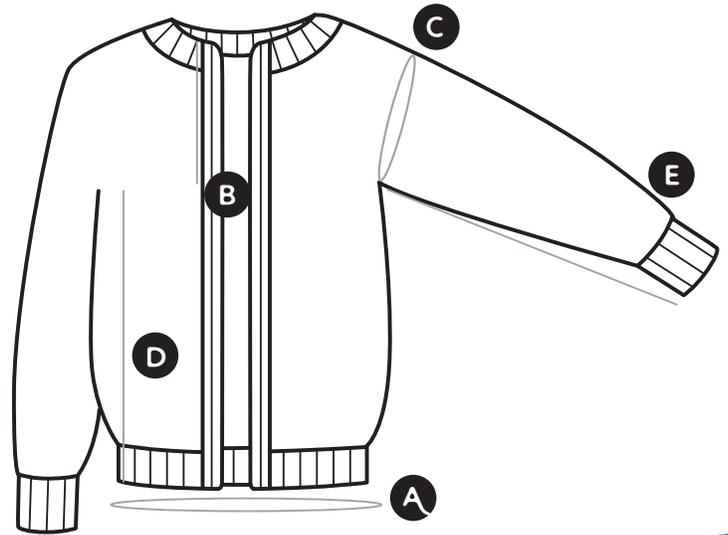


## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

### Sizes

1 (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9)

Choose the size that corresponds to your chest circumference. The Bumpy Cardigan is designed to stay open; the finished width around the chest, including the space between the bands ( $2\frac{3}{4}$ " / 6.5 cm) will give a positive ease of 2–6" / 5–15 cm. If your chest size falls between two sizes, choose the size that corresponds to the amount of desired ease; choose the smaller size if you want around 2" / 5 cm of positive ease, or the larger size if you want 6" / 15 cm of positive.

### Yarn

**Weight:** DK

- **Yarn A (dark blue)**

890 (979, 1077, 1185, 1304, 1434, 1577, 1735, 1909) yd

814 (895, 985, 1084, 1192, 1311, 1442, 1586, 1746) m

4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 8) skeins of British DK from Les Garçons

**Weight:** Sport

*Yarn B is thinner than Yarn A to avoid puckering on the i-cord stripes*

- **Yarn B (gradient)**

195 (215, 236, 260, 286, 315, 347, 382, 420) yd

178 (197, 216, 238, 262, 288, 317, 349, 384) m

2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 3) skeins of Dyed in the Wool by Spincycle Yarns

Sample shown in British DK from Les Garçons (75% bluefaced leicester wool, 25% masham wool, non-superwash; 263 yd / 240 m per 100 g skein), in the “Édith’s Butler” colourway (Yarn A), and in Dyed in the Wool from Spincycle Yarns (100% merino wool; 200 yd / 183 m per 50 g skein), in the “After Midnight (TKL Exclusive)” colourway (Yarn B).

Max is wearing size 4 and is 5’11” with a 38” / 96.5 cm chest girth



### Needles

- **Main needles:** circular, US 5 / 3.75 mm, or size needed to obtain gauge

- **Ribbing needles:** circular, US 3 / 3.25 mm, or 0.5 mm smaller than main needles

Double-pointed needles in the same two sizes for the sleeves and smaller circumferences, if you’re not using the magic-loop method



### Gauge

21 sts and 32 rows = 4” / 10 cm in stockinette stitch with Yarn A, blocked



### Notions

Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, and a tapestry needle

## COLLAR

### I-cord cast-on

Using Yarn A, the main needles and the long-tail cast-on method, CO 3 sts.

\*K3, slide the sts from one end of the needle to the other (do not turn), repeat from \* a total of 103 (109, 111, 111, 111, 113, 113, 117, 117) times, k3.

With the RS facing, tip the needles to the left; pick up and knit 1 st per row from the i-cord.

You should have 106 (112, 114, 114, 114, 116, 116, 120, 120) sts on your needles.

**Setup row 1 (WS):** Turn the work, pick up and knit 3 sts from the i-cord CO, [p1, k1] 3 times, pm, [p1, k1] to last 10 sts, p1, pm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have 109 (115, 117, 117, 117, 119, 119, 123, 123) sts on your needles.

Switch to ribbing needles.

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to 1 st before m, k1, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Work **rows 1 and 2** until collar measures 1½" / 4 cm, ending after a row 2.

**Next row (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, [sl1 wyib, p1] to 1 st before m, sl1 wyib, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

Switch to main needles.

### Size 1 only

**Next row (WS, dec):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, p50, k2tog, p to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *1 st dec'd*

### Size 2 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p16, m1p] 5 times, p to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *5 sts inc'd*

### Size 3 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p6, m1p] to 9 sts before m, p9, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *15 sts inc'd*

### Size 4 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1p, p3, m1p] to 8 sts before m, p4, m1p, p4, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *27 sts inc'd*

### Size 5 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p3, m1p, p2, m1p] to 4 sts before m, p2, m1p, p2, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *39 sts inc'd*

### Size 6 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1p] to 5 sts before m, p5, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *24 sts inc'd*

**Next row (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p5, m1p] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *25 sts inc'd*

### Size 7 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1lp, p3, m1lp] to 3 sts before m, p3, m1lp, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *29 sts inc'd*

**Next row (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1lp] to 2 sts before m, p2, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *32 sts inc'd*

### Size 8 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p3, m1lp] to 3 sts before m, p3, m1lp, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *34 sts inc'd*

**Next row (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1lp] to 3 sts before m, p3, m1lp, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *35 sts inc'd*

### Size 9 only

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p3, m1lp, p2, m1lp] to 5 sts before m, p5, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *40 sts inc'd*

**Next row (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Next row (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1lp, p3, m1lp] to 5 sts before m, p3, m1lp, p2, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *41 sts inc'd*

You should have 108 (120, 132, 144, 156, 168, 180, 192, 204) sts on your needles

## BACK SHAPING

In the following section, you will be working back and forth using short rows to add some length to the back of the sweater.

**Short row 1 (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k72 (81, 90, 99, 108, 117, 126, 135, 144), turn.

**Short row 2 (WS):** Make a ds, p53 (59, 65, 71, 77, 83, 89, 95, 101), turn.

**Short row 3:** Make a ds, k to 2 sts before ds from previous row, turn.

**Short row 4:** Make a ds, p to 2 sts before ds from previous row, turn.

**Short rows 5–8:** Work **short rows 3** and **4** twice more.

In the next two rows, work the doubled stitches in the next round by knitting or purling both legs together as a single stitch.

**Short row 9 (RS):** Make a ds, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Next row (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, p to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

## YOKE

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, p to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Rows 3–6:** Work **rows 1** and **2** twice more.

**Row 7:** Work **row 1**.

**Row 8 (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p3, m1|p] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *30 (34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts inc'd*

You should have 138 (154, 170, 186, 202, 218, 234, 250, 266) sts on your needles.

**Rows 9–10:** Work **rows 1** and **2** once more.

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

When picking up stitches, pick up both legs of the i-cord stitch closest to the wrong side of the work to achieve a 3D effect.

**Row 11 (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pm, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, pm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have 138 (154, 170, 186, 202, 218, 234, 250, 266) sts on your needles.

**Row 12 (WS):** Work **row 2**.

**Rows 13–16:** Work **rows 1** and **2** twice more.

**Row 17:** Work **row 1**.

**Row 18 (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p4, m1|p] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *30 (34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts inc'd*

You should have 168 (188, 208, 228, 248, 268, 288, 308, 328) sts on your needles.

### I-cord stripe

Sl9 wyib, rm. Using Yarn B and the long-tail cast-on method, CO 3 sts. Slip the 3 sts you've just cast on from the right needle to the left needle.

\*K2, k2tog tbl, sl 3 sts from the right needle to the left needle\*; repeat \*-\* until there are 12 sts left on the left needle (9 sts of Yarn A and 3 sts of Yarn B), rm. Break Yarn B.

Thread a tapestry needle with the tail and pull it through the remaining 3 sts of Yarn B, from right to left, then drop the Yarn B sts from the needle.

You should have 18 sts of Yarn A on your needles: 9 sts on each needle.

Sl 9 sts from the right needle to the left needle.

**Row 19–24:** Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 3 times.

**Row 25:** Work **row 1**.

**Row 26 (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p5, m1lp] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *30 (34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts inc'd*

You should have 198 (222, 246, 270, 294, 318, 342, 366, 390) sts on your needles.

**Rows 27–30:** Work **rows 1** and **2** twice.

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

**Row 31 (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pm, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, pm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have 198 (222, 246, 270, 294, 318, 342, 366, 390) sts on your needles.

**Row 32:** Work **row 2**.

**Rows 33–40:** Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 4 times.

**Row 41:** Work **row 1**.

**Row 42 (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p6, m1lp] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *30 (34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts inc'd*

You should have 228 (256, 284, 312, 340, 368, 396, 424, 452) sts on your needles.

**Rows 43–48:** Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 3 times.

**Row 49:** Work **row 1**.

**Row 50 (WS, inc):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, [p7, m1lp] to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *30 (34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts inc'd*

You should have 258 (290, 322, 354, 386, 418, 450, 482, 514) sts on your needles.

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

**Row 51 (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pm, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, pm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have 258 (290, 322, 354, 386, 418, 450, 482, 514) sts on your needles.

**Row 52:** Work **row 2**.

### Sizes 1 & 2 only

**Rows 53 & 54:** Work **rows 1** and **2** once more.

### Sizes 3 & 4 only

**Rows 53–62:** Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 5 times.

### Size 5 only

**Rows 53–66:** Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 7 times.

### Sizes 6 & 7 only

**Rows 53–70:** Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 9 times.

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

**Row 71 (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pm, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, pm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have - (-, -, -, -, 418, 450, -, -) sts on your needles.



**Row 72:** Work row 2.

### Sizes 8 & 9 only

**Rows 53–70:** Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 9 times.

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

**Row 71 (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pm, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, pm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have - (-, -, -, -, -, -, 482, 514) sts on your needles.

**Row 72:** Work row 2.

**Rows 73–76:** Work rows 1 and 2 twice more.

### All sizes resume

Proceed to next section.

## SEPARATING BODY FROM SLEEVES

**Setup row 1 (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k22 (27, 33, 38, 43, 49, 52, 58, 63), place the next 60 (66, 70, 76, 82, 86, 96, 100, 106) sts (for the first sleeve) on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder. Using the backwards loop method, CO 8 (8, 8, 8, 8, 8, 10, 10, 12) sts, k76 (86, 98, 108, 118, 130, 136, 148, 158), place the next 60 (66, 70, 76, 82, 86, 96, 100, 106) sts (for the left sleeve) on hold. Using the backwards loop method, CO 8 (8, 8, 8, 8, 8, 10, 10, 12) sts, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have 154 (174, 198, 218, 238, 262, 278, 302, 326) sts on your needles.

**Setup row 2 (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, p to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to m, sm, k to m, sm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] to m, sm, p to m, sm, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

### Sizes 1 & 2 only

**Row 3–14:** Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 6 times.

### Sizes 3 & 4 only

**Row 3–6:** Work rows 1 and 2 twice more.

### Sizes 6 & 7 only

**Row 3–16:** Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 7 times.

### Sizes 8 & 9 only

**Row 3–12:** Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 5 times.

### All sizes resume

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

### Body repeat

**Next row (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pm, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, pm, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

You should have 154 (174, 198, 218, 238, 262, 278, 302, 326) sts on your needles.

Work **row 2**.

Work **rows 1** and **2** a total of 9 times.

Work an **i-cord stripe**.

You should have 20 rows of stockinette and 1 i-cord stripe in each body repeat.

Work **Body repeat** a total of 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5) times for the long version. If you want a cropped version, you can work one or two fewer repeats.

**Next row (RS):** Using Yarn A, k3, [k1, p1] 3 times, pick up 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 9 sts, [p1, k1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif.

## RIBBING

Switch to ribbing needles.

**Next row (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] 3 times, [sl1 wyif, k1] to last 13 sts, sl1 wyif, k2tog, sl1 wyif, [k1, p1] to last 3 sts, sl3 wyif. *1 st dec'd*

You should have 153 (173, 197, 217, 237, 261, 277, 301, 325) sts on your needles.

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, [k1, p1] to last 4 sts, k1, sl3 wyif.

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, [p1, k1] to last 4 sts, p1, sl3 wyif.

Work **rows 1** and **2** until ribbing measures 2½ (3, 2, 2, 3, 2, 2, 2¾, 2¾)" / 6.5 (7.5, 5, 5, 7.5, 5, 5, 7, 7) cm.

### I-cord bind-off

[K2, k2tog tbl, place 3 sts back onto left needle] until there are 6 sts left.

K3. Do not turn. Reverse the order of the 3 sts on your left needle by removing your needle and re-inserting it through the live sts the other way. Both your needles should now be parallel, with tips pointing left. Rotate your needles so that tips are pointing right, with your right needle behind your left needle. Break the yarn, leaving a 6" / 15 cm tail. Thread a tapestry needle with the tail and using the Kitchener stitch, graft the live sts together.

## SLEEVES

Place the 60 (66, 70, 76, 82, 86, 96, 100, 106) held sts for one sleeve on the main needles. Using Yarn A, pick up and knit 4 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts from the underarm starting in the middle of the CO edge from the body, k to end, pick up and knit 4 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts from the underarm. Pm to indicate BOR and join to work in the rnd.

You should have 68 (74, 78, 84, 90, 94, 106, 110, 118) sts on your needles.

**Rnd 1:** [P1, k1] twice, k to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice, sm.

Work **rnd 1** a total of 14 (14, 6, 6, 2, 16, 16, 12, 12) times.

**Next rnd (dec):** P1, k1, p1, ssk, k to last 6 sts, k2tog, [p1, k1] twice, sm. *2 sts dec'd*

You should have 66 (72, 76, 82, 88, 92, 104, 108, 116) sts on your needles.

Work an **i-cord sleeve stripe**.

### I-cord sleeve stripe

Sl4 wyib. Using Yarn B and the long-tail cast-on method, CO 3 sts. Slip the 3 sts you've just cast on from the right needle to the left needle.

\*K2, k2tog tbl, sl 3 sts from the right needle to the left needle\*; repeat \*-\* until there are 7 sts left on the left needle before the m (4 sts of Yarn A and 3 sts of Yarn B). Break Yarn B.

Thread a tapestry needle with the tail and pull it through the remaining 3 sts of Yarn B, from right to left, then drop the Yarn B sts from the needle.

You should have 8 sts of Yarn A on your needles.

Sl 4 sts from the right needle to the left needle, sm.

Read the following shaded instruction section completely before starting the sleeve repeats. You will be working decrease rounds while working the i-cord stripe sections on the sleeve.

### Sleeve repeat

**Next rnd:** Using Yarn A, [p1, k1] twice, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice, sm.

A hole is formed when making the i-cord stripe in the round. Use the yarn tail and a tapestry needle to fix it when weaving in ends.

**Rnd 1:** [P1, k1] twice, k to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice, sm.

Work **rnd 1** a total of 19 times.

Work an **i-cord sleeve stripe**.

Each Sleeve repeat consists of 20 rounds of stockinette stitch and 1 i-cord stripe.

Work **Sleeve repeat** a total of 5 (5, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6) times, while, **AT THE SAME TIME**, working a **dec rnd** every 9th (8th, 9th, 9th, 7th, 7th, 5th, 5th, 4th) stockinette stitch rnd a further 9 (11, 12, 12, 15, 16, 22, 22, 25) times, or until you have 48 (50, 52, 58, 58, 60, 60, 64, 66) sts left.

If the decrease round falls on the first round after an i-cord stripe, work it on the following round.

You should have 48 (50, 52, 58, 58, 60, 60, 64, 66) sts on your needles.

**Next rnd:** Using Yarn A, [p1, k1] twice, pick up and knit 1 st for each row of the i-cord to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice, sm.

You should have 48 (50, 52, 58, 58, 60, 60, 64, 66) sts on your needles.



### CUFF

Switch to ribbing needles.

**Next rnd:** [P1, k1] twice, [p1, sl1 wyib] last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice, sm.

**Rnd 1:** [P1, k1] to m, sm.

Work **rnd 1** until ribbing measures 2½ (3, 2, 2, 3, 2, 2, 2¾, 2¾) / 6.5 (7.5, 5, 5, 7.5, 5, 5, 7, 7) cm.

Bind off all sts using the tubular bind off technique.

Repeat for the second sleeve.

### FINISHING TOUCHES

Weave in the ends and block to measurements.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**BOR** beginning of round

**CO** cast on

**DEC'D** decrease(d)

**DS** doubled stitch : Slip the next stitch with yarn in front. Bring the yarn over the right needle to the back and pull on the slipped stitch to distort it. It will look as if there are two stitches instead of one, because the two legs of the stitch below will come up on the needle.
