

# Meydenbauer Hat

MeriKash®

Knitting Pattern DK804 - Easy/Intermediate

## Size:

To fit 16" (18", 20", 22") head circumference

Shown in 20" size

## Materials:

- Cascade Yarns® Merikash®: 80% Extra-fine Merino Wool / 20% Cashmere; 100 g (3.5 oz) / 255 yds (233 m); 1 skein color #07 Pomegranate
- US 4 (3.5 mm) 16-20" circular knitting needles
- US 6 (4.0 mm) 16-20" circular knitting needles
- US 6 (4.0 mm) double pointed knitting needles (DPNs)
- Yarn needle

## Finished Measurements:

Unstretched circumference 12" (14", 16", 18")

Height: 7.5" (8.5", 9.5", 10.5")

Hat will stretch several inches in diameter.

## Gauge:

28 sts and 29 rows = 4" (10 cm) in 2x2 ribbing, unstretched, on smaller needles

## Begin Pattern:

With US 4 circular needles, CO 80 (96, 112, 128) sts. Join in the round being careful not to twist stitches.

K2, P2 for 2", 2.5", 3", 4"

Switch to US 6 circular needles.

## Hat body:

**Round 1:** \*K3, P2, K, P2, K, P2, K3, P2, repeat from \* to end of round



## Abbreviations:

CO = Cast on

K = Knit

P = Purl

P2tog = Purl 2 sts together

St(s) = Stitch(es)





**Round 2:** \*K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 3:** \*K, P2, K3, P2, K3, P2, K, P2, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 4:** \*K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P2, repeat from \* to end of round



Continue Rounds 1-4 until hat measures 6" (7", 8", 9") from cast on edge.

**Crown decreases - change to DPNs when necessary**

**Round 1:** \* K2, [K, P2] x 3, K3, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 2:** \*[K2, P2] x 3, K, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 3:** \*[K, P2, K2] x 2, K, P, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 4:** \*[K2, P2] x 2, K2, P, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 5:** \*K2, [K, P2] x 2, K, P, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 6:** \*[K2, P2] x 2, K, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 7:** \*K, P2, K3, P2, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 8:** \*K2, P2, K2, P, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 9:** \*K3, P2, K, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 10:** \*K2, P2, K, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 11:** \*K, P2, K, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 12:** \*K2, P, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 13:** \*K2, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 14:** \*K, P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

**Round 15:** \*P2tog, repeat from \* to end of round

Break yarn, weave tail through all remaining stitches and pull to close. Weave in ends with yarn needle.
