DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Shown in Small size with approx. 4" of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 35¼ (38¾, 43, 47¼, 51¼, 54¾, 59, 63¼)"

Length: 25½ (26¼, 27, 28, 28½, 29¼, 30, 31)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Deluxe Worsted Tweed (90% superwash wool, 7% anti-pill acrylic, 3% viscose; 100g/218 yds)

- 908 Navy (MC) – 4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 6, 7, 7) balls
- 915 Cloud Blue (CC1) – 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) ball(s)
- 916 Tulipwood (CC2) – 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) ball(s)

Needles:

Needle A: US Size 8 (5 mm) 32" circular and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Needle B: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16", 32", and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Needle C: US Size 6 (4 mm) 16", 32" circular and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences)

Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, cable needle (cn)



GAUGE

19 sts x 24 rnds = 4" in St st with Ndl B

19 sts x 33 rnds = 4" in Crosses patt with Ndl A

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Chiaroscuro is a boldly patterned yoke sweater you'll love knitting and wearing. The funnel neck and generous length will keep you warm and cozy. Thoughtful touches like a rolled, contrast color hem,

neckline, and sleeve cuffs plus A-line shaping makes this piece infinitely wearable. It's the perfect pullover to wear after a day on the slopes or an for an evening sipping wine with a good book in hand.

This sweater is knit seamlessly from the top down. Only one color per row is used during Crosses, Left Slant, and Right Slant patterns. Whichever color is shown before the round number is the color that will be used for that round.

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In this pattern, slip all stitches purlwise with yarn held in back unless otherwise noted.

STITCH GUIDE

Slipped Right Cross (RC): Slip 1 st to cn and hold in back, sl 1 st to right ndl, k1 from cn.

Slipped Left Cross (LC): Slip 1 st to cn and hold in front, k1 from left ndl, sl 1 from cn to right ndl.

K2, P2 Ribbing

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

SWEATER

With CC2 and Ndl C, cast on 96 (96, 96, 96, 96, 96, 108) sts. PM for bor and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Collar

Rnds 1-2: With CC2, knit. Break CC. Join MC.

Rnd 3: With MC, *k2, p2: rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 3 until piece meas 4" from cast-on edge.

Shape Back Neck with Short Rows

Row 1 (RS): Work in est'd ribbing over 18 sts, W&T.

Row 2 (WS): Work in est'd ribbing to beg of rnd, sl m, work in est'd ribbing over 18 sts, W&T.

Row 3 (RS): Work in est'd ribbing to wrapped st, work tog wrap with its st, work next st, W&T.

Row 4 (WS): Work in est'd ribbing to wrapped st, work tog wrap with its st, work next st, W&T.

Rows 5-6: Rep Rows 3-4.

Next 2 Rnds: Work in K2, P2 ribbing, working tog rem wraps.

Yoke

Inc Rnd 1: * K2, m1; rep from * to

end – 48 (48, 48, 48, 48, 48, 54) sts inc'd, 144 (144, 144, 144, 144, 144, 162) sts. Switch to Ndl A. Work Rnds 1-14 of Crosses patt. Patt will be repeated 24 (24, 24, 24, 24, 24, 27) times across each rnd.

Inc Rnd 2: With MC, knit, increasing 36 (36, 42, 48, 54, 42, 48, 48) sts evenly around – 180 (180, 186, 192, 198, 186, 192, 210) sts.

Work Rnds 1-10 of Right Slant patt.

Inc Rnd 3: With MC, knit, increasing 30 (36, 42, 48, 54, 42, 48, 48) sts evenly around – 210 (216, 228, 240, 252, 228, 240, 258) sts.

Work Rnds 2-14 of Crosses patt. Patt will be repeated 35 (36, 38, 40, 42, 38, 40, 43) times across each rnd.

Inc Rnd 4: With MC, knit, increasing 30 (36, 36, 42, 54, 42, 48, 48) sts evenly around – 240 (252, 264, 282, 306, 270, 288, 306) sts.

Work Rnds 1-10 of Left Slant patt.

Inc Rnd 5: With MC, knit, increasing 24 (12, 36, 42, 54, 42, 48, 42) sts evenly around – 264 (264, 300, 324, 360, 312, 336, 348) sts.

Work Rnds 2-14 of Crosses patt. Patt will be repeated 44 (44, 50, 54, 60, 52, 56, 58) times across each rnd.

Sizes 3X (4X, 5X) Only:

Inc Rnd 6: With MC, knit, increasing - (-, -, -, -, 36, 48, 42)

sts evenly around -- (-, -, -, -, 348, 384, 390) sts.

Work Rnds 1-10 of Right Slant patt.

Inc Rnd 7: With MC, knit, increasing - (-, -, -, -, 36, 36, 42) sts evenly to end -- (-, -, -, -, 384, 420, 432) sts.

Work Rnds 2-14 of Crosses patt. Patt will be repeated 64 (70, 72) times across each rnd.

All Sizes:

Switch to Ndl B. With MC, work even in St st until piece meas 8½ (9, 9½, 10, 10½, 11, 11½, 12)" from Inc Rnd 1.

Separate Body and Sleeves

Rnd 1: K39 (40, 45, 45, 51, 54, 57, 60) sts, place next 54 (52, 60, 72, 78, 84, 96, 96) sts on holder for Sleeve, cast on 3 (6, 6, 11, 10, 11, 13, 15) sts, pm for side, cast on 3 (6, 6, 11, 10, 11, 13, 15) sts, k78 (80, 90, 90, 102, 108, 114, 120) sts Front sts, place next 54 (52, 60, 72, 78, 84, 96, 96) sts on holder for Sleeve, cast on 3 (6, 6, 11, 10, 11, 13, 15) sts, pm for side, cast on 3 (6, 6, 11, 10, 11, 13, 15) sts, k39 (40, 45, 45, 51, 54, 57, 60) sts –168 (184, 204, 224, 244, 260, 280, 300) sts rem for Body.

Work even in St st for 2".

Waist Shaping

Inc Rnd: * Knit to 1 st bef side m, m1, k1, sl m, k1, m1; rep from * 1 more time, knit to end – 4 sts inc'd, 172 (188, 208, 228, 248, 264, 284, 304) sts.

Rep Inc Rnd every 14 (12, 12, 12, 16, 13, 13, 14) rows, 2 (4, 3, 1, 3, 4, 2, 4) more time(s), then rep Inc

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Rnd every 15 (0, 13, 13, 0, 14, 14, 0) rows, 1 (0, 1, 3, 0, 0, 2, 0) time(s) – 12 (16, 16, 16, 12, 16, 16, 16) sts inc'd, 184 (204, 224, 244, 260, 280, 300, 320) sts.

Work even in St st until piece meas 15 (15¼, 15½, 16, 16, 16¼, 16½, 17)'' from underarm.

Ribbing

Switch to Ndl C.

Rnd 1: * K2, p2: rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 for 2''. Break MC.

Switch to CC2.

Knit 2 rnds.

Bind off all sts kwise.

Sleeves

Return held Sleeve sts to Ndl B

dpns. With MC, beg at center of underarm, pick up and knit 3 (6, 6, 11, 10, 11, 13, 15) sts, knit across 54 (52, 60, 72, 78, 84, 96, 96) held sts, pick up and knit 3 (6, 6, 11, 10, 11, 13, 15) sts along other side of underarm – 60 (64, 72, 94, 98, 106, 122, 126) sts.

Work in St st for 3''.

Shape Sleeve

Dec Rnd: K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd, 58 (62, 70, 92, 96, 104, 120, 124) sts rem.

Rep Dec Rnd every 10 (8, 6, 4, 4, 3, 3, 3) rnds, 7 (9, 11, 12, 10, 27, 13, 13) times, then rep Dec Rnd every 0 (0, 5, 3, 3, 2, 2, 2) rnds, 0 (0, 2, 10, 14, 1, 23, 23) time(s) – 14 (18, 26, 44, 48, 56, 72, 72) sts dec'd, 44

(44, 44, 48, 48, 48, 48, 52) sts rem.

Work even in St st until Sleeve meas 16¼ (16¼, 16¾, 16¾, 17¼, 17¼, 17¾, 17¾)'' from underarm.

Ribbing

Switch to Ndl C dpns.

Rnd 1: * K2, p2: rep from * to end. Break MC.

Rep Rnd 1 for 2½''.

Switch to CC2. Knit 2 rnds. Bind off all sts kwise.

FINISHING

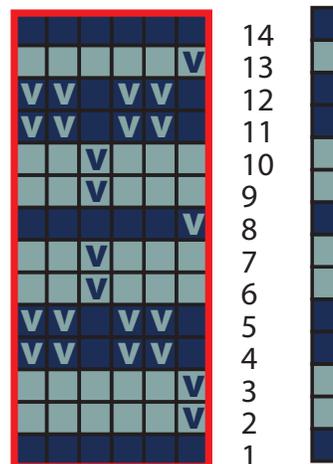
Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.



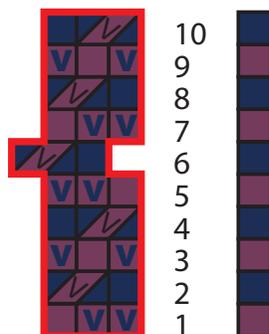

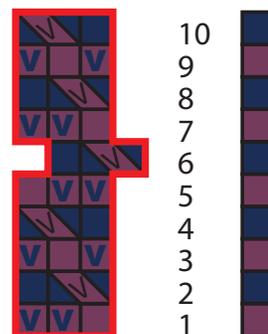

Right Slant

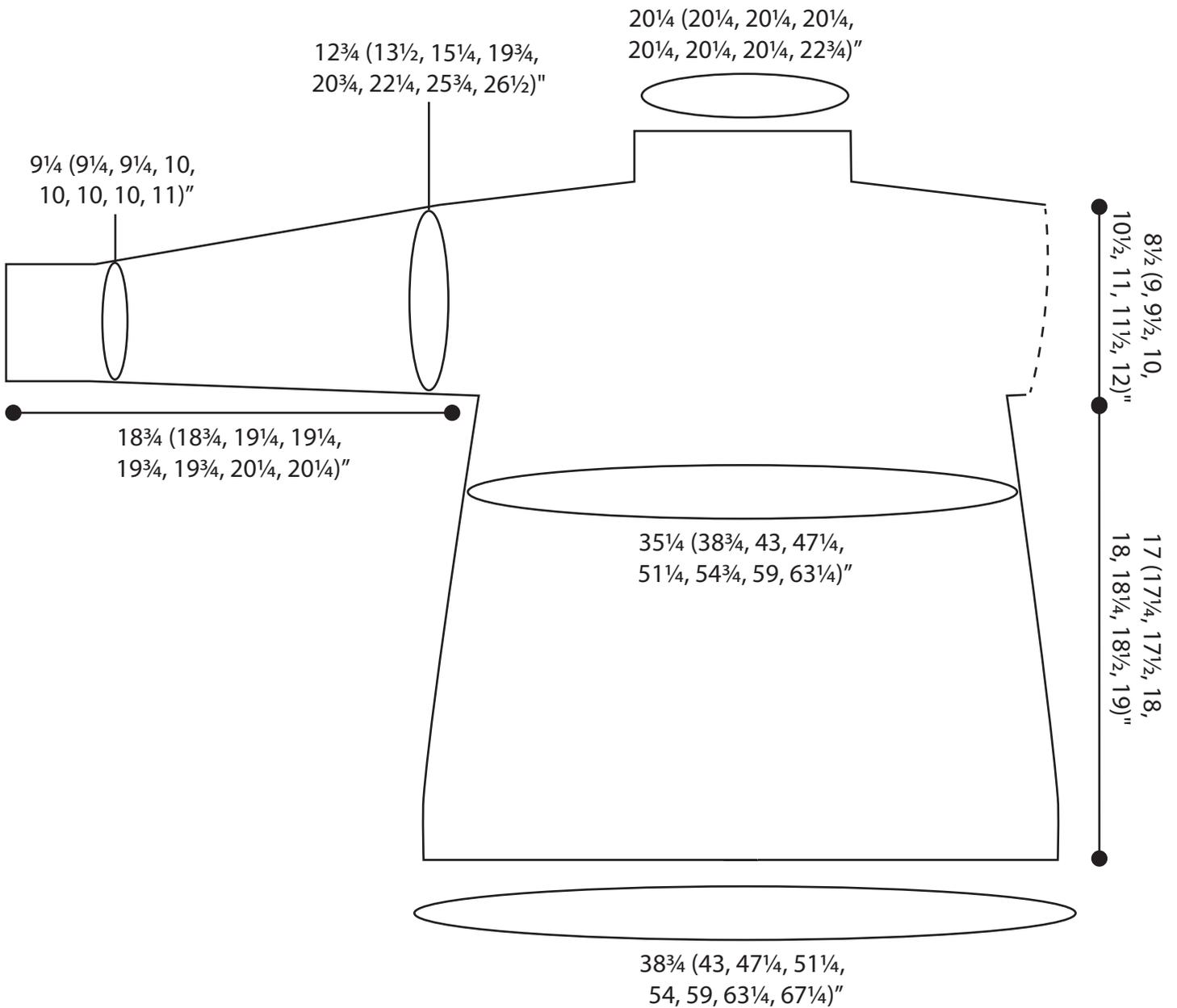

Crochet: 12 sc x 14 rows = 4" / US Size H-8 (5 mm)
