

Crochet bag pattern

Regina

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Ready bag size: 22×17×10 cm (8,7×6,7×4 inches)

The required materials:

1. Polyester cord without core (D=4.5-5 mm)
150-160 m (5900-6300 inches)
2. 5 mm crochet hook

3. Plastic tapestry needle, sewing needle, scissors, lighter, stitch markers, fishing line, or thread that matches the cord color
4. Sewing snap on a piece of leather



Abbreviations (US):

Ch - chain

t-ch – turning chain

sc – single crochet

sl st – slip stitch

The bottom of the bag

Crochet the bottom in the form of an oval in spirals without joining.


Make 5 rounds.

0 - chain

1 - 1 sc

2 - 2 sc in one stitch (increase)

Chain 12 + 1 t-ch.

Rnd 1: crochet 11 sc in waistcoat stitch through back loops only, 3 sc in the last chain foundation, 10 sc, 2 sc in one chain foundation.

Mark the first stitch of the round and stitches without increases.

Rnd 2: 2 sc, 10 sc, (2 sc)×3, 10 sc, (2 sc)×2

Rnd 3: 1, 2, 10, (2, 1)×3, 10, (1, 2)×2

Rnd 4: 2, 1, 1, 10, (1,1,2)×3, 10, (2,1,1)





Rnd 5: 1, 1, 2, 1, 10, (1, 2, 1, 1)×3, 10, (1, 1, 2, 1)×2


In total, 50 stitches.

Make 5 rounds or more as desired.

Rnd 6: 1, 1, 1, 1, 2, 10, (2, 1, 1, 1, 1)×3, 10,

$(1, 1, 1, 1, 2) \times 2$





Steam both sides of the bottom through the cotton fabric without breaking the yarn.



The sides of the bag

Continue crocheting using sc without



increases in spirals. In total, make 24 rounds (including the bottom of the bag).

Handle of the bag

Fold the bag in half and mark the edge stitches. The distance between the markers is 24 sc.

Crochet the handle using 4 sc + 1 t-ch from the edge without breaking the yarn in back and forth rows.

Row 1: 3 sc + 1 t-ch

Row 2: 3 sc + 1 t-ch

Row 3: 3 sc + 1 t-ch

Continue crocheting the handle to the



desired length.

The last row: 3 sc, break yarn, leaving 30 cm (12 inches) yarn tail.

Sew the handle to the other edge of the bag.

Steam pressing

Steam the ready bag. Put a tightly folded towel in the bag. Cover the bag with a cotton cloth and steam on all sides. Give the desired shape to the bag while it is hot.

Sewing snap on a piece of leather

Attach the snap on the leather to the bag and mark the center of the bag. There are 10 stitches from the snap to the edges. Sew one part of the snap using a fishing line or sewing thread that matches the color of the cord.

Attach the other part of the snap to the bag and mark the position of sewing the snap on the wrong side of the bag.

There are 9 stitches from the snap to the edges. Make sure you sew the snap in the center of the bag. Sew it on.



The bag is finished.
