottom, Sides, Handle Part
Making slip stitch to one and second parts repetitively





















While joining the parts check the marker points to be sure that you are not missing any joining point from any of the side.

Finished assembling of the parts **CLOSE THE BOTTOM.** I just path the yarn tail from side to side closing it stitch by stitch.

CROCHET MEASUREMENTS

Size:

Width: 11 in (28 cm)

Height: 8,7 in (22 cm)

Depth: 6 in (15 cm)

Handle: 9,5 in (24cm)

MATERIALS

Crochet hook: 5 mm (US H-8)

USED Yarn type: Polypropylene Cord 2mm

Name: Thai Swan Black

Color: Gold

Quantity: 1 skein (about 500 grams (17 oz) with length about 400-450 meters (435 yards))

Additionally, you will need

- 2 opening O-rings for purse with inner diameter not less than 2,5cm (0,98")
- Magnetic closure


GUAGE:

13 stitches and 15 rows = 4 inches (10cm) in single crochet


STITCH CLOSSARY AND SYMBOLS

PATTERN USES USA TERMS!!!

1.  Chain



2. † Single crochet USA (in UK double crochet)




3. Crossed Double Crochet stitch (in UK crossed treble)

When you are making crossed double crochet you should skip the first stitch, make double crochet into the next one and after make double crochet into the first stitch.





4. ● Slip Stitch



Slip stitch is the shortest crochet stitch used for joining, shaping & taking yarn to another part of motif or work (button hole for example)

5. Cluster (in UK Treble Cluster)

YO, insert hook in stitch & draw up a loop, YO & draw through 2 loops on hook repeat one more time into the same stitch (you should end up with 3 loops on the hook), YO & draw through all loops on hook.

6 Bobble – to make the bobble make cluster into one stitch and single crochet into the next stitch



7. Half double crochet (in UK half treble) - YO, insert hook in stitch & draw up a loop, YO & draw through all loops on the hook.

Single crochet – sc

Chain – ch

Crossed DC – cdc

Bobble - bob

Repeat – rep

Slip Stitch – sl st

Half DC - hdc

BOTTOM (crocheted flat)

Row 1 (Right Side): make chain of 29 stitches, starting from the second stitch make 28sc, turn



Row 2 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the row, 1sc, 13bob, 1sc, turn

Row 3 (Right Side): 1ch to start the row, 28 sc, turn

Row 4 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the row, 28 sc, turn

Row 5 (Right Side): 2ch (counts as the first hdc), 13 hdc, 1hdc, turn

Row 6 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the row, 1sc, 13bob, 1sc, turn

Row 7 (Right Side): 1ch to start the row, 28 sc, turn



Repeat Rows 2-6 2 more times

Row 20 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the row, 1sc, 13bob, 1sc, turn

Row 21 (Right Side): 1ch to start the row, 28 sc, turn

Your Bottom is Ready!




DON'T CUT THE YARN!

MAIN PART (crocheted in round)

*If you have difficulty to recognise first and last stitch while crocheting in round just use the stitch markers for them!!!

Round 1 (Right Side): Continue to crochet from the RIGHT SIDE!
Crochet around all 4 sides of the bottom part by sl st making 1 st into each stitch on the top and bottom parts and 1 sl st into each sc and bob row and 2sl sts into each cdc rows of the right and left sides.
Totally you should make 102 sl st (23+28+23+28)



Round 2 (Right Side): continue to crochet from the right side, ch1. 102 sc (crocheting into the top loop of each sl st of the previous Round), sl st into ch1 to close the Round, turn

Round 3 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the round, 51bob, sl st to ch1 to close the round, turn

Round 4 (Right Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Round 5 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Round 6 (Right Side): 2ch to start the round (in this case it doesn't count as the first hdc!!!!), 51 cdc, sl st into the top st of 2ch to close the round, turn

Round 7 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Round 8 (Right Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Repeat Rounds 3-8 2 more times.

Round 21 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the round, 51bob, sl st to ch1 to close the round, turn

Round 22 (Right Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Round 23 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Round 24 (Right Side): 2ch to start the round (in this case it doesn't count as the first hdc!!!!), 51 cdc, sl st into the top st of 2ch to close the round, turn

Round 25 (Wrong Side): 1ch to start the round, 102 sc, turn

Round 26; (Right side): make 102 sl st around all 4 sides of the bag! Cut the yarn, path the yarn tail to the rong side, fix it and weave in the end!



HANDLE

Handle is crocheted from the Wrong Side!

Make Magic ring

Crochet 10 sc into magic ring and close it



Continue to crochet around in spiral by sc (10sc)

Make as many rounds as necessary to get the desired handle length.

My handle is about 24 cm (9,5 inches)

IsWOOLISHcrochet

Make the last stitch as a sl st, cut the yarn, fix the yarn tail, path the yarn tail through all 10 sts, close the hole, fix the yarn tail making the knot and hide it inside of the handle



ASSEMBLING

Shape the Bag using the Rings as shown below (path the rings through the spaces created by cdc sts)!





Attach the Handle pathing the rings through it.

IsWOOLISHcrochet



Attach magnetic closure inside!



Your Bag is ready!
