



CROCHET PATTERN HORSE AND UNICORN



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You can ask any questions via private message in the Etsy shop. Please contact the author if you require any clarifications regarding the pattern.

The toy is approx. – 16 cm (L)*15 cm (H). Pay attention that your toy can be smaller or bigger depending on the materials you use and your manner to crochet.



MATERIALS

- You can use any slightly fluffy or smooth yarn. It is perfect to use wool, angora, acrylic or mix. My yarn is :
 - horse - Brilliant by Vita 45% wool,55% acrylic (380m./100gr.) 4983 - «baked milk» (approx. 50 gr.);
 - unicorn - Angora Real 40 by Alize 40% wool 60% acrylic (380m./100gr.) - white.
- Mane and tail (crochet). I used cotton Eldorado by Puppets (350m./100gr.):
 - «white» (approx. 15 gr.);
 - Lurex embroidery thread col. GOLD.Mane and tail (made of yarn) — I used microfiber Diva by Alize.

Accessories

- Wreath, blanket, bridle. Any smooth nonelastic yarn. For accessories with a rigid shape, I like to use cotton. I used Eldorado by Puppets (350m./100gr.)
 - «red» (approx 5 gr.)
 - «green» (approx 5 gr.)
 - «white» (mane+tail+blanket approx 15 gr.)
- 2 gold-colored metal rings for decorating the bridle;
- 3 bells or gold beads for decorating the wreath.
- 1.5 mm copper wire – approx. 1 m.

You can buy this wire in a craft shop, but I suggest buying it in an electronic goods store. There you can buy a 3*1.5 cord. Before buying the cord, make sure that the wire inside it is whole and does not consist of several thin wires. With a paper knife, remove the insulation.
- Stuffing polyester;
- Fabric plaster;
- Toy eyes. Size – 7 mm or other according the toy's size.
- Dry paster (black and pink color)+thin black marker (0,5mm) or black gel pen.

TOOLS

- 1,5 mm crochet hook (the size of the hook depends on the yarn you use);
- Scissors;
- Needle with a blunt end;
- Wire cutter.



ABBREVIATIONS

ST – stitch (loop)

CH – chain

DEC – decrease 2 SC together

SHIFT ST – shift stitch – an additional SC in a next loop and only after that change the position of the marker

FO – fasten off, weave in the end

SS – slip ST

SC – single crochet

DC – double crochet


2 SC in next ST – 2 single crochet to a next ST

“X” SC DEC – decrease “X” SC together

“X” SC in next ST - “X” SC crochet to a next stitch

SC-BLO – single crochet through back loop only;

Attention! The toy is made with right side facing you.



DESCRIPTION OF TOY MAKING

Back legs.

- Crochet with the main color;
- Work in continuous spiral;
- The marker goes along the back part of the leg. Correct/move the marker via SHIFT SC if you will need it;
- Stuff with polyester while crocheting. The density of the stuffing is medium. Final stuffing during toy assembly. Stuffing should be done after the frame has been inserted into the leg;
- If you want you can crochet a colored hoof from rows 1 to 6, then continue on to the main color.


1) 4 CH, 2 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 1 SC, 3 SC in next ST, 2 SC (8)

2) (2 SC in next ST)*2, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*3, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (14)

3) 14 SC (14)

4) 14 SC (14). Outline the sole on a piece of plastic and cut it out. Insert the plastic sole inside the hoof. The sole will make the leg flatter.

5) 6 SC, DEC, 5 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (14)





6) 14 SC (14) Change a color to main color (if you crocheted a hoof with an other color).

7) 4 SC, (2 SC DEC)*2, 3 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (12)

8) 4 SC, (2 SC DEC), 3 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2 (14)

9) 14 SC (14).

Cut out 40 cm of wire (the length depends on the yarn you use). Make a small circle at one end — the circle should fit into the foot. Then press the circle a bit to make an oval. Wrap the both ends of the wire with fabric plaster to avoid injuries. Bend the circle to an angle a bit more than 90° and insert into the foot. Continue working around the wire.



10) 10 SC, (2 SC DEC), 1 SC (12)

11) 12 SC (12)

12) 10 SC, DEC (11)

13) 11 SC (11).

Next, move the marker ourselves as needed along the center of the back of the leg.

14) 4 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2, 4 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (15)

15) (2 SC in next ST), 4 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2, 8 SC (19)

16) (2 SC DEC), 6 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2, 6 SC, DEC (18)

17) 8 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2, 8 SC (20)

18) 9 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2, 8 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (23)

19) (2 SC in next ST), 10 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 10 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (26)

20) (2 SC in next ST), 11 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 12 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (29)

21) (2 SC in next ST), 13 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 13 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (32)

22) (2 SC in next ST), 30 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (34)

23) (2 SC in next ST), 15 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 16 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (37)

24) (2 SC in next ST), 36 SC (38)

25) (18 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2 (40)

26) 40 SC. Don't forget move the marker.

Front legs.

- Crochet with the main color;
- Work in continuous spiral;
- The marker goes along the back part of the leg. Correct/move the marker via SHIFT SC if you will need it;
- Stuff with polyester while crocheting. The density of the stuffing is medium. Final stuffing during toy assembly;
- Up to the 29th row, both legs are crocheted the same way according to the following pattern;
- If you want you can crochet a colored hoof from rows 1 to 6, then continue on to the main color.

1) 4 CH, 2 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 1 SC, 3 SC in next ST, 2 SC (8)

2) (2 SC in next ST)*2, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*3, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (14)

3) 14 SC (14)

4) 14 SC (14). Insert the plastic sole inside the hoof.

5) 6 SC, DEC, 5 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (14)

6) 14 SC (14). Change a color to main color (if you crocheted a hoof with an other color).

7) 4 SC, (2 SC DEC)*2, 3 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (12)

8) 4 SC, (2 SC DEC), 3 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2 (14)

Make framing (by analogy with the frame of the back legs).

10) 10 SC, (2 SC DEC), 1 SC (12).

11) 10 SC, DEC (11)

12) 11 SC (11).


Next, move the marker ourselves as needed along the center of the back of the leg.

13) 4 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2, 4 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (15)

14) 5 SC, DEC, 5 SC, (2 SC DEC) (12)

15) 11 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (13)

16) 6 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 6 SC (14)





17) 13 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (15)

18) 7 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 7 SC (16)

19) 15 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (17). Don't forget move the marker.

Ears.

- Crochet with the main color;
- Work in continuous spiral;
- The marker goes along the back the back lateral side of the ear. Correct/move the marker via SHIFT SC if you will need it;
- Don't stuff with polyester.
- Make 2 same ears according to the following pattern.





- 1) make a Magic Ring, 6 SC into the ring (6)
- 2) (2 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2 (8)
- 3) 8 SC (8)
- 4) (3 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2 (10)
- 5) 10 SC (10)
- 6) (3 SC, DEC)*2 (8)
- 7) 4 SC. FO.



Head-Body

- Crochet with the main color;
- Work in continuous spiral;
- The marker goes along the central line of the forehead and spine. Make SHIFT when it necessary;
- Stuff with polyester while crocheting. The density of the stuffing is medium.

- 1) 4 CH, 2 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 1 SC, 4 SC in next ST, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (10)
- 2) (2 SC in next ST)*2, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*4, 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*2 (18)
- 3) 7 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 7 SC (20)
- 4) 2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 14 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC (22)
- 5) 9 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 9 SC (24)
- 6) (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2, 16 SC, ((2 SC in next ST), 1 SC)*2 (28)
- 7) 12 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 12 SC (30)
- 8) 1 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 26 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 1 SC (32)
- 9) 14 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 14 SC (34).
- 10) 14 SC, DEC, 2 SC, DEC, 8 SC, 4 SC together with the ear, 2 SC (32)



- 11) 2 SC, 4 SC together with the ear, 6 SC, DEC, 4 SC, DEC, 6 SC, 4 SC ONLY along the 7th row of the ear, 2 SC (30)



18) 2 SC, 4 SC ONLY along the 7th row of the ear, 5 SC, DEC, 4 SC, DEC, 11 SC (28)

In the next photos the horse has no ears, because I added the ears on the next toy.


If you want that your horse could move her head (up, down, or side to side), or if you are making a unicorn, you need to add a wire frame. If you don't need this, just skip the instructions below and follow the basic pattern. Photos of the frame are on the next page. This page shows the diagram.

If you are making a unicorn, you can insert the main body frame and bring the second end of the wire out where the horn will be.


The wire should be about 40 cm long because the frame goes inside the head, neck, body (like a spine), and tail. It is better to cut off extra wire than to add more later!

Cover the sharp end of the horn with medical tape so it will not scratch you.

84) (13 SC, DEC)*3 (42)

If you plan to make a wired tail where you will later attach long yarn strands, crochet the next two rows as following pattern:

85) (6 SC, DEC, 6 SC)*2, 6 SC, DEC, 4 SC, 4 CH (39). Bring the wire frame out the resulted hole.

86) skip 2 stitches BEFORE the marker and 2 stitches AFTER the marker and crochet 1 SC in 3th ST, 8 SC, DEC, (11 SC, DEC)*2 (36)

If you don't plan to make a wired tail and will simply attach a tassel of yarn strands to the back, or a crocheted curly tail following my pattern, work the next two rows as following pattern:

85) (6 SC, DEC, 6 SC)*3 (39)

86) (11 SC, DEC)*3 (36)


87) (2 SC, DEC, 2 SC)*6 (30)

88) (3 SC, DEC)*6 (24)

89) (1 SC, DEC, 1 SC)*6 (18)

90) (1 SC, DEC)*6 (12)


91) DEC*2, close the resulted hole. FO.





Check the symmetry of the markers on the body. If you forgot to place additional markers earlier, add them now.

- Front legs: Between rows 48 and 49, find the center of the belly. From that point, count 9 stitches to the left and 9 stitches to the right.
- Back legs: Between rows 81 and 82, find the center of the belly. From that point, count 12 stitches to the left and 12 stitches to the right.



Before crocheting the tail, attach the back legs to the horse's body, twist the leg wire frames together, and bring the wire out through the tail hole. To do this:

- Insert the wire frames of the front and back legs into the points marked with the additional markers. Bring out only the wire of the back legs through the tail hole and twist the two back-leg wires together. Pin the front and back legs to the body with sewing pins, positioning them so the spine stays parallel to the floor.
- Carefully sew the legs to the body, adding more stuffing as you go. Do not stuff too tight, so the legs will not bulge outward.



Tail (base). Optional part.

- Crochet with the main color;
- Work in continuous spiral;
- Don't move the marker;
- Don't stuff with polyester.

If you decided to crochet a wired tail, return to rows 85/86 of the body and work into the remaining unworked front loops from any point around the opening. The marker position does not matter.

- 1) Crochet 4 SC in the remaining unworked front loops of row 85, then 4 SC in the remaining unworked front loops of row 86 (8 stitches total).
- 2) (2 SC, DEC)*2 (6)



3-6 (4 rows) 6 SC (6). Cut off excess pieces of wire and insulate with fabric plaster. FO. Close the hole.



Unicorn horn. Optional part.

- Crochet with golden or any other color;
- Work in continuous spiral FOR THE BACK half loops;
- Don't move the marker;
- Don't stuff with polyester.

1) make a Magic Ring, 6 SC into the ring (6)

2-4) 6 SC (6)

5) 5 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (7)

6-7) 7 SC (7)

8) 6 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (8)

9-10) 8 SC (8). FO. Close the hole. Place the horn on the frame, cutting off any excess wire. Sew the horn to the head.



Curly mane (crocheted).

- Crochet with white color+golden lurex yarn;
- Crochet without breaking the thread in one piece;
- I've numbered the rows below to make the text more understandable. The graphic diagram matches the text;

1) 22 CH of the main chain (in the following text I named it the main chain), along which we will crochet the mane and then another 11 CH for the first strand, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook,



9 SC along the chain.

2) 1 SS into the loop of the main chain and from it make 21 CH for the second strand, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 19 SC along the chain.

3) 1 SC into the loop of the main chain.

4) 1 SS into the loop of the main chain and from it make 26 CH for the 3rd strand, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 24 SC along the chain.

5) 1 SS into the loop of the main chain and from it make 28 CH for the 4th strand, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 26 SC along the chain.

6) 1 SC into the loop of the main chain.

7) 1 SS into the loop of the main chain and from it make 31 CH for the 5th strand, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 29 SC along the chain.

8) Crochet several strands with 30 SC in each according to the pattern, not forgetting to make 1 SC in a chain through every 2 strands (otherwise the mane will be too voluminous).

9) The last strand of the left side of the mane: 1 SS into the last loop of the main chain and from it make 26 CH, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 24 SC (on the graphic diagram this strand is marked "25" according to the number of SC in this strand) along the chain.

10) 1 SC into the last loop of the main chain.

11) The last strand of the right side of the mane: 1 SS into the last loop of the main chain and from it make 26 CH, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 24 SC along the chain.

12) Make the right side of the mane in the same way as the left side, but in the opposite direction so that we finish crocheting the mane with a strand "10" SC.





Curly tail (crocheted).

- Crochet with white color+golden lurex yarn;
- Crochet without breaking the thread in one piece;
- I've numbered the rows below to make the text more understandable.

- 1) Make 40 CH, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 38 SC along the chain.
- 2) Make 41 CH, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 38 SC along the chain.
- 3) In the same way as the second strand, crochet the third and fourth strands.
- 4) The fifth and following strands: make 62 CH, 1 SC into 2nd loop from the hook, 59 SC.
- 5) In total, I made 4 short and 5 long strands. You can make more long strands.

The tail can be twisted into a snail and sewn onto the horse's rump (if you did not make the tail frame), or sewn onto the tail frame in a spiral so that the short yarns are on the outside of the tail as close to the horse's rump as possible.





Mane and tail (yarn made).

- Use pink or any other color microfiber yarn. I used Diva by Alize.
- Cut several identical strands 20 cm long. If you won't be braiding the hair, make it single-layered; if you will, make it double-layered.
- The distance between stands is 1 row.
- Insert the hook into a point (first point) near the horn and bring it out to a point one row in front of the horn. Fold the strand in half and hook it where the strand bends. Pull out the loop through the first point by 0.5 cm.



- Insert the hook into the next row from the pulled-out loop, bring it up to the point with the pulled-out loop, and insert the hook into the pulled-out loop. Take the next strand, fold it in half, and hook it at the fold. Pull through the first loop and pull-out the loop by 0.5 cm where you inserted the hook. Repeat this process until Row 40 of the body. Create another symmetrical layer of strands if you plan to braid the mane.




In a similar way, make strands on the tail, inserting them into EACH loop of the tail from the first to the last row of the tail.



DECORATION

Horse.

- Sculpture the eyes. Between 13/14/15 rows place an additional marker in the center of the forehead. Count 6 stitches to the left and right and place additional markers. With strong thread, pull these dots closer to each other. Attach the eyes into the eye sockets.




- Sew on the ears (if didn't crochet).



- Sew the mane to the horse, wrong side out, right side facing the horse's body.
- Glue/sew on the eyes. I used 7mm glass toy eyes on a metal loop.



- Make 2 identical upper eyelids;



- Pin the upper eyelids and sew them in place following the outline.
- Lightly shade the hooves with gray.
- Draw the nostrils with a black marker/liner or embroider them with black embroidery floss.

Unicorn.

- Using a needle, unravel the strands onto the threads.



- Braid the strands. One braid is every next three rows. Braid strands from the left and right sides of the mane into one braid. Do NOT make separate braids for the left and right sides.
- Braid one braid at the base of the tail and wrap it around the base of the tail. You can secure it under the tail. Only then you can cut extra hair of the strands.



- Make shading similar to the horse's. You can add color tones to the mane. You can make the nose darker with dark gray on the sides and use the color of the strands in the center of the nose.
- Shade the hooves dark grey and make the edging the same color as the strands.

ACCESSORIES

Chest wreath.

- Crochet the wreath in green;
- Crochet the poinsettia flowers in red.

1) Make ODD numbers of CH of length equal to the horse's neck. I made 37 CH. Next crochet (from the 2nd loop from the hook) several DC to the halfway point of the chain, make 2 CH, and crochet DC to the end of the chain. For me, it's 18 DC, 2 CH, 18 DC. 2 CH, turn.

2) 18 DC, 1 DC under the chain of 2 CH of the previous row, 2 CH, 1 DC under the chain of 2 CH of the previous row, 18 DC. 2 CH, turn.

3) 19 DC, 1 DC under the chain of 2 CH of the previous row, 2 CH, 1 DC under the chain of 2 CH of the previous row, 19 DC. FO

Sew on a button or snap fastener.




Poinsettia.

For one flower make 6 identical petals according to the following pattern.

1) 5CH (the diagram shows 4 CH because 5th CH is a lifting loop). 1 SS into 2nd loop from the hook, 2 SC, (1 SC, 1 DC, 1 SC) into the last loop of the chain, 2 SC, 1 SS (9). FO

Join together to one thread, pull into a ring, and tie the ends into a knot. Don't cut the ends of the thread, but tie a bell to them. Then attach flowers to the wreath using the same ends of the thread.





Blanket.

- Crochet with red, green, white+gold lurex and gold color;
- Work in continuous spiral;
- Don't move the marker.

Upper part.

1-red) 11 CH, (2 SC in next ST) into the 2nd loop from the hook, 8 SC, 3 SC into the last loop of the chain, 9 SC (22)

2-red) (2 SC in next ST)*2, 8 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*3, 8 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (28)

3-red) (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2, 8 SC, (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*3, 8 SC, (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST)) (34)

4-red) (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 1 SC)*2, 8 SC, (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 1 SC)*3, 8 SC, (1 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 1 SC) (40)



5-white+gold) (3 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2, 8 SC, (3 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*3, 8 SC, (3 SC, (2 SC in next ST)) (46)

6-white+gold) (2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC)*2, 8 SC, (2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC)*3, 8 SC, (2 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 2 SC) (52)

7-green) (5 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*2, 8 SC, (5 SC, (2 SC in next ST))*3, 8 SC, (5 SC, (2 SC in next ST)) (58)

10-red) (4 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 4 SC)*2, 8 SC, (4 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 4 SC)*3, 8 SC, (4 SC, (2 SC in next ST), 4 SC) (76). FO

Find the last increase of the 10th row and crochet with gold thread (5 CH, 6 SC into the 2nd loop from the hook, 3 SS down along the chain, 2 SS along the blanket)*10, 5 CH, 6 SC into the 2nd loop from the hook, 3 SS down along the chain. Repeat the edging on the opposite side of the blanket.

Lower part.

Make a chain with stitch equal to the circumference of the horse's belly from edge to edge of the blanket.

My measurements are as follows:

1) 31 CH, (2 SC in next ST) into the 2nd loop from the hook, 28 SC, 3 SC into the last loop of the chain, 29 SC (62)

2) (2 SC in next ST)*2, 28 SC, (2 SC in next ST)*3, 28 SC, (2 SC in next ST) (68). FO. Sew it to the top of the blanket on one side and install a snap fastener on the other side so that the blanket is removable.





Bridle.

- Crochet with red color;

- first chain — $\frac{2}{3}$ of the mouth circumference;

- second chain — $\frac{1}{3}$ of the mouth circumference;

Pin the chains around the horse's mouth. Place the pin at the corner of the mouth, where the metal jump ring will be located.

- third chain — from the ring on the left side of the horse's head, through the head and to the ring on the right side of the horse's head.

Connect all the chains to a metal ring.

That's it! Now the horse is completely ready!
