

Zalo cat



Zalo cat has a height of about 40cm

Knitting stitches used: k, p, skpo, k2tog, kll, krl.. (these stitches are very simple, you can watch them on youtube)

The wool I used for the body is white lanagold 450, and light brown 207

Knitting needle used: 2.75mm

* Zalo cats are woven from the feet to the head, so we will start from the feet!

***Left leg:**

Use 14 stitches of skinny white yarn

H1 and odd rows knit p

H2:k1(k1,kll)x12,k1 (26m)

H4:k1,(k1,kll,k1)x12,k1 (38m)

H5->h13: knit starting from row p

H14:k4,(k2tog)x6,k22 (32m)

H16:k4,(k2tog)x4,k20 (28m)

H17: knit p

H18:k2(brown), k26 (white)

H19:p25 (white),p3(brown)

H20:k4(brown),k24 (white)

H21:p23(white),p5(brown)

H22:k6(brown),k22(white)

H23:p22(white),p6(brown)

H24:k5(brown),k23 (white)

H25:p24(white),p4(brown)

Cut the yarn leaving the stitches on the needle intact

*Right leg:

Using skinny white yarn, knit 14 stitches similar to the left leg to row 13

H14:k22,(k2tog)x6,k4

Loose row knitting p

H16:k20,(k2tog)x4,k4

H18:k26(white),k2(brown)

H19:p3(brown),p25 (white)

H20:k24 (white),k4(brown)

H21:p5(brown),p23(white)

H22:k22(white),k6(brown)

H23:p6(brown),p22(white)

H24:k23 (white),k5(brown)

H25:p4(brown),p24(white)

Do not cut the wool and continue knitting

Start knitting the cat's body:

Knitting white wool:

H26: skinny 3 stitches, k28 (right leg),(m1a)x4, k28 (left leg),(m1a)x3 (66m)

H27:P

H28:k3,(k3,kll,k3)x10,k3 (76m)

H29->h37: knit plain starting row p (9 rows)

H38:k10(brown),k56 (white),k10(brown)

H39:p11(brown),p54 (white),p11(brown)

H40:k12(brown),k52(white),k12(brown)

H41:p13(brown),p50(white),p13(brown)

H42:k14(brown),k48(white),k14(brown)

H43 to row 71: knit plain as follows:

LCL:p14(brown),p48(white),p14(brown)

Even rows:k14(brown),k48(white),k14(brown)

H72:k13(brown),[k9,skpo,k2tog,k24,skpo,k2tog,k9] (white),k13(brown) (72m)

H73:p12(brown),p48 (white),p12(brown)

H74:k11(brown),[k10,skpo,k2tog,k22,skpo,k2tog,k10](white),k11(brown) (68m)

H75:p10(brown),p48 (white),p10(brown)

H76: change to white wool k20,skpo,k2tog,k20,skpo,k2tog,k20 (64m)

H77:p

H78:(k1,k2tog,k1)x16 (48m)

H79:p cut another long yarn and thread it through the stitches to draw the neck

H80:k1,(kfb)x46,k1 (94m)

Odd rows knit p

H81 -> h83: plain knit

H84:k21,(krl,k1)x5,k42,(k1,kll)x5,k21 (104m)

H85 to h97: plain knit

H98: 39k (white),6k(brown),14k(white),6k(brown),39k(white)

H99:38p(white),8p(brown), 12p (white),8p(brown),38p (white)

H100->h 135: change to brown wool and knit plain

H136: (k6,k2tog)x13

Loose row knitting p

H138:(k5,k2tog)x13

H140:(k4,k2tog)x13

H142: (k3,k2tog)x13

H144: (k2,k2tog)x13

H146: (k1,k2tog)x13

H148: (k2tog)x13

H149:p cut a long wool thread and thread it through the knitting stitches, then tighten and sew the edges together then stuff it with cotton.

* Hands (2 pieces)

Use 10m skinny white wool

H1 and odd rows knit p

H2: k1,kfb,k6,kfb,k1 (12m)

H4: k1,kfb,k8,kfb,k1 (14m)

H6: k1,kfb,k10,kfb,k1 (16m)

H8: k6(white),k4(brown),k6 (white)

H9:p5 (white),p6(brown),p5 (white)

H10:k4 (white),k8(brown), k4 (white)

H11:p3 (white),p10(brown),p3 (white)

H12 ->h23:

even row: k3 (white),k10(brown), k3 (white)

Odd row: p3 (white),p10(brown),p3 (white)

H24:K4 (white),k8(brown),k4 (white)

H25:p5 (white),p6(brown),p5 (white)

H26:k6 (white) ,k4(brown),k6 (white)

H27->h31: change to white wool and plain knitting

H32: (k2tog)x8 (8m)

Cut a long yarn thread through the tight stitches and sew the edges then stuff the cotton



* Ears:(2 things)

Use skinny brown yarn for 20 stitches

H1 -> h3: plain knit

H4:k1,skpo,k14,k2tog,k1 (18m)

Odd rows knit p

H6:k1,skpo,k12,k2tog,k1 (16m)

H8:k1,skpo,k10,k2tog,k1 (14m)

H10: k1,skpo,k8,k2tog,k1 (12m)

H12:k1,skpo,k6,k2tog,k1 (10m)

H14:k1,skpo,k4,k2tog,k1 (8m)

H16:k1,skpo,k2,k2tog,k1 (6m)

H18:k1,skpo,k2tog,k1 (4m)

H19:p

Change to white wool

H20:k1,(kfb)x2,k1 (6m)

Loose row knitting p

H22:k1, kfb,k2,kfb,k1 (8m)

H24: k1,kfb,k4,kfb,k1 (10m)

H26:k1,kfb,k6,kfb,k1 (12m)

H28:k1,kfb,k8,kfb,k1 (14m)

H30:k1,kfb,k10,kfb,k1 (16m)

H32:k1,kfb,k12,kfb,k1 (18m)

H34:k1,kfb,k14,kfb,k1 (20m)

H35:p

H36:k

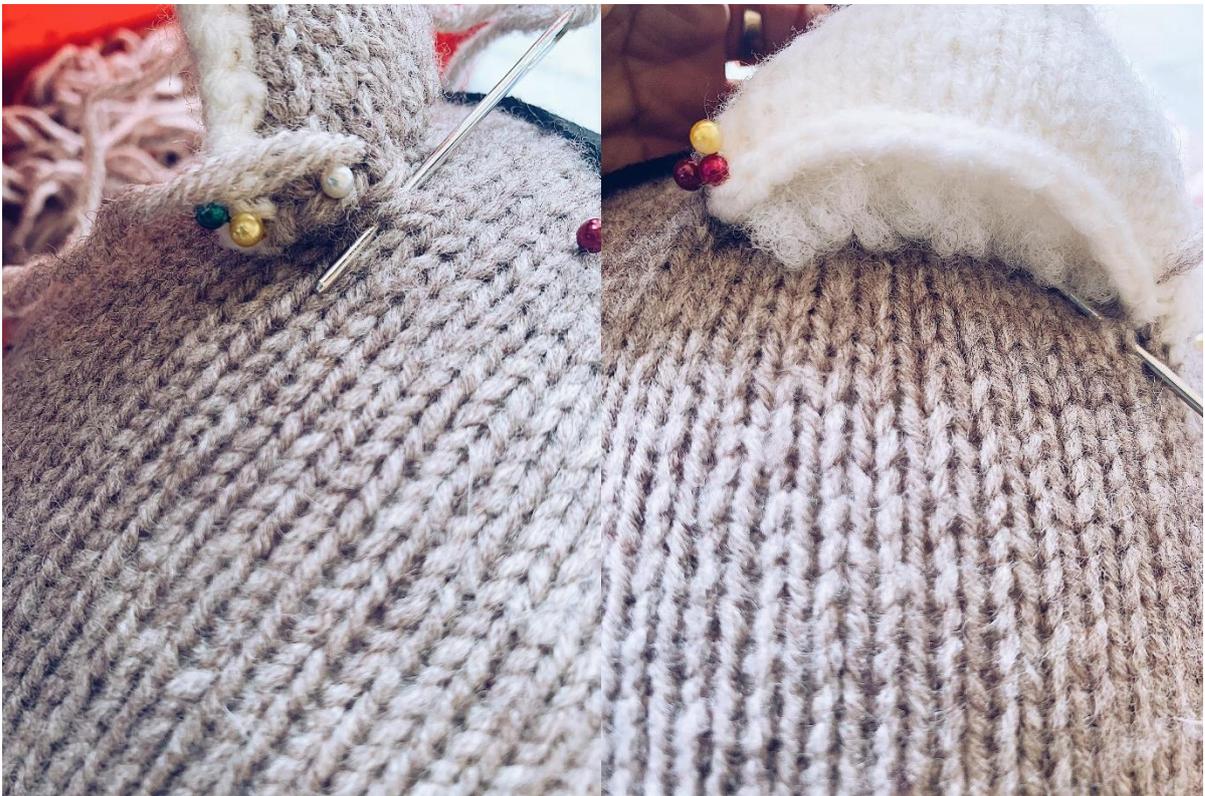
H37: Cut the wool and leave a long piece for sewing





How to sew ears:

Stuff some cotton into your ears to create volume (don't stuff it too tight).



*Christmas hat (I knit red and white easy wool with 2.75mm needle)

Thin 36 stitches of red wool

H1->h3: knit k

For every 4 red rows, 2 white rows

H4 -> h 17: knit plain starting with row k

H18: (k4,k2tog)x 6 (30m)

H19 -> h21: plain knitting

H22: (k3,k2tog)x6 (24m)

H23->h25: plain knit

H26: (k2,k2tog)x6 (18m)

H27->h29: plain knit

H30: (k1,k2tog)x6 (12m)

H31->h33: plain knit

H34: (k2tog)x6 (6m)

H35->h37 plain knitting, cut the yarn through the knitting stitches, tighten and sew

Use white wool to make a bombom and attach it to the hat!



*fish:

Use blue wool (or any color you like)

Skinny 16 noses

H1->h3: plain knit starting with row p

H4: k1, (k1,kll)x14,k1 (30m)

Loose row knitting p

H6: k1,(k1,kll,k1)x14 ,k1 (44m)

H7->h17: plain knit

S 18: change to white wool and knit k

H19:p

Question 20: change to green wool and knit k

H21:p

H22: change to white wool and knit k

H23:p

Change to green wool

H24:k

H25:p

H26:k9,skpo,k2tog,k18,skpo,k2tog,k9 (40m)

Loose row knitting p

H28:k8,skpo,k2tog,k16,skpo,k2tog,k8 (36m)

H30:k7,skpo,k2tog,k14,skpo,k2tog,k7 (32m)

H32:k6,skpo,k2tog,k12,skpo,k2tog,k6 (28m)

H34:k5,skpo,k2tog,k10,skpo,k2tog,k5 (24m)

H36:k4,skpo,k2tog,k8,skpo,k2tog,k4 (20m)

H38:k3,skpo,k2tog,k6,skpo,k2tog,k3 (16m)

H40:k2,skpo,k2tog,k4,skpo,k2tog,k2 (12m)

H42:k1,skpo,k2tog,k2,skpo,k2tog,k1 (10m)

Cut the yarn and thread it through the stitches, tighten and sew, then stuff it with cotton to create a fish head

*fish tail:

Use green wool to knit 14 stitches

H1 and odd rows knit p

H2:k1,skpo,k8,k2tog,k1 (12m)

H4:k1,skpo,k6,k2tog,k1 (10m)

H6:k1,skpo,k4,k2tog,k1 (8m)

H8:k1,skpo,k2,k2tog,k1 (6m)

H10:k1,skpo,k2tog,k1 (4m)

Cut the yarn and thread the yarn through tight stitches and sew the edges



Tail: (1 piece)

Thin with 4 white noses, 10 brown noses, 4 white noses

H1->h17: knit as follows:

Retail items: p4 (white), p10 (brown), p4 (white)

Even rows: k4 (white), k10 (brown), k4 (white)

H18:k5 (white),k8 (brown),k5 (white)

H19:p6 (white),p6 (brown),p6 (white)

H20:k7 (white),k4(brown),k7(white)

Change to white wool:

H19:p

H20:k3,skpo,k2tog,k6,skpo,k2tog,k3 (16m)

Loose row knitting p

H22:k2,skpo,k2tog,k4,skpo,k2tog,k2 (14m)

H24:k1,skpo,k2tog,k2,skpo,k2tog,k1 (12m)

Step 25: Cut the yarn, sew the edges together, then stuff



* Nose (1 piece)

Skinny with 10 white noses

H1 and odd rows knit p

H2:k1,kfb,k6,kfb,k1 (12m)

H3 -> h11: plain knit

H12: k1,skpo,k6,k2tog,k1 (10m)

H13: cut the wool and leave a long thread to sew the nose to the cat's face



*Instructions for creating a cat face:

How to create eye sockets for cats:

The two eyes are 10 stitches apart

Thread the long yarn into the needle (the needle is long). Pierce the first stitch, pull the yarn through, then stab it down to the stitch next to the thread, thread it behind the head like photo number 2, then pull the 2 yarns tightly and hide the yarn (remember The puncture location in the back of the head must be the same hole ^__^)

For the second eye, we do the same, the two eye holes are 10 stitches apart

After that, you can create the face as you like. If you don't like making eyes like me, then attach plastic eyes (usually, I don't use dowels but inject plastic glue, this way I don't have to worry about falling off :D:D:D)



How to create a nose:

After sewing the nose and stuffing it with cotton to create volume, use a black wool needle to stab the middle of the nose and pull it tight as shown in the picture below.



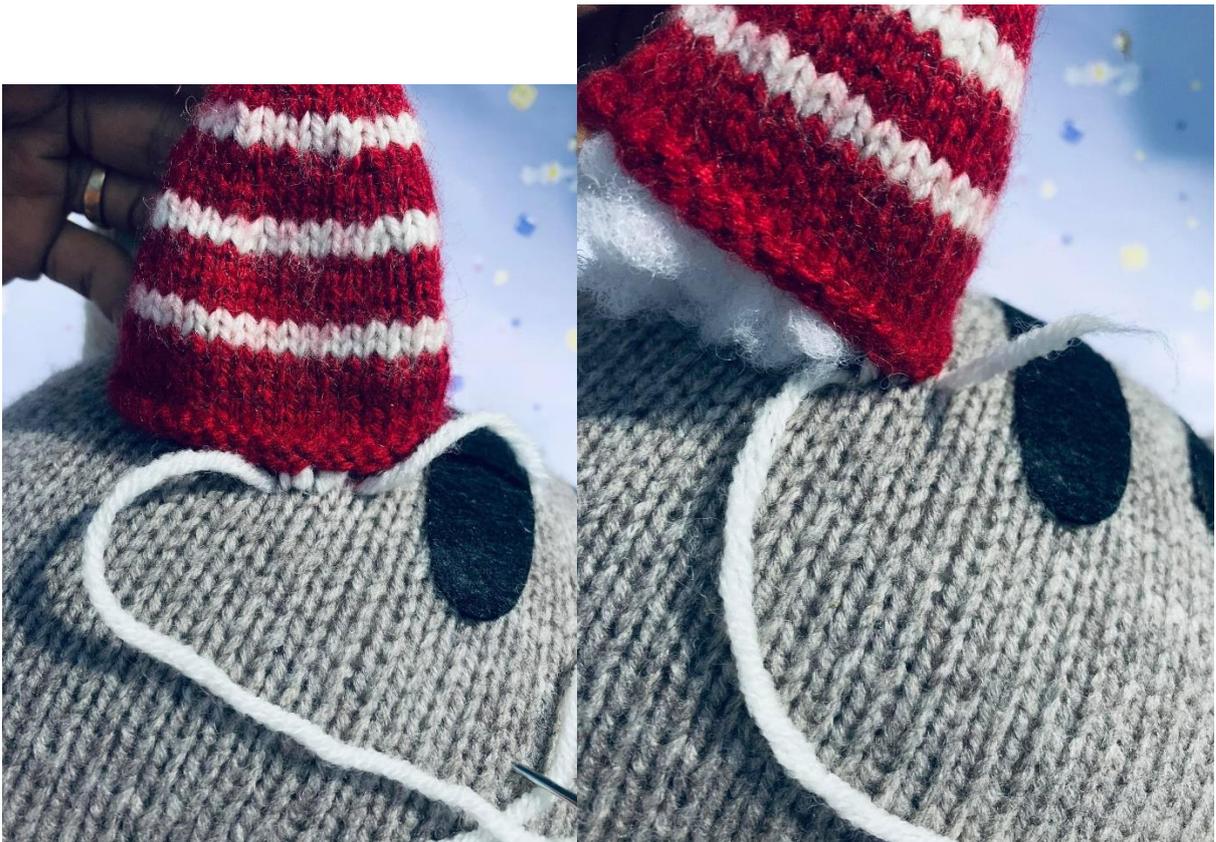
Sew the stuffed body and tighten the neck: Insert a hard milk tea straw between the face and body to make the head stronger. I insert 2 straws (remember to insert them long along the head and body).





Sew the hat to the head:

Stuff the hat to create a standing shape



Use black felt fabric to cut 2 pieces 15cm long, 2cm wide and 1 piece 20cm long, 2cm wide

Then use plastic glue to balance it on the cat's head! Stick the longest piece on the middle and the 2 shorter pieces on both sides for symmetry! :D
