SIZES

XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL].

- If there is only one number, it applies to all sizes.
- If there is an "-", that size needs to skip those instructions.
- If there is an "X", those instructions don't apply to that size.

- XS: Bust sizes between 71-76cm (28-30 in). Approx. 47cm (18.5 in) w & 50.5cm (19.8 in) l.
- S: Bust sizes between 81-86cm (32-34 in). Approx. 53cm (20.8 in) w & 52cm (20.4 in) l.
- M: Bust sizes between 91.5-96.5cm (36-38 in). Approx. 57cm (22.4 in) w & 52cm (20.4 in) l.
- L: Bust sizes between 101.5-106.5cm (40-42 in). Approx. 63cm (24.8 in) w & 53.5cm (21 in) l.
- XL: Bust sizes between 111.5-117cm (44-46 in). Approx. 68.5cm (26.9 in) w & 54.5cm (21.4 in) l.
- 2XL: Bust sizes between 122-127cm (48-50 in). Approx. 73cm (28.7 in) w & 54.5cm (21.4 in) l.
- 3XL: Bust sizes between 132-137cm (52-54 in). Approx. 78.5cm (30.9 in) w & 54.5cm (21.4 in) l.
- 4XL: Bust sizes between 142-147cm (56-58 in). Approx. 83cm (32.6 in) w & 56cm (22 in) l.
- 5XL: Bust sizes between 152-158cm (60-62 in). Approx. 88.5cm (34.8 in) w & 56cm (22 in) l.



MATERIALS

Crochet hooks

- 6.5mm (US K-10.5)
OR any other hook that gives you the correct gauge measurements.

Other

- 5 buttons ~28L (18mm (23/32 in))
- Yarn needle OR smaller hook (e.g. ~3mm (US D/3))
- Scissors
- At least 6 stitch markers

Yarn

This cardi was made using Drops Air, blow yarn made of Baby Alpaca and Merino wool. Aran/Worsted 10ply, 50g (1.8 oz), 150m (164 yd). 8 wraps per inch (wpi).

- Size XS: ~1200m (1312 yd) total. 940m (1028 yd) MC & 260m (284 yd) CC.
- Size S: ~1300m (1421 yd) total. 1020 m (1115 yd) MC & 280m (306 yd) CC.
- Size M: ~1400m (1531 yd) total. 1100m (1203 yd) MC & 300m (328 yd) CC.
- Size L: ~1500m (1640 yd) total. 1175m (1285 yd) MC & 325m (355 yd) CC.
- Size XL: ~1650m (1804 yd) total. 1290m (1411 yd) MC & 360m (394 yd) CC.
- Size 2XL: ~1750m (1913 yd) total. 1370m (1498 yd) MC & 380m (416 yd) CC.
- Size 3XL: ~1850m (2023 yd) total. 1450m (1586 yd) MC & 400m (437 yd) CC.
- Size 4XL: ~1950m (2132 yd) total. 1530m (1673 yd) MC & 420m (459 yd) CC.
- Size 5XL: ~2000m (2187 yd) total. 1570m MC (1717 yd) & 430m (470 yd) CC.

Note: You will work with the CC in 2 separate sections simultaneously, so make sure you buy at least 2 skeins or take the time to split your yarn into 2 balls.

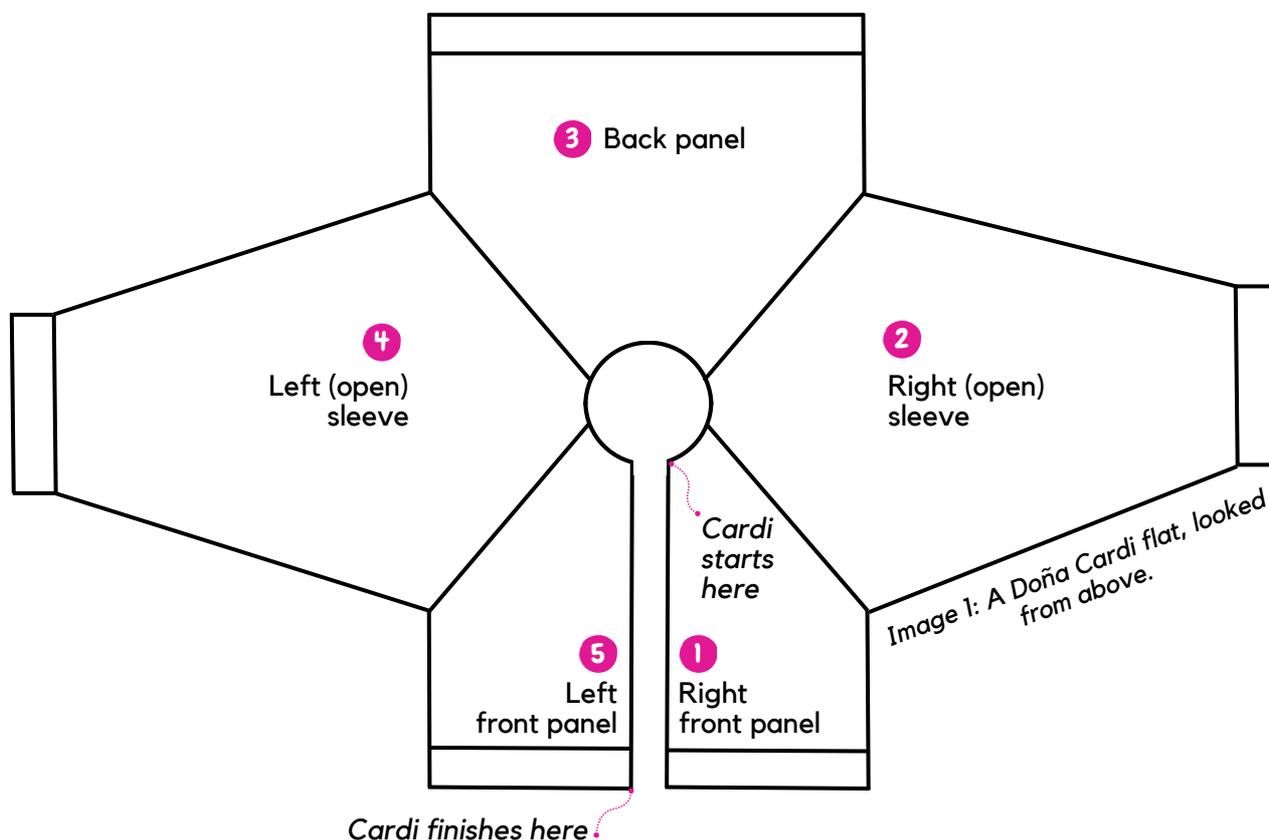
ABBREVIATIONS

- St(s) = Stitch(es)
- Ch(s) = Chain(s)
- Ch-1 = Chain previously made
- Sk = Skip
- RS = Right side
- WS = Wrong side
- MC = Main colour
- CC = Contrasting colour
- SLST = Slip Stitch (hook through both loops or chain)
- SLST BLO = Slip Stitch in the back loop only
- SLST 2TOG = Slip Stitch two loops together
- HDC SLST = Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch (hook through both loops or chain)
- HDC SLST 2TOG = Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch two loops together
- HDC SLST BLO = Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch in the back loop only
- HDC SLST BLO INC = Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch increase
- HDC SLST BLO AINC = Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch after increase (a regular HDC SLST BLO made in the last back loop worked).
- HDC SLST BLO DEC = Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch decrease

THE PROJECT

The Doña Cardi is an innovative knit-look project that is crocheted sideways in one single panel. The raglan effect is created with short rows and the result is a flat cardigan that is finished by joining the sides and sleeves lengthwise. The diagram below details the order that you will follow to create your cardi:

- 1) Crochet the right front panel first.
- 2) Begin the right sleeve.
- 3) Move to the back panel.
- 4) Continue with the left sleeve.
- 5) Finish with the left front panel.



HOW TO MAKE THE MAIN STITCHES

HDC SLST BLO

Check out how to crochet the HDC SLST BLO here:

This stitch is like a HDC with a twist. Yarn over and insert your hook into the back loop of the stitch. Pull up a loop, you will have three loops on your hook. Now instead of yarning over again (like you would do on a regular HDC), use the loop you just pulled up and pull it through the 2 other loops on your hook.



Image 2: To crochet a HDC SLST BLO you must pull the loop closest to your hook through the other two.

HDC SLST BLO INC

Yarn over and insert your hook into the st you just used (3.a and 3.b) and also into the back loop of the st after (3.c). You should have 4 loops on your hook (3.c). Yarn over and pull through 2 loops, you will have three loops on your hook (3.d). Now use the loop you just pulled up and pull it through the other 2 (3.e and 3.f).

The HDC SLST BLO INC will be explained in the video about the neck increases on page 18.

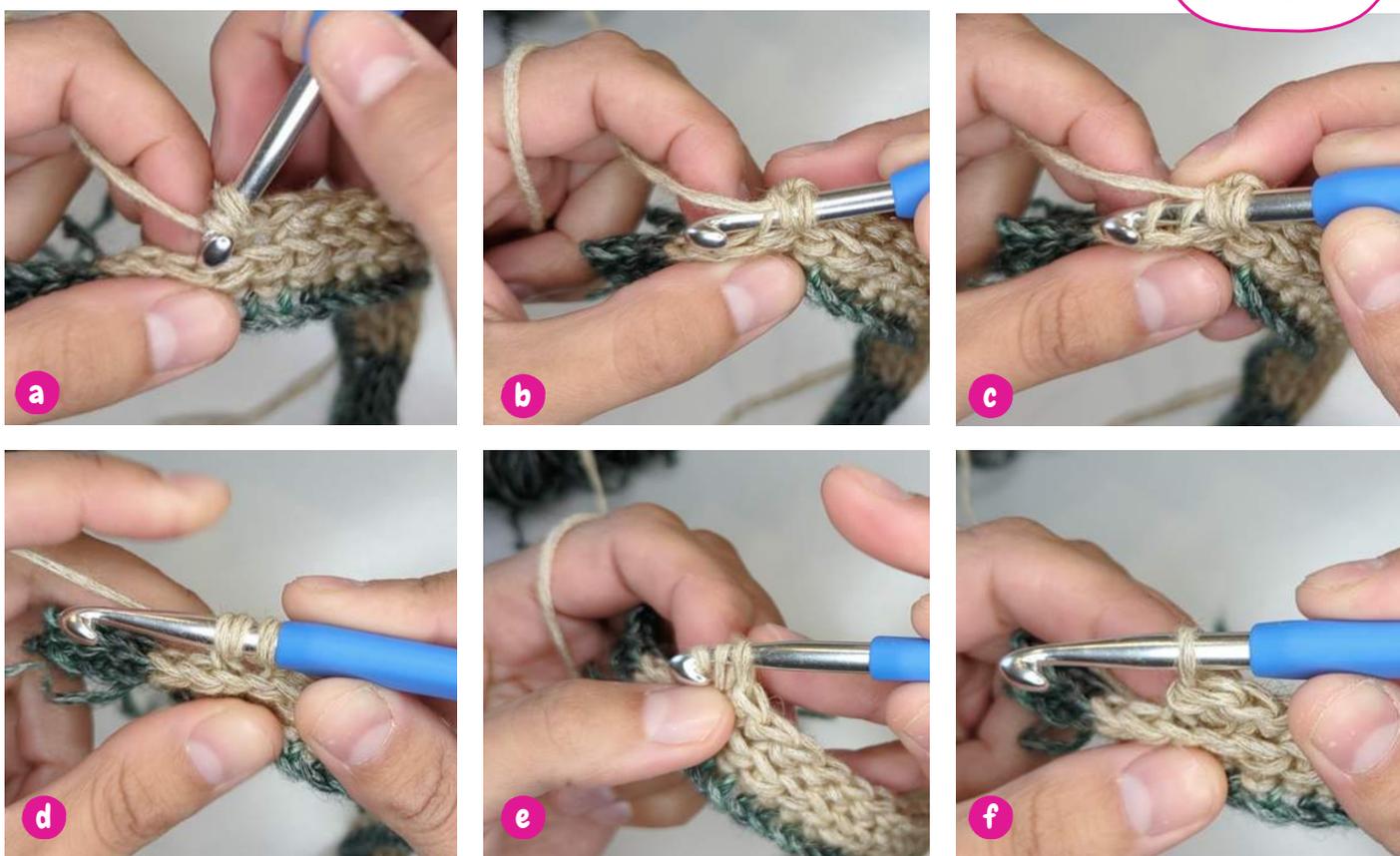


Image 3: This is how you make a HDC SLST BLO INC.

HDC SLST BLO AINC

This is just a regular HDC SLST BLO that happens right after the HDC SLST BLO INC. This st is made in the last back loop worked -the same second back loop you used to make the HDC SLST BLO INC- but because of the latter, this loop looks a little different now.

The HDC SLST BLO AINC will be explained in the video about the neck increases on page 18.



Image 4: The arrow shows where you have to insert your hook to make a HDC SLST BLO AINC.

HDC SLST BLO DEC

This is just a regular HDC SLST that is made by inserting your hook into the back loop of the next 2 sts. Yarn over and insert your hook into the back loop of the next stitch (image 5.a) and also into the back loop of the st after (5.b). You should have 4 loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull through 2 loops (5.c), you will have 3 loops on your hook. Now use the loop you just pulled up and pull it through the other 2.

The HDC SLST BLO DEC will be explained in the video about neck decreases on page 36.



Image 5: This is how you make a HDC SLST BLO DEC.

The HDC SLST 2TOG will be explained in the video about raglan rows on page 20.

HDC SLST 2TOG (to join short rows to a raglan row and viceversa)

Once you have done the last HDC SLST BLO on the current short row (image 6.a below), yarn over (6.b) and insert your hook into the turning ch of the previous short row (6.c and 6.d). Without yarning over again, also insert your hook into the back loop of the next available stitch (on the row crocheted under the current short row, as shown on image 6.e below). Now yarn over (6.f) and pull up a loop through the 4 loops on your hook.

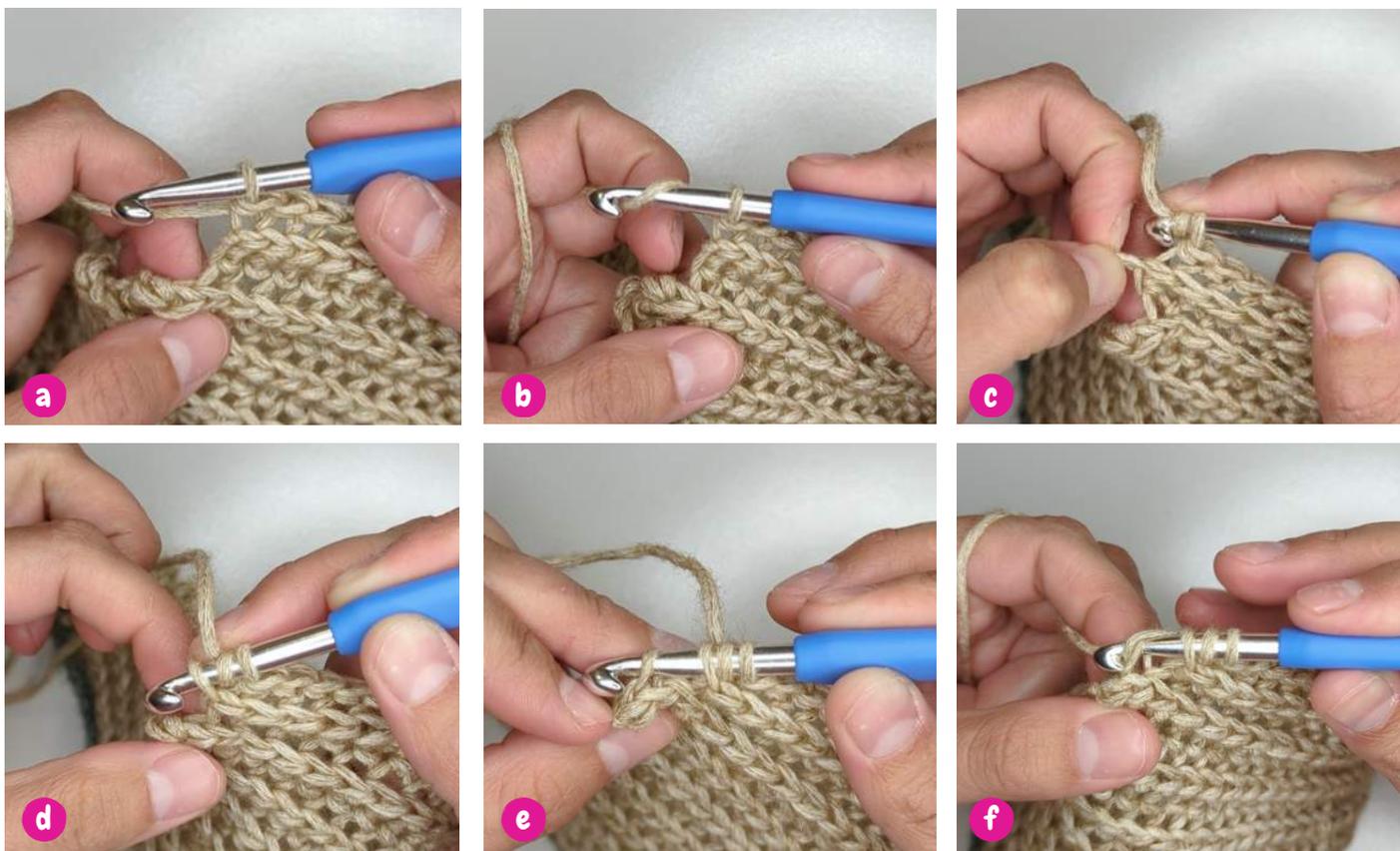


Image 6: This is how you make a HDC SLST 2TOG.

HOW TO CHANGE COLOURS

FROM THE RS OF THE PROJECT

Changing colour from SLST BLO (CC) to HDC SLST BLO (MC) (when going from the bottom ribbing/cuffs to the body of the cardi)

You will change colours on the last ch/st of the bottom ribbing/cuff area. With CC, insert your hook in the last ch/back loop of the cuff/bottom ribbing area. Place MC behind your work (image 7.a below), yarn over and pull up a loop (7.b). This loop now goes through the other loop on your hook (7.c).



Image 7: This is how you change colours and go from SLST to HDC SLST on the RS of your work.

The technique to change colours on the RS will be explained on the video on page 18.

Changing colour from HDC SLST BLO (MC) to SLST BLO (CC) (when going from the body of the cardi to the neckline)

You will change colours on the last ch/st of the body area. With MC, yarn over and insert your hook in the ch/back loop of the last ch/st of the body area (8.a). Place CC behind your work (8.b), yarn over and pull up a loop. This loop now goes through the other 2 (8.c).



Image 8: This is how you change colours and go from HDC SLST to SLST on the RS of your work.

FROM THE WS OF THE PROJECT

Changing colour from SLST BLO (CC) to HDC SLST BLO (MC) (when going from the neckline to the body of the card)

With CC, insert your hook in the back loop of the last st of the of the neckline (as shown on image 9.a below). Move CC from the back of the project, under your hook and to the front of your work (9.b). Now hold your MC, which will already be at the front of your work (9.c), and yarn over (9.d and 9.e) and pull up through the 2 loops (9.f).

How to change colours on the WS will be explained on the video on page 18.

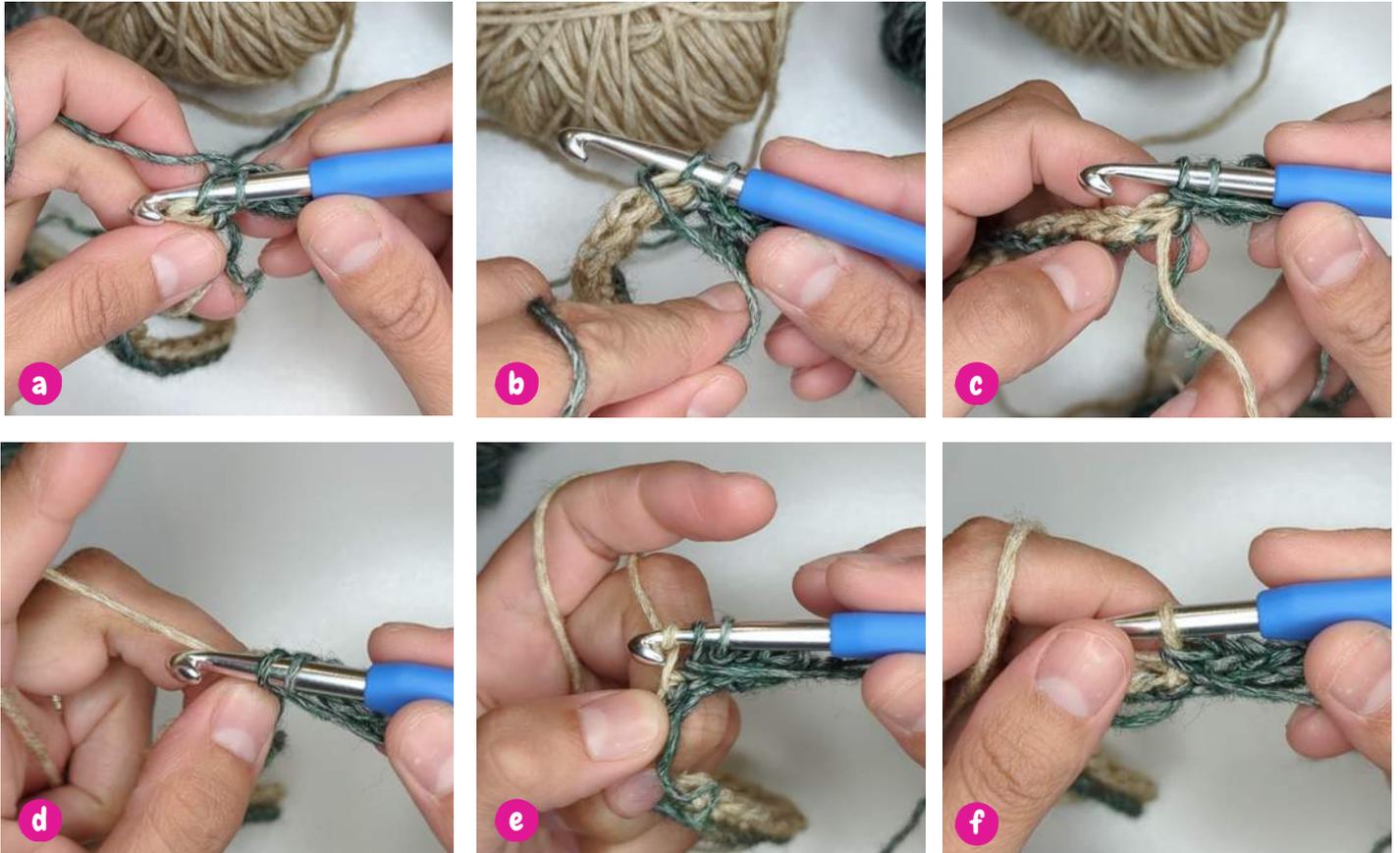


Image 9: This is how you change colours and go from SLST BLO to HDC SLST BLO on the WS of your work.

Changing colour from HDC SLST BLO (MC) to SLST BLO (CC) (when going from the body of the cardi to the bottom ribbing/cuffs)

With MC, yarn over and insert your hook in the back loop of the last st of the body area (as shown on image 10.a). Move MC from the back of the project, under your hook and to the front of your work (10.b). Now hold your CC, which will already be at the front of your work (10.c) and yarn over (10.d) and pull up a loop (10.e). This loop now goes through the other two (10.f).

How to change colours on the WS will be explained on the video on page 18.

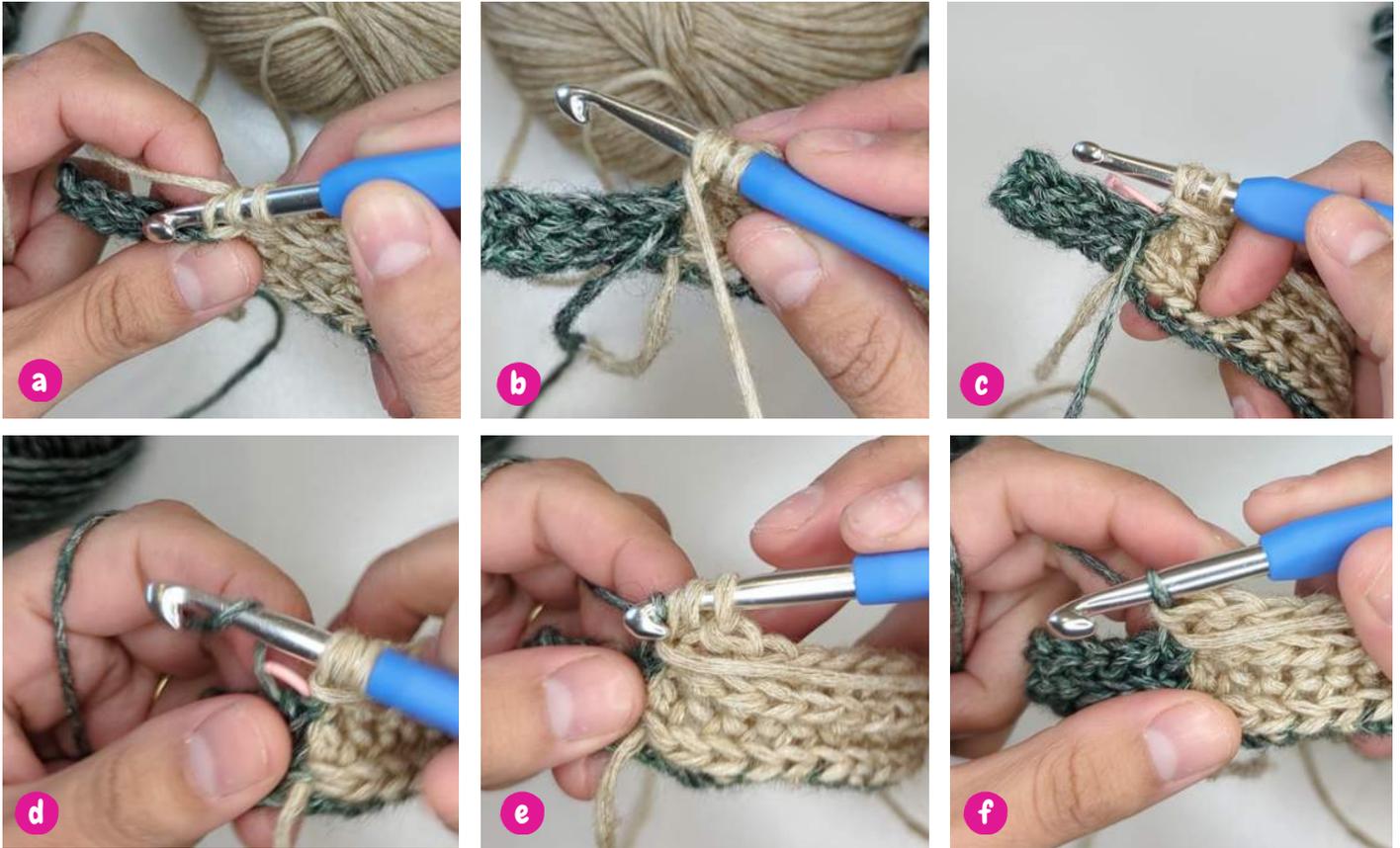
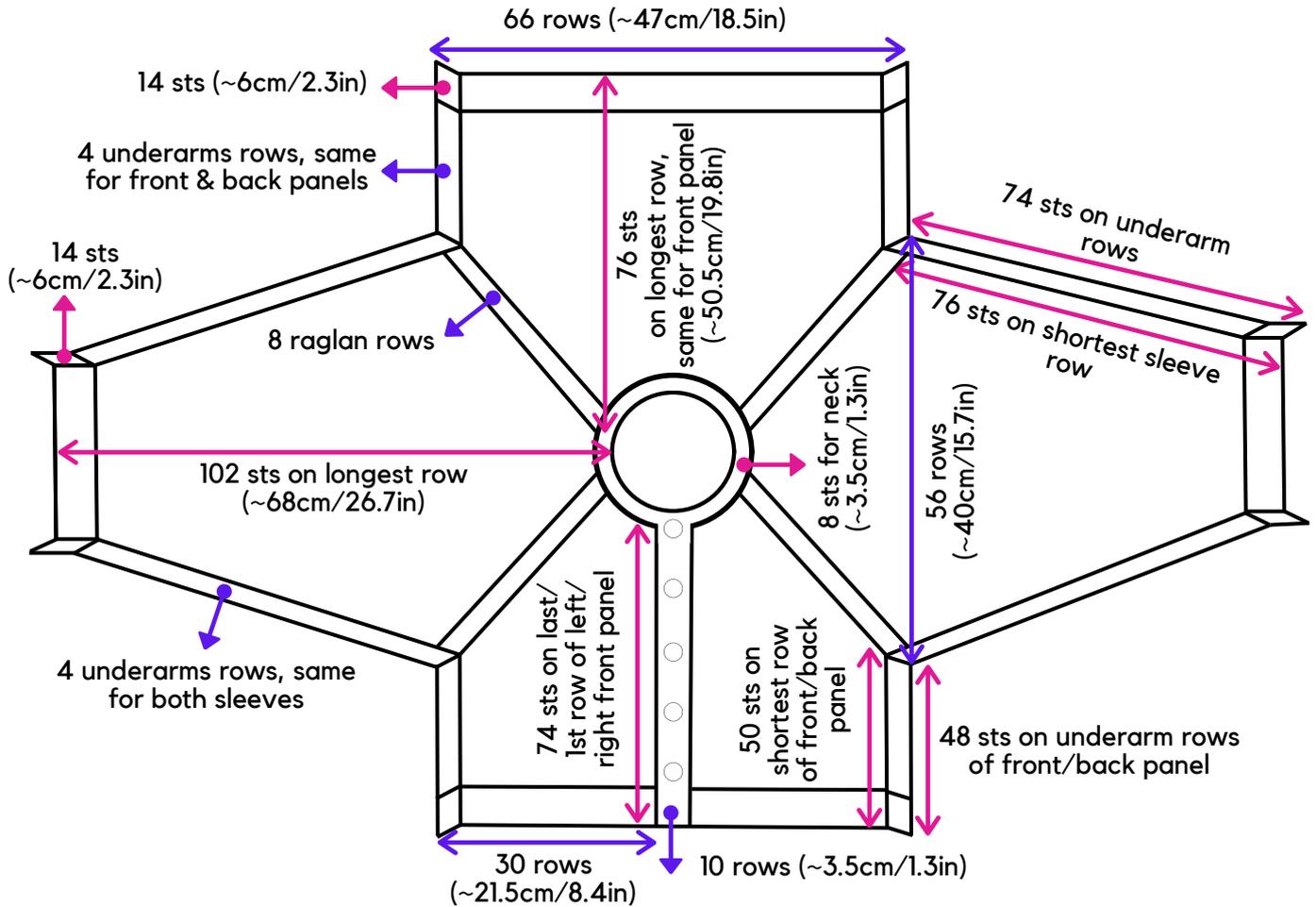


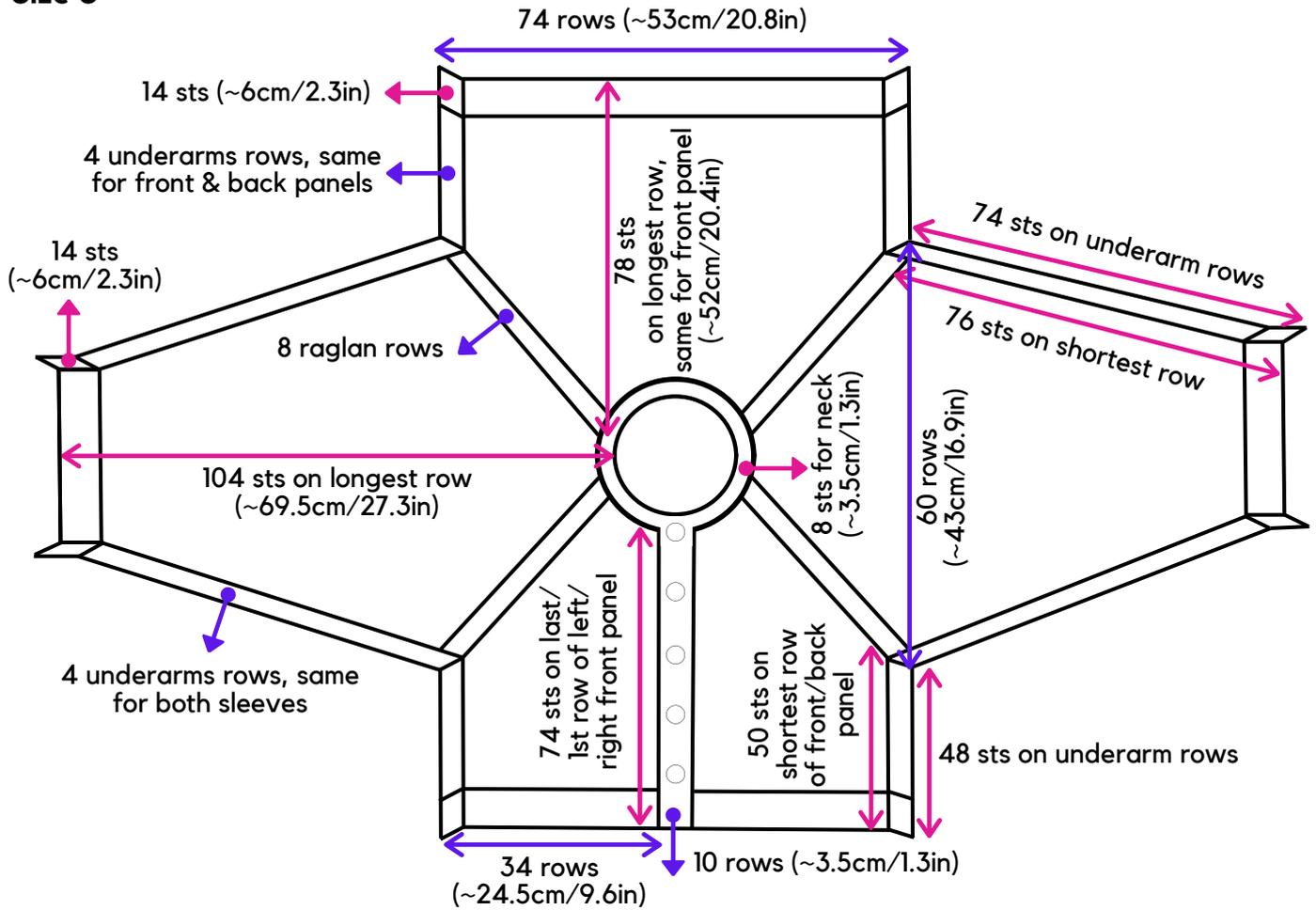
Image 10: This is how you change colours and go from HDC SLST BLO to SLST BLO on the WS of your work.

Let's crochet your gauge!

GAUGE MEASUREMENTS

- 10cm (4 in) in width equals to 14 rows of HDC SLST BLO.
- 10cm (4 in) in height equals to 15 sts of HDC SLST BLO.

With the CC, ch 19.

- Row 1: 18 HDC SLST. Ch 1 and turn.
 - Note: Insert your hook on the back bump of the ch, as show on image 11.
- Row 2: 17 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 3: 18 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 4: 17 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST. Ch 1 and turn.
- Repeat row 3 and 4 until you finish row 17. Fasten off.
- Measure your 10cm square in the centre of your swatch.

Note: I have a surprise for you... This gauge will be reused as one of your cardi's pockets! Leave a long tail when fastening off to sew this pocket onto your cardigan after blocking.

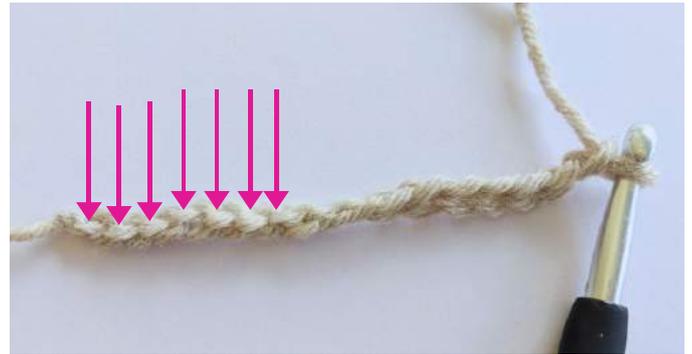


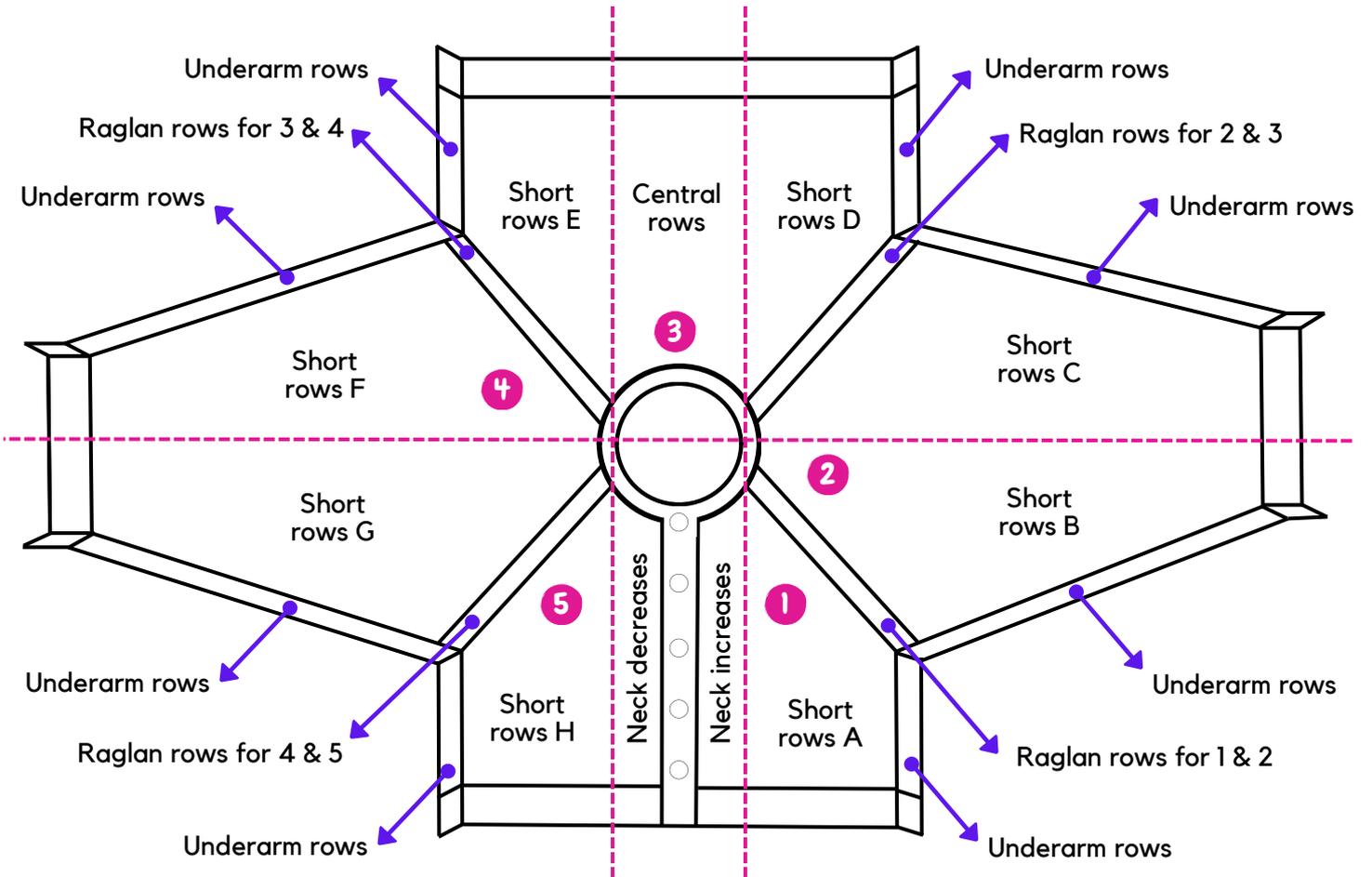
Image 11: These are the back bumps on any given chain. Please note: this is only a sample, NOT the same gauge length.



Let's crochet your card!

The construction of the Doña Cardi has been divided in different sections and will be presented as per below:

To make your card in a different length, see appendix on page 42.



RIGHT FRONT PANEL

Ch 75 [75, 73, 75, 77, 77, 77, 79, 79] with CC. (Always insert your hook in the second ch/st from hook at the beginning of each row).

NECK INCREASES

- Row 1: 14 SLST with CC, then change to MC. HDC SLST until you have 8 sts left on the row, then change to a secondary ball of CC and make 8 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Row 2: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
 - Sizes L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL repeat rows 1 and 2 a total of 1, 2, 2, 3, 4, 6 more time(s) respectively, until you finish row 4, 6, 6, 8, 10, 14. Ch 1 and turn.
 - *Note: When repeating row 1 you will insert your hook in the BLO moving forward, except in the last st of the row, which will be a SLST (hook goes through both loops).*

Place a stitch marker on the front loop of st no. 14 (the last SLST of the bottom ribbing area) on row 3 [3, 3, 5, 7, 7, 9, 11, 15] and on all odd rows moving forward. This st tends to disappear when you change colours on even rows, so this will help you to see it.

- Row 3 [3, 3, 5, 7, 7, 9, 11, 15]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make HDC SLST BLO until you have 11 sts left on the row. Continue with 1 HDC SLST BLO INC, 1 HDC SLST BLO AINC, 1 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST BLO INC, 1 HDC SLST BLO AINC. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [76, 74, 76, 78, 78, 78, 80, 80] sts).
- Row 4 [4, 4, 6, 8, 8, 10, 12, 16]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn. (76 [76, 74, 76, 78, 78, 78, 80, 80] sts).
 - Size XS skip to the "Short Rows A" section. All other sizes continue below.
- Row X [5, 5, 7, 9, 9, 11, 13, 17]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make HDC SLST BLO until you have 11 sts left on the row. Continue with 1 HDC SLST BLO INC, 1 HDC SLST BLO AINC, 1 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST BLO INC, 1 HDC SLST BLO AINC. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [78, 76, 78, 80, 80, 80, 82, 82] sts).
- Row X [6, 6, 8, 10, 10, 12, 14, 18]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [78, 76, 78, 80, 80, 80, 82, 82] sts).
 - Size S skip to "Short rows A" section. All other sizes continue below.

- Row X [X, 7, 9, 11, 11, 13, 15, 19]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make HDC SLST BLO until you have 11 sts left on the row. Continue with 1 HDC SLST BLO INC, 1 HDC SLST BLO AINC, 1 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST BLO INC, 1 HDC SLST BLO AINC. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [X, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row X [X, 8, 10, 12, 12, 14, 16, 20]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [X, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

SHORT ROWS A

- Row 5 [7, 9, 11, 13, 13, 15, 17, 21]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 10 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (66 [68, 68, 70, 72, 72, 72, 74, 74] sts).
- Row 6 [8, 10, 12, 14, 14, 16, 18, 22]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST (66 [68, 68, 70, 72, 72, 72, 74, 74] sts).



- Row 7 [9, 11, 13, 15, 15, 17, 19, 23]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 2 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (64 [66, 66, 68, 70, 70, 70, 72, 72] sts).
- Row 8 [10, 12, 14, 16, 16, 18, 20, 24]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (64 [66, 66, 68, 70, 70, 70, 72, 72] sts).

Sequence for the short rows

- On odd rows, continue crocheting 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 2 sts left on the row. Then ch 1 and turn. On even rows, HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. The last row of this sequence will be row 22 [26, 30, 34, 38, 40, 44, 48, 52]. You should have 50 [50, 48, 48, 48, 46, 44, 44, 44] sts. Ch 1 and turn.

RAGLAN ROWS

- Row 23 [27, 31, 35, 39, 41, 45, 49, 53]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. *1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Repeat from * 7 [8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 14] more times. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 24 [28, 32, 36, 40, 42, 46, 50, 54]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 25 [29, 33, 37, 41, 43, 47, 51, 55]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 26 [30, 34, 38, 42, 44, 48, 52, 56]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

UNDERARM ROWS

- Row 27 [31, 35, 39, 43, 45, 49, 53, 57]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make 34 [34, 32, 32, 32, 30, 28, 28, 28] HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Row 28 [32, 36, 40, 44, 46, 50, 54, 58]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Repeat rows 27 [31, 35, 39, 43, 45, 49, 53, 57] and 28 [32, 36, 40, 44, 46, 50, 54, 58] one more time, until you finish rows 30 [34, 38, 42, 46, 48, 52, 56, 60]. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 31 [35, 39, 43, 47, 49, 53, 57, 61]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then cut CC and leave a tail to hide it later. Change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Cut your yarn after the last st*. Do not ch 1 and turn, but continue on the "Right Sleeve" section on the next page. From the next row forward you will start crocheting the right sleeve and the row count will start from 1 again.
 - ***Note:** If you are using one colour for the whole cardi, then you don't need to cut your yarn after the last st of this row.

RIGHT SLEEVE

After finishing row 31 [35, 39, 43, 47, 49, 53, 57, 61] on the right front panel, change to CC and ch 75 [75, 73, 73, 71, 71, 69, 69, 69]. (Always insert your hook in the second ch/st from hook at the beginning of each row).

UNDERARM SECTION

- Row 1: 14 SLST with CC, then change to MC and make 60 [60, 58, 58, 56, 56, 54, 54, 54] HDC SLST.
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch-1 loop from row 30 [34, 38, 42, 46, 48, 52, 56, 60] of the right front panel as per shown on image 12.a. You will have 2 loops on your hook (12.b). Now yarn over and pull through both loops (12.c). This will count as your ch 1. Turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
- Row 2: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).

Image 12: This is how you connect two armholes rows from different sections together.

- Row 3: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch-1 loop from row 28 [32, 36, 40, 44, 46, 50, 54, 58] of the right front panel. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn.
- Row 4: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).

RAGLAN ROWS

Note: From row 6 onwards, you will start making some short rows in the cuff area as well, to create the balloon effect for the sleeves. From this point forward, you will count your rows on the sleeves only (never on the cuffs).

actually just a slip stitch into row 26[34]

- Row 5: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue by making a HDC SLST BLO in the next available st of row 26 [30, 34, 38, 42, 44, 48, 52, 56] of the right front panel, as show on image 13. HDC SLST BLO across until you have 8 sts left. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (102 [104, 104, 106, 106, 108, 108, 110, 110] sts).
- Row 6: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (88 [90, 90, 92, 92, 94, 94, 96, 96] sts).

Place a stitch marker on the front loop of st no. 14 (the last SLST of the cuff area) on row 5. Row 6 and 7 won't have cuff sts and the 1st st back on the cuffs will be on row 8. If you don't place a st marker this st will be very hard to find.



Image 13: To create the first row of your raglan rows (on row 5 of the right sleeve), you must go from crocheting over row 4 of the underarm section, to row 26 [30, 34, 38, 42, 44, 48, 52, 56] of the right front panel.

- **Row 7:** HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (88 [90, 90, 92, 92, 94, 94, 96, 96] sts).
- **Row 8:** 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (102 [104, 104, 106, 106, 108, 108, 110, 110] sts).

Image 14: To create a cuff row after short rows, you basically ignore the previous short rows and change colour from MC to CC on the last st of the body area (this will always happen on even rows, on the WS of your project). Make sure to tighten both your MC and CC after making this st, as they will be loose due to the previous short rows. From there you just continue working on your cuff as normal. The first st of your cuff will have a st marker on the back loop. This is the marker that you placed on row 5 and it will help you see where you must insert your hook to make the st (this tends to disappear when changing colours).

SHORT ROWS B

- Row 9: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make 62 [62, 60, 60, 58, 58, 56, 56, 56] HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (76 [76, 74, 74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 70]).
- Row 10: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (62 [62, 60, 60, 58, 58, 56, 56, 56] sts).
- **Row 11:** HDC SLST BLO with MC until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (64 [64, 62, 62, 60, 60, 58, 58, 58] sts).
- Row 12: HDC SLST BLO with MC until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (78 [78, 76, 76, 74, 74, 72, 72, 72] sts).
- Row 13: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (80 [80, 78, 78, 76, 76, 74, 74, 74] sts).
- Row 14: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (66 [66, 64, 64, 62, 62, 60, 60, 60] sts).
- Row 15: HDC SLST BLO with MC until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (68 [68, 66, 66, 64, 64, 62, 62, 62] sts).

Sequence for the end of each short row (when they are joined to the raglan rows)

- Continue adding 1 HDC SLST 2TOG and 1 HDC SLST BLO with MC at the end of all odd rows. On even rows HDC SLST BLO with MC across until there are 14 sts left, then you will either make or skip the cuff rows (for the cuff sequence, see next bullet points below). The last row of this sequence will be row 26 [28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 40]. You should have 78 [94, 80, 96, 82, 98, 84, 100, 100] sts and no cuffs [cuffs, no cuffs, cuffs, no cuffs, cuffs, no cuffs, cuffs, cuffs].

Sequence for the cuffs

- Continue crocheting 2 rows that include the 14 cuff sts, followed by 2 rows that exclude the cuff sts. The rows where you will skip the cuff sts are detailed below.
 - XS: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26.
 - S: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27.
 - M: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30.
 - L: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30 & 31.
 - XL: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30 & 31, 34.
 - 2XL: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30 & 31, 34 & 35.
 - 3XL: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30 & 31, 34 & 35, 38.
 - 4XL: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30 & 31, 34 & 35, 38 & 39.
 - 5XL: 18 & 19, 22 & 23, 26 & 27, 30 & 31, 34 & 35, 38 & 39.
- Row 27 [29, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 41]:
 - - [S, -, L, -, 2XL, -, 4XL, 5XL]: 14 SLST BLO with CC.
 - XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until the end of the row, followed by 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (88 [104, 90, 106, 92, 108, 94, 110, 110] sts).
- Row 28 [30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 42]:
 - XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC.
 - - [S, -, L, -, 2XL, -, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Ch 1, turn and continue on section "Short rows C" on the next page.
 - XS [-, M, -, XL, -, 3XL, -, -]: HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (102 [90, 104, 92, 106, 94, 108, 96, 96] sts).

SHORT ROWS C

- Row 29 [31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 43]:
 - XS [-, M, -, XL, -, 3XL, -, -]: 14 SLST BLO with CC.
 - XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (102 [90, 104, 92, 106, 94, 108, 96, 96] sts).
- Row 30 [32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 44]:
 - XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC.
 - XS [-, M, -, XL, -, 3XL, -, -]: HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Ch 1, turn and continue on the row below.
 - - [S, -, L, -, 2XL, -, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (88 [104, 90, 106, 92, 108, 94, 110, 110] sts).
- Row 31 [33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45, 45]:
 - - [S, -, L, -, 2XL, -, 4XL, 5XL]: 14 SLST BLO with CC.
 - XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 10 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (78 [94, 80, 96, 82, 98, 84, 100, 100] sts).
- Row 32 [34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 46]:
 - - [S, -, L, -, 2XL, -, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Ch 1 and turn.
 - XS [-, M, -, XL, -, 3XL, -, -]: HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (92 [80, 94, 82, 96, 84, 98, 86, 86] sts).
- Row 33 [35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45, 47, 47]:
 - XS [-, M, -, XL, -, 3XL, -, -]: 14 SLST BLO with CC.
 - XS [S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 2 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (90 [78, 92, 80, 94, 82, 96, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 34 [36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 48]:
 - XS [-, M, -, XL, -, 3XL, -, -]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn.
 - - [S, -, L, -, 2XL, -, 4XL, 5XL]: HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (76 [92, 78, 94, 80, 96, 82, 98, 98] sts).

Sequence for the end of each short row

- On odd rows, continue to HDC SLST BLO with MC across, until there are 2 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn. On even rows, HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. You will then either ch 1 and turn or change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST (for the cuff sequence, see next bullet points below). The last row of this sequence will be row number 46 [50, 54, 58, 62, 66, 70, 74, 74]. You should have 64 [64, 62, 62, 60, 60, 58, 58, 58] sts and no cuffs. Ch 1 and turn.

Sequence for the cuffs

- Continue crocheting 2 rows that include the 14 cuff sts, followed by 2 rows that exclude the cuff sts. The rows where you will skip the cuff sts are detailed below.
 - XS: 35, 38 & 39, 42 & 43, 46.
 - S: 38 & 39, 42 & 43, 46 & 47, 50.
 - M: 39, 42 & 43, 46 & 47, 50 & 51, 54.
 - L: 42 & 43, 46 & 47, 50 & 51, 54 & 55, 58.
 - XL: 43, 46 & 47, 50 & 51, 54 & 55, 58 & 59, 62.
 - 2XL: 46 & 47, 50 & 51, 54 & 55, 58 & 59, 62 & 63, 66.
 - 3XL: 47, 50 & 51, 54 & 55, 58 & 59, 62 & 63, 66 & 67, 70.
 - 4XL: 50 & 51, 54 & 55, 58 & 59, 62 & 63, 66 & 67, 70 & 71, 74.
 - 5XL: 50 & 51, 54 & 55, 58 & 59, 62 & 63, 66 & 67, 70 & 71, 74.
- Row 47 [51, 55, 59, 63, 67, 71, 75, 75]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 2 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (62 [62, 60, 60, 58, 58, 56, 56, 56] sts).
- Row 48 [52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 76]: HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (76 [76, 74, 74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 70] sts).



RAGLAN ROWS

- Row 49 [53, 57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 77]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. *1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Repeat from * 7 [8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 14] more times. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (102 [104, 104, 106, 106, 108, 108, 110, 110] sts).
- Row 50 [54, 58, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78, 78]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (88 [90, 90, 92, 92, 94, 94, 96, 96] sts).
- Row 51 [55, 59, 63, 67, 71, 75, 79, 79]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and the finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (88 [90, 90, 92, 92, 94, 94, 96, 96] sts).
- Row 52 [56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 80, 80]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (102 [104, 104, 106, 106, 108, 108, 110, 110] sts).

UNDERARM SECTION

- Row 53 [57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 81, 81]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make 60 [60, 58, 58, 56, 56, 54, 54, 54] HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
- Row 54 [58, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78, 82, 82]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
- Repeat rows 53 [57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 81, 81] and 54 [58, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78, 82, 82] one more time, until you finish rows 56 [60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 80, 84, 84]. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 57 [61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 81, 85, 85]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then cut CC and leave a tail to hide later. Change to MC, HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row and cut your yarn after the last st*. Do not ch 1 and turn, but continue on the "Back panel" section on the next page. From the next row forward you will start crocheting the back panel and the row count will start from 1 again.
 - ***Note:** *If you are using one colour for the whole card, then you don't need to cut your yarn after the last st of this row.*

BACK PANEL

After finishing row 57 [61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 81, 85, 85] on the right sleeve, change to CC and ch 49 [49, 47, 47, 47, 45, 43, 43, 43]. (Always insert your hook in the second ch/st from hook at the beginning of each row).

UNDERARM SECTION

- Row 1: 14 SLST with CC, then change to MC and make 34 [34, 32, 32, 32, 30, 28, 28, 28] HDC SLST BLO.
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch-1 loop from row 56 [60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 80, 84, 84] of the right sleeve. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Row 2: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts)
- Row 3: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row.
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch-1 loop from row 54 [58, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78, 82, 82] of the right sleeve. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Row 4: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).

RAGLAN SECTION

- Row 5: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue by making a HDC SLST BLO in the next available st of row 52 [56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 80, 80] of the right sleeve. HDC SLST BLO across until you have 8 sts left. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 6: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 7: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 8: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

SHORT ROWS D

- Row 9: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make 36 [36, 34, 34, 34, 32, 30, 30, 30] HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (50 [50, 48, 48, 48, 46, 44, 44, 44] sts).
- Row 10: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (50 [50, 48, 48, 48, 46, 44, 44, 44] sts).
- Row 11: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (52 [52, 50, 50, 50, 48, 46, 46, 46] sts).
- Row 12: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (52 [52, 50, 50, 50, 48, 46, 46, 46] sts).
- Row 13: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (54 [54, 52, 52, 52, 50, 48, 48, 48] sts).
- Row 14: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (54 [54, 52, 52, 52, 50, 48, 48, 48] sts).

Sequence for the short rows

- On odd rows, continue crocheting 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO across. At the end of the row, make 1 HDC SLST 2TOG and 1 HDC SLST BLO with MC. Ch 1 and turn. On even rows HDC SLST BLO across with MC until there are 14 sts left, then change to CC and make 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. The last row of this sequence will be row 26 [28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 40]. You should have 66 [68, 68, 70, 72, 72, 72, 74, 74] sts.
- Row 27 [29, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 41]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row, followed by 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 28 [30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 42]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

CENTRE ROWS

- Row 29 [31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 43]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 30 [32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 44]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Repeat rows 29 [31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 43] and 30 [32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 44] a total of 4 [6, 7, 9, 11, 12, 14, 15, 19] more times, until you finish row 38 [44, 48, 54, 60, 64, 70, 74, 82]. Ch 1 and turn.

SHORT ROWS E

- Row 39 [45, 49, 55, 61, 65, 71, 75, 83]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 40 [46, 50, 56, 62, 66, 72, 76, 84]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 41 [47, 51, 57, 63, 67, 73, 77, 85]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 10 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (66 [68, 68, 70, 72, 72, 72, 74, 74] sts).
- Row 42 [48, 52, 58, 64, 68, 74, 78, 86]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST (66 [68, 68, 70, 72, 72, 72, 74, 74] sts).
- Row 43 [49, 53, 59, 65, 69, 75, 79, 87] 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 2 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (64 [66, 66, 68, 70, 70, 70, 72, 72] sts).
- Row 44 [50, 54, 60, 66, 70, 76, 80, 88]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (64 [66, 66, 68, 70, 70, 70, 72, 72] sts).

Sequence for the short rows

- On odd rows, continue crocheting 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 2 sts left on the row. Then ch 1 and turn. On even rows, HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 sts left on the row. Then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. The last row of this sequence will be row 58 [66, 72, 80, 88, 94, 102, 108, 116]. You should have 50 [50, 48, 48, 48, 46, 44, 44, 44] sts. Ch 1 and turn.

RAGLAN ROWS

- Row 59 [67, 73, 81, 89, 95, 103, 109, 117]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. *1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Repeat from * 7 [8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 14] more times. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 60 [68, 74, 82, 90, 96, 104, 110, 118]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 61 [69, 75, 83, 91, 97, 105, 111, 119]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 62 [70, 76, 84, 92, 98, 106, 112, 120]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

UNDERARM SECTION

- Row 63 [71, 77, 85, 93, 99, 107, 113, 121]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make 34 [34, 32, 32, 32, 30, 28, 28, 28] HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Row 64 [72, 78, 86, 94, 100, 108, 114, 122]: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Repeat rows 63 [71, 77, 85, 93, 99, 107, 113, 121] and 64 [72, 78, 86, 94, 100, 108, 114, 122] one more time, until you finish rows 66 [74, 80, 88, 96, 102, 110, 116, 124]. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 67 [75, 81, 89, 97, 103, 111, 117, 125]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then cut CC and leave a tail to hide later. Change to MC, HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row and cut your yarn after the last st*. Do not ch 1 and turn, but continue on the "Left Sleeve" section on the next page. From the next row forward you will start crocheting the left sleeve and the row count will start from 1 again.

- ***Note:** If you are using one colour for the whole cardi, then you don't need to cut your yarn after the last st of this row.

LEFT SLEEVE

After finishing row 67 [75, 81, 89, 97, 103, 111, 117, 125] on the back panel, change to CC and ch 75 [75, 73, 73, 71, 71, 69, 69, 69]. (Always insert your hook in the second ch/st from hook at the beginning of each row).

UNDERARM SECTION

- Row 1: 14 SLST with CC, then change to MC and make 60 [60, 58, 58, 56, 56, 54, 54, 54] HDC SLST.
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch 1 loop from row 66 [74, 80, 88, 96, 102, 110, 116, 124] of the back panel. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
- Row 2: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
- Row 3: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch 1 loop from row 64 [72, 78, 86, 94, 100, 108, 114, 122] of the back panel. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).
- Row 4: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts).

RAGLAN ROWS

Note: From row 6 onwards, you will start making some short rows in the cuff area as well, to create the balloon effect for the sleeves. From this point forward, you will count your rows on the sleeves only, never on the cuffs.

- Row 5: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue by making a HDC SLST BLO in the next available st of row 62 [70, 76, 84, 92, 98, 106, 112, 120] of the back panel. HDC SLST BLO across until you have 8 sts left. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (102 [104, 104, 106, 106, 108, 108, 110, 110] sts).
- Row 6: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Ch 1 and turn (88 [90, 90, 92, 92, 94, 94, 96, 96] sts).

- Row 7: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (88 [90, 90, 92, 92, 94, 94, 96, 96] sts).
- Row 8: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the short row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST on the cuffs. Ch 1 and turn (102 [104, 104, 106, 106, 108, 108, 110, 110] sts).

Sequence for the left sleeve

- Repeat the short rows B, short rows C, raglan section and underarm section of the right sleeve, from pages 23 to 27. The last row of the left sleeve will be row 57 [61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 81, 85, 85]. You should have 74 [74, 72, 72, 70, 70, 68, 68, 68] sts. At the end of this row do not ch 1 and turn, but continue on the "Left front panel" section on the next page. From the next row forward you will start crocheting the left front panel and the row count will start from 1 again.



LEFT FRONT PANEL

After finishing row 57 [61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 81, 85, 85] on the left sleeve, change to CC and ch 49 [49, 47, 47, 47, 45, 43, 43, 43]. (Always insert your hook in the second ch/st from hook at the beginning of each row).

UNDERARM SECTION

- Row 1: 14 SLST with CC, then change to MC and make 34 [34, 32, 32, 32, 30, 28, 28, 28] HDC SLST BLO.
 - Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch-1 loop from row 56 [60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 80, 84, 84] of the left sleeve. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Row 2: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts)
- Row 3: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row.
- Before you ch 1, insert your hook on the ch-1 loop from row 54 [58, 62, 66, 70, 74, 78, 82, 82] of the right sleeve. You will have 2 loops on your hook. Now yarn over and pull through both loops. This will count as your ch 1. Turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).
- Row 4: Insert your hook on the second st from hook and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 st left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (48 [48, 46, 46, 46, 44, 42, 42, 42] sts).

RAGLAN SECTION

- Row 5: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Continue by making a HDC SLST BLO in the next available st of row 52 [56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 76, 80, 80] of the left sleeve. HDC SLST BLO across until you have 8 sts left. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 6: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to colour MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 7: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 8: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

SHORT ROWS H

- Row 9: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and make 36 [36, 34, 34, 34, 32, 30, 30, 30] HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (50 [50, 48, 48, 48, 46, 44, 44, 44] sts).
- Row 10: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (50 [50, 48, 48, 48, 46, 44, 44, 44] sts).
- Row 11: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (52 [52, 50, 50, 50, 48, 46, 46, 46] sts).
- Row 12: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (52 [52, 50, 50, 50, 48, 46, 46, 46] sts).
- Row 13: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row. Finish with 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn (54 [54, 52, 52, 52, 50, 48, 48, 48] sts).
- Row 14: HDC SLST BLO with MC until you have 14 st left on the row, then change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (54 [54, 52, 52, 52, 50, 48, 48, 48] sts).

Sequence for the short rows

- On odd rows, continue crocheting 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO across. At the end of the row, make 1 HDC SLST 2TOG and 1 HDC SLST BLO with MC. Ch 1 and turn. On even rows HDC SLST BLO across with MC until there are 14 sts left, then change to CC and make 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. The last row of this sequence will be row 26 [28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 40]. You should have 66 [68, 68, 70, 72, 72, 72, 74, 74] sts.
- Row 27 [29, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 41]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until the end of the row, followed by 1 HDC SLST 2TOG, 1 HDC SLST BLO. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).
- Row 28 [30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 42]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (76 [78, 78, 80, 82, 82, 82, 84, 84] sts).

NECK DECREASES

Check out how to make the neck decreases here:

- Row 29 [31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 43]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 12 sts left, then 2 HDC SLST DEC. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [76, 76, 78, 80, 80, 80, 82, 82] sts).
- Row 30 [32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 44]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [76, 76, 78, 80, 80, 80, 82, 82] sts).
 - Size XS cut your CC after the making the neck and your MC after finishing the body. Skip to "Side ribbing" section. All other sizes continue below.
- Row X [33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45, 45]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 12 sts left, then 2 HDC SLST DEC. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [74, 74, 76, 78, 78, 78, 80, 80] sts).
- Row X [34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 46]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [74, 74, 76, 78, 78, 78, 80, 80] sts).
 - Size S cut your CC after the making the neck and your MC after finishing the body. Skip to "Side ribbing" section. All other sizes continue below.
- Row X [X, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45, 47, 47]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 12 sts left, then 2 HDC SLST DEC. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [X, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Row X [X, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 48]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [X, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
 - Size M cut your CC after the making the neck and your MC after finishing the body. Skip to "Side ribbing" section. All other sizes continue below.
- Row X [X, X, 41, 43, 45, 47, 49, 49]: 14 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 8 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 7 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [X, X, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Row X [X, X, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50, 50]: 8 SLST BLO with CC, then change to MC and HDC SLST BLO until you have 14 sts left on the row. Change to CC and finish with 13 SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (X [X, X, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
 - Size L cut your CC after the making the neck and your MC after finishing the body. Skip to "Side ribbing" section. All other sizes continue below.
- Repeat rows X [X, X, X, 43, 45, 47, 49, 49] and X [X, X, X, 44, 46, 48, 50, 50] a total of X [X, X, X, 1, 1, 2, 3, 5] more time(s), until you finish row X [X, X, X, 46, 48, 52, 56, 60]. Cut your CC after the neck and your MC after finishing the body. Continue on "Side ribbing" section.

SIDE RIBBING

LEFT FRONT PANEL RIBBING

- Row 1: After finishing row 30 [34, 38, 42, 46, 48, 52, 56, 60] of the left front panel, ch 1 and SLST BLO across with CC, until you have 1 st left of the row. Finish with 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Row 2: SLST BLO across, until you have 1 st left of the row. Finish with 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn. (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Repeat rows 1 and 2 one more time, until you finish row 4. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 5: 16 [16, 18, 16, 18, 14, 14, 16, 16] SLST BLO, ch 1, sk 1. *12 [12, 11, 12, 12, 13, 13, 13, 13] SLST BLO, ch 1, sk 1. Repeat from * 3 more times. Finish with 4 [4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4] SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Row 6: 5 [5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5] SLST BLO, 1 SLST under ch-1. *12 [12, 11, 12, 12, 13, 13, 13, 13] SLST BLO, 1 SLST under ch-1. Repeat from * 3 more times. Finish with 15 [15, 17, 15, 17, 13, 13, 15, 15] SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Repeat rows 1 and 2 two more times, until you finish row 10. Fasten off.

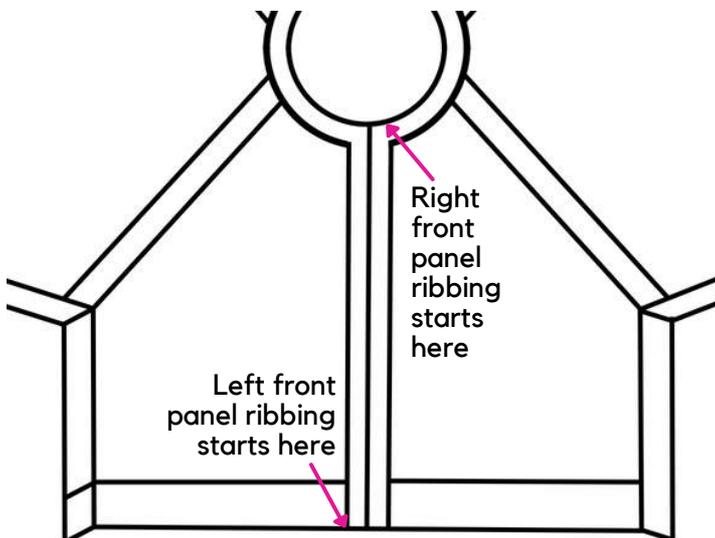


Image 15: The arrows indicate where you have to start your left and right front panel ribbings.

RIGHT FRONT PANEL RIBBING

- Row 1: With the RS of the project looking at you, SLST to join on the first st on the neck edge, then ch 1, and SLST across. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
 - **Note:** Insert your hook under the first foundation row, as close as possible to first row of "V's" from the body, as shown on image 17. If you don't, there will be a noticeable gap between this body ribbing and the neck and bottom ribbing.
- Row 2: SLST BLO across, until you have 1 st left of the row. Finish with 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).



Image 17: When crocheting the right front panel ribbing, insert your hook as close as possible to the first row of "V's".

- Row 3, 4 and 5: SLST BLO across, until you have 1 st left of the row. Finish with 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74, 72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).
- Row 6: 17 [17, 19, 17, 19, 15, 15, 17, 17] SLST BLO. Place a stitch marker on the third loop of the last st, as shown on image 18. *13 [13, 12, 13, 13, 14, 14, 14, 14] SLST BLO, place a stitch marker on the third loop of the last st. Repeat from * 3 more times. Finish with 4 [4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4] SLST BLO, 1 SLST. Ch 1 and turn (74 [74,

72, 74, 76, 76, 76, 78, 78] sts).

- **Note:** All sts with stitch markers are where you will sew a button later.
- Repeat rows 3 & 4 two more times, until you finish row 10. Fasten off.

Your cardi is now ready for you to add the buttons, either now or after you block it.



Image 18: The fuchsia arrow shows where you need to insert your stitch marker to keep track of the spot where you need to sew your buttons later.

POCKETS

You will now crochet your second pocket (the first one was your gauge). To do this, you will simply replicate the pocket you already made on the gauge section.

Using CC, ch 19.

- Row 1: 18 HDC SLST. Ch 1 and turn.
 - **Note:** Insert your hook on the back bump of the ch. This will leave a neater edge which will look better when sewing the pocket onto the cardigan.
- Row 2: 17 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 3: 18 HDC SLST BLO. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 4: 17 HDC SLST BLO, 1 HDC SLST. Ch 1 and turn.
- Repeat row 3 and 4 until you finish row 17. Fasten off, leaving a long tail to join this pocket onto your cardigan after blocking.



BLOCKING

If you are planning to block your Doña Cardi, now is the best time. Your project is almost done but the sides and sleeves haven't been joined lengthwise yet, which means that you can block your cardi flat, as per image below. If you are not familiar with blocking, I leave you some basic info below.

What is blocking?

Blocking is the process of wetting or steaming your final piece to set the finished size. Blocking can enhance the drape of your garment and minor sizing adjustments may be made during this process.

How to block?

There are three main methods of blocking: wet blocking, steam blocking, and spray blocking.

I chose to wet block my cardi. I immersed it in room temperature water for 20 mins. I then gently squeezed out the water (being careful not to wring or twist it). I rolled it in a bath towel to blot out the excess water and then laid it on a surface until it was completely dry. Blocking mats or kids interlocking mats are perfect for this last step.

When you lay your cardi to dry make sure you mould it to your desired finished measurements. You can also insert blocking wires or pins along the edges to keep them straight.

There are several ways and methods to block depending on the yarn you are using and your own preference. If you're not familiar with this process and want to give it a go, I suggest you do a quick online search to decide what's best for you and your piece.



Image 19: A Doña Cardi on the blocking mat. Pockets are not pictured here but should be blocked together, just place them in any free space on your mat.

SEWING THE POCKETS & JOINING THE SIDES AND SLEEVES LENGTHWISE

JOINING THE SIDES & SLEEVES LENGTHWISE

Check how to join the sides and sleeves of your cardi:

With tapestry needle:
until min 5:53

With crochet hook:
From min 5:54
onwards

You can choose to join your front and back panels together and also the sides of your sleeves by either crocheting a row of SLST on the WS of the work or sewing all panels with a tapestry needle on the RS of your project. I prefer the latter, as I believe it leaves a better finish, but I will show you both options in the video here.

Regardless of what technique you go with, I recommend that you start from the bottom up, and join the front to the back panel of the cardi first. Once you reach the bottom of the armhole, keep going and continue sewing the edges of your sleeve lengthwise. For the detailed technique please watch the video tutorial in this section.

SEWING THE POCKETS

To sew these pockets onto your cardi, turn them around, leaving the WS up facing you and the ends where you made 1 HDC SLST on both loops of the st, facing up, as per shown on image 20.



Image 20: To sew the pockets onto your cardi, place them on the WS, with the bottom edge of the even rows towards the top (as shown by the fuchsia arrow).

Now you can start sewing them to the cardi. I recommend that you use the mattress stitch technique to join. For a detailed explanation, please watch the video tutorial here.

You can choose how close to your edges you want your pockets to be. I left 4 sts between the bottom of my pockets and the beginning of the bottom ribbing and 6 rows between the side ribbing and my pocket's closest edge.

Appendix

HOW TO CHANGE YOUR CARDI'S LENGTH

If you want to customise the length of your cardi, you will need to add sts (if you are making a longer cardigan) or subtract sts (if you are making a shorter cardigan) to all rows.

Based on the gauge of this project, 15 sts equal to 10cm/4 in. This means that 1 cm equals to 1.5 sts and 1 in equals to 3.8 sts. With this information you can calculate exactly how many more/less sts you need to make to achieve your desired length.

LONGER CARDI

For example, let's say you want your cardi to be 70cm/27.5 in in length and you are making a size M. You know that the length for this size in the pattern is 52cm/20.4 in, which means that you need your cardigan to be 18cm/7.1 in longer.

To make this happen, you simply need to multiply the extra length you want by the value of 1 cm/in turned into sts, as shown below:

In cm: $18 \times 1.5 = 27$ sts

In in: $7.1 \times 3.8 = 26.98$ sts (which rounded up to the closest number, is 27 sts)

The above means that you need to add 27 sts to all your rows.

SHORTER CARDI

Let's say you want to make a cropped cardi with a length of 40cm/15.7 in and you are making a size M. You know that the length for this size in the pattern is 52cm/20.4 in, which means that you need your cardigan to be 12cm/4.7 in shorter.

To make this happen, you simply need to multiply the length you want to remove by the value of 1 cm/in turned into sts, as shown below:

In cm: $12 \times 1.5 = 18$ sts

In in: $4.7 \times 3.8 = 17.86$ sts (which rounded up to the closest number, is 18 sts)

The above means that you need to subtract 18 sts to all your rows.

INSPIRATION

The Doña Cardi had a total of 30 testers who created beautiful pieces and provided crucial feedback to make this pattern the best version it could be. If you are looking for some inspiration, you can see here some of their versions as well as the yarn they used to make this cardi.
