

Crochet Bunny Pouch



Airi crochet

Materials

- 5 ply milk cotton yarn in any color
- Size vary depending on size of yarn
(In this tutorial, I used a 2.5mm hook)
- needle
- stitch markers
- scissors
- a button with a diameter of 1cm
- felt / safety eyes
- Optional: 2 '4 ply milk cotton yarn' in any different colors

Abbreviation

MR=Magic Ring

F0=fasten off

ch=chain

BLO=work in back loop only

dc= double crochet

inc=2 sc in 1 st

sl st=slip stitch

FP=Front Post stitches

sts=stitches


sc=single crochet

hdc=half double crochet

tr=treble crochet

dec=1 sc in 2 st

sk=skip





Bunny Backpack



i. Start with Body and drawstring

Body: Foundation row: 13 ch.

R1: Back to 2nd st, 1 inc, 10 sc, 3 sc in 1st, 11sc {25}

R2: 2 inc, 10 sc, 3 inc, 10 sc, 1 inc {32}

R3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 2, 10 sc, (1sc, 1 inc) x 3, 11sc, 1 inc {38}

R4: BLO 38 sc {38}


R5-19: 38 sc

R20: (1 sc, 2ch, sk 1 st) x 2, (7 sc, 2ch, sk 1st, x, 2ch, sk 1 st) x 2, 6 sc, 2 ch, sk 1 st, x, 2ch, sk 1 st, 5 sc, sl st {44}

FO*, cut the yarn. Invisible fasten off.

Drawstring: I mixed 2 color of 4 ply milk cotton, work for chain sts. 48 ch

Weave through R20 (Fig 1)



ii. Cover and Top grab handle

Cover: Foundation row: 10 ch.

R1: Back to 2nd st, 9 sc {9}

R2-17: 9 sc

i. FO, leave a long tail for sewing.

ii. Sew the cover onto the back of the body R17 and R16.

(Please refer to Fig 2)

iii. Sew the button on the front middle of body, position it between R15 and R16

Top grab handle

iV. FP slst at R12, 4ch, sk 3 sts, FP slst.

FO*, cut the yarn. Invisible fasten off.

(Please refer to Fig 3)

iV.Fig 3 - Cover grids

FP slst here :

place the hook behind the post which brings the post to the front of your hook

Post is in between 2 stitches

iii. Ears, Straps and loop

Ears: Foundation row: 13 ch.

R1: Back to 2nd st, 3 sc , 3hdc, 5 dc, 8dc in 1st, 5dc, 3hdc, 3sc {30}

i. FO, leave a long tail for sewing.

ii. Sew them on the back of the bag cover, between R5 to R6

Loop:

FP slst at Cover R5, 7ch, sk 2 sts, FP slst at Cover

Backpack straps (Please refer to Fig5 & Fig 6):

First strap: FP slst at Cover R14, 24ch, FP slst at body R4.

FO*, cut the yarn. Invisible fasten off.

Second strap: FP slst at Cover 14, 24ch, FP slst at body R4

FO*, cut the yarn. Invisible fasten off.



Bunny case



i. Start with case bottom ①

Foundation row: 11 ch.


R1: Starting with 11ch, Back to 2nd sts, 10 sc {10}

R2-10: 1 ch, turn, 10 sc {10}

R11: Crochet along the outermost part of the square shape (10 sc in each side) {40} (Please refer to Fig 7)

i. DO NOT FASTEN OFF. Continuing with the crochet Bunny case body

ii. Case body ②

R1: BLO 10 sc {10}

R2: turn, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 ins {12}

R3: turn, 12 sc {12}

R4: turn, 1 ins, 10 sc, 1 ins {14}

R5: turn, 14 sc {14}

R6: turn, 14 sc {14}

R7: turn, 14 sc {14}

R8: turn, 1 dec, 10 sc, 1dec {12}

R9: turn, 12 sc {12}

R10: turn, 1 dec, 8sc, 1dec {10}

R11: turn, 10 sc {10}

i. Still DO NOT FASTEN OFF. Continuing with the crochet the one of the Bunny ears

v. Case body ⑤



- R1: BLO 10 sc {10}
- R2: turn, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 ins {12}
- R3: turn, 12 sc {12}
- R4: turn, 1 ins, 10 sc, 1 ins {14}
- R5: turn, 14 sc {14}
- R6: turn, 14 sc {14}
- R7: turn, 1 dec, 10 sc, 1dec {12}
- R8: turn, 12 sc {12}
- R9: turn, 1 dec, 8sc, 1dec {10}
- R10: turn, 10 sc {10}




i. Still DO NOT FASTEN OFF. Continue crocheting one part of the handles

vi. Handles ⑥

- R11: turn, 4 sc {4}
- R12: turn, 4 sc {4}
- R13: turn, 4 sc {4}
- R14: turn, 2 sc, 1 dec {3}
- R15: turn, 3 sc {3}
- R16: turn, 3 sc {3}
- R17: turn, 1 dec, 1 sc {2}
- R18: turn, 2 sc {2}
- R19: turn, 2 sc {2}


i. FO*, cut the yarn. Invisible fasten off.



vii. Handle ⑦

- R11: turn, 4 sc {4}
- R12: turn, 4 sc {4}
- R13: turn, 4 sc {4}
- R14: turn, 1 dec, 2 sc {2}
- R15: turn, 3 sc {3}
- R16: turn, 3 sc {3}
- R17: 1 sc, 1 dec {2}
- R18: turn, 2 sc {2}
- R19: turn, 2 sc {2}

i. DO NOT FASTEN OFF. Continue crocheting the handle



viii. Handles ⑧

R20: turn, 2 sc, 2 ch, 1 sc into the stitch of the other part of the handle which is near to the part of handle you just worked on, 1 sc

R21: turn, 6 sc {6}



Repeat steps v. Case body, vi. Handles (part 1) and vii. Handle (part 2), viii. Handles (part 3) to crochet the opposite part.
