

## • SCHEMATIC, MEASUREMENTS & INFORMATIONS •

A: 38 (37.5 - 40 - 41.25) 45.75 (46.5 - 49.5 - 53) 57 (61.5 - 59)  
B: 12.5 (adjustable)  
C: 17.25 (adjustable)  
D: 7.5 (8 - 8.25) 9 (9.5 - 10) 10.25 (11 - 11.5)  
E: 11.5 (12 - 12.5) 13.75 (15 - 15.75) 16 (17.25 - 18)

**SIZES:** 1 (2 - 3) 4 (5 - 6) 7 (8 - 9)

Finished bust circumference approximately: 38 (37.5 - 40 - 41.25) 45.75 (46.5 - 49.5 - 53) 57 (61.5 - 59) inches or 91 (95 - 101) 105 (116 - 126) 135 (145 - 156) cm.



**GAUGE:** 21 sts x 26 rows for 4 x 4 inches or 10 x 10 cm in st st with larger needles.



**YARN:** this sweater is knitted with two strands of lace weight held together.

Approximately 1770 (1870 - 2970) 2140 (2370 - 2550) 2700 (2950 - 3160) yards or 1620 (1710 - 1800) 1960 (2170 - 2340) 2470 (2700 - 2900) m of total.

If you prefer, you can knit this sweater with only one strand of a DK weight yarn.



**NOTIONS:** needles sizes 3 mm/US 2.5 (rib) and 4 mm/US 6 (body and sleeves), tapestry needle, cable to hold live stitches, 10 stitch markers and 8 (8 - 8) 9 (9 - 10) 9 (11 - 11) buttons of 10 mm.



**NOTES:** the pattern is knitted using Soft silk mohair from Knitting for olive color « Artichoke purple ».

Recommended ease: 2.25 to 4.75 inches or 6 to 12 cm of positive ease. To pick your best size, measure your full bust and add your desired ease, then pick the finished bust circumference closest to that number.

Sample is shown in size 3 with 3.5 inches or 9 cm of positive ease.

**CAMEE** is a very feminine cardigan with straight sleeves tightened at the cuff, a round neckline and a lace pattern on each front.

It is knitted from top to bottom seamlessly. We start the yoke from the back then the front stitches are picked on the top of the shoulders formed by shortened rows. The stitches of the sleeves are picked up then worked at the same time as the top of the body and then left on hold at the separation. The body (back and front) is worked back and forth with a lace pattern and the button band at the same time. The sleeve stitches are picked up and knit in the round. The neckline is finished with a ribbed collar.

## • ABBREVIATIONS, STITCHES & TECHNIQUES •

**dec** decrease

**DS** double stitch

**inc** increase

**k** knit

**K2 tog** knit 2 sts together (decrease)

**K4 tog** knit 4 sts together (decrease)

**M** marker

**M1L (make 1 left)** Increase leans to the left :

pick up the horizontal bar between the sts from front to back, knit through back leg

**M1R (make 1 right)** Increase leans to the right :

pick up the horizontal bar between the sts from back to front, knit through front leg

**PM A/B** place marker A/B

**PS** pulled stitch

**p** purl

**pssso** pass slip stitch over knitted stitch

**rep** repeat

**RM** remove marker

**RS** right side

**SI** slip stitch as if to purl with yarn in front

**SI1, K3 tog, pssso** slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front, knit 3 sts together, pass slip stitch over knit stitch (decrease)

**SM** slip marker

**SR** short row

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**WS** wrong side

**St st (stockinette stitch):** (worked in round) knit every round  
(worked flat) knit stitches on RS, purl stitches on WS

**1/1 ribs:** \*k1, p1\* to end.

**Cable Cast-on method:** see this vidéo

**German short rows:** work to the instructed stitch and turn your work. Slip the last st purlwise from left needle to right needle with yarn in front. Pull the yarn towards the back, to reveal the two legs of the last stitch. It's the "double st" (DS). Work even remaining sts. On next row, work the 2 legs of DS together.

## • INSTRUCTIONS •

### BACK

With 4 mm/US 6 circular needles cast on loosely 72 (72 - 74) 80 (84 - 86) 88 (90 - 92) sts. Do not join in the round.

**Note :** to make it easier to pick up the front stitches, it is advisable to use removable markers and place these markers on the cast on row.

**Set up row (WS):** p 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts (left shoulder), PMB, p 30 (30 - 32) 36 (40 - 40) 42 (42 - 44) sts (neck), PMA, p 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts (right shoulder).

#### Shorts rows (using German shorts rows) for shaping round neckline

**SR 1 (RS):** k to MB, SM, k4, turn.

**SR 2 (WS):** create DS, p to MA, SM, p4, turn.

**SR 3 (RS):** create DS, k to DS, k DS, k4, turn.

**SR 4 (WS):** create DS, p to DS, p4, turn.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times.

Work RS and WS rows to end (including DS). Continue in st st until work measures 1.25 (1.25 - 1.25) 1.25 (1.5 - 1.5) 1.5 (1.5 - 2) inches or 3 (3 - 3) 3 (4 - 4) 4 (4 - 5) cm from cast-on row along armhole. Ending with WS.

Cut yarn and hold sts on cable.

### FRONTS

#### SHOULDER RIGHT

With 4 mm/US 6 circular needles and RS facing you pick up 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts along cast on edge starting on armhole until MA. Remove M.

#### Short rows shoulder

**SR 1 (WS):** p4, turn work.

**SR 2 (RS):** create DS, k to end.

**SR 3 (WS):** p until the DS, p DS, p4, turn work.

**SR 4 (RS):** create DS, k to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times. Then work WS row (including the DS).

Continue in st st until work measures 1.25 (1.25 - 1.25) 1.25 (1.5 - 1.5) 1.5 (1.5 - 2) inches or 3 (3 - 3) 3 (4 - 4) 4 (4 - 5) cm from cast-on row along armhole, ending with WS.

Cut yarn and hold sts on cable.

## SHOULDER LEFT

**Measure about 60 cm from the two threads and pick up the sts by starting at the neckline keeping the threads connected to the skein on the right, then slip the sts over the cable so you can knit a RS row.**

With 4 mm/US 6 circular needles and RS facing you pick up 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts along cast on edge starting on the MB (neckline side). Remove M.

### Short rows shoulder

**SR 1 (RS):** k4, turn work.

**SR 2 (WS):** create DS, p to end.

**SR 3 (RS):** k until DS, k DS, k4, turn work.

**SR 4 (WS):** create DS, p to end.

Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times.

Work RS (including DS) and WS rows.

Continue in st st until work measures 1.25 (1.25 - 1.25) 1.25 (1.5 - 1.5) 1.5 (1.5 - 2) inches or 3 (3 - 3) 3 (4 - 4) 4 (4 - 5) cm from cast-on row along armhole. Ending with WS. **Do not cut yarn.**

## BACK, FRONTS, and TOP of SLEEVES

**Note:** on next row, pick up sts between each front and back to form top of sleeves.

K 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts of left front, PM, pick up and knit 12 (14 - 14) 14 (16 - 16) 18 (18 - 20) sts along top of shoulder (left sleeve), PM, resume and knit 72 (72 - 74) 80 (84 - 86) 88 (90 - 92) sts of back left on hold, PM, pick up and knit 12 (14 - 14) 14 (16 - 16) 18 (18 - 20) sts along top of shoulder (right sleeve), PM, resume and knit 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts of right front left on hold.

You have 138 (142 - 144) 152 (160 - 164) 170 (174 - 180) sts in total.

Work WS.

### Increases part 1 (sleeves)

**Row 1 (RS):** \*k to next M, SM, M1L, k to next M, M1R, SM\* rep \*to\* 1 more times, k to end of row. (4 sts inc)

**Row 2 (WS):** p to end of row.

Repeat last 2 rows 3 (3 - 2) 2 (1 - 1) 0 (0 - 0) more times.

You have 154 (158 - 156) 164 (168 - 172) 174 (178 - 184) sts in total : 21 (21 - 21) 22 (22 - 23) 23 (24 - 24) sts for each front, 72 (72 - 74) 80 (84 - 86) 88 (90 - 92) sts for back and 20 (22 - 20) 20 (20 - 20) 20 (20 - 22) sts for each sleeves.

### Increases part 2 (neckline and sleeves)

**Row 1 (RS):** k1, M1L, \*k to next M, SM, M1L, k to next M, M1R, SM\* rep \*to\* 1 more times, k to 1 st of end of row, M1R, k1. (6 sts inc)

**Row 2 (WS):** p to end of row.

Repeat the last 2 rows 6 (6 - 7) 7 (8 - 9) 9 (10 - 10) more times.

You have 196 (200 - 204) 212 (222 - 232) 234 (244 - 250) sts in total : 28 (28 - 29) 30 (31 - 33) 33 (35 - 35) sts for each front, 72 (72 - 74) 80 (84 - 86) 88 (90 - 92) sts for back and 34 (36 - 36) 36 (38 - 40) 40 (42 - 44) sts for each sleeves.

### **Increases part 3 (sleeves and lace pattern on each front)**

#### **Set up**

**Row 1 (RS):** RS facing you, cast-on 10 (10 - 10) 12 (13 - 12) 13 (12 - 13) sts (cable cast-on is recommended), k1, sl1, k1, PM, p1, k2, PM, k 13, PM, \*k to next M, SM, M1L, k to next M, M1R, SM\* rep \*to\* 1 more time, k to end of row, (4 sts inc)

**Row 2 (WS):** WS facing you, cast-on 10 (10 - 10) 12 (13 - 12) 13 (12 - 13) sts, sl1, k1, sl1, PM, k1, p2, PM, p13, PM, p to 1 st to last M, k1, SM, sl1, k1, sl1.

You have 220 (224 - 228) 240 (252 - 260) 264 (272 - 280) sts in total : 38 (38 - 39) 42 (44 - 45) 46 (47 - 48) sts for each front, 72 (72 - 74) 80 (84 - 86) 88 (90 - 92) sts for back and 36 (38 - 38) 38 (40 - 42) 42 (44 - 46) sts for each sleeves.

**Row 3 (RS):** k1, sl1, k1, SM, p1, k2, SM, work 13 sts following lace pattern (chart page 9), SM, \*k to next M, SM, M1L, k to next M, M1R, SM\* rep \*to\* 1 more time, k to next M, SM, work 13 sts following lace pattern, SM, k2, p1, SM, k1, sl1, k1. (4 sts inc)

**Row 4 (WS):** sl1, k1, sl1, SM, k1, p2, SM, p to 1 st to last M, k1, SM, sl1, k1, sl1.

**Note : at the same time,** start the first buttonhole on right front at 2 (2 - 2) 1.5 (1.5 - 1.5) 2 (1.5 - 1.5) inches or 5 (5 - 5) 4 (4 - 4) 5 (4 - 4) cm then continue the following ones every 2.25 (2.25 - 2.25) 2 (2 - 2) 2.25 (2 - 2) inches or 6 (6 - 6) 5 (5 - 5) 6 (5 - 5) cm.

**Buttonhole row :** work as established until second last M, SM, k1, k2 tog, yo, SM, k1, sl1, k1.

Repeat last 2 rows (3 et 4) 4 (3 - 3) 7 (6 - 4) 3 (2 - 0) more times.

You have 240 (240 - 244) 272 (280 - 280) 280 (284 - 284) sts in total : 38 (38 - 39) 42 (44 - 45) 46 (47 - 48) sts for each front, 72 (72 - 74) 80 (84 - 86) 88 (90 - 92) sts for back and 46 (46 - 46) 54 (54 - 52) 50 (50 - 48) sts for each sleeves.

### **Increases part 4 (armholes front and back and sleeves)**

**Row 1 (RS):** k1, sl1, k1, SM, p1, k2, SM, work 13 sts following lace pattern, SM, k to 1 st to next M, M1R, k1, SM, M1L, k to next M, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k to 1 st to the next M, M1R, k1, SM, M1L, k to next M, M1R, SM, k1, M1L, k to next M, SM, work 13 sts following lace pattern, SM, k2, p1, SM, k1, sl1, k1. (8 sts inc)

**Row 2 (WS):** sl1, k1, sl1, SM, k1, p2, SM, p to 1 st to last M, k1, SM, sl1, k1, sl1.

**Row 3 (RS):** k1, sl1, k1, SM, p1, k2, SM, work 13 sts following lace pattern, SM, k to 1 st to next M, M1R, k1, SM, k to next M, SM, k1, M1L, k to 1 st to next M, M1R, k1, SM, k to M, SM, k1, M1L, k to next M, SM, work 13 sts following lace pattern, SM, k2, p1, SM, k1, sl1, k1. (4 sts inc)

**Row 4 (WS):** sl1, k1, sl1, SM, k1, p2, SM, p to 1 st to last M, k1, SM, sl1, k1, sl1.

Repeat these 4 rows 2 (3 - 4) 3 (4 - 6) 7 (9 - 10) more times.

**Only for sizes 1 (2 - ) 4 (5 - ) 7 ( - 9) :** work 1 more time rows 3 and 4.

You have 280 (292 - 304) 324 (344 - 364) 380 (404 - 420) sts in total : 45 (47 - 49) 51 (55 - 59) 63 (67 - 71) sts for each front, 86 (90 - 94) 98 (106 - 114) 122 (130 - 138) sts for back and 52 (54 - 56) 62 (64 - 66) 66 (70 - 70) sts for each sleeves.

## **BODY (BODY AND SLEEVES SEPARATION)**

Work 45 (47 - 49) 51 (55 - 59) 63 (67 - 71) sts of left front as established, RM, put on hold 52 (54 - 56) 62 (64 - 66) 66 (70 - 70) sts for left sleeve, RM, cast-on 10 (10 - 12) 12 (16 - 18) 20 (22 - 26) sts (cable cast-on is recommended), k 86 (90 - 94) 98 (106 - 114) 122 (130 - 138) sts of the back sts, RM, put on hold 52 (54 - 56) 62 (64 - 66) 66 (70 - 70) sts for right sleeve, RM, cast-on 10 (10 - 12) 12 (16 - 18) 20 (22 - 26) sts (cable cast-on is recommended), work 45 (47 - 49) 51 (55 - 59) 63 (67 - 71) sts of front as established.

You have 192 (204 - 212) 220 (244 - 264) 284 (304 - 328) sts in total.

Continue as established until you have 11 inches or 28 cm from the armhole (or 2.25 inches or 6 cm less than desired length).

On the last RS work one decrease (k2 tog).

**Note :** on last row remove all M except for the first and the last M.  
You have 191 (203 - 211) 219 (243 - 263) 283 (303 - 327) sts in total.

Change to 3 mm/US 2.5 circular needles and work :

**Row 1 (RS):** k1, sl1, k1, SM, p1, \*k1, p1\* to last M, SM, k1, sl1, k1.

**Row 2 (WS):** sl1, k1, sl1, SM, k1, \*p1, k1\* to last M, SM, sl1, k1, sl1.

Continue as established until 2.25 inches or 6 cm. Bind off loosely. Tubular sewn bind-off is recommended.

## NECKBAND

**Note:** neck is worked in 1/1 ribs.

Starting from back on right side, RS facing you and with 3 mm/US 2.5 circular needles pick up 113 (113 - 121) 125 (133 - 133) 137 (143 - 143) sts all around neckline. About 1 st for 1 cast on st of back and st cast-on on front and about 2 sts for 3 rows on each of neckline sides.

### Set up

**Row 1 (WS):** sl1, k1, sl1, PM, \*k1, p1\* to last 4 st to end, k1, PM, sl1, k1, sl1.

**Row 2 (buttonhole and RS):** k1, sl1, k1, SM, yo, k2 tog, p1 \*k1, p1\* to M, SM, k1, sl1, k1.

**Row 3 (WS):** sl1, k1, sl1, SM, \*k1, p1\* to last 4 st to end, k1, SM, sl1, k1, sl1.

**Row 4 (RS):** k1, sl1, k1, SM, p1, \*k1, p1\* to last M, SM, k1, sl1, k1.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until 0.75 inches or 2 cm in 1/1 ribs starting and bind-off very loosely. Italian bind-off is recommended.

## SLEEVES

Sleeves are worked in round using 4 mm/US 6 DPNs or circular needles in st st.

**Note :** when picking up stitches, a hole is often formed at underarm. To solve this problem you can:  
- close the hole when finishing by weaving in the ends.  
- pick up 2 additional stitches and work 2 decreases on the first and last stitches of the next row. We then obtain the recommended number of stitches.

Starting at the center of underarm, pick up and knit 5 (5 - 6) 6 (8 - 9) 10 (11 - 13) sts, resume and k 52 (54 - 56) 62 (64 - 66) 66 (70 - 70) sts left on hold, pick up 5 (5 - 6) 6 (8 - 9) 10 (11 - 13) sts, PM (beginning of round). You have 62 (64 - 68) 74 (80 - 84) 86 (92 - 96) sts in total.

Continue in st st until the total height of 11.75 inches or 30 cm from the armhole (or 2.25 inches or 6 cm shorter than the desired length), then work decreases.

### Decreases for the sleeve:

**Size 1:** SM, (k2, \*k2 tog\* 5 times), rep (to) 3 more times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 6 times.

**Size 2:** SM, (k2, \*k2 tog\* 5 times), rep (to) 4 more times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 6 times, k2.

**Size 3:** SM, k2, \*k2 tog\* 7 times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 7 times, k4, \*k2 tog\* 7 times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 7 times, k2.

**Size 4:** SM, k2, \*k2 tog\* 7 times, (k2, \*k2 tog\* 6 times), rep (to) 2 more times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 7 times.

**Size 5:** SM, k2, \*k2 tog\* 5 times, (k2, \*k2 tog\* 6 times), rep (to) 3 more times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 5 times.

**Size 6:** SM, (k4, \*k2 tog\* 9 times, k4, \*k2 tog\* 8 times), rep (to) 1 more times.

**Size 7:** SM, k2, \*k2 tog\* 5 times, (k4, \*k2 tog\* 6 times, k2, \*k2 tog\* 6 times), rep (to) 1 more times, k4, \*k2 tog\* 5 times.

**Size 8:** SM, k4, \*k2 tog\* 8 times, (k4, \*k2 tog\* 7 times), rep (to) 3 more times.

**Size 9:** SM, (k4, \*k2 tog\* 6 times), rep (to) 5 more times.

36 (38 - 40) 42 (46 - 50) 52 (56 - 60) sts remain.

With 3 mm/US 2.5 circular needles, work 2.25 inches or 6 cm total height in 1/1 ribs and bind off loosely. Italian bind-off is recommended.

## FINISHING

Close little holes at underarms if there's any, weave in all ends and block to finished measurements.

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

## WRITES EXPLANATIONS:

**Row 1 (RS):** k4tog, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front, knit 3 sts together, pass slip stitch over knit stitch.

**Row 2 (WS):** purl all.

**Row 3:** knit all.

**Row 4:** purl all.







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
