## Construction:

-This is a top-down knit triangle shaped shawl, with increases at both sides and the center of the shawl.

-4 stitches increased on every Right-side rows.


-The slip-stitch knitting is also known as mosaic knitting. To use this type of colorwork, you will not floating the yarn in the back of the work, and you don't have to worry about the tension the floats are creating.

## Measurements:

Gauge:

16 sts and 25 rows = 10 x 10 cm ( 4 x 4 in ) in stockinette after blocking.

## Materials:

### Yarns:

Brooklyn Tweed -Shelter

140 yards=50g / worsted-weight yarn

MC -- Fossil 3 skein (beige)

CC1 -- Barn owl 1 skein (brown)

CC2 -- Wool socks 1 skein (red)

CC3 -- Woodsmoke 2 skein (light brown)

### Needles:

4.5mm / 7 US or size to achieve gauge

### Other Materials:

Stitch markers



## Abbreviations

## Instructions

Cast on 3 stitches with MC, knit 7 rows. Rotate your knitting then pick up and knit 3 stitches along the side of the garter tab where the purl bumps are, then pick up and knit 3 stitches from the cast on.

Now you have 9 stitches on the needle, and this is Row 1 (RS).

Row 2 (WS): k3, p1, **PM**, p1, **PM**, p1, k3.

### Section 1

Row 3 (RS) : k3, M1L, k1, M1R, **SM**, k1, **SM**, M1L, k1, M1R, k3. [TS:13](#)

Row 4 (WS) : k3, p3, **SM**, p1, **SM**, p3, k3.

Row 5 (RS) : k3, M1L, k to M, M1R, **SM**, k1, **SM**, M1L, k to last 3 sts, M1R, k3. [TS:17](#)

Row 6 (WS) : k3, p to M, **SM**, p1, **SM**, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Row 5~6, until you have completed Row 20.

Row 21 (RS) : k3, M1L, k to M, M1R, **SM**, k1, **SM**, M1L, k to last 3 sts, M1R, k3. [TS:49](#)

Row 22 (WS) : k to M, **SM**, k1, **SM**, k to end.

Row 23 (RS) : k3, M1L, k to M, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L, k to last 3 sts, M1R, k3. TS:53

Row 24 (WS) : k3, p to M, SM, p1, SM, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Row 23~24, until you have completed Row 32.

Row 33 (RS) : k3, M1L, k to M, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L, k to last 3 sts, M1R, k3. TS:73

Row 34 (WS) : k to M, SM, k1, SM, k to end.

Rep Row23 ~ 34 for 6 more times, until you have completed Row106.

Note: If you want to make the shawl larger, rep Row23 ~ 34 for 9 more times, until you have completed Row142, then start Chart A with Row143.

Row 110 (WS) : k3, \*SM, k1, [ sl2, k1 ] rep to M, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With MC:

Row 111 (RS) : k3, \*SM, M1L, sl1, [ k5, sl1 ] rep to M, M1R, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3. TS:229

Row 112 (WS) : k3, \*SM, k1, sl1, [ k5, sl1 ] rep to 1 st before M, k1, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

Row 116 (WS): k3, \*SM, k2, sl1, k1, sl1, [ k3, sl1, k1, sl1 ] rep to 2 sts before M, k2, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

Row172 (WS): k3, \*SM, k4, sl1, [ k5, sl1 ] rep to 4 sts before M, k4, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

Row178 (WS): k3, \*SM, k1, sl1, [ k2, sl1 ] rep to 1 st before M, k1, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With MC:

Row179 (RS): k3, \*SM, M1L, [ k3, sl1, k1, sl1 ] rep to 3 sts before M, k3, M1R, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3. [TS:365](#)

Row180 (WS): k3, \*SM, k4, [ sl1, k1, sl1, k3 ] rep to 1 st before M, k1, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With CC1:

Row181 (RS): k3, \*SM, M1L, k1, [ sl3, k3 ] rep to 4 sts before M, sl3, k1, M1R, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3. [TS:369](#)

Row182 (WS): k3, \*SM, k2, sl3, [ k3, sl3 ] rep to 2 sts before M, k2, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With MC:

Row183(RS): k3, \*SM, M1L, [ sl1, k5 ] rep to 1 st before M, sl1, M1R, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3. [TS:373](#)

Row184(WS): k3, \*SM, k1, sl1, [ k5, sl1 ] rep to 1 st before M, k1, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With CC1:

Row185 (RS): k3, \*SM, M1L, sl1, [ k1, sl2 ] re to 2 sts before M, k1, sl1, M1R, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3. [TS:377](#)

Row186 (WS): k3, \*SM, k1, sl1, k1, [ sl2, k1 ] rep to 2 sts before M, sl1, k1, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With MC:

Row187 (RS): k3, \*SM, M1L, k to marker, M1R, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3. [TS:381](#)

Row188 (WS): k3, \*SM, k to M, SM\*, k1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

With CC3:

Row189 (RS): Same as Row187. [TS:385](#)

Row190 (WS): k3, \*SM, k1, [ p1, k1 ] rep to M, SM \*, p1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

Row191 (RS): Same as Row187. [TS:389](#)

Row192 (WS): k3, \*SM, p1, [ k1, p1 ] rep to M, SM\*, p1, rep from \* to \*, k3.

Row193 (RS): Same as Row187. [TS:393](#)

Row194 (WS): Same as Row190.

Row195 (RS): Same as Row187. [TS:397](#)

Row196 (WS): Same as Row192.

Row197 (RS): Same as Row187. [TS:401](#)

Row198 (WS): Same as Row190.

### I-cord bind off

With RS facing and work cable cast on 3 stitches to the left needle, then

[ k2, k2tog through the back loop, slip 3 sts back to left needle ] rep to last 3 sts, knit 3 sts together through the back loop, cut yarn and pull through.

### Finishing

Weave in ends and block to measurements.

### Chart Legend


 =  **knit (k)** Knit RS / Purl WS

 **purl (p)** Purl RS / Knit WS

 **M1** Make 1 stitch

 **M1L** Make 1 left : Lift bar between sts on left needle from front to back and knit through the back leg.

 **M1R** Make 1 right: Lift bar between sts on left needle from back to front and knit through the front leg.





**slip (sl)** Slip the next stitch onto the right-hand needle without knitting it


	→ WS/ Slip 1 with yarn in front (wyif)

<How to make a tassel>

1. Wrap yarn around cardboard several times.



2. Remove from cardboard.




