

Camel dress



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	Small	Medium	Large
Bust circumference	37" / 94 cm	39" / 99 cm	41" / 104 cm
Length	33" / 84 cm	33,5" / 85 cm	24" / 86 cm
Sleeves	19,5" / 50 cm	19,5" / 50 cm	19,5" / 50 cm

Materials

For this dress I have used 2 different light fingering yarns - lambswool & baby-camel wool.

- Color A - 130/150/180 gram baby-camel wool
- Color B - 100/100/130 gram lambswool
- Color C - 10 gram lambswool

Needles

29" circular needle size US2 & US3 (2,5 & 3 mm)

16" circular needle size US2 (2,5 mm)

1 set of DPN size US2 & US3 (2,5 & 3 mm)

4 stitch markers

1 tapestry needle

Gauge

25 stitches & 40 rows in stockinette stitch

Abbreviations

K = knit

P = purl

Co = cast on

K2tog = knit two stitches together

SSK = slip one stitch as if to knit. Replace on left needle in new direction. Knit two stitches together in the back loops.

M1 = make one. Pick up the stream between 2 stitches, and knit the stitch in the back loop.

Stc = stitch (es)

M = stitch marker

PM = place stitch marker

Begin skirt

With circular needle size US2 (2,5 mm) and color C co 338/351/364 stc. PM, join and work in the round.

K 3 rounds.

Change to color A, and begin ribbing:

k1, p1. Repeat ** total 6 rounds.

Change to needle size US3 (3 mm). K all rounds in stripes pattern as follows:

4 rounds color B

6 rounds color A

When total 25 rounds are worked, begin decrease as follows:

K 24/25/26, k2tog. Repeat ** to end of round = 13 stc decreased.

K24 rounds.

K 23/24/25, k2tog. Repeat ** to end of round = 13 stc decreased.

K24 rounds

Continue working in this way - 1 stc less between decreases in the following decrease-rounds.

Repeat decrease-round total 8 times = 234/247/260 stc on the needle.

Work until skirt measures 23,5" (60 cm) or the length you prefer. Next round:

Bind off 10 stc, k 97/103/110 bind off 20 stc, k 97/104/110, bind off 10 stc.

Break yarn, and set aside.

Sleeves

With 1 set of DPN size US 2 (2,5 mm) and color C co 58/60/62 stc. Join and work in the round.
K 3 rounds.

Change to color A, and begin ribbing: *k1, p1*. Repeat ** total 6 rounds.

Change to needle size US3 and k stripes with color B and A as instructed for skirt, and at the same time, begin increase:

K1, M1, k until 1 stc left, M1, k1.

Repeat increase round every 7th round total 20/22/24 times = 98/104/110 stc

Work until sleeves measures approximately 19,5" (50 cm) - ending in the same stripe row as skirt, when the last round are worked.

Bind off 10 stc, k 78/84/90, bind off 10 stc.

Break yarn and set aside. Follow the instruction for the second sleeve.

Yoke - raglan

Unite sleeves and skirt on circular needle and work the first round as follows:

Sleeve, PM, 97/103/110 stc (front), PM, sleeve, PM, 97/104/110 stc (back), PM = beginning of round.

Begin raglan decrease:

Round 1: k1, k2tog, k until 3 stc before next M, SSK, k1*. Repeat ** to end of round.

Round 2: k one full round

Repeat the two rounds total 27/29/30 times.

Neckline

Break yarn and

- Slip stc from L to R needle without knitting, until front piece
- On front, set 24/25/26 center stc on holder or thread.

Continue working flat - beginning in front neckline with a K-row.

Continue raglan decrease on all K-rows

In the beginning of the next rows, bind off 3-2-1-1 stc in both sides.

Break yarn.

Neckband

With 16" circular needle size US2 (2,5 mm) and color A knit/pick up all stc in neckline.

Work rib in the round - *k1, p1* total 6 rounds.

Change to color C. K 3 rounds. Bind off all stc.

Finishing

Weave in all ends.

Sew together body and sleeves under the arm.
