

DUSK INTO TWILIGHT

This pattern is part of a collection celebrating Romi's new home in beautiful Northern Nevada. ❧

The sun has set, and dusk steals across the high desert toward the mountains, in streaks of purple, mauve and grey. Overhead, waking stars burn bright in the gathering twilight, pinpoints of brilliant light in a cloudless crystal sky.

A half circle of asymmetrical stripes wraps across your shoulders and into the twilight of a starry lace border. Created with short rows, this shawl's stockinette stitch stripes balance one another throughout the shawl, with garter ridges of the dark contrast throughout. The lace border, narrow on one side, widens across the shawl and is finished with a simple picot bind off.

SIZE One

MEASUREMENTS Width, tip to tip: 88 inches after blocking
Depth: 33 inches after blocking

MATERIALS Sample pictured: Color 1 (C1): Lorna's Laces Solemate [55% superwash wool, 15% nylon, 30% Outlast®; 425yd/100g skein]; color: Dobson (light mauve), 1 skein
Color 2 (C2): Lorna's Laces Solemate [55% superwash wool, 15% nylon, 30% Outlast®; 425yd/100g skein]; color: Kerfuffle (amethyst, 1 skein
Color 3 (C3): Lorna's Laces Solemate [55% superwash wool, 15% nylon, 30% Outlast®; 425yd/100g skein]; color: Bigger on the Inside (deep delft blue), 1 skein

1 - set US #4/3.5 mm circular knitting needles

Stitch Markers, at least 11
Tapestry Needle
T-pins

GAUGE 20 sts/28 rows = 4"/10cm in stockinette st after blocking

Every knitter's gauge is different; please check gauge! Exact gauge is not important. However, a looser gauge will result in the use of more yardage.

STITCH PATTERNS

Notes: see C1, C2, C3 designation at beginning of each row for color used; slip all markers as needed - specific direction to do so will not be given. Markers are counted in order from your current starting edge.

Stripe Combination 1:

C2 Row 1: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C2 Row 2: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 1 st before 1st marker, w&t
C2 Row 3 and all subsequent odd numbered rows through 21: knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C2 Row 4: WP, k1, purl to 1 st before 2nd marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 6: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 1 st before 3rd marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 8: WP, k1, purl to 1 st before 4th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 10: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 1 st before 5th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 12: WP, k1, purl to 1 st before 6th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 14: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 1 st before 7th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 16: WP, k1, purl to 1 st before 8th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 18: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 1 st before 9th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 20: WP, k1, purl to 1 st before 10th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 22: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, k1, k1 tbl
C2 Row 23: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C2 Row 24: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C3 Row 1: k1 tbl, [knit to 1 st before end], k1 tbl
C3 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 1: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C1 Row 2: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
C1 Row 3: k1 tbl, k1, knit to 1st marker, k1, w&t

C1 Row 4 and all subsequent even numbered rows through 22: purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
C1 Row 5: WP, k1, knit to 2nd marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 7: k1 tbl, k1, knit to 3rd marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 9: WP, k1, knit to 4th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 11: k1 tbl, k1, knit to 5th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 13: WP, k1, knit to 6th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 15: k1 tbl, k1, knit to 7th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 17: WP, k1, knit to 8th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 19: k1 tbl, k1, knit to 9th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 21: WP, k1, knit to 10th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t
C1 Row 23: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1 tbl
C1 Row 24: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
C1 Row 25: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C1 Row 26: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Stripe Combinaton 2:

C2: Work C2 rows 1-21 as shown in Stripe Combination 1
C2 Row 22: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 1 st before 11th marker while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Rows 23 and 25: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C2 Row 24: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end while purling previous wrap together tbl with its st, w&t
C2 Row 26: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
C2 Row 27: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
C2 Row 28: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C3 Row 1: k1 tbl, [knit to 1 st before end], k1 tbl
C3 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1: Work C1 rows 1-22 as shown in Stripe Combination 1

C1 Row 23: k1 tbl, k1, knit to 11th marker while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1, w&t

C1 rows 24 and 26: purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 Row 25: WP, k1, knit to 2 sts from end while knitting previous wrap together with its st, w&t

C1 Row 27: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end while knitting previous wrap together with its st, k1 tbl

C1 Row 28: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 Row 29: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 30: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

PATTERN

Set-up:

C1: CO 2 stitches using backwards loop method, then knit 1 row.

C1 Row 1: k1 tbl, k1

C1 Row 2: k1 tbl, k1

C1 Row 3: WP, knit

C1 Row 4: k1 tbl, k1

C1 Repeat rows 1 and 2.

Main body:

C1 Row 1: WP, k1, turn work 90 degrees and continue working along side: [YO, PUK1] 3 times, YO; turn work 90 degrees and PUK 2 sts along cast on edge: 11 sts

C1 Row 2: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, working all YOs tbl to twist sts, k1, k1 tbl

C1 (increase row) Row 3: k1 tbl, k1, kfbf 2 times, kfb 3 times, kfbf 2 times, k1, k1 tbl: 22 sts

C1 Row 4: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 Row 5: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 6: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 Row 7: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 8: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 Row 9: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 10: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 (increase row) Row 11: k1 tbl, k1, kfb to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl: 40 sts

C1 Row 12: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 13: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 14: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C1 Row 15: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C1 Row 16: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Work rows 13-16 two additional times.

Work rows 13 and 14.

C1 (increase row) Row 27: k1 tbl, k1, kfb to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl: 76 sts

C1 Row 28: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

Work rows 13-16 a total of 4 more times.

Work rows 13 and 14.

C3 (increase row) Row 47: k1 tbl, k1, kfb to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl: 148 sts

C3 Row 48: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 49: WP, k1, [k12, pm] 11 times, k13, k1 tbl (for the remainder of directions, slip markers as you come to them)

C2 Row 50: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Work Stripe Combination 1.

Transition 1:

C3 (increase row) Row 1: k1 tbl, k1, [kfb, k1] to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl (there will be 18 sts between markers): 220 sts

C3 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 3: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 4: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Work Stripe Combination 1.

Transition 2:

C3 (increase row) Row 1: k1 tbl, k1, [k2, kfb] to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl (there will be 24 sts between markers): 292 sts

C3 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 3: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 4: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Work Stripe Combination 2.

Transition 3:

C3 (increase row) Row 1: k1 tbl, k1, [k1, kfb, k2] to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl (there will be 30 sts between markers): 364 sts

C3 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 3: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 4: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Work Stripe Combination 2.

Transition 4:

C3 Row 1: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C3 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 3: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 4: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

C2 Row 5: k1 tbl, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C2 Row 6: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl

Repeat rows 3-6

C3 Row 11: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl

C3 Row 12: WP, k1, knit to 2 sts before end, kfb, k1 tbl: 365 sts

C3 Remove stitch markers and work Chart A a total of 7 times. C1 and C2 will not be used further.

alternate Chart A written instructions:

Row 1: k1 tbl, k1, [YO, k2tog, k2] 8 {20, 32, 44, 56, 68, 80} times, w&t
 Rows 2 and 4: purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
 Row 3: WP, k1 [k2, YO, k2tog] 8 {20, 32, 44, 56, 68, 80} times, [k2, YO, k2tog] 6 times, w&t

C3 Work Chart B a total of 2 times.

alternate Chart B written instructions:

Row 1: k1 tbl, k1, [YO, k2tog, k2] 90 times, YO, k2tog, k1 tbl
 Rows 2 and 4: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
 Row 3: WP, k1, [k2, YO, k2tog] 90 times, k2, k1 tbl

C3 Work Chart C a total of 1 time.

alternate Chart C written instructions:

Row 1: k1 tbl, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
 Row 2: k1 tbl, knit to 1 stitch before end, k1 tbl
 Rows 3 and 4: WP, k1, purl to 2 sts before end, k1, k1 tbl
 Row 5: k1 tbl, k1, k2tog tbl, k1, [k1, k2tog, YO 2 times, k2tog tbl, k2] 51 times, k2, k1 tbl
 Row 6: k1 tbl, knit to 1 stitch before end while working [k1, p1, k1] into each double YO, k1 tbl: 415 sts
 Row 7: repeat row 3
 Row 8: WP, knit to 1 st before end, k1 tbl
 Rows 9 and 10: repeat row 2
 Row 11: Repeat row 8

Bind off next row (415 sts): Use picot bind off as follows. [CO 2 using knitted cast on, k2tog tbl, k1 tbl, pass 1st stitch over 2nd st on right needle, BO2, sl st back to left needle] to end, fasten off.

Finishing


Weave in ends and wash using wool wash. Remove excess water from shawl and block using blocking wires and T-pins. Stretch shawl tight, and pin wires and bottom point. When thoroughly dry, unpin and enjoy!

ABBREVIATIONS


BO: bind off
cdd: slip 2 sts tog knitwise, k1, pssso
CO: cast on
k: knit
kfb: k1, k1 tbl into 1 st
k2tog: (right leaning decrease) knit 2 stitches together
k2tog tbl: (left leaning decrease) knit 2 stitches together tbl
k tbl: knit through back loop to twist stitch
k3tog: knit 3 together
M1: make stitch by lifting bar between sts in previous row; twist lifted bar; knit into resulting loop
p2tog: purl two stitches together
p2tog tbl: purl two stitches together tbl
pssso: pass slipped st(s) over
p: purl
RS: right side
ss: stockinette stitch
ssk: [slip 1 stitch knitwise] 2 times, slip both stitches back onto left needle, knit stitches together
sk2p: sl 1 st knitwise, k2 tog, pssso
st(s): stitch(es)
tbl: through back loop
w&t: (short row) wrap next stitch with working yarn and turn without completing current row
WS: wrong side
WP: (work picot) CO 2 sts using knitted CO, k2tog tbl, k1 tbl, pass 1st st over 2nd st
wyib: with yarn held to back of work
wyif: with yarn held to front of work
YO: yarn over



C3 Chart A - note that there are short rows in chart. Work chart a total of 7 times.




C3 Chart B - Work chart a total of 2 times.
