Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
kfb = Knit into front and back of next stitch.
p = purl
p2tog= purl two (2) stitches together
sl2k = slip a stitch knit-wise
st(s) = stitch (es)
RN= right needle
LN= left needle
RS = right side
WS = wrong side



Yarn:

A – Malabrigo Sock 204 - (400m/100r) - 200g

B - Malabrigo Mechita 866 - (385m/100r) - 200g

Size: wide - 32cm. / long - 200cm. (the size can be varied easily lengthwise).

Needles: 2,5mm

Gauge: 25sts and 32 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Double Jacquard.

Double Jacquard is a technique that produces two color designs with no floats on the back. It is a process of knitting a fabric that has the two sides stocking knit. One side is predominantly color A, the other side is predominantly color B.

The basic method of 2 color double knitting.

Yarn A - CO 82sts.

Beginning row: double the 82sts in this way: kfb x 82 times.

= 82 double sts (164) for both sides of the scarf.

Next row: sl2k, [k1, p1] x 80 times, p2tog.

Add **Yarn B**. When working jacquard double knitting, both yarns move together (as one) but only one yarn is used to work a stitch. Hold both yarns in one hand or use special tools for jacquard knitting.




Selvedge sts (purple color on the chart) always: first double st– slip, last double st– purl two yarn together.

For the odd-numbered rows on the Chart :

Every white square of the Chart = Knit first stitch with **Yarn (color) B**, move both yarns to front, (as to purl); purl next stitch with **Yarn (color) A**
move both yarn to back (as to knit).

Every black square of the Chart = Knit first stitch with **Yarn (color) A**, move both yarns to front, (as to purl); purl next stitch with **Yarn (color) B**
move both yarn to back (as to knit).



For the even-numbered rows on the Chart :

Every white square of the Chart = Knit first stitch with **Yarn (color) A**, move both yarns to front, (as to purl); purl next stitch with **Yarn (color) B**
move both yarn to back (as to knit).

Every black square of the Chart = Knit first stitch with **Yarn (color) B**, move both yarns to front, (as to purl); purl next stitch with **Yarn (color) A**
move both yarn to back (as to knit).

Next work the Chart starting from Row 1.

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Rows 241-320 (or more, if you want to have the scarf longer):

For the odd-numbered rows: sl1k(AB), [k1(B), p1(A)] x 80 times, p1 (AB).

For the even-numbered rows: sl1k(AB), [k1(A), p1(B)] x 80 times, p1 (AB).

Center of work – after center, continue mirror-inverted.

For example: Row 321= Row 319, Row 318 = Row 316, ... etcetera.

Binding Off

Using Yarn A only: [k1, p1] x repeat from to end of row. Turn work. K2tog, [k2tog, slip 2st from RN to LN, k2tog] x repeat from to end of row.
