## MATERIALS

WildStar Fibers Supernova Sock (100g, 437 yds, 85% Merino Wool, 15% Nylon), Amor

Rico Design Essentials Super Kid Mohair Silk (25g, 260yds, 72% Super Kid Mohair, 28% Silk), 21 Fuchsia

### Both yarns held together

US 8/5.0 mm needles or size to obtain desired fabric

Cable needle

Stitch marker

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

This shawl is knit point-to-point. The ribbed cable (k1, p1) and the seed stitch make it fully reversible. You can follow the pattern for sizing or make it your own – simply increase until you reach half of the desired length (or half the skein weight) and then work decreases.

## SIZE & MEASUREMENTS

Sizes: Small (**Regular**)

Length: 30"/76 cm (**52"/132 cm**)

Width: 4"/10 cm (**5½"/14 cm**)

Yardage: 75 yds (**140 yds**)

## ABBREVIATIONS & STITCHES

**pm** = place marker, **m** = marker,  
**sm** = slip marker, **sl** = slip knitwise  
**4/4LC** = 4 over 4 left cable  
**mod-RLI** = modified right lifted  
increase

**mod-RLIP** = modified right lifted  
increase purl

**p2tog** = purl 2 together

**k2tog** = knit 2 together

## GAUGE

Choose needle size to achieve fabric you like.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**4/4LC** = slip the next 4 stitches on to a cable needle and hold in front, work the next 4 stitches in pattern (k1, p1), then work the stitches on the cable needle in pattern (k1, p1).

**mod-RLIP** = With the right needle pick up the purl bump of the stitch below the stitch on your left needle. Place it knitwise on your left needle and knit it. ([Video link on Ravelry pattern page](#))

**mod-RLI** = With the right needle and from back to front pick up the right leg of the stitch below the stitch on your left needle. Place it knitwise on your left needle and purl it. ([Video link on Ravelry pattern page](#))

## DIRECTIONS

### SETUP

CO 10sts

Setup Row (RS): sl1, k1, pm, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 1 (WS): sl1, p1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 2 (RS): sl1, k1, sm, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 3: as Row 1.

Row 4: sl1, **mod-RLIP**, p1, sm, **4/4LC**.

Row 5: sl1, p1, [k1, p1] to m, sm, p1, k1, p1.

Row 6: sl1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 7: as Row 5.

Row 8: as Row 6.

Row 9: as Row 5.

Row 10: as Row 6.

Row 11: as Row 5.

Row 12: sl1, k1, **mod-RLI**, k1, sm, **4/4LC**.

### INCREASE

Row 13 (WS): sl1, p1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 14 (RS): sl1, [k1, p1] to last st before m, k1, sm, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 15: as Row 13.

Row 16: as Row 14.

Row 17: as Row 13.

Row 18: as Row 14.

Row 19: as Row 13.

Row 20: sl1, [k1, p1] to 1 st before m, **mod-RLIP**, p1, sm, **4/4LC**.

Row 21: sl1, p1, [k1, p1] to m, sm, p1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 22: sl1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 23: as Row 21.

Row 24: as Row 22.

Row 25: as Row 21.

Row 26: as Row 22.

Row 27: as Row 21.

Row 28: sl1, [k1, p1] to 2 sts before m, k1, **mod-RLI**, k1, sm, **4/4LC**.

Repeat Rows 13-28 until you have 22 (**30**) stitches or until you have reached half of the desired length.

### DECREASE

Row 29-35: Repeat Rows 13-19.

Row 36 (RS): sl1, [k1, p1] to 3 sts before m, k1, p2tog, sm, **4/4LC**.

Rows 37-43: Repeat Rows 21-27.

Row 44 (RS): sl1, [k1, p1] to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sm, **4/4LC**.

Repeat Rows 29-44 until 10 sts remain.

Remove marker.

### BIND OFF

Row 45 (WS): sl1, p1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 46 (RS): sl1, k1, [k1, p1] to end.

Row 47: P2tog, k1, p2tog, k1, p2tog, k2tog.

Row 48: BO all sts tightly.

Weave in ends and block.
