

Distance Scarf (DK)

Distance Scarf DK is a plump version of the original [Distance Scarf](#). It's worked flat from one short end to the other, full of easy-to-knit cables throughout which are all done on the right side of work. Instructions are given on how to easily shorten or lengthen the scarf. This is a true "just one more row" kind of project, as you become mesmerized watching the cables bend and weave into one another. A great little travel project and maybe even a gift for a loved one 

INFORMATION

SIZES

1 (2) 3

Finished measurements:

Length: approx. 41.5 (42) 43.3 in (easily adjustable - instructions given how to lengthen and shorten).

Width: 4.15 (4.75) 5.4 in.

DK weight

Yarn used in sample: Clinton Hill Cashmere - Bespoke

DK 50g/1.75oz 125yds/114m 100% cashmere.

Yardage needed: 145 (184) 203 yds

GAUGE

26 sts x 28 rows - in cable pattern in 4 in. worked flat and measured after blocking.

Recommended needles: US6 straight or circular needles.

Notions: cable needle, darning needle for weaving in ends.

YARN

ABBREVIATIONS

CDD - central double decrease

CO - cast on

k - knit

kpk - knit, purl, knit into the same stitch

k2tog - knit 2 together

m1L - make one left leaning

m1R - make one right leaning

p - purl

pkp - purl, knit, purl into the same stitch

p2tog - purl two together

ssp - slip 2 sts knitwise one by one, place back to left hand needle purlwise, p2tog tbl.

sl - slip

ssk - slip, slip, knit

st/s - stitch/es

tbl - through back loop

wyib - with yarn in back

wyif - with yarn in front

PATTERN

When making your swatch, I recommend working Chart B (E) H two times. This should equal 3.4 (5.7) 5.7 inches in length and 4.5 (5) 5.7 inches in width.

Using the long tail cast on, CO 7 sts (all sizes).

Row 1 (WS): sl 3 wyif, k1, p3.

Row 2 (RS): sl 3 wyib, pkp, k3. (+2 sts)

Row 3 (WS): sl 3 wyif, k3, p3.

Row 4 (RS): sl 3 wyib, p1, kpk, p1, k3. (+2 sts)

Row 5 (WS): sl 3 wyif, "k1, p1" twice, k1, p3.

Row 6 (RS): sl 3 wyib, p1, m1L, k1, p1, k1, m1R, p1, k3. (+2 sts)

Row 7 (WS): sl 3 wyif, “k1, p2” twice, k1, p3.
13 sts (all sizes)

Work Chart A (D) G. Now work Chart B (E) H - 18 (10) 10 times total.

Size 2: after working Chart E 10 times, work just Rows 1-16 of the chart.

Size 3: after working Chart H 10 times, work just Rows 1-12 of the chart.

If you would like to lengthen or shorten your scarf, you can repeat Chart B (E) H more or less times. Each repeat adds/subtracts about 1.7 (2.85) 2.85 in.

Work Chart C (F) I.
11 sts (all sizes)

Row 8 (RS): sl 3 wyib, k2tog, p1, ssk, k3. (-2 sts)

Row 9 (WS): sl 3 wyif, CDD, p3. (-2 sts)

Bind off: sl1 wyib, k2tog, pass 1st st over the 2nd, p1, pass previous st over, ssk, pass previous st over, k1, pass previous st over.

Cut yarn, weave in ends and wet block.



STITCH DICTIONARY

CDD - Central Double Decrease: sl 2 sts together knitwise (insert RH needle as if you're going to knit 2 sts together but just slip them off the LH needle), k the next st, then pass the 2 slipped sts over the knitted st.

1/1 LC - 1/1 left cross: hold 1 st on cable needle to front, k1, then k the st on cable needle.

1/1 RC - 1/1 right cross: hold 1 st on cable needle to back, k1, then k the st on cable needle.

2/2 LC - 2/2 left cross: hold 2 sts on cable needle to front, k2, then k the sts on cable needle.

2/2 RC - 2/2 right cross: hold 2 sts on cable needle to back, k2, then k the sts on cable needle.

2/2 LPC - 2/2 left purl cross: hold 2 sts on cable needle to front, p2, then k the sts on cable needle.

2/2 RPC - 2/2 right purl cross: hold 2 sts on cable needle to back, k2, then p the sts on cable needle.

2/1 LC - 2/1 left cross: hold 2 sts on cable needle to front, k1, then k the sts on cable needle.

2/1 RC - 2/1 right cross: hold 1 st on cable needle to back, k2, then k the st on cable needle.

1/2 LC - 1/2 left cross: hold 1 st on cable needle to front, k2, then k the st on cable needle.

1/2 RC - 1/2 right cross: hold 2 sts on cable needle to back, k1, then k the sts on cable needle.

ssp - slip 2 sts knitwise one by one, place back to left hand needle purlwise, p2tog tbl.

CHART "F" RED and GREEN STITCHES

2/1 LC - hold 2 sts on cable needle to front, k1, then k2tog the sts on cable needle.

2/1 RC - hold 1 st on cable needle to back, ssk, then k the st on cable needle.

2/3 LPC - hold 2 sts on cable needle to front, p1, p2tog knitwise, then k the sts on cable needle.

2/3 RPC - hold 3 sts on cable needle to back, k2, then p2tog, p1 the sts on cable needle.

CHART "I" GREEN STITCHES

2/3 LPC - hold 2 sts on cable needle to front, p1, p2tog knitwise, then k the sts on cable needle.

2/3 RPC - hold 3 sts on cable needle to back, k2, then p2tog, p1 the sts on cable needle.
