## SIZE

1 (2)

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 20 (22) cm / 8 (8.75) inches

Length: 26 (26) cm / 10.25 (10.25) inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The Dorthea Mittens are worked in the round from the bottom up. You start with a ribbed cuff, then continue in stranded colorwork following chart. A piece of scrap yarn is knitted in for the thumb placement. Finally, the scrap yarn is removed, and the thumb is worked in the round.

## MATERIALS

### Version 1:

**Natural Wool**, COPENHAGEN Fibers:

Color A: 1 (1) skein, color 24

Color B: 1 (1) skein, color 21

**Brushed Alpaca**, COPENHAGEN Fibers:

Color C: 1 (1) skein, color 11

Color D: 1 (1) skein, color 20

Color E: 1 (1) skein, color 16

### Version 2:

**Natural Wool**, COPENHAGEN Fibers:

Color A: 1 (1) skein, color 19

Color B: 1 (1) skein, color 12

**Brushed Alpaca**, COPENHAGEN Fibers:

Color C: 1 (1) skein, color 15

Color D: 1 (1) skein, color 10

Color E: 1 (1) skein, color 20

Double pointed needles 4.5 mm  
Double pointed needles 3.5 mm  
if using the magic loop method, double pointed  
needles can be omitted.

1 stitch marker  
Scrap of cotton yarn

## YARN QUALITY

 **Natural Wool**, COPENHAGEN Fibers

100% Wool  
50 g = 91 m

 **Brushed Alpaca**, COPENHAGEN Fibers

52% Alpaca, 23% Wool, 25% Polyamide  
50 g = 110 m

## GAUGE

20 sts x 23 r = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4 inches  
In stranded colorwork using needles 4.5 mm

Always use the needle size that gives you the  
correct gauge in both height and width,  
measured after washing and blocking.

## ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on

St(s) = stitch(es)

R = row(s)

K = knit

P = purl

K2tog = knit 2 sts together

Ssk = slip, slip, knit. Slip 2 sts one at a time,  
move them back onto the left-hand needle and  
knit them together through the back loops

BO = bind off

# PATTERN

## TIPS AND INFO

The right and left mitten are worked the same way, except for the thumb, which is placed according to either the red or the yellow marking in the chart.

## RIBBED CUFF

Cast on 40 (44) sts with color B using the long-tail cast-on and double-pointed needles 3.5 mm. Join to a ring, place a marker at the beginning of the round, and work in rib stitch [k1, p1]. Continue until the ribbing measures 6 (7) cm / 2.5 (2.75) in *or desired length*.

## MITTEN

Change to double-pointed needles 4.5 mm. Work in the round following the chart for your size until you have completed round 15 (16).

You will now knit in a piece of waste yarn across the marked sts for the thumb on the right and left mitten as follows: Slip sts from the right to the left needle until you reach the marked sts in the chart, without knitting them. Knit the 5 (6) marked sts with the waste yarn. Slip the sts back onto the left needle, without knitting them, until you are again at the beginning of the round.

Continue knitting in the round following the chart until all rounds are completed.

Finish by sewing the top of the mitten closed with Kitchener stitch.

## Thumb

Carefully remove the waste yarn and place the 10 (12) sts onto double-pointed needles 4.5 mm. Let the round begin in one side and work in stockinette stitch with color B, picking up 2 extra sts — 1 on each side between the upper and lower sts = 12 (14) sts.

Work until the thumb measures 5 (6) cm / 2 (2.5) inches *or the desired length*. Try on the mitten to check if the length fits your thumb. Continue in stockinette stitch and decrease as follows:

Round 1: ssk, 2 (3) k, k2tog, repeat from \* to \* once more = 8 (10) sts.


Round 2: ssk, 0 (1) k, k2tog, repeat from \* to \* once more = 4 (6) sts.

Break the yarn and thread it through the remaining 4 (6) sts twice.

## FINISHING

Weave in all loose ends. Wash the mittens according to the yarn label and block in finished measurements.


Chart Size 1
