




Lacy Vee Tee

FREE KNIT PATTERN

Lacy Vee Tee



TYPE: Knit

DESIGNER: Tori Gurbisz for Premier® Yarns

SIZE:

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)
Shown in size S

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Bust: 34 (38¼, 41¾, 46, 50) (54¼, 57¾, 62, 66)”

Length: 22¾ (23¼, 23¾, 24¼, 24¾)
(25¼, 25½, 25½, 26)”

GAUGE:

23 sts x 28 rows = 4” in St st with larger
needle; **Save time, check your gauge.**

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair® Sport
(52% Cotton, 48% Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g,
317 yds/290m)

- MC: 27-02 Cream – 3 (4, 5, 5, 6) (6, 7, 8, 8) balls
- CC: 27-09 Lavender – 1 ball

NEEDLES & NOTIONS:

- **US Size 4 (3.5 mm) and US Size 3 (3.25 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge**
- **Tapestry needle**
- **Locking stitch markers**
- Stitch holder or waste yarn

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- K2tog and ssk decreases.
- Yarn overs.
- Placing stitches on hold.
- Seaming with mattress stitch.
- Picking up and knitting stitches.
- Changing colors.

STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Rib (*multiple of 2 sts*)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Row 1 for patt.

Vee Lace (*multiple of 10 sts*)

Row 1 (RS): *Yo, ssk, k8; rep from * to end.

WS Rows 2-12: Purl.

Row 3: *K1, yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo; rep from * to end.

Row 5: *K2, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 7: *K5, yo, ssk, k3; rep from * to end.

Row 9: *K3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 11: *K2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This Tee is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. It features a fun lace pattern and a touch of contrast at the edges. We recommend choosing a size that measures 3-5” larger than your actual full bust measurement.

TEE

Back

With smaller needles and CC, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 146) (158, 168, 180, 192) sts.

Work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas ½”. Cut CC and join MC, work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas 3” from cast-on edge.

Switch to larger needles. The following rows est the St st edge sts at the edge of the piece, these will be maintained for the remainder of the piece.

Setup Row 1 (RS): K5 (1, 1, 2, 3) (4, 4, 5, 1), pm, work even in **Vee Lace** patt (beg with Row 1) to last 5 (1, 1, 2, 3) (4, 4, 5, 1) sts, pm, k5 (1, 1, 2, 3) (4, 4, 5, 1).

Setup Row 2 (WS): Purl to m, sm, work even in **Vee Lace** patt, sm, purl to end.

Work in est'd patt until piece meas 22¾ (23¼, 23¾, 24¼, 24¾) (25¼, 25½, 25½, 26)” from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

Front

Work as for Back until piece meas 18½ (19, 19½, 19¾, 20¼) (20¾, 20½, 20½, 21)”. End having just worked a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Note: Maintain est'd Vee Lace patt as much as possible throughout this section, work in St st if you are not able to work the yo and it's coordinating decrease.

Row 1 (RS): K34 (40, 45, 51, 57) (63, 68, 74, 80) (left shoulder sts) bind off 32 sts, knit across rem 34 (40, 45, 51, 57) (63, 68, 74, 80) (right shoulder sts), place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

Row 2 (WS): Work even in est'd patt.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, work in patt to end — 1 st dec'd.

Even Row: Work even in est'd patt.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) (6, 7, 7, 7) more times — 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) (6, 7, 7, 7) sts dec'd, 28 (34, 39, 44, 50) (56, 60, 66, 72) sts rem.

Work even in patt until piece meas 22³/₄ (23¹/₄, 23³/₄, 24¹/₄, 24³/₄) (25¹/₄, 25¹/₂, 25¹/₂, 26)" from cast-on edge. Bind off sts.

Place held sts on working needle and with WS facing, join yarn.

Next Row (WS): Work even in patt to end.

Dec Row (RS): Work in est'd patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1— 1 st dec'd.

Even Row: Work even in est'd patt.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) (6, 7, 7, 7) more times — 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) (6, 7, 7, 7) sts dec'd, 28 (34, 39, 44, 50) (56, 60, 66, 72) sts rem.

Work even in patt until piece meas 23³/₄ (24¹/₄, 24¹/₂, 25, 25³/₄) (26¹/₄, 26¹/₂, 26¹/₂, 27)" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

Sleeves (*make 2*)

With smaller needles and CC, cast on 86 (92, 98, 104, 108) (114, 118, 118, 124) sts. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas ½". Cut CC and join MC, work even in **1x1 Rib** until piece meas 1½" from cast-on edge.

Switch to larger needles. The following rows est the St st edge sts at the edge of the piece, these will be maintained for the remainder of the piece.

Setup Row 1 (RS): K3 (1, 4, 2, 4) (2, 4, 4, 2), pm, work even in **Vee Lace** patt (beg with Row 1) to last 3 (1, 4, 2, 4) (2, 4, 4, 2) sts, pm, k3 (1, 4, 2, 4) (2, 4, 4, 2).

Setup Row 2 (WS): Purl to m, sm, work even in **Vee Lace** patt, sm, purl to end.

Work in est'd patt until piece meas 3½" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Wash and block Front, Back and Sleeves, if desired.

Sew one shoulder seam using mattress st, use MC for all seams.

Neck Edging

With smaller needles, MC and RS facing, pick up and knit 122 (122, 122, 126, 126) (126, 134, 134, 134) sts along neck opening. Work even in **1x1 Rib** until rib meas 1". Cut MC, join CC and work even in **1x1 Rib** for ½". Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Sew other shoulder seam and Neck Edging.

Place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Sleeves and then the Front and Back. Weave in ends.


MEET THE DESIGNER
