



# CUTIE COLLAR

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CUTIE COLLAR IS A FANCY ACCESSORY, IN ONE SIZE, WORKED FROM THE NECKLINE DOWN TO THE OUTER EDGE, FINISHED WITH I-CORD, AND CORDS FOR BONDING.

**Size:** One size

**Needles:** Circular needles 4 mm, 80 cm for body and 3,5 mm, 40 cm or 60 cm for cords

**Suggested yarn:** 25 g of Sunday Sandnes Garn (235 m / 50 g) or Fabel by Drops (205 m / 50 g) or Tynn Peer Gynt Sandnes Garn (205 m / 50 g) held together with 10 g of Tynn Silk Mohair Sandnes Garn (212 m / 25 g) or Kid-Silk by Drops (210 m / 25 g)

**Sample knitted with yarns:**

Beige: Sunday Sandnes Garn in 2650 and Tynn Silk Mohair in colour 2511

Red: Fabel by Drops in colour 106 and Tynn Silk Mohair in colour 4008

Blue: Tynn Peer Gynt Sandnes Garn in 6046 and Tynn Silk Mohair in colour 6046

## Abbreviations

RS/WS - right side / wrong side

k - knit

p - purl

st/sts - stitch(es)

yo - yarn over

sm - slip marker

ssk - slip, slip, knit - slip 2 stitches knitwise to the right needle, slip back to the left needle and knit them together through the back loop to lean decrease to the left

k2tog - knit two stitches together to lean decrease to the right

tbl - through the back loop

## Pattern

Cast on 98 stitches on **4 mm, 80 cm circular needles**. Work as follows:

**Row 1 (WS):** purl all stitches

**Row 2 (RS):** knit all stitches, in the meantime place 10 markers: \*k9, place marker\* until there is last 8 sts on the needle, k8

**Row 3 (WS):** purl all sts

**Row 4 (RS):** \*k8, yarn over, k1, slip marker, yo\* until there is last 8 stitches, k8. You increased 20 stitches and have now 118 stitches on your needles

**Row 5 (WS):** purl all sts

**Row 6 (RS):** knit all sts

**Row 7 (WS):** purl all sts

**Row 8 (RS):** \*k until 1 st before marker, yo, k1, sm, yo\* 10 times, k till the end of row

**Row 9 (WS):** purl all sts

**Row 10 (RS):** knit all sts

**Row 11 (WS):** purl all sts

Work rows < 8 - 11 > 2 more times (3 times in total).

**Row 20 (RS):** k2, ssk, \*k until 1 st before marker, yo, k1, sm, yo\* 10 times, k until 4 sts before the end of row, k2tog, k2

**Row 21 (WS):** purl all sts

**Row 22 (RS):** k2, ssk, k until 4 sts before the end of row, k2tog, k2

**Row 23 (WS):** purl all sts

Work Rows < 20 - 23 > 1 more time (2 times in total).

**Row 28 (RS):** Remove all markers while working as follows: k2, ssk, k until 4 sts before the end of row, k2tog, k2.

Now you will work i-cord edges: on the both sides and outer edge, then cords and inner neckline edge.

# CUTIE COLLAR

Without breaking the yarn, pick up 25 sts along the side of collar, 1 st in each row, skip the first and the last row. Break the yarn.

Now pick up 25 sts along the other side of collar, starting from the neckline to an edge (picture 1), 1 st in each row, skip the first and the last row. Break the yarn. Slip 25 picked up sts from right needle to the left one.

Now you can start to work i-cord from left shoulder. Cast on 2 sts on the left needle and work as follows: \*k1, k2tog tbl, slip 2 sts back to the left needle\* until last 2 sts, bind off remaining sts, break the yarn.

Pick up sts along inner neckline as follows: 4 sts in every 5 rows, it's approximately 80 sts. Break the yarn.

Now you will work the cord, and then connect it to the inner edge to continue with i-cord edge. Using 3,5 mm needles, cast on 3 sts and work as follows: \*k2, k1 tbl, slip back all sts to the left needle\* until cord is approximately 30 cm long.

Do not break the yarn, move 3 sts on the left needle (4 mm), next to previously picked up stitches (picture 2), to continue i-cord edge along the neckline.

Work as follows: k1, k3tog tbl, slip 2 sts back to the left needle, \*k1, k2tog tbl, slip 2 sts back to the left needle\* until you work all sts along the neckline and have 3 sts on the needle.

Change the needle to 3,5 mm. Continue working the cord for approx. 30 cm: \*k2, k1 tbl, slip 3 sts back to the left needle\*. Once the cord is 30 cm long, bind off the remaining 3 sts.

Weave in all ends in. Wash and block your collar, and make sure to shape it properly. Your Cutie Collar is ready to wear!
