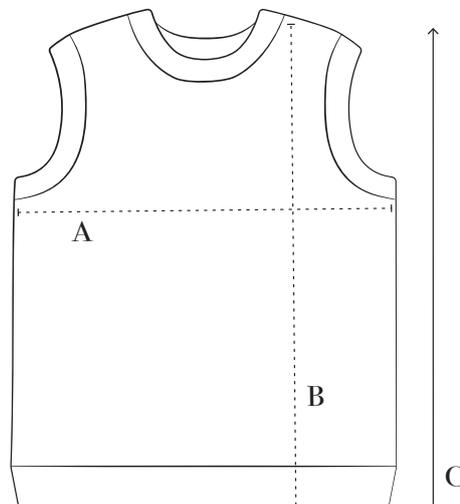

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## Materials

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**YARN FROM FILCOLANA**

**Peruvian colour 977 (Marzipan)**

300 (300) 350 (350) 400 (400) g

**NEEDLES**

Circular needle 4.5 mm, 80-120 cm

1 Double pointed needle 4.5 mm for wrap sts

**EXTRAS**

1 Stitch marker

2 Stitch holders

Scrap yarn for Italian cast on

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## Gauge

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20 sts and 28 rows in pattern according to chart C,  
worked on 4.5 mm needle = 10 x 10 cm.

Gauge are measured after washing.

Needle sizes are for guidance only.

If you have more stitches on 10 cm, change to a larger  
needle. If you have fewer stitches on 10 cm, change to  
smaller needles.



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## Technique

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### ABBREVIATIONS

**k:** knit

**p:** purl

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**yo:** yarn over

**RS:** right side

**WS:** wrong side

**tog:** together

**tbl:** through the back loop of stitch

**sl1p:** slip 1 st purlwise

**DPN:** Double pointed needle

### M1L (Left slanted increase)

From the front, lift the horizontal strand between stitches with the left needle and knit through the back loop (1 st increase).

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## Workflow

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Coralina is knitted in the round from the bottom up.

The pattern sections are worked according to charts. When the body is worked up to armholes, the work is divided into front and back pieces, which are then worked back and forth separately.

The front and back pieces are joined at the shoulders, and stitches are picked up along the neckline and armholes for the ribbed edges.

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## Charts

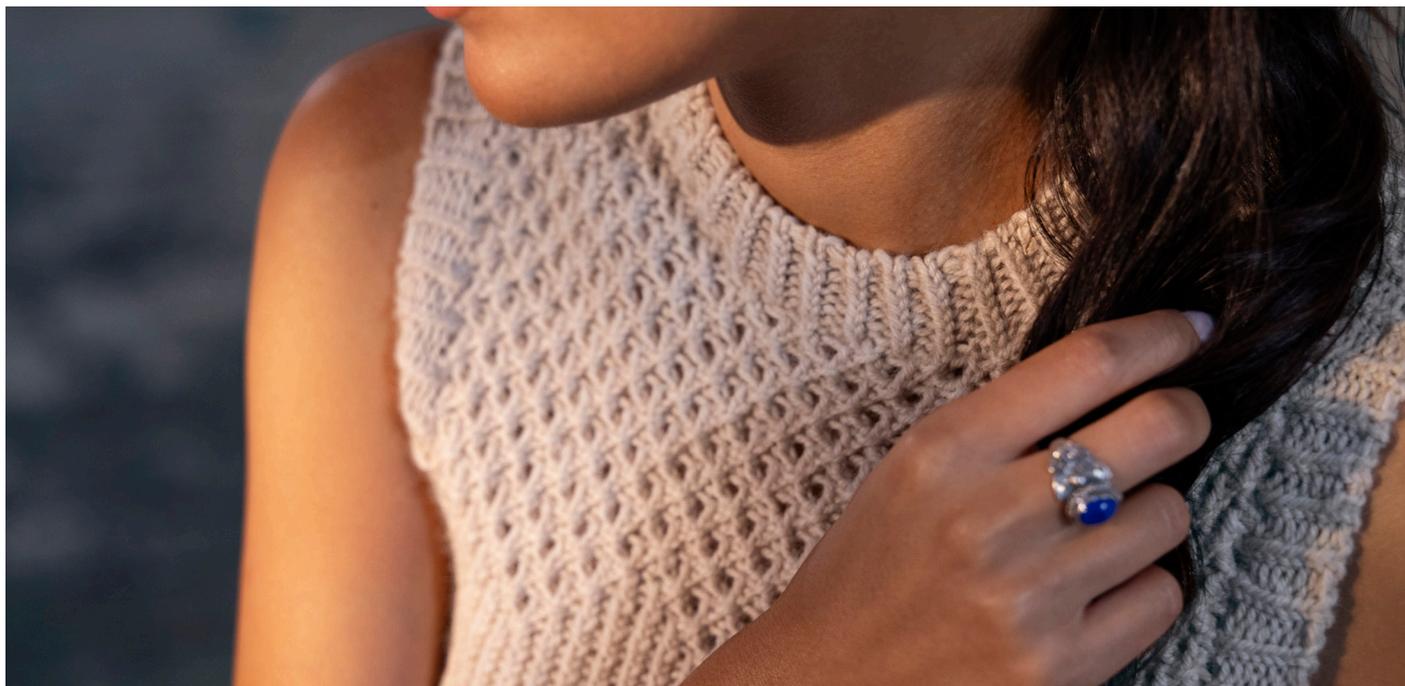
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Charts are located at the last pages in this pattern.

All charts are read from the bottom and up.

When working back and forth the charts are read from right to left on right side rows and from left to right on wrong side rows.

When working in the round, the charts are read from right to left on all rounds.



# Pattern

## BODY

Cast on 81 (86) 91 (101) 106 (111) sts on 4.5 mm circular needle, using the scrap yarn.

Knit 2 rows back and forth on the needle. Break the scrap yarn.

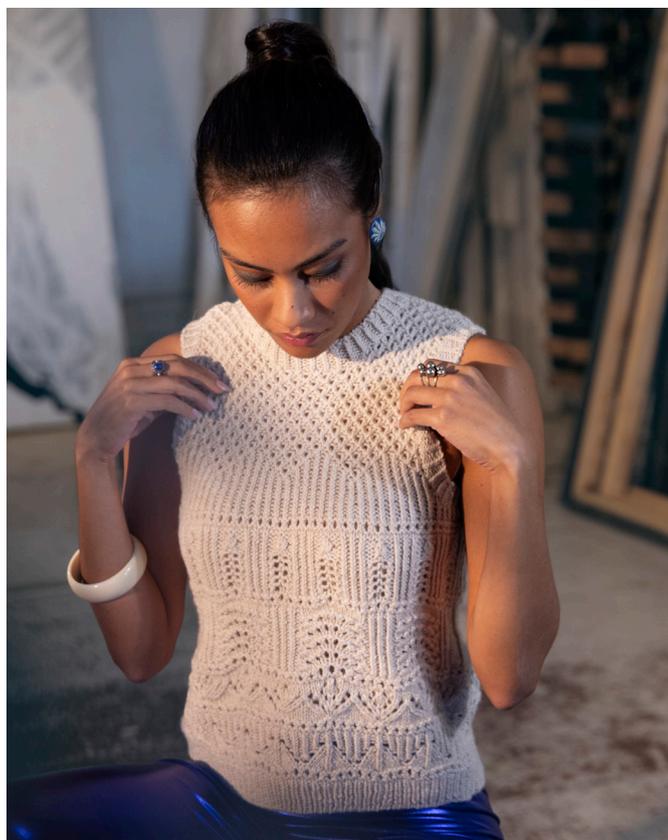
Join Peruvian to work and purl 1 row. Do not turn work but join to a round and purl 2 rounds.

**Next round:** \*P1, insert right hand needle under the lowest bar worked in Peruvian, 3 rows down (= 1st row worked in Peruvian), pull the yarn through as a knit st\*, repeat from \* to \*, to the last st, pick up the last bar on left hand needle and work it k2tog with the last st = 160 (170) 180 (200) 210 (220) sts.

Slip the first st to right-hand needle, insert a beginning of round marker.

The first st on the round is now a knit st.

Work ribbing (k1, p1) in the round, to rib measures 4 cm.



Carefully remove the scrap yarn.

Now work pattern according to the charts as follows:

Work 1st – 13th round of chart A.

Work 3 (3) 3 (5) 5 (7) rounds of twisted rib (p1, k1tbl).

Work 1st – 5th round of chart A.

Work 1st – 6th round of chart B.

Work 7th round of chart B as follows:

K1, work according to chart B to the last 2 sts, slip these 2 sts to right-hand needle, remove the marker, slip the 2 sts back to left-hand needle, slip p with the yarn at back of work, k2tog, pass the slipped st over, insert the marker on left-hand needle.

Work 8th – 10th round of chart B.

Work 1st – 5th round of chart A.

### Size XS, M, L and 2XL only

Work 1st – 17th round of chart C.

Work 1st – 5th round of chart A.

Work 3rd-18th (-) 3rd-18th (1st-19th) - (1st-19th) round of chart D, repeating the sts in the red box to end of round.

Work 1st – 5th round of chart A.

### Size S and XL only

Work k1tbl, p2tog, work the 1st round of chart C repeating the 20 sts in the red box - (4) - (-) 5 (-) times, k1tbl, p2tog, k1tbl, p1, repeat the 20 sts in the red box - (4) - (-) 5 (-) times, k1tbl, p1 = - (168) - (-) 208 (-) sts.

**Next round:** K1tbl, p1, work the 2nd round of chart C repeating the 20 sts in the red box - (4) - (-) 5 (-) times, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, repeat the 20 sts in the red box - (4) - (-) 5 (-) times, k1tbl, p1.

Work 3rd – 17th round of chart C as above round.

Work 1st – 5th round of chart A.

Work the 1st round of chart D and D1, as follows:

Work according to chart D1 once, work chart D and repeat the sts in the red box - (6) - (-) 8 (-) times, work chart D1 twice, work chart D and repeat the sts in the red box - (6) - (-) 8 (-) times, work chart D1 once.

Work - (4th-18th) - (-) 2nd-19th (-) round of chart D and D1 as above round.

**Next round:** M1L, knit - (84) - (-) 104 (-) sts, M1L, knit to end of round = - (170) - (-) 210 (-) sts.

Work 2nd – 5th round of chart A.

### Size M and 2XL only

Work 3 rounds of twisted rib (k1tbl, p1), last round ends 5 sts before the beginning of round marker.

### Size XS, S, L and XL only

Work 3 rounds of twisted rib (p1, k1tbl), last round ends 5 sts before the beginning of round marker.



### All sizes

Divide sts into back and front, as follows:

**Next round:** Bind off 11 (10) 11 (11) 10 (11) sts stitch wise, work 69 (75) 79 (89) 95 (99) sts in twisted rib, bind off the next 11 (10) 11 (11) 10 (11) sts stitch wise, work twisted rib to end of round.

Now work back and forth on the needle.

Work back and forth in twisted rib, as follows:

**RS:** Work knit sts through the back loop, purl all purl sts.

**WS:** Work purl sts through the back loop, knit all knit sts.

### FRONT

#### Armhole

**Next row (WS):** Bind off 2 sts purl wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

**Next row:** Bind off 2 sts knit wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

**Next row:** Bind off 1 st purl wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

**Next row:** Bind off 1 st knit wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

Now there are 63 (69) 73 (83) 89 (93) sts on the front.

**NOTE:** From this point, knit the first and last st on every row. These selvedge sts are NOT included in the charts.

Continue in twisted rib as established, to work measures 3.5 (3.5) 4 (4) 4.5 (4.5) cm from the top purl round of chart A. Last row is from the WS.

Work 1. – 8. Row of chart E, as follows:

Begin at the arrow for your size and repeat the sts in the red box until there are no longer enough sts to complete a full repeat, then work the sts on the other side of the box, end at the arrow for your size.

**NOTE:** If there are not enough sts at the beginning and end of the row, to complete the 3-over, then work these sts either purl or k1tbl.

Repeat 9th – 12th row of chart E, until work measures 8.5 (9.5) 9.5 (10.5) 11.5 (11.5) cm from the first row of chart E. Last row is from the WS.



### Neck

Continue in pattern according to chart E and bind off for neckline, as follows:

**Next row (RS):** Work 24 (26) 28 (33) 35 (37) sts in pattern, bind off the next 15 (17) 17 (17) 19 (19) sts knit wise, work 24 (26) 28 (33) 35 (37) sts in pattern.

### Right side

**1st row (WS):** Work pattern as established to the last 2 sts, k2tog.

**2nd row:** Work pattern as established.

Work 1st and 2nd row a total of 11 (11) 11 (12) 12 (13) times. The last row is from RS.

There are now 13 (15) 17 (21) 23 (24) sts on the right shoulder.

Work 1st – 4th row of chart A. The last row is WS.

Break the yarn and leave the sts to rest on a stitch holder.

### Left side

Join the yarn to WS of the resting sts on the left side and work decreases towards the neckline.

**NOTE:** If there are not enough sts at the beginning and end of the row to complete the 3-over, then work these sts either purl or k1tbl.

**1st row (WS):** P2tog tbl, work pattern as established to end of row.

**2nd row:** Work as established to end of row.

Work 1st and 2nd row a total of 11 (11) 11 (12) 12 (13) times. The last row is from RS.

There are now 13 (15) 17 (21) 23 (24) sts on the right shoulder.

Work 1st – 4th row of chart A. The last row is WS.

Break the yarn and leave the sts to rest on a stitch holder.

### BACK

Join the yarn to WS of the resting sts and bind off 2 sts purl wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

**Next row (RS):** Bind off 2 sts knit wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

**Next row:** Bind off 1 st purl wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

**Next row:** Bind off 1 st knit wise, work twisted rib to end of row.

There are now 63 (69) 73 (83) 89 (93) sts on the needle.

**NOTE:** From this point, knit the first and last st on every row. These selvedge sts are NOT included in the charts.





Continue in twisted rib as established, to work measures 3.5 (3.5) 4 (4) 4.5 (4.5) cm from the top purl round of chart A. Last row is from the WS.

Work 1st – 6th row of chart F, begin at the right-side arrow for your size and repeat the sts in the red box until there are not enough sts to complete a full repeat, then work the sts on the other side of the box.

Work 4.5 cm of twisted rib as established.

Work 1st – 8th row of chart E, as follows:  
Begin at the arrow for your size and repeat the sts in the red box until there are no longer enough sts to complete a full repeat, then work the sts on the other side of the box, end at the arrow for your size.

**NOTE:** If there are not enough sts at the beginning and end of the row, to complete the 3-over, then work these sts either purl or k1tbl.

Repeat 9th – 12th row of chart E, until work measures 17 (18) 19 (19) 20 (20,5) cm from the first row of chart E. Last row is from the WS.

### Shoulders

**Next row (RS):** Work 21 (23) 25 (29) 31 (32) sts in pattern (= left shoulder), bind off the next 21 (23) 23 (23) 27 (29) sts, work the last 21 (23) 25 (29) 31 (32) sts in pattern (= right shoulder).

### Left shoulder

**1st row (WS):** Work pattern as established to the last 3 sts, p3tog.

**2nd row:** Work pattern as established to end of row.

Work 1st and 2nd row a total of 4 times = 13 (15) 17 (21) 23 (24) sts. The last row is from RS.

Break the yarn and leave the sts to rest on a stitch holder.

### Right shoulder

Join the yarn to WS of the resting sts and work right shoulder, as follows:

**1st row (WS):** P3tog tbl, work pattern as established to end of row.

**2nd row:** Work pattern as established to end of row.

Work 1st and 2nd row a total of 4 times = 13 (15) 17 (21) 23 (24) sts. The last row is from RS.

Do not break the yarn.

Slip the right shoulder sts back to a needle, use a DPN and work a 3needle bind off, as follows:

Hold the needle with the front shoulder sts and the needle with the back shoulder sts, parallel in the left hand, RS facing RS.

Using the DPN, knit through both the first st on front needle and the first st of the far needle, knit the sts together, knit through both first sts once more, slip the second st on right-hand needle over the first st as in a regular bind off.

Continue this way until all sts have been bind off.

Work a 3needle bind off on the left shoulder, the same way.

### NECKBAND

With a 4.5 mm needle and RS facing, pick up and knit sts along the neckline, as follows:

Begin at the shoulder seam and pick up and knit 80 (82) 84 (88) 90 (94) sts evenly distributed all the way around the neckline, pick up approx. 2 sts for every 3 sts on the neckline.

Insert a beginning of round marker and join round.

Work 2.5 cm twisted rib (k1tbl, p1).

Bind off the sts using Italian bind off method as follows:

1. Insert the needle into the 1st st on the left needle purl-wise and pull the yarn through.
2. Insert the needle between the 1st and 2nd st from back to front.
3. Insert the needle through the 2nd st from front to back.
4. Insert the needle into the 1st st knit-wise and slip off the needle.
5. From the front, insert the needle from right to left into the front leg of the 2nd st, pull the yarn through.
6. Insert the needle into the 1st st purl-wise and slip off the needle.

Repeat points 2-6 until there is 1 (purl) st left on the left needle.

### Finishing:

7. From the front, insert the needle from right to left through the first bound off st, pull the yarn through.

8. As point 6.

Weave in the end thoroughly.



## ARMBANDS

With a 4.5 mm needle and RS facing, pick up and knit sts along the armhole, as follows:

Begin at center of the armhole and pick up and knit 74 (78) 82 (86) 92 (96) sts evenly distributed along the armhole.

Insert a beginning of round marker and join round.

Work 2.5 cm twisted rib (k1tbl, p1).

Bind off using Italian bind off as on the neckband.

Work the other armband the same way.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

Wash the slipover according to the instructions on the ball band and leave to dry flat on towel.

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# Charts

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-  Knit on RS, purl on WS
-  Knit
-  Purl on RS, knit on WS
-  Purl
-  K2tog tbl
-  K2tog
-  Slip 2 sts knitwise as to k2tog, k1, pass slipped sts over
-  Ktbl on RS, ptbl on WS
-  Yarn over
-  Knit 3 sts
-  Slip 1 st purlwise with yarn at back, k2tog, pass slipped st over
-  K3tog
-  Slip 2 sts, one after the other, slip the sts back to the left-hand needle and work them together through the back loops
-  P2tog
-  K4tog
-  Slip 4 sts knit wise, one after the other, slip the sts back to the left-hand needle and knit them together
-  Repeat
-  Insert the right-hand needle into the st marked with red in the chart, pull the yarn through, yarn over, insert the needle into the same st once more and pull the yarn through. Pull all 3 loops to the same length and drop the first st on the left-hand needle
-  3-over: Insert right-hand needle purl wise into the 3rd st on left-hand needle and pass the 3rd st over the first 2 sts, knit 1 st through the back loop, yarn over, knit 1 st through the back loop
-  Using a double pointed needle, knit 1 st through the back loop, purl 1 st, knit 1 st through the back loop, wrap the yarn counterclockwise twice around the sts on the DPN, slip the wrapped sts to right-hand needle
-  Using a double pointed needle, knit 1 st through the back loop, purl 1 st, wrap the yarn counterclockwise twice around the sts on the DPN, slip the wrapped sts to right-hand needle
