SIZES

Head circumference: 51 - 53 (54 - 56) 57 - 59
(60 - 62) cm

MEASUREMENTS

Hat crown: 8 (8.5) 9 (9.5) cm
Hat brim: 7 (7.5) 8 (8.5) cm

YARN

100 (100) 100 (100) g of Wool and the Gang
,Raffia' (100 % long fibred wood, approx 250 m/
100 g)

NEEDLES

Crochet hook size US G/6

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle, stitch marker

STITCH GLOSSARY

Stitches you need to know: Chain, single crochet,
slip stitch.

GAUGE

13 sts x 19 - 20 rows working single crochets with hook US G/6 (steamed and stretched) = 10 x 10 cm (Take time to check gauge, changing needle sizes if necessary.)

BEFORE YOU START

This model has the shape of a bucket hat, with a broad brim that points down. It is worked from top down in spiral rounds so that there will be no visible "seam".

Raffia is an extremely stretchy material, so stretch the hat from time to time while you are working and pull it into shape - or just put it on for a moment. This way you can check the fit at the same time and adjust the pattern to your liking. The hat receives its finishing touches and its actual shape when you steam the fabric.

INSTRUCTIONS

Hat crown

All sizes

Work sc in spiral rounds, ie when you come to the end of a round just keep on working. The first sc of a rnd is always worked into the first sc of the previous rnd. Mark the beginning of the round with a stitch marker.¹

Make a yarn ring and using a hook US G/6 work 6 sc into the ring.² After the last stitch, tug the tail to tighten the hole and work as follows:

Rnd 1: 2 sc into each sc (= 12 sc in total).

Rnd 2: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc into the following sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 18 sc in total).

Rnd 3: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 2 sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 24 sc in total).

Rnd 4: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 3 sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 30 sc in total).

Rnd 5: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 4 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last sc (= 36 sc in total).

Rnd 6: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 5 sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 42 sc in total).

Rnd 7: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 6 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1sc into the last 2 sc (= 48 sc in total).

Rnd 8: Work 1 sc into the first sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 7 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 6 sc (= 54 sc in total).

Rnd 9: Work 1 sc into each of the first 5 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 8 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 3 sc (= 60 sc in total).

For head circumferences (54-56) 57-59 (60-62) work further rnds as follows:

For head circumference of 54 -56 cm

Rnd 10: Work 1 sc into each of the first 2 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 9 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 7 sc (= 66 sc in total).

For head circumference of 57 - 59 cm

Rnd 10: Work 1 sc into each of the first 2 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 9 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 7 sc (= 66 sc in total).

Rnd 11: Work 1 sc into each of the first 6 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 10 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 4 sc (= 72 sc in total).

For head circumference of 60 - 62 cm

Rnd 10: Work 1 sc into each of the first 2 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 9 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 7 sc (= 66 sc in total).

Rnd 11: Work 1 sc into each of the first 6 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 10 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 4 sc (= 72 sc in total).

Rnd 12: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 11 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 8 sc (= 78 sc in total).

The ,base' of the hat is now finished, the diameter is approx.12 (13) 14 (15) cm. Work the crown as follows:

All sizes

Rnd 1: 1 sc into the back loop of every sc (= 60 (66) 72 (78) sc in total).

Rnds 2 and 3: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 4: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 19 (21) 23 (25) sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 63 (69) 75 (81) sc in total).

Rnds 5 - 7: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 8: Work 1 sc into each of the first 10 (11) 12 (13) sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 20 (22) 24 (26) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 10 (11) 12 (13) sc (= 66 (72) 78 (84) sc in total).

Rnds 9 - 16 (17) 18 (19): 1 sc into each sc.

Now the crown is finished. Its measurement should be about 8 (8.5) 9 (9.5) cm.

Hat brim

Work increases for the brim. Keep on stretching and shaping the hat as you go.

All sizes

Rnd 1: 1 sc into the back loop of every sc (= 66 (72) 78 (84) sc in total).

Rnd 2: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 10 (11) 12 (13) sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 72 (78) 84 (90) sc in total).

Rnd 3: Work 1 sc into each of the first 8 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 11 (12) 13 (14) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 3 (4) 5 (6) sc (= 78 (84) 90 (96) sc in total).

Rnd 4: Work 1 sc into the first sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 12 (13) 14 (15) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 11 (12) 13 (14) sc (= 84 (90) 96 (102) sc in total).

Rnd 5: Work 1 sc into each of the first 9 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 13 (14) 15 (16) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 4 (5) 6 (7) sc (= 90 (96) 102 (108) sc in total).

Rnd 6: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 7: Work 1 sc into each of the first 2 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 14 (15) 16 (17) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 12 (13) 14 (15) sc (= 96 (102) 108 (114) sc in total).

Rnd 8: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 9: Work 1 sc into each of the first 10 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 15 (16) 17 (18) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 5 (6) 7 (8) sc (= 102 (108) 114 (120) sc in total).

Rnd 10: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 11: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 16 (17) 18 (19) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 13 (14) 15 (16) sc (= 108 (114) 120 (126) sc in total).

Rnd 12: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 13: Work 1 sc into each of the first 11 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 17 (18) 19 (20) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 6 (7) 8 (9) sc (= 114 (120) 126 (132) sc in total).

For head circumferences (54-56) 57-59 (60-62) work further rnds as follows:

For head circumference of 54 - 56 cm

Rnd 14: 1 sc into each sc.

For head circumference of 57 - 59 cm

Rnd 14: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 15: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 20 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 16 sc (= 132 sc in total).

For head circumference of 60 - 62 cm

Rnd 14: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 15: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 21 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 17 sc (= 138 sc in total).

Rnd 16: 1 sc into each sc.

All sizes

Work one round of slip stitches along the brim edge. The brim's measurement should be about 7 (7.5) 8 (8.5) cm.

FINISHING

Sew in all yarn ends. Stretch the brim and carefully steam it under a damp cloth. Stuff a towel into the hat crown and steam the crown as well.

SIZES

Head circumference: 51 - 53 (54 - 56) 57 - 59
(60 - 62) cm

MEASUREMENTS

Hat crown: 8 (8.5) 9 (9.5) cm
Hat brim: 7 (7.5) 8 (8.5) cm

YARN

100 (150) 150 (200) g Drops ,Paris'
(100 % Cotton; LL 75 m/50 g)

NEEDLES

Crochet hook size US H/8

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle, stitch marker

STITCH GLOSSARY

Stitches you need to know: Chain, single crochet, slip stitch.

GAUGE

14 sts x 19 - 20 rows working single crochets with hook US H/8 (steamed and stretched) = 10 x 10 cm (Take time to check gauge, changing needle sizes if necessary.)

BEFORE YOU START

This model has the shape of a bucket hat, with a broad brim that points down. It is worked from top down in spiral rounds so that there will be no visible "seam".

INSTRUCTIONS

Hat crown

All sizes

Work sc in spiral rounds, ie when you come to the end of a round just keep on working. The first sc of a rnd is always worked into the first sc of the previous rnd. Mark the beginning of the round with a stitch marker.¹ Make a yarn ring and using a hook US H/8 work 6 sc into the ring.² After the last stitch, tug the tail to tighten the hole and work as follows:

Rnd 1: 2 sc into each sc (= 12 sc in total).

Rnd 2: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc into the following sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 18 sc in total).

Rnd 3: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 2 sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 24 sc in total).

Rnd 4: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 3 sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 30 sc in total).

Rnd 5: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 4 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last sc (= 36 sc in total).

Rnd 6: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 5 sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 42 sc in total).

Rnd 7: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 6 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1sc into the last 2 sc (= 48 sc in total).

Rnd 8: Work 1 sc into the first sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 7 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 6 sc (= 54 sc in total).

Rnd 9: Work 1 sc into each of the first 5 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 8 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 3 sc (= 60 sc in total).

Rnd 10: Work 1 sc into each of the first 2 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 9 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 7 sc (= 66 sc in total).

Rnd 11: Work 1 sc into each of the first 6 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 10 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 4 sc (= 72 sc in total).

For head circumferences (54-56) 57-59 (60-62) work further rnds as follows:

For head circumference of 54 -56 cm

Rnd 12: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 11 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 8 sc (= 78 sc in total).

For head circumference of 57 - 59 cm

Rnd 12: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 11 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 8 sc (= 78 sc in total).

Rnd 13: Work 1 sc into each of the first 7 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 12 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 5 sc (= 84 sc in total).

For head circumference of 60 - 62 cm

Rnd 12: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 11 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 8 sc (= 78 sc in total).

Rnd 13: Work 1 sc into each of the first 7 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 12 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 5 sc (= 84 sc in total).

Rnd 14: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 13 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 9 sc (= 90 sc in total).

The top of the hat is now finished. Work the crown as follows:

All sizes

Rnd 1: 1 sc into the back loop of every sc (= 72 (78) 84 (90) sc in total).

Rnds 2. - 16. (17.) 18. (19.): 1 sc into each sc.

Now the crown is finished. Its measurement should be about 8 (8.5) 9 (9.5) cm.

Hat brim

Work increases for the brim.

All sizes

Rnd 1: 1 sc into the back loop of every sc (= 72 (78) 84 (90) sc in total).

Rnd 2: *2 sc into the first sc, 1 sc each into the following 11 (12) 13 (14) sc, repeat from * to end of rnd (= 78 (84) 90 (96) sc in total).

Rnd 3: Work 1 sc into each of the first 8 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 12 (13) 14 (15) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 4 (5) 6 (7) sc (= 84 (90) 96 (102) sc in total).

Rnd 4: Work 1 sc into the first sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 13 (14) 15 (16) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 12 (13) 14 (15) sc (= 90 (96) 102 (108) sc in total).

Rnd 5: Work 1 sc into each of the first 9 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 14 (15) 16 (17) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 5 (6) 7 (8) sc (= 96 (102) 108 (114) sc in total).

Rnd 6: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 7: Work 1 sc into each of the first 2 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 15 (16) 17 (18) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 13 (14) 15 (16) sc (= 102 (108) 114 (120) sc in total).

Rnd 8: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 9: Work 1 sc into each of the first 10 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, * 1 sc into the following 16 (17) 18 (19) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 6 (7) 8 (9) sc (= 108 (114) 120 (126) sc in total).

Rnd 10: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 11: Work 1 sc into each of the first 3 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 17 (18) 19 (20) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 14 (15) 16 (17) sc (= 114 (120) 126 (132) sc in total).

Rnd 12: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 13: Work 1 sc into each of the first 11 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 18 (19) 20 (21) sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 7 (8) 9 (10) sc (= 120 (126) 132 (138) sc in total).

For head circumferences (54-56) 57-59 (60-62) work further rnds as follows:

For head circumference of 54 - 56 cm

Rnd 14: 1 sc into each sc.

For head circumference of 57 - 59 cm

Rnd 14: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 15: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 21 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 17 sc (= 138 sc in total).

For head circumference of 60 - 62 cm

Rnd 14: 1 sc into each sc.

Rnd 15: Work 1 sc into each of the first 4 sc, then 2 sc into the following sc, *1 sc into the following 22 sc, 2 sc into the next sc, repeat from * throughout, end with 1 sc into the last 18 sc (= 144 sc in total).

Rnd 16: 1 sc into each sc.

All sizes

Work one round of slip stitches along the brim edge. The brim's measurement should be about 7 (7.5) 8 (8.5) cm.

FINISHING

Sew in all yarn ends. Stretch the brim and carefully steam it under a damp cloth. Stuff a towel into the hat crown and steam the crown as well.
