SOFT AND FINE FINGERLESS MITTENS WITH THE BEAUTIFUL FIELD PATTERN.
FIELD MITTENS IS WORKED SEAMLESS IN THE ROUND FROM WRIST TO FINGERS
A MUST HAVE FOR THE COLD DAYS

SIZES ONE SIZE

MEASUREMENTS

Width:

8 cm

Length:

30 cm

YARN

Cardiff Cashmere: 50 g (col. 518)

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Circular needle or double pointed needles (what ever you prefer to use knitting in the round) size 3 mm

1 cable needle (or a large darning needle)

GAUGE

Stockinette on needle size 3 mm: 30 sts x 38 rows = 10 x 10 cm

NOTE

Field mittens is worked seamless in the round from wrist to fingers.

INC (increase)

Pick up the loop between two stitches and work it as k1 tbl (through the back loop).

INC-L (increase left)

Slip the next stitch purlwise, with the yarn behind, pick up the left "leg" of the stitch below the slipped stitch and work it as k1 tbl.

GRAIN

Work k1 from the front into the 1st stitch on the left needle, leave the stitch on the left needle, yarn over, work k1 in the 1st stitch on the left needle again. You have now worked 3 stitches in the 1st stitch of the left needle. Let the stitch drop off the left needle. The 3 new stitches on the right needle are now a grain, but they only count as 1 st when you count your sts.

LARGE GRAIN

* Work k1 from the front into the 1st stitch on the left needle, leave the stitch on the left needle, yarn over*, repeat from * to * once more and then work k1 into the same stitch once more. You have now worked 5 stitches in the 1st stitch of the left needle. Let the stitch drop off the left needle. The 5 new stitches on the right needle are now a large grain, but they only count as 1 st when you count your sts.

SLIP GRAIN PW WYIB

You slip the grain (the 3 grain sts) from left to right needle purlwise with yarn in back.

SLIP LARGE GRAIN PW WYIB

You slip the large grain (the 5 grain sts) from left to right needle purlwise with yarn in back.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

rnd = round(s)

inc = increase

yo = yarn over

tbl = through the back loop (i.e. twisted)

pw = purlwise

sl1pw = slip 1 st purlwise

wyib = with yarn in back

ssk = slip next 2 sts knitwise one after the other, place the 2 sts back onto left needle and work them k2tog tbl

M = marker

BOR = beginning of round

BO = bind off

CO = Cast on

Pattern

CO 48 sts loosely on size 3 mm needle.

Work in rib *k1, p1*. Join, PM to indicate BOR, work rib in the round.

Work 29 rnds of rib so you have a total of 30 rnds of rib.

Continue in Field pattern, sow some grains and make it grow into a field round by round on these lovely Field Mittens.

A TIP! : If you don't work the Field-pattern on the mittens all in once, please do mark in your pattern how far you have come before you let it (or you!) take a rest. It is not easy to count the rows in the Field pattern and it would be a pity if you have to 'harvest' all the lovely grains and start all over because you forgot which row you were knitting.

You could also place extra markers between the grains so you know if there is 8 sts between every grain. Should you get lost (in the field or) in the pattern then it is recommended to knit backwards instead of just rip out.

Remember...this is slow crafting!

So take a deep breath and enjoy how wonderful knitting can be and watch the grains grow into a Field Mitten for every round you knit 🌾

FIELD PATTERN

Rnd 1: Inc-l (see INC-L on p. 3) PM, *k2, make grain (see GRAIN on p. 2), sl1pw, make grain, k2, sl1pw *, repeat from * to * 4 more times, k2, make grain, sl1pw, make grain, k2, remove M, sl1pw, this

is now the last st on your right needle, PM.

You now have 49 sts and 2 markers on your needle (one on each side of the first st on the rnd)

Rnd 2: k1 tbl, *k2, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, slip grain pw wyib, k2, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 3: slip 1 st pw, *k1, slip next st on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the st on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, place grain on cable needle in front of work, k1, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k1, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 4: k1 tbl, *k3, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 1st row of grains)

Rnd 5: Inc 1 (see INC on p. 2), PM, slip 1 st pw, remove M, *k2, make grain, slip 1 st pw, make grain, k2, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 50 sts and 2 markers on your needle (one on each side of the first st on the rnd)

Rnd 6: k1, k1 tbl, *k2, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, slip grain pw wyib, k2, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 7: k1, slip 1 st pw, * slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 8: k1, k1 tbl, *k3, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 2nd row of grains)

Rnd 9: inc-l, slip 1 st pw, *2k, make grain, slip 1 st pw, make grain, k2, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 51 sts on your needle

Rnd 10: k2, k1 tbl, *k2, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, slip grain pw wyib, k2, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 11: k2, slip 1 st pw, * slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 12: k2, k1 tbl, *k3, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 3rd row of grains)

Rnd 13: k1, PM, inc 1, PM, k1, remove M, slip 1 st pw, *k2, make grain, slip 1 st pw, make grain, k2, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 52 sts on your needle and 3 markers (the first one marks BOR and the next two markers marks the st/sts where you make inc for the thumb)

Rnd 14: k3, k1 tbl, *k2, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, slip grain pw wyib, k2, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 15: k3, slip 1 st pw, * slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 16: k3, k1 tbl, *k3, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 4th row of grains)

Rnd 17: k1, inc 1, k1, slip 1 st pw, *k2, make grain, slip 1 st pw, make grain, k2, slip 1 st pw *, repeat

from * to * 5 more times

You now have 53 sts on your needle

Rnd 18: k4, k1 tbl, *k2, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, slip grain pw wyib, k2, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 19: k4, slip 1 st pw, * slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 20: k4, k1 tbl, *k3, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 5th row of grains)

Rnd 21: k1, remove M, k1, PM, inc 1, slip 1 st pw, remove M, move st back to left needle, PM on right needle, k2, slip 1 st pw, *k2, make grain, slip 1 st pw, make grain, k2, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 54 sts on your needle

Rnd 22: k5, k1 tbl, *k2, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, slip grain pw wyib, k2, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 23: k5, slip 1 st pw, *k1, slip next st on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the st on cable needle, make **large** grain (see LARGE GRAIN on p. 2), place grain on cable needle in front of work, k1, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k1, slip 1 st pw*, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 24: k5, k1 tbl, *k3, slip large grain pw wyib, k3, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 6th row of grains)

Rnd 25: k2, inc-l, k2, slip 1 st pw, *k3, k the 5 sts in the large grain tog tbl, k3, slip 1 st pw*, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 55 sts on your needle and the first grains are made. Now on to make the next grain straws and the last 19 rnds of Field knitting.

Rnd 26: k6, k1 tbl, *k3, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl* repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 27: make grain, k4, make grain, slip 1 st pw, * make grain, k5, make grain, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 28: slip grain pw wyib, k4, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, * slip grain pw wyib, k5, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 29: place grain on cable needle in front of work, k1, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, remove M, k1, PM, inc 1, slip 1 st pw, remove M, move st back to the left needle, PM on the right needle, k1, slip next st on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the st on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, * place grain on cable needle in front of work, k1, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k3, slip next st on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the st on cable needle, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 56 sts on your needle

Rnd 30: *7r, 1 dr r *, repeat from * to * 6 more times

(= 1st row of grains on new straw)

Rnd 31: * make grain, k5, make grain, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 6 more times

Rnd 32: * slip grain pw wyib, k5, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 6 more times

Rnd 33: place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, inc-1, slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, * place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k1, slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle,

hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 57 sts on your needle

Rnd 34: k8, k1 tbl, *k7, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 2nd row of grains on new straw)

Rnd 35: make grain, k6, make grain, slip 1 st pw, * make grain, k5, make grain, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 36: slip grain pw wyib, k6, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, * slip grain pw wyib, k5, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 37: place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k1, PM, inc 1, slip 1 st pw, remove M, move st back to the left needle, PM on your right needle, k1, slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw, * place grain on cable needle in front of work, k2, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k1, slip next 2 sts on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the 2 sts on cable needle, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 58 sts on your needle

Rnd 38: k9, k1 tbl, *k7, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 3rd row of grains on new straw)

Rnd 39: make grain, k7, make grain, slip 1 st pw, * make grain, k5, make grain, slip 1 st pw *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 40: slip grain pw wyib, k7, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl, * slip grain pw wyib, k5, slip grain pw wyib, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 41: place grain on cable needle in front of work, k1, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k2, inc-1, k2,

slip next st on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the st on cable needle, make **large** grain, * place grain on cable needle in front of work, k1, k the 3 sts in the grain tog tbl, k3, slip next st on to the cable needle, hold it to the back of work, k the 3 sts in the grain tog, k the st on cable needle, make **large** grain *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

You now have 59 sts on your needle

Rnd 42: k10, slip large grain pw wyib, *k7, slip large grain pw wyib *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

(= 4th row of grains on new straw)

Rnd 43: k10, k the 5 sts in the large grain tog tbl, *k7, k the 5 sts in the large grain tog tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 44: k10, k1 tbl, *k7, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * 5 more times

Rnd 45: k4, remove M, k1, PM, inc 1, slip next pw, remove M, move st back to the left needle, PM on right needle, k till end of rnd

You now have 60 sts on your needle

K 3 rnds

Rnd 49: k5, inc-l, k till end of rnd

You now have 61 sts on your needle

K 3 rnds

Rnd 53: k5, remove M, k1, inc 1, k1, remove M, k till end of rnd

You now have 62 sts on your needle

K 3 rnds

Rnd 57: K to last st before M, slip last st pw, remove M, move the st back to the left needle. Place the next 15 sts on a stitchholder, PM to indicate BOR, cast on 1 st, k till end of rnd.

You now have 48 sts on your needle

K 6 rnds more and continue in rib *k1, p1*. Work a total of 8 rnds of rib.

Bind off all sts in your preferred way

THUMB

Place the 15 sts from the stitchholder on needle size 3 mm. Add yarn and k15, pick up 1 st before the cast-on st, pick up 1 st in the cast-on st, pick up 1 st after the cast-on st.

You now have 18 sts on your needle

K 2 rnds and continue in rib *k1, p1*. Work a total of 5 rnds of rib.

Bind off all sts in your preferred way.

Weave in ends and make the Field Mitten in the same way. Wash the finished knit gently, block it to the finished measurements. Leave it to dry flat.

Enjoy your new Field Mittens!
