Details & Knitting Chart Symbols

Difficulty Intermediate

Recommended for knitters who have experience in finishing more than one (top-down) garment.

Needles & Notions

4 mm circular needles, tapestry needle, 4/0 crochet hook, stitch marker

Gauge

10 x 10 cm = 22 stitches and 30 rows

(Washing and blocking is recommended before measuring)

Yarn

size L MC : Mominoki Yarn - German Merino Light - Night Blue 450g 1530m

size L CC : ISAGER - ALPACA1 - Hold 4 strand - E0 10g 80m

Knitting Chart Symbols

These knitting chart symbols resemble the knitted shapes. You can knit from the charts by understanding what these symbols represent.

(Work the stitches that include purl symbols purlwise)



Notes

Durumagi Cardigan is inspired by Korean traditional outer robe, "Durumagi".

The design is intended to embody the beauty of Hanbok.

Durumagi Cardigan is worked from the **top down** using short rows and double knitting technique. The cardigan has dropped shoulder armholes and an oversized fit so it is recommended to wear it with 20~30 cm of positive ease.

Also, you could omit stitch pattern and work only with knit stitch, use different colors for Git and Dongjeong and Keutdong, or add some length to the body. Enjoy Korean traditional aesthetic with pleasant variations!

Construction


Follow the numbers from 1 to 10 as they show the sequence of working. Parts with same number are worked at the same time.

From part 1 to part 5 are worked from the top down. Part 6, part 8, part 10, and from part A to part D are worked in double knitting technique.

First, work part 1 and 2. Pick up stitches from each shoulder and work part 3 and part 4 respectively. Then you work part 5.

Work part 6 for Git along the neckline and pick up stitches from each armhole to work sleeves.

For Keutdong (cuffs), work in double knitting technique and make slits. Work Goreum (tie strings) to finish.



Gauge in Stitch Pattern


Overview

Different stitch patterns have different gauges so you need to knit the gauge swatch in the stitch pattern chart below.

Familiarizing yourself with the this patterns used in the pattern in advance helps when working the short rows on the shoulders.


4mm needles are recommended but you could size up or down the needles to get the right gauge. Cast on 26 stitches and work 34 rows following the chart. Measure it except garter border.

10 x 10 cm = 22 sts 30 row




Picking Up Stitches & Italian bind off

Picking Up Stitches Yarn in this direction




First, you need to measure out the length of yarn for picking up stitches. Then add some extra length. This makes your tail yarn. Now put the tail yarn on your left-hand.


Italian bind off



1. Insert tapestry needle through the first stitch 1 purlwise and through the second stitch 2 knitwise. Draw the yarn leaving the stitches on the knitting needle.



2. Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch knitwise and through stitch 3 purlwise. Draw the yarn and drop the stitch 1 off the knitting needle.
(knit stitch - knit stitch)



3. Insert tapestry needle through stitch 2 purlwise and through stitch 4 knitwise. Draw the yarn and drop the stitch 2 off the knitting needle.
(purl stitch - purl stitch)

Stitch Pattern And The Hem

How to work on the pattern on wrong side (even numbered row)



→ wrong side, even numbered row

← right side, odd numbered row

When working flat, keep in mind to work the chart in reverse for even rows on the wrong side.



1. On even numbered row, knit the first stitch of the 4 stitches.



2. Yarn over.



3. Purl 2 stitches together.



4. Knit 1 stitch.

The Hem



Cut yarn 3.5~4 times the width of the hem and thread it onto a tapestry needle. Place the garment with the wrong side facing you and fold the hem. Join all the stitches on the needle one by one to the row of stitches on the lifeline.

See the orange stitches in the left image. This is similar method to kitchener stitch.

Or, finish with standard bind-off then sew the hem with lighter yarn after washing and blocking.

Double Knitting For Git and Dongjeong




In Hanbok, the neckband is called Git. And the characteristic white trim around the neckband is called Dongjeong. A neckband worked in double knitting technique has a smoother line than one knitted flat and sewed. With double knitting technique, you can create two layers of fabric at the same time. The stitches for both sides are placed alternately on one needle. When you're knitting on the right side, from right to left, the stitches with odd numbers are knitted while the stitches with even numbers are slipped. When you're knitting on the wrong side, from left to right of the fabric, the stitches with even numbers are knitted and this time the stitches with odd numbers are slipped. The finished fabric looks like it is knitted in the round. Stitches are picked up along the neckline. Then you cut the yarn and work on the neckband with a new thread of yarn. Colorwork is needed for Dongjeong. To prevent a gap between two colors, don't forget to cross the two working arms when you change the colors on the right side.


Casting on

First, you need to pick up stitches along the neckline. The number of stitches depends on each size. Pick up stitches one by one from the back but from the row edges of both left and right front you skip one row on every five rows. Break yarn and keep the picked up stitches rest on the needle. Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from both ends to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.


Place the garment with right side facing you and cast on 23 stitches with a new strand of yarn.




1. Flip the piece to face the wrong side. Slide picked up stitches aside to make some space on the needle. Now you're going to cast on in tubular cast on method.



2. Grasp the yarn with your thumb and index finger under the working yarn. Put the needle on the yarn and twist it around to make the first stitch.



3. Weave the needle around the yarn as shown in the picture to make a knit stitch.




4. Weave the needle around the yarn as shown in the picture to make a purl stitch



5. Repeat step 3 and 4 to make alternating knit and purl stitches until you have 7 stitches.



6. Twist the tail around the working yarn not to be unraveled.



7. Holding tail yarn together with the needle, flip the piece. Now the point of the needle is on your right.

In the picture, odd numbers are knitted on the right side and even numbers are knitted on the wrong side. The stitch on the far left is knitted together with the stitch picked from the garment.

(7 stitches are made in the image. Repeat until you have 23 stitches.)

Right side



1. Holding the tail yarn carefully not to be unraveled, knit the first stitch.



2. Bring the yarn in front as you purl.



3. Slip 1 stitch to the right hand needle.



4. Repeat step 1 – 3 until you have one cast-on stitch left. Slip the last stitch with yarn in back and knit the stitch picked from the garment.



5. Pick up the slipped stitch with left hand needle and pass it over the stitch you just knitted.


Wrong side



1. Turn the piece inside out to work on wrong side. Slip the first stitch and knit only even numbered stitches.



2. Slip the last stitch to right hand needle. Now you have knit stitches on both sides. This is counted as one row.



Work on double knitting to row 35 and start working on Dongjeong from row 36.

Colorwork for Dongjeong

Work on double knitting for the right side of row 36 and 16 stitches on the wrong side.

Leave the yarn on rest and work 7 stitches with a new strand of (white) yarn for Dongjeong.

On the right side of row 37, work 7 stitches. Then twist the two working yarns (one for Dongjeong, one for Git) and work 16 stitches. (See the images below.)



1. On the right side of row 37, work 7 stitches with white yarn then cross two working yarns placing white yarn over blue yarn. (White yarn is for Dongjeong)

2. Pull the blue yarn for Git to the front.

3. Move one stitch on the left hand needle to the right hand needle and knit one stitch. Keep on double knitting with 15 stitches on the right side then 16 stitches on the wrong side too.



4. On the wrong side, work on colorwork for 7 stitches of Dongjeong without twisting the yarns.

5. You have 16 stitches for Git and 7 stitches for Dongjeong. Twist the yarns only on the right side not to separate the two parts. Keep on to the marker, which is the 36th stitch from the end of picked up stitches on the body.

On the next row, work Dongjeong only on the right side then cut the white yarn.

From the wrong side of the same row work on double knitting without colorwork.

Keep working on Git to the end of picked up stitches.

The Goreum



Goreum are a pair of tie strings attached to the breast part to fasten the front of Durumagi. The Cardigan has two pairs of Goreum, outer and inner Goreum.

Originally outer Goreum consist of longer one on the outer wrap (left front) and shorter one in the middle of right front. Meanwhile, inner Goreum are attached to left underarm on the wrong side and on inner wrap (right front).

However, for Durumagi Cardigan here, two outer Goreum has no difference in length.

Stitches are picked up for each Goreum and worked in double knitting then bound off.

When you wear Durumagi Cardigan, tie inner Goreum (C and D) first then outer Goreum (A and B) later.

Goreum A

Pick up 5 stitches under left front Git.



1. With yarn tail on your right, begin picking up stitches from right to left. Pick up 3 stitches, skip one, then pick up 2 more stitches. Now you have 5 stitches picked up.




2. Flip the garment to the wrong side.
Purl 1, * yarn over, purl 1*. Repeat * to * 4 times. You made 4 more stitches to have 9 stitches on the needle.

On the right side, knit 1, * slip 1, knit 1*. Repeat * to * 4 times.




3. On the wrong side, slip 1, * knit 1 through back loop, slip 1*. Repeat * to * 4 times.



4. You've just finished row 1.
Work 88 rows in double knitting technique, where stitches with odd numbers are knitted and stitches with even numbers are slipped on the right side while vice versa on the wrong side.
Finish with Italian bind off technique.

Goreum B



1. With yarn tail on your left, pick up 3 stitches, slip one, pick up 2 more stitches. You picked up 5 stitches.
2. Knit 1 row from right to left.
Follow step 2, 3, and 4 for Goreum A to finish.

Goreum C

Pick up 5 stitches under right front Git.



1. With yarn tail on your right, begin picking up stitches from right to left. Pick up 2 stitches, skip one, then pick up 3 more stitches. Now you have 5 stitches picked up.
2. Follow step 2, 3, and 4 for Goreum A to finish.

Goreum D



1. With tail yarn on your right, pick up 3 stitches, skip one, and pick up 2 more stitches. You have 5 stitches on your needle.

2. Knit the first row from left to right

Follow step 2, 3, and 4 for Goreum A to finish.

Size XS



Back

1. Cast on 27 stitches for left shoulder and follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time.

Work row 7 (RS) then break yarn to rest. (29 stitches)

[How to Knit the Shoulder with 1 Circular Needle]




2. With 29 stitches for left shoulder resting on the needle, cast on 27 stitches on the other end of the same needle for right shoulder.

Follow the chart until row 7. Working row 8 (WS), cast on 28 stitches using backward loop method. (57 stitches)

After casting on 28 stitches, continue working on the left shoulder to join the pieces. (86 stitches on your needle)

Work in flat for the back until row 60 then break yarn to rest. (90 stitches)

Front



[How to Pick up Stitches at the shoulder for the back]

3. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 27 stitches from right shoulder, line 2 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time. Work until row 60 to break yarn. (58 stitches)

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left. See p.6)

4. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 27 stitches from left shoulder, line 1 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch patterns at the same time until row 60.

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left.)

5. Work row 61 then cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method. Continue working with 90 stitches resting for the back.

Cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method and work with stitches resting for right front.

Now 3 parts are joined. Follow the chart working on increasing until row 86.

From row 87 to row 161 follow the chart without increasing. Using a tapestry needle, thread a scrap yarn with contrasting color (**life line**) through every stitches on **row 160** to mark sewing line for hem. Work until row 180.

Finish the hem. (See p.7)

Git and Dongjeong (See p.8, 9, 10, 11)

6. Pick up 186 stitches along the neckline and break yarn.

(72 stitches from right front, 42 stitches from back, 72 stitches from left front)

Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from each end to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 186 rows in **double knitting** technique, working on Dongjeong from marker to marker. Finish with Italian bind-off technique for 1x1 rib.

Sleeves

7. Starting from the center of underarm, pick up 88 stitches along the armhole. Follow the chart in the round working on decreasing until row 100.

(When picking up stitches, do it from left to right. Start knitting according to the chart from the right to left after the stitches are picked up.)

8. Now you have 54 stitches on the needle. Do not bind off and work double knitting for Keutdong (cuff), in the same way as you did for Git.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 54 rows in **double knitting** technique without colorwork. Finish with Italian bind-off for 1x1 rib using tapestry needle.



Back

1. Cast on 34 stitches for left shoulder and follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time.

Work row 7 (RS) then break yarn to rest. (36 stitches)

[How to Knit the Shoulder with 1 Circular Needle]




2. With 36 stitches for left shoulder resting on the needle, cast on 34 stitches on the other end of the same needle for right shoulder.

Follow the chart until row 7. Working row 8 (WS), cast on 30 stitches using backward loop method. (66 stitches)

After casting on 30 stitches, continue working on the left shoulder to join the pieces. (102 stitches on your needle)

Work in flat for the back until row 62 then break yarn to rest. (106 stitches)

Front



[How to Pick up Stitches at the shoulder for the back]

3. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 34 stitches from right shoulder, line 2 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time. Work until row 62 to break yarn. (66 stitches)

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left. See p.6)

4. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 34 stitches from left shoulder, line 1 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch patterns at the same time until row 62.

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left.)

5. Work row 63 then cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method. Continue working with 106 stitches resting for the back.

Cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method and work with stitches resting for right front.

Now 3 parts are joined. Follow the chart working on increasing until row 88.

From row 89 to row 161 follow the chart without increasing. Using a tapestry needle, thread a scrap yarn with contrasting color (**life line**) through every stitches on **row 160** to mark sewing line for hem. Work until row 180.

Finish the hem. (See p.6)

Git and Dongjeong (See p.8, 9, 10, 11)

6. Pick up 190 stitches along the neckline and break yarn.

(73 stitches from right front, 44 stitches from back, 73 stitches from left front)

Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from each end to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 190 rows in **double knitting** technique, working on Dongjeong from marker to marker. Finish with Italian bind-off technique for 1x1 rib.

Sleeves

7. Starting from the center of underarm, pick up 92 stitches along the armhole. Follow the chart in the round working on decreasing until row 100.

(When picking up stitches, do it from left to right. Start knitting according to the chart from the right to left after the stitches are picked up.)

8. Now you have 58 stitches on the needle. Do not bind off and work double knitting for Keutdong (cuff), in the same way as you did for Git.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 58 rows in **double knitting** technique without colorwork. Finish with Italian bind-off for 1x1 rib using tapestry needle.



Back

1. Cast on 40 stitches for left shoulder and follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time.

Work row 7 (RS) then break yarn to rest. (42 stitches)

[How to Knit the Shoulder with 1 Circular Needle]




2. With 42 stitches for left shoulder resting on the needle, cast on 40 stitches on the other end of the same needle for right shoulder.

Follow the chart until row 7. Working row 8 (WS), cast on 34 stitches using backward loop method. (76 stitches)

After casting on 34 stitches, continue working on the left shoulder to join the pieces. (118 stitches on your needle)

Work in flat for the back until row 62 then break yarn to rest. (122 stitches)

Front



[How to Pick up Stitches at the shoulder for the back]

3. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 40 stitches from right shoulder, line 2 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time. Work until row 62 to break yarn. (72 stitches)

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left. See p.6)

4. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 40 stitches from left shoulder, line 1 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch patterns at the same time until row 62.

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left.)

5. Work row 63 then cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method. Continue working with 122 stitches resting for the back.

Cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method and work with stitches resting for right front.

Now 3 parts are joined. Follow the chart working on increasing until row 92.

From row 93 to row 161 follow the chart without increasing. Using a tapestry needle, thread a scrap yarn with contrasting color (**life line**) through every stitches on **row 160** to mark sewing line for hem. Work until row 180.

Finish the hem. (See p.6)

Git and Dongjeong (See p.8, 9, 10, 11)

6. Pick up 202 stitches along the neckline and break yarn.

(77 stitches from right front, 48 stitches from back, 77 stitches from left front)

Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from each end to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 202 rows in **double knitting** technique, working on Dongjeong from marker to marker. Finish with Italian bind-off technique for 1x1 rib.

Sleeves

7. Starting from the center of underarm, pick up 92 stitches along the armhole. Follow the chart in the round working on decreasing until row 92.

(When picking up stitches, do it from left to right. Start knitting according to the chart from the right to left after the stitches are picked up.)

8. Now you have 60 stitches on the needle. Do not bind off and work double knitting for Keutdong (cuff), in the same way as you did for Git.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 60 rows in **double knitting** technique without colorwork. Finish with Italian bind-off for 1x1 rib using tapestry needle.



1. Cast on 46 stitches for left shoulder and follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time.

Work row 7 (RS) then break yarn to rest. (48 stitches)

[How to Knit the Shoulder with 1 Circular Needle]




2. With 48 stitches for left shoulder resting on the needle, cast on 46 stitches on the other end of the same needle for right shoulder.

Follow the chart until row 7. Working row 8 (WS), cast on 38 stitches using backward loop method. (86 stitches)

After casting on 38 stitches, continue working on the left shoulder to join the pieces. (134 stitches on your needle)

Work in flat for the back until row 62 then break yarn to rest. (138 stitches)

Front



[How to Pick up Stitches at the shoulder for the back]

3. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 46 stitches from right shoulder, line 2 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time. Work until row 62 to break yarn. (78 stitches)

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left. See p.6)

4. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 46 stitches from left shoulder, line 1 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch patterns at the same time until row 62.

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left.)

5. Work row 63 then cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method. Continue working with 138 stitches resting for the back.

Cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method and work with stitches resting for right front.

Now 3 parts are joined. Follow the chart working on increasing until row 96.

From row 97 to row 161 follow the chart without increasing. Using a tapestry needle, thread a scrap yarn with contrasting color (**life line**) through every stitches on **row 160** to mark sewing line for hem. Work until row 180.

Finish the hem. (See p.6)

Git and Dongjeong (See p.8, 9, 10, 11)

6. Pick up 212 stitches along the neckline and break yarn.

(80 stitches from right front, 52 stitches from back, 80 stitches from left front)

Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from each end to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 212 rows in **double knitting** technique, working on Dongjeong from marker to marker. Finish with Italian bind-off technique for 1x1 rib.

Sleeves

7. Starting from the center of underarm, pick up 92 stitches along the armhole. Follow the chart in the round working on decreasing until row 92.

(When picking up stitches, do it from left to right. Start knitting according to the chart from the right to left after the stitches are picked up.)

8. Now you have 60 stitches on the needle. Do not bind off and work double knitting for Keutdong (cuff), in the same way as you did for Git.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 60 rows in **double knitting** technique without colorwork. Finish with Italian bind-off for 1x1 rib using tapestry needle.



1. Cast on 52 stitches for left shoulder and follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time.

Work row 7 (RS) then break yarn to rest. (54 stitches)


2. With 54 stitches for left shoulder resting on the needle, cast on 52 stitches on the other end of the same needle for right shoulder.

Follow the chart until row 7. Working row 8 (WS), cast on 42 stitches using backward loop method. (96 stitches)

After casting on 42 stitches, continue working on the left shoulder to join the pieces. (150 stitches on your needle)

Work in flat for the back until row 66 then break yarn to rest. (154 stitches)

Front



[How to Pick up Stitches at the shoulder for the back]

3. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 52 stitches from right shoulder, line 2 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time. Work until row 66 to break yarn. (86 stitches)

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left. See p.6)

4. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 52 stitches from left shoulder, line 1 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch patterns at the same time until row 66.

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left.)

5. Work row 67 then cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method. Continue working with 154 stitches resting for the back.

Cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method and work with stitches resting for right front.

Now 3 parts are joined. Follow the chart working on increasing until row 100.

From row 101 to row 171 follow the chart without increasing. Using a tapestry needle, thread a scrap yarn with contrasting color (**life line**) through every stitches on **row 170** to mark sewing line for hem. Work until row 180.

Finish the hem. (See p.6)

Git and Dongjeong (See p.8, 9, 10, 11)

6. Pick up 222 stitches along the neckline and break yarn.

(83 stitches from right front, 56 stitches from back, 83 stitches from left front)

Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from each end to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 222 rows in **double knitting** technique, working on Dongjeong from marker to marker. Finish with Italian bind-off technique for 1x1 rib.

Sleeves

7. Starting from the center of underarm, pick up 98 stitches along the armhole. Follow the chart in the round working on decreasing until row 88.

(When picking up stitches, do it from left to right. Start knitting according to the chart from the right to left after the stitches are picked up.)

8. Now you have 66 stitches on the needle. Do not bind off and work double knitting for Keutdong (cuff), in the same way as you did for Git.


Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 66 rows in **double knitting** technique without colorwork. Finish with Italian bind-off for 1x1 rib using tapestry needle.

9. Work likewise for the other sleeve.







1. Cast on 58 stitches for left shoulder and follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time.

Work row 7 (RS) then break yarn to rest. (60 stitches)


2. With 60 stitches for left shoulder resting on the needle, cast on 58 stitches on the other end of the same needle for right shoulder.

Follow the chart until row 7. Working row 8 (WS), cast on 46 stitches using backward loop method. (106 stitches)

After casting on 46 stitches, continue working on the left shoulder to join the pieces. (166 stitches on your needle)

Work in flat for the back until row 66 then break yarn to rest. (170 stitches)

Front

3. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 58 stitches from right shoulder, line 2 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch pattern at the same time. Work until row 66 to break yarn. (92 stitches)

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left. See p.6)

4. Place the piece with the right side facing you and pick up 58 stitches from left shoulder, line 1 on the image.

Follow the chart working on short rows and stitch patterns at the same time until row 66.

(Pick up stitches with tail yarn on your left and work the first row from right to left.)

5. Work row 67 then cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method. Continue working with 170 stitches resting for the back.

Cast on 6 stitches in backward loop method and work with stitches resting for right front.

Now 3 parts are joined. Follow the chart working on increasing until row 104.

From row 105 to row 171 follow the chart without increasing. Using a tapestry needle, thread a scrap yarn with contrasting color (**life line**) through every stitches on **row 170** to mark sewing line for hem. Work until row 190.

Finish the hem. (See p.6)

Git and Dongjeong (See p.8, 9, 10, 11)

6. Pick up 234 stitches along the neckline and break yarn.

(87 stitches from right front, 60 stitches from back, 87 stitches from left front)

Place stitch markers on the 36th stitches from each end to mark the beginning and the end of Dongjeong.

Cast on 23 stitches in tubular cast on method and work 234 rows in **double knitting** technique, working on Dongjeong from marker to marker. Finish with Italian bind-off technique for 1x1 rib.

Sleeves

7. Starting from the center of underarm, pick up 98 stitches along the armhole. Follow the chart in the round working on decreasing until row 88.

(When picking up stitches, do it from left to right. Start knitting according to the chart from the right to left after the stitches are picked up.)

8. Now you have 66 stitches on the needle. Do not bind off and work double knitting for Keutdong (cuff), in the same way as you did for Git.






