




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# Hello, crocheter!

# Basic Materials

- Crochet hooks  
(Recommended size: 2.25mm)
- Scissors
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Stitch markers
- Sewing pins
- Tapestry needle
- Craft glue
- 1 pair of 8mm safety eyes per amigurumi
- Pink dry pastel (or powder blush)
- Makeup brush  
(for crochet use only)
- 1 golden chain keyring for assembly per amigurumi
- Fabric stiffener
- Fabric waterproofing spray
- Pliers, including one for jewelry making

## Supplies for Rumi's accessories:

- Golden jewelry chain
- 3 pieces of 5mm golden jump rings
- One golden hair cuff bead or hair ring
- 5mm golden half pearls

## Supplies for Zoey's accessories:

- 2 pieces of approx. 6mm golden jump rings
- 2 pieces of 4mm golden star shaped sequins - optional

## Supplies for Mira's accessories:

- 2 pieces of 8mm half pearls
- 2 pieces of 5mm half pearls

# Head

## Beige yarn

- 1) 6sc in a MR [6]
- 2) 6inc [12]
- 3) (1sc, 1inc) x6 [18]
- 4) (1sc, 1inc, 1sc) x 6 [24]
- 5) (3sc, 1inc) x 6 [30]
- 6) 30sc
- 7) (2sc, 1inc, 2sc) x 6 [36]
- 8-14) 36sc - 7 rounds

Place the **safety eyes** between **rounds 11-12**, 4 stitches apart from each other.

Also, stuff the head as you go.

- 15) (7sc, 1dec) x 4 [32]
- 16) (2sc, 1dec) x 8 [24]
- 17) (1sc, 1dec) x 8 [16]

- 18) 8dec [8]

Work **2dec**, make a reverse magic ring, and fasten off.

## Nose



Embroider it in the beige between rounds 12-13, making it 2 stitches wide.

## Ears (2x)

### Beige yarn

- 1) 6sc in a MR [6]

Close the MR and fasten off leaving a yarn tail to sew the ear between rounds 11-12, 4 stitches away from the eye.



# Facial Expression

## Eyes

Indent the eyes slightly for a cuter and more realistic face.



## Sclerae

Use the white yarn to embroider the sclera (white of the eyes) on the outer side of each eye.



## Eyelashes

Use the black lace weight yarn to embroider the eyelashes above and beside the eyes; use **pictures 8-9** as a reference.



## Eye shadow

Use golden yarn to embroider the eye shadow behind the eyelashes, as shown in **pictures 10-11**.



## Eyebrows

Embroider dark purple eyebrows above the eyes, between rounds 9-10, making them 3 stitches wide.



# Facial Expression

## Blush

Apply pink dry pastel (or pink powder blush) to the cheeks and nose.




# Earrings

Use the **gold jewelry chain and gold jump rings** to make the earrings.

First, use the pliers to open two jump rings. Attach the gold chain to them (**picture 17**) and close the jump rings around the tips of the ears, as shown in **pictures 18-19**. Then, use the pliers to trim the excess chain — I left the chain about 1.5 cm long.

**TIP!** If you prefer, you can cut the chain before attaching it to the jump ring and ear. Personally, I found it easier to cut it afterward, as it makes handling simpler.



# Earrings

Open another gold jump ring and attach it to the side of the left ear.



# Hair

## Purple yarn

- 1) 6sc in a MR [6]
- 2) 6inc [12]
- 3) (1sc, 1inc) x 6 [18]
- 4) (1sc, 1inc, 1sc) x 6 [24]
- 5) (3sc, 1inc) x 6 [30]
- 6) (2sc, 1inc, 2sc) x 6 [36]
- 7) 36sc
- 8) (5sc, 1inc) x 6 [42]
- 9-11) 42sc - 3 rounds
- 12) 20sc, 1slst [21]



Make the hair strands:

**Strand 1)** ch-11; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:

2slst, 2sc, 5hdc, 1sc [10].

Work 1slst in the same stitch you started in.



# Hair

**Strand 2)** ch-65; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
12slst, 12sc, 12hdc, 26dc, 2sc [64].  
*Work 1slst in the next stitch.*

**Strand 3)** ch-65; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
12slst, 12sc, 12hdc, 26dc, 2sc [64].  
*Work 1slst in the same stitch you started in.*

**Strand 4)** ch-65; start in the 2nd

chain from the hook:  
12slst, 12sc, 12hdc, 26dc, 2sc [64].  
*Work 1slst in the next stitch.*

**Strand 5)** ch-11; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
2slst, 2sc, 5hdc, 1sc [10].  
*Work 1slst in the same stitch you started in.*


Fasten off on the right side as the hair will be worn inside out.



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# Hairstyle



Turn the **hair base inside out** and place it on the head with the strands centered in the middle of the forehead. Also, the hairline should be approximately 5 stitches away from the eyebrows.

Next, stick strands 1 and 5 in front of the ears, so that the strands lie flat along the hairline.

**Glue the hair base to the head, as well as strands 1 and 5.**



Braid strands 2 to 4 and glue the ends together to keep them from unraveling.

# Hairstyle



Bring the braid to the back and glue it across the head, as shown in the pictures above, but leave the front slightly loose to add volume.



Attach the golden hair cuff bead or hair ring to the tip of the braid. If you don't have a cuff/ring, wrap a piece of golden yarn around the tip of the braid and glue the ends in place so won't come loose.



Finally, glue some golden half pearls to embellish the braid.

# Assembly



Use purple yarn to sew the chain keyring to the top of the head.

Next, apply fabric waterproofing spray to the keychain, let it dry, and it's ready. I hope you had a great time crocheting!

### Beige yarn

- 1) 6sc in a MR [6]
- 2) 6inc [12]
- 3) (1sc, 1inc) x6 [18]
- 4) (1sc, 1inc, 1sc) x 6 [24]
- 5) (3sc, 1inc) x 6 [30]
- 6) 30sc
- 7) (2sc, 1inc, 2sc) x 6 [36]
- 8-14) 36sc - 7 rounds

Place the **safety eyes between rounds 11-12**, 4 stitches apart from each other.

Also, stuff the head as you go.

- 15) (7sc, 1dec) x 4 [32]
- 16) (2sc, 1dec) x 8 [24]
- 17) (1sc, 1dec) x 8 [16]

18) 8dec [8]

Work **2dec**, make a reverse magic ring, and fasten off.

### Nose



Embroider it in the beige between rounds 12-13, making it 2 stitches wide.

### Ears (2x)

#### Beige yarn

1) 6sc in a MR [6]

Close the MR and fasten off leaving a yarn tail to sew the ear between rounds 11-12, 4 stitches away from the eye.



# Facial Expression

## Eyes

Indent the eyes slightly for a cuter and more realistic face.



## Sclerae

Use the white yarn to embroider the sclera (white of the eyes) on the outer side of each eye.



## Eyelashes

Use the black lace weight yarn to embroider the eyelashes above the eyes, as shown in **pictures 8-9**.



## Eye shadow

Use golden yarn to embroider the eye shadow behind the eyelashes; use **pictures 10-11** as a reference.



## Eyebrows

Embroider black eyebrows above the eyes, between rounds 9-10, making them 3 stitches wide.



# Facial Expression

## Blush

Apply pink dry pastel (or pink powder blush) to the cheeks and nose.



# Earrings

Use the 6mm golden jump rings to make the earrings.

So, use pliers to open the rings and close them around the tip of the ears.



# Hair

## Black yarn

- 1) 6sc in a MR [6]
- 2) 6inc [12]
- 3) (1sc, 1inc) x 6 [18]
- 4) (1sc, 1inc, 1sc) x 6 [24]
- 5) (3sc, 1inc) x 6 [30]
- 6) (2sc, 1inc, 2sc) x 6 [36]
- 7) 36sc
- 8) (5sc, 1inc) x 6 [42]
- 9-11) 42sc - 3 rounds

The hair base must be long enough to get close to the ears (**picture 18**). In this case, work **1slst in the next stitch** and make the hair strands.

However, if it is too long and touching the ears, undo 1 round. If it's too short and too far from the ears, make another round of 42sc. Then, work **1slst in the next stitch** and make the hair strands.

**Strand 1)** ch-13; start in the 2nd ch from the hook: 1slst, 2sc, 1hdc, 1hdc-inc, 7hdc [13].

Skip 2 stitches and work 1slst in the next one.



**Strands 2-3)** ch-4; start in the 3rd ch from the hook: 2hdc.

Skip 1 stitch and work 1slst in the next one.

**Strands 4)** ch-5; start in the 3rd ch from the hook: 3hdc.

Skip 2 stitches and work 1slst in the next one.

**Strands 5-6)** ch-4; start in the 3rd ch from the hook: 2hdc.

Skip 1 stitch and work 1slst in the next one.

# Hair

**Strand 7)** ch-14; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:

1slst, 2sc, 1hdc, 1hdc-inc, 7hdc, skip the last chain [13].

*Skip 2 stitches and work 1slst in the next one.*

Fasten off on the right side as the hair will be worn inside out.

## Buns (2x)

**Black yarn**

1) 6sc in a MR [6]

2) 6inc [12]

3) (1sc, 1inc) x 6 [18]

4-5) 18sc - 2 rounds

Fasten off leaving a yarn tail for sewing.



# Hairstyle



Turn the **hair base inside out** and put it on the head so that strand 4 is 2 stitches away from the eyebrows - **picture 23**.

Pin strands 1 and 7 in front of the ears, and position strands 2 to 6 on the forehead. **Glue the strands and hair base to the head.**



Pin a bun behind one ear, placing it on one side of the head.  
After doing so, sew the bun in place, stuffing as you sew.

Repeat the process to sew the other bun onto the other side of the head.



# Finishing



**Ch-22 in gold** — or make as many chains as it takes to go around a bun.  
Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail to sew the chains around one bun.

Make another piece and sew it around the other bun.



If you have gold star-shaped sequins, glue one on each cheek,  
as shown in the pictures above.

# Assembly



Use black yarn to sew the chain keyring to the top of the head.

Next, apply fabric stiffener to the ends of strands 1 and 7, curl them, and let them dry for a few hours.

Then, apply fabric waterproofing spray to the keychain and let it dry. It's ready. I hope you had a great time crocheting!






## Eyelashes

Use the black lace weight yarn to embroider the eyelashes below the eye shadows; use **pictures 11-12** as a reference.



## Eyebrows

Embroider dark pink eyebrows above the eyes, between rounds 9-10, making them 3 stitches wide.



# Facial Expression

## Blush

Apply pink dry pastel (or pink powder blush) to the cheeks and nose.



# Earrings

Use the tapestry needle to wrap the golden yarn around the side of the ears three times — or as many times as you prefer.

Use the images beside as reference for this step.



# Hair

## Dark pink yarn

- 1) 6sc in a MR [6]
- 2) 6inc [12]
- 3) (1sc, 1inc) x 6 [18]

Work **1slst in the next stitch**, then make the strands.

**Strand 1)** ch-30; start in the 3rd chain from the hook: 28hdc.

Work **1slst in the next stitch of the hair base**, ch-1, and turn your work (**pic 20**).

From now on, **crochet in rows, working in the back loops** of the previous strand.

**Strand 2) BLO:** 28hdc - **pics 21-22** +2 turning chains - **picture 23**.

**Strand 3) BLO:** 28hdc - **picture 24**  
Work **1slst in the next stitch of the hair base** (**picture 25**).  
+1 turning chain.

**Strands 4, 6, 8, 10) BLO:** 28hdc.  
+2 turning chains.

**Strands 5, 7, 9, 11) BLO:** 28hdc.

Skip 1 stitch of the hair base and work **1slst in the next one**.  
+1 turning chain.



# Hair

**Strand 12) BLO:** 28hdc.  
+2 turning chains.

**Strand 13) BLO:** 28hdc.  
*Skip 1 stitch and work 1slst in the next one.*

**Stop working in rows and continue:**

**Strands 14 and 15)** ch-32; start in the 3rd chain from the hook:  
29hdc, 1slst [30].

**Strand 16)** ch-32; start in the 3rd ch from the hook: 29hdc, 1slst [30].  
*Work 1slst in the same stitch you started in.*

**Strand 17)** ch-9; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
1slst, 1sc, 5hdc, 1dc [8].  
*Skip 1 stitch and work 1slst in the next one, then make 1 more slst.*

**Strand 18)** ch-25; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
2slst, 2sc, 19hdc, 1slst [24].



*Work 1slst in the same stitch you started in.*

**Strand 19)** ch-25; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
2slst, 2sc, 19hdc, 1slst [24].  
*Work 1slst in the same stitch you started in, then make 1 more slst.*

**Strand 20)** ch-9; start in the 2nd chain from the hook:  
1slst, 1sc, 5hdc, 1dc [8].  
*Skip 1 stitch and work 1slst in the next one.*

# Hair

**Strands 21 and 22)**  
ch-32; start in the 3rd  
chain from the hook:  
29hdc, 1slst [30].

**Strand 23)** ch-32; start  
in the 3rd chain from  
the hook:  
29hdc, 1slst [30].  
*Work 1slst in the same  
stitch you started in.*

*Fasten off.*



## IRON BLOCKING

### How to straighten the hair strands

If your crochet stitches are too tight and the strands of hair are curling, you can use an iron to keep the piece straight. In this case, be mindful of:



- Not burning your fingertips. Be careful!
- Using the iron's steam function or dampening the piece before ironing it;
- Paying attention to the iron's temperature, especially if you're working with acrylic or mixed yarn.

# Hairstyle




Place the hair base on the head so that the magic ring of the hair is directly over the magic ring of the head, as shown in **picture 28**.

Strands 1 to 13 should cover the back of the head, so pin them to the head in such a way that the 1st and 13th strands are behind the ears.




Next, pin strands 17 and 20 (the smaller ones) above the ears - **pics 32-33**.  
Then, turn **strands 18-19 inside out** and pin them in front of the ears.

**Glue the hair base and strands onto the head,**  
except for strands 14-16 and 21-23.




# Hairstyle



Group strands 14-16 into a pigtail at the top of the head and use the dark pink yarn to tie them together.  
Then, use a tapestry need to hide the yarn tails in the head.

Repeat these steps to group and secure strands 21-23.



Glue the **golden half pearls** to the sides of the head, onto strands 17 and 20: stick an 8mm half pearl, then glue a 5mm half pearl above it.



# Assembly



Use dark pink yarn to sew the chain keyring to the top of the head.

Then, apply fabric waterproofing spray to the keychain and let it dry.  
It's ready. I hope you had a great time crocheting!
