


Lovely snood with a delicate lace stitch that will keep you warm and cosy.

This snood is knit in circular and finish by I-cord.

# Pattern

Sizes:	One size
Finished circumference:	62 cm
Length:	36 cm
Gauge:	27 stitches * 35 rows, lace stitch, needles 4 mm, after blocking
Needles:	Circular needles size 4 & 5 mm Needles size is only a suggestion! If you have too many stitches on 10cm switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches on 10cm switch to smaller needles.
Materials:	3 yarn balls of Angora yarn from Le Terrier du Lapin Blanc (80% Angora, 20% merinos, 25g=105m) Or any other equivalent yarn: 75 g = 315 m 1 stitch marker

B (circumference) : 62 cm



## Overview

This snood is knit in circular with a lace stitch and finished by an I-cord on each side.

# Abbreviations

- CO: cast on
- K : Knit
- P: Purl
- Pssso: pass the slip stitch over
- tog : together
- st: stitch
- sl: Slip 1 stitch knitwise with yarn in back.
- SM: Stitch marker
- yo : Yarn over

# Color chart



Knit in the round:

Round 1 : \*K1, yo, K1\*, repeat 2 times

Round 2: \*K3, pass the first st over the two next one\*, repeat 2 times

Round 3: K2, yo, k2

Round 4: K1, K3, pass the first st over the two next one, k1

Knit flat:

Row 1 : \*P1, yo, P1\*, repeat 2 times

Row 2: \*K3, pass the first st over the two next one\*, repeat 2 times

Row 3: P2, yo, P2

Row 4: K1, K3, pass the first st over the two next one, k1

# Explanations

With 5mm needles, CO 162 stitches with the long tail method then change to 4mm needles. Place a SM and join to knit in the round, making sure that the cast on edge is not twisted.

Round 1: K until the end of the round.

Round 2: \*K2tog, yo, k1\*, repeat \* to \* until the end of the round.

Round 3: \*K3, pass the first st over the two next one\*, repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round

Round 4: \*YO, k2\*, repeat \* to \* until the end of the round

Round 5: K2, \*k3, pass the first st over the two next one\*, repeat from \* to \* until the 1 st remains prior the SM, k1, remove the SM, sl2, pass the third st on your right needle over the two next one, place SM.

Round 6: \*K2, yo\*, repeat \* to \* until the end of the round, yo

Round 7: K1, \*k3, pass the first st over the two next one\*, repeat from \* to \* until the 2 st remain prior the SM, k2, remove the SM, sl1, pass the third st on your right needle over the two next one, place SM.

Repeat rounds 6 & 7 until the snood measures 33,5cm from the CO round ending with a round 6.

Next round: Knit until the end of the round. At the end of the round, cast on 3 stitches on your left needle.

Start the I-cord edge:

Round: Knit 2 stitches casted-on previously, sl1, knit the first stitch on your left needle, pssso. Slit the 3 last stitches on your right needle back to your left needle.

Repeat this round until you work all the stitches from your left needle (only 3 st remain on your right needle).

Sew the beginning and the end of your I-cord using grafting (grafting tutorial: [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9dYP\\_GeHLG0](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9dYP_GeHLG0))

Break the yarn.

Start the I-cord edge at the other side of the snood:

Pick up 162 st from the CO edge and CO 3 st on your left needle. (pick up the stitch tutorial: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=htAhtNnuE7Q>)

Round: Knit 2 stitches casted-on previously, sl1, knit the first stitch on your left needle, pssso. Slit the 3 last stitches on your right needle back to your left needle.

Repeat this round until you work all the stitches from your left needle.

Sew the beginning and the end of your I-cord using grafting technic.

Break the yarn.

## Finishing

Weave in all ends. Don't forget to block your project so that the lace can reveal all its beauty.
