

TELYBEAN KNITS



STEPHANIE LOTVEN

BONEYARD SWEETHEARTS

SIZES

Adult S (M, L)

This hat is designed to fit with 0-2 inches [0-5cm] of negative ease.

YARN

FINGERING weight yarn

Lolodidit LORIGINAL (85% Extra Fine Superwash Merino & 15% Nylon, 124 yards / 1 oz [114 meters / 28 grams])

Heart Hat shown in "Bubblicious" (C1), "Narnia" (C2), & "Peaches n Cream" (C3)

Ghost Hat shown in "Rumpelstiltskin" (C1), "Words" (C2), & "Naked" (C3)

TOOLS

1 stitch marker & tapestry needle

NEEDLES

US 1 (2.25mm) & US 2 (2.75mm) 16-inch (40cm) circular or as required to meet gauge and DPNs in larger size

GAUGE

28 sts & 32 rounds = 4 inches [10cm] in colorwork motif in the round after blocking on LARGER needles

SKILLS


knitting in the round, stranded colorwork

ABBREVIATIONS

BOR	Beginning of Round
cdd	central double decrease
CO	Cast On
C1	color one
C2	color two
C3	color three
k2tog	knit two together
ssk	slip slip knit
st(s)	stitch(es)

YARDAGES

C1	C2	C3
<i>shown in pink</i>	<i>shown in dark blue</i>	<i>shown in white</i>
50 (55, 60) yds [46 (50, 55)m]	105 (115, 120) yds [96 (105, 110) m]	65 (70, 75) yds [60 (64, 69) m]



TECHNICAL NOTES

cdd : slip 2 stitches together as if to knit, knit 1, pass the slipped stitches over the first stitch on the right needle.
[2 stitches decreased, centered]

ssk : Slip the first stitch on the left needle knitwise. Repeat for the second stitch. Insert the left needle into the front loops of these stitches from left to right and knit them together [1 stitch decreased, leans left]

PATTERN NOTES

- This hat is knit from the bottom up, in the round.
- I highly recommend the Old Norwegian cast-on for this hat. You can find a video tutorial in **RESOURCES**.
- You can find the **CHART** on pg.4. There are two chart options. Choose one chart to create your hat.

Using SMALLER needles and C1, CO 128 (144, 160) sts. Place BOR marker and join to work in the round.

Work in **2x2 RIBBING** (knit 2, purl 2) for 1 inch [2.5cm]. Break C1, leaving a 6-inch [15-cm] tail.

Change to LARGER needles and join C2.

Knit one round.

Next Round: Slip 1 stitch purlwise with yarn in back, knit to the end of the round.

Join C3. Work **CHART** on p.4. After working **Round 44**, break C3, leaving a 6-inch [15-cm] tail.

[NOTE: If you would like to add length to your hat, work additional rounds of stockinette (knitting every round) in C2 after completing **Round 53** and before starting **Round 54**. For a slouchy hat, work in stockinette until your hat measures 9.75 inches [25cm] from the cast on edge before beginning the crown decreases on **Round 54**. This will increase the total length of your

hat to 11.5 inches [29cm]]

After completing the **CHART**, break C2, leaving a 6-inch [15-cm] tail. Using a tapestry needle, pull yarn through 8 (9, 10) remaining live sts.


FINISHING

Weave in all ends. For the best results, be sure to wet-block your finished hat. Soak the hat in cold water, squeezing to remove the air bubbles. Press out water, but do not wring. Roll the hat in a dry towel and press on it to remove excess water. Use a measuring tape to make sure your hat is the correct dimensions. You're finished!

Once your hat is dry, you can add a pom pom. See **RESOURCES** for more information on making a pom pom. A pom pom will require additional yardage. To create my 2-inch [5-cm] pom pom, I used 35 yards [32 meters] of C1.


CHART

KEY




- There are two chart options shown on this page: skeletons with ghosts (shown on the left) & skeletons with hearts (shown on the right). Choose the chart that best fits your taste to create your hat. You will not work both charts. Choose one chart for your hat.
- The **CHART** is worked **in the round**.
- Begin at the bottom right corner and work right to left.
- The chart is a 16-stitch motif worked 8 (9, 10) times on every round.
