You need to have basic crochet skills to finish the pattern!

If you have any trouble following the pattern, feel free to contact me directly from the shop.

Final size of the toy with the recommended materials and tools ~ 18 cm/7.08”.

Use any materials and tools you like, but the final size of your toy may differ.

Recommended materials and tools:

- Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Lime juice) #392 50g/125m
- Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Sage green) #212 25g/62,5m
- Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Snow white) #106 10g/25m
- Scheepjes Catona 100% mercerized cotton yarn (Tulip) #222 10g/25m
- 2 mm crochet hook (US B)
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- Tapestry needle and scissors
- Black embroidery thread
- Sewing pins

For the 2nd Dragon I used Scheepjes Catona:
(Silver green) #402
(Deep ocean green) #391
(Snow white) #106
(Tulip) #222

Abbreviations:

- st / sts = stitch / stitches
- ch = chain stitch
- sc = single crochet
- slst = slip stitch
- inc = increase (2 single crochets in one stitch)
- dec = invisible decrease (2 stitches together working on front loops only)
- hdc = half double crochet
- 5-dc-bobble = 5 double crochets in one stitch together
- BLO = back loop only
- (...) = repeat between () number of times indicated
- [...] = total number of stitches in the round or row



Skill level: beginner-intermediate

Fine weight yarn.

Number 2 in Standard Yarn Weight System (SPORT, BABY).
I used Sport (5 ply) cotton yarn.

Suggested substitute yarn:

- “Alize Bahar”
- “Alpina Anabel”
- “Ice Yarns Camilla Cotton”
- “Schachenmayr Catania”
- “Phildar Phil Cotton 3”
- “Patons Grace”

- ❖ Toy is crocheted in continuous spirals without joining the rounds, do not turn or slip stitch unless otherwise stated in the pattern!
- ❖ You can use a scrap of contrasting yarn instead of the stitch marker!

Head:

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Lime juice) #392.

Start with foundation chain.

Rnd 1. 15 ch [15]

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: 13 sc, 3 sc into the last chain, (turn the crocheting and on the other side of foundation chain work) 12 sc, 2 sc into the last chain [30]

Crochet in continuous spirals!

Rnd 2. inc, 12 sc, (inc) * 3 times, 12 sc, (inc) * 2 times [36]

Rnd 3. 1 sc, inc, 12 sc, (1 sc, inc) * 3 times, 12 sc, (1 sc, inc) * 2 times [42]

Rnd 4. 2 sc, inc, 12 sc, (2 sc, inc) * 3 times, 12 sc, (2 sc, inc) * 2 times [48]

Rnd 5. 3 sc, inc, 12 sc, (3 sc, inc) * 3 times, 12 sc, (3 sc, inc) * 2 times [54]

Rnd 6. 4 sc, inc, 12 sc, (4 sc, inc) * 3 times, 12 sc, (4 sc, inc) * 2 times [60] *Image 1*

Rnds 7-12. 60 sc [60] – 6 rounds

Rnd 13. 4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec) * 5 times, 4 sc [54]

Rnds 14-15. 54 sc [54] – 2 rounds

Rnd 16. (7 sc, dec) * 6 times [48]

Rnds 17-18. 48 sc [48] – 2 rounds

Rnd 19. 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec) * 5 times, 3 sc [42]

Rnds 20-21. 42 sc [42] – 2 rounds

Rnd 22. (5 sc, dec) * 6 times [36]

Rnd 23. 36 sc [36] – 1 round

Stuff the detail firmly with filler! Insert small amounts at a time until you get the right shape. Take your time with this step.

Rnd 24. 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) * 5 times, 2 sc [30]

Rnd 25. (3 sc, dec) * 6 times [24]

Rnd 26. 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) * 5 times, 1 sc [18]



Rnd 27. (1 sc, dec) * 6 times [12]

Rnd 28. (1 sc, dec) * 4 times [8]

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops *Image 2* and pull to tighten *Image 3*! Weave in the yarn end.

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.



Antlers (make 2):

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Sage green) #212.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2. 6 sc [6]

Rnd 3. (1 sc, inc) * 3 times [9] *Image 5*

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing



Ears (make 2):

Working in rows. Using Scheepjes Catona (Snow white) #106.

Row 1. ch 6

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: 3 sc, 2 slst into the last chain, 1 ch and turn

Row 2. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: BLO (back loop only) 2 slst, 2 sc, 1 ch and turn

Row 3. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: BLO (back loop only) 2 sc, 2 slst, 1 ch and turn


Row 4. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: BLO (back loop only) 2 slst, 1 sc, 1 ch and turn

Row 5. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: BLO (back loop only) 1 sc, 2 slst

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.

Weave in the smaller tail using the needle *Image 6*.

Thread the long yarn tail through the visible loops at the side *Image 7* and pull to tighten *Image 8*.



Crest:

Working in rows. Using Scheepjes Catona (Sage green) #212.

Row 1. ch 37

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: (1 slst, 2 hdc in the same stitch, 1 slst into the next stitch) * 12 times.

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing *Images 10*.

Muzzle:

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Snow white) #106.

Start with foundation chain.


Rnd 1. ch 5

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: 3 sc, 3 sc into the last chain, (turn the crocheting and on the other side of foundation chain work) 2 sc, 2 sc into the last chain [10]

Rnd 2. inc, 2 sc, (inc) * 3 times, 2 sc, (inc) * 2 times [16]

Rnds 3-4. 16 sc in each stitch around [16] – 2 rounds

slst into the next stitch. Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing *Image 11*.

Wings (make 2):

Working in rows. Using Scheepjes Catona (Sage green) #212.

Row 1. ch 12

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: 8 sc, 3 slst into the last chain, 1 ch and turn

Row 2. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: **BLO (back loop only)** 3 slst, 6 sc, 1 ch and turn


Row 3. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: **BLO (back loop only)** 6 sc, 3 slst, 1 ch and turn

Row 4. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: **BLO (back loop only)** 3 slst, 4 sc, 1 ch and turn

Row 5. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: **BLO (back loop only)** 4 sc, 3 slst, 1 ch and turn

Row 6. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: **BLO (back loop only)** 3 slst, 2 sc, 1 ch and turn

Row 7. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: **BLO (back loop only)** 2 sc, 3 slst

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing *Image 12*.

Weave in the smaller tail using the needle.

Thread the long yarn tail through the visible loops at the side *Image 13* and pull to tighten *Image 14*.

Body:

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Lime juice) #392.

Start with foundation chain.

Rnd 1. 12 ch

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: 10 sc, 3 sc into the last chain, (turn the crocheting and on the other side of foundation chain work) 9 sc, 2 sc into the last chain [24]

Crochet in continuous spirals!

Rnd 2. inc, 9 sc, (inc) * 3 times, 9 sc, (inc) * 2 times [30]

Rnd 3. 1 sc, inc, 9 sc, (1 sc, inc) * 3 times, 9 sc, (1 sc, inc) * 2 times [36]

Rnd 4. 2 sc, inc, 9 sc, (2 sc, inc) * 3 times, 9 sc, (2 sc, inc) * 2 times [42]

Rnd 5. 3 sc, inc, 9 sc, (3 sc, inc) * 3 times, 9 sc, (3 sc, inc) * 2 times [48]

Rnd 6. 4 sc, inc, 9 sc, (4 sc, inc) * 3 times, 9 sc, (4 sc, inc) * 2 times [54] *Image 15*

Rnds 7-15. 54 sc [54] – 9 rounds

Rnd 16. (7 sc, dec) * 6 times [48]

Rnd 17. 48 sc [48] – 1 round

Rnd 18. 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec) * 5 times, 3 sc [42]


Rnd 19. 42 sc [42] – 1 round

Rnd 20. (5 sc, dec) * 6 times [36]

Rnds 21-22. 36 sc [36] – 2 rounds

Rnd 23. 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec) * 5 times, 2 sc [30]

Rnds 24-25. 30 sc [30] – 2 rounds



Rnd 26. (5 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec) * 2 times [26]

Stuff the detail firmly with filler! Insert small amounts at a time until you get the right shape.

Take your time with this step *Image 17*.

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.

Legs (make 2):

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Lime juice) #392.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in Magic ring [6]

Rnd 2. (inc) * 6 times [12]

Rnd 3. (1 sc, inc) * 6 times [18]

Rnd 4. BLO (back loop only): 6 sc, 5-dc-bobble, 2 sc, 5-dc-bobble, 2 sc, 5-dc-bobble, 5 sc [18]

Rnds 5-6. 18 sc [18] – 2 rounds

Rnd 7. (4 sc, dec) * 3 times [15]

Rnds 8-9. 15 sc [15] – 2 rounds

Rnd 10. (3 sc, dec) * 3 times [12]

Rnds 11-12. 12 sc [12] – 2 rounds

Rnd 13. (2 sc, dec) * 3 times [9]

Fill the leg with fiberfill. At the bottom fill it tightly, the top remains unfilled

Rnds 14-15. 9 sc [9] – 2 rounds


Rnd 16. (1 sc, dec) * 3 times [6]

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops *Image 27* and pull to tighten *Image 28*! Weave in the yarn end.




5-dc-bobble

Yarn over, insert the hook into the next stitch.



5-dc-bobble

Yarn over again and pull the yarn through the stitch. Now you have 3 loops on the hook. 20



5-dc-bobble

Yarn over again and pull the yarn through the first two loops on the hook. Now you have one half-closed double crochet stitch and 2 loops remaining on the hook.



5-dc-bobble

In the same stitch, repeat the previous steps four times. Now you have 5 half-closed double crochet stitches into one stitch. 22



5-dc-bobble

Yarn over and pull the yarn through all 6 loops on the hook at once. You have now completed one 5-dc-bobble stitch 23

Arms (make 2):

Working in rounds. Using Scheepjes Catona (Lime juice) #392.

Rnd 1. 7 sc in Magic ring [7]

Rnd 2. (inc) * 7 times [14]

Rnd 3. BLO (back loop only): 5 sc, 5-dc-bobble, 1 sc, 5-dc-bobble, 1 sc, 5-dc-bobble, 4 sc [14]

Rnds 4-6. 14 sc [14] – 3 rounds

Rnd 7. (5 sc, dec) * 2 times [12]

Rnds 8-9. 12 sc [12] – 2 rounds

Rnd 10. (4 sc, dec) * 2 times [10]

Rnds 11-12. 10 sc [10] – 2 rounds

Rnd 13. (3 sc, dec) * 2 times [8]

Rnds 14-19. 8 sc [8] – 6 rounds

Fill the arm with fiberfill. At the bottom fill it tightly, the top remains unfilled *Image 29*.

Using a needle or crochet hook thread the yarn tail through the front loops and pull to tighten! Weave in the yarn end.

Belly:

Working in rows. Using Scheepjes Catona (Sage green) #212.

Row 1. ch 6

Start in the 2nd chain from the hook: 5 sc, 1 ch and turn [5]

Row 2. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 ch and turn [7]

Row 3. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 ch and turn [9]

Row 4. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 ch and turn [11]

Rows 5-8. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: 11 sc, 1 ch and turn [11] – 4 rows

Row 9. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 ch and turn [9]

Row 10. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: dec, 5 sc, dec, 1 ch and turn [7]

Row 11. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 ch and turn [5]

Row 12. in the 2nd stitch from the hook: 5 sc

Do NOT cut the yarn! Crochet the belly around with sc (*work just on 3 sides, follow the red arrow as shown on Image 31*) *Image 31, 32*

Work slst and fasten off and leave long thread for sewing.



Tail:

Working in rounds. Using 2 mm crochet hook and Scheepjes Catona (Lime juice) #392.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2. 6 sc [6] – 1 round

Rnd 3. 2 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 2 sc [8]



Rnds 4-5. 8 sc [8] – 2 rounds

Rnd 6. 3 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 3 sc [10]

Rnds 7-8. 10 sc [10] – 2 rounds

Rnd 9. 4 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 4 sc [12]

Rnd 10. 12 sc [12] – 1 round

Rnd 11. 5 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 5 sc [14]

Rnd 12. 14 sc [14] – 1 round

Rnd 13. 6 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 6 sc [16]

Rnd 14. 16 sc [16] – 1 round

Rnd 15. 7 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 7 sc [18]

Rnd 16. 8 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 8 sc [20]

Rnd 17. 9 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 9 sc [22]

Rnd 18. 10 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 10 sc [24]

Rnd 19. 11 sc, (inc) * 2 times, 11 sc [26]

Now fold the tail in half the increases are right on the upper side of the tail **Image 34**.

Fasten off and leave long thread for sewing



Assembling:

Sew the muzzle between rounds 7 and 12 (Count up from the head's bottom). Place the muzzle correctly, centering in the middle parallel to the foundation chain. Stuff it slightly. Weave in the yarn end. **Images 35-38**



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Embroider the nostrills using 3 strands of black embroidery thread on Round 2 *Images 39*. Fixate each nostrill with a loop *Image 40*.



Using 3 strands of black embroidery thread embroider the eyes on the Rounds 10 and 11, skip 1 sc from the muzzle as shown on *Image 41*! Weave in the ends.



Using the yarn (Tulip) #222 embroider the cheeks
1 round lower the eyes, 2 stitches wide. Repeat
this stitch 2 times for each cheek *Image 46!*
Weave in the ends.



Sew the ears onto either side of the head between
rounds 14 and 18 (count from the head`s bottom).
Skip 5 sts from the eyes *Image 48.* Place the ears
correctly, turn the longer side of the ear upwards
Image 49. Weave in the yarn ends.



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Sew the antlers on the head`s top between rounds 6 and 10 (count from the head`s top) *Image 53*. Place the antlers correctly, symetrically to the muzzle *Images 53*. Stuff them slightly with filler. Weave in the yarn ends.



Sew the crest in the middle of the head`s top *Images 57, 58*. Use the sewing pins to sew it streight *Image 59*. Weave in the yarn ends.

Using the yarn (Sage green) #212 embroider the spots on the head's top randomly *Images 63, 64!* Repeat this stitch 3 times for each spot *Image 63*. Weave in the ends.


Attach the Dragon head to the body. And sew it around. You can also add some stuffing material in the neck to strengthen it before you finish sewing *Image 71*.

Attach the two details correctly. Foundation chains of head and body should be PARALLEL to each other *Image 67*, fixate details with pins.

Weave in the yarn end.

Useful Tip. Mark 2 stitches onto either side of the neck, they should be parallel to the foundation chain (with the distance 12 sc between markers).

This will help to attach the body to the head correctly!

Useful Tip. Attach the body, the markers should be placed in the stitches of foundation chain.

This will help to sew the details correctly!

Foundation chains of head and body will PARALLEL to each other!!!

Sew the belly to the body (the yarn end for sewing should be at the bottom **Image 73**). Weave in the yarn end **Images 73-77**.

Sew the arms 2 rounds lower the head onto either side of the body using thread joint *Image 78*. Attach the arms correctly, the side with the claws turn to the side *Image 79*. Previously secure them with pins.





Sew the legs between rounds 6 and 7 onto either side of the body using thread joint. Attach the legs correctly, the side with the claws turn to the forth *Image 79*. Previously secure them with pins.



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Sew the tail to the body, centering it in the middle, place it correctly (the tail's tip curves up *Image 82*). Weave in the yarn end.



Using the yarn (Sage green) #212 embroider the spots on the tail's top randomly *Image 87, 88!* Repeat this stitch 3 times for each spot *Image 87*. Weave in the ends.



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Sew the wings to the body (behind). Weave in the yarn end *Images 89, 90*.
