

CROCHET Frog Limbs Supplement

YARN A Use same shade as your frog's body

I used: Cardiff Cashmere Classic 4-ply/ fingering shade 700 Futon

HOOK 2mm (or 1.8mm) - favourites are *KnitPro Soft Grip Crochet Hook* and/ or *Tulip Etimo Red Crochet Hook*

TENSION

18 stitches and 22 rows to 5cm (2in) over double crochet using 2.00mm hook and yarn A.

STOCKISTS

I've created this pattern to make the limbs slimmer and longer and, I think easier to add the wire armature into.

Use this pattern in place of the arms and legs if you choose to have longer, finer limbs

NOTE:

In this pattern I've used UK term: Half Treble Crochet UK abbreviation: HTR
(to convert to USA term: Half Double Crochet USA abbreviation: hdc)



HIND LEGS

The Hind Legs are knitted independently and sewn on, with wires (*optional*) after you've crocheted them, as follows:

Left and Right Hind Legs are worked similarly

Each Leg is worked in rows then rounds of double crochet (DC) and half treble crochet (HTR), starting with a row of chain stitches as follows:

With yarn A, make 32CH

Row 1. (WS) 1DC in second ch from hook, 1DC in next 15ch, 1HTR in next 15ch, 1CH; Working in reverse side of each 32ch: 1HTR in next 15ch, 1DC in each 16ch then 1DC in 1ch from beginning of row, 1CH - 66sts (*including 2 ch*)

Round 1. 1DC into each 61sts which leaves 5 sts (including the 1ch) for working the toes as follows:

Add Webbed Feet 'Toes'

Make 4CH for **Toe 1:** 1DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1DC in next 2ch, slip stitch at the bottom of 4ch.

1DC in next 2sts

Make 4CH for **Toe 2:** 1DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1DC in next 2ch, slip stitch at the bottom of 4ch.

1DC in each next 2sts

Make 3CH for **Toe 3:** 1DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1DC in next 2ch, slip stitch at the bottom of 4ch, fasten off leaving a long tail end.

Complete the Foot

*Using a yarn sewing needle, use the yarn end to shape and strengthen each toe by sewing back and forth through them.

To join the Legs

You'll find that the crochet naturally curls in on itself, curling in to what is the RS of the crochet which means the WS of the crochet becomes the outside of the leg - this is correct for this pattern.

Once curled inwards you can quickly join along the back leg seam, lacing the stitches by sewing in and out at the same time joining the two edges together - joining around wire that has been wrapped with yarn if you want an armature.

At the foot, leave the toes splayed outwards and simply join behind the toes to close up the hind leg seam (and keep the wire in place if using).**



FORELEGS

The Forelegs are knitted independently and sewn on, with wires (*optional*) after you've crocheted them, as follows:

Left and Right Forelegs are worked similarly

Each Leg is worked in rows then rounds of double crochet (DC) and half treble crochet (HTR), starting with a row of chain stitches as follows:

With yarn A, make 16CH

Row 1. (WS) 1DC in second ch from hook, 1DC in next 11ch, 1HTR in next 3ch, 1CH; Working in reverse side of each 16ch: 1HTR in next 3ch, 1DC in each 12ch then 1DC in 1ch from beginning of row, 1CH - 34sts (*including 2 ch*)

Round 1. 1DC into each 29sts which leaves 5 sts (including the 1ch) for working the toes as follows:

Add Webbed Feet 'Toes'

Make 4CH for **Toe 1**: 1DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1DC in next 2ch, slip stitch at the bottom of 4ch.

1DC in next 2sts

Make 4CH for **Toe 2**: 1DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1DC in next 2ch, slip stitch at the bottom of 4ch.

1DC in each next 2sts

Make 3CH for **Toe 3**: 1DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1DC in next 2ch, slip stitch at the bottom of 4ch, fasten off leaving a long tail end.

Complete the Foot

As Hind Leg from * to **
