## MATERIALS

### Pica Pau Cotton 8/7 Nude

1 skein of color 03

### Pica Pau Cotton 8/7

1 skein of color 09

1 skein of color 27

1 skein of color 32

1 skein of color 35

1 skein of color 37

Crochet hook 2.75 mm / US C2

2 safety eyes 10 mm

Stuffing

Tapestry needle

Stitch marker

## YARN QUALITY

 **Pica Pau Cotton 8/7 Nude**, Hobbii

100% Cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

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100% Cotton

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## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 22 cm / 8.6"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Dylan Ladybug is an intermediate project, worked in a continuous spiral. To keep track of the rounds you may use a stitch marker or safety pin to mark the beginning of a round. Dylan Ladybug also has 2 accessories: a hat and a pair of boots.

Remember that it's always advisable to give the entire pattern a read before starting crocheting and, most importantly, be patient with yourself!

## ABBREVIATIONS

### US terms

mr = magic ring

st = stitch

Rnd = round

slst = slip stitch

BLO = back loop only

FLO = front loop only

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease (2 sts together)

inc = increase (2 sts in the same st)

## INFO AND TIPS

You may sew the spots of the wings as you crochet the wings.

When working jacquard with color changes that are widely spread, I like to cut the inside strands and tie them together.

### CHEEKS (make 2)

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (09)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in mr [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### HEAD SPOTS (make 2)

Work with Pica Pau Cotton Nude color (03)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### HEAD AND BODY

Start with Pica Pau Cotton color (35)

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a mr [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 6 times [30]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) 6 times [36]

Rnd 7: (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) 6 times [42]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) 6 times [48]

Continue working with alternating yarns, Pica Pau Cotton (35) and Pica Pau Cotton Nude (03). The color you work with is indicated before each part.

Rnd 9: (*color 35*) sc in next 17 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 14 st (*color 35*) sc in next 17 st [48]

Rnd 10: (*color 35*) sc in next 16 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 16 st (*color 35*) sc in next 16 st [48]

Rnd 11-16: (*color 35*) sc in next 15 st, (*color 03*) sc in next 18 st (*color 35*) sc in next 15 st [48]

Embroider the mouth with Pica Pau Cotton (37) in the center of the Buttermilk (*color 03*) patch, on rounds 13 and 14. Insert the safety eyes between rounds 13 and 14, about 3 stitches away from the mouth. Sew the cheeks behind the safety eyes. Sew the head spots between rounds 6 and 8, on the top of the head.

Continue in a stripe pattern, changing color every round, alternating Pica Pau Cotton (32) and Pica Pau Cotton Nude (03)

Rnd 17-26: sc in all 48 st [48]

Change to Pica Pau Cotton color (35)

Rnd 27-32: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 33: (sc in next 6 st, dec) 6 times [42]

Rnd 34: (sc in next 5 st, dec) 6 times [36]

Rnd 35: (sc in next 4 st, dec) 6 times [30]

Stuff the head and body and continue stuffing as you go.

Rnd 36: (sc in next 3 st, dec) 6 times [24]

Rnd 37: (sc in next 2 st, dec) 6 times [18]

Rnd 38: (sc in next st, dec) 6 times [12]

Rnd 39: dec 6 times [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

## ANTENNAE

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (35)

Pull up a loop in Rnd 5 at the top center of the head. Ch 7.

Row 1: start in second ch from hook, slst in next 6 ch [5]. Join with a slst in the next st on the head.

Insert the hook in the next stitch and ch 7, slst in next 6 ch. Join with a slst to the head. Weave in the yarn end.

## ARMS (make 2)

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (35)

Rnd 1: start 7 sc in a magic ring [7]

Rnd 2-7: sc in all 7 st [7]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff lightly. Sew the arms to both sides between rounds 18 and 20.

## LEGS (make 2)

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (35)

Rnd 1: start 7 sc in a magic ring [7]

Rnd 2-12: sc in all 7 st [7]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff lightly. Sew the legs to both sides between rounds 32 and 34.

### **WING SPOTS (make 14)**

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (32)

Rnd 1: start 8 sc in a magic ring [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### **WINGS (make 2)**

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (09)

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a mr [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) 6 times [30]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) 6 times [36]

*Note: You may sew the spots as you crochet the wings.*

Rnd 7-18: sc in all 36 st [36]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff. Flatten the wings before sewing them to the back, between rounds 17 and 18.

### **BOOTS (make 2)**

Work with Pica Pau Cotton (27)

Ch 6. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: start in second ch from the hook, inc in this st, sc in next 3 st, 4 sc in last st. Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, sc in next 3 st, inc in last st [14]

Rnd 2: inc in next 2 st, sc in next 4 st, inc in next 3 st, sc in next 4 st, inc in next st [20]

Rnd 3: BLO: sc in next 9 st, dec 2 times, sc in next 7 st [18]

Rnd 4: sc in next 6 st, dec 4 times, sc in next 4 st [14]

Rnd 5: sc in next 6 st, dec 2 times, sc in next 4 st [12]

Rnd 6-7: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 8: slst in all 12 st [12]

Fasten off, weave in the yarn end.

Join Pica Pau Cotton (27) in the last front loop stitch of round 3 and FLO slst in all 18 st. Fasten off, weave in the yarn end.

### **HAT**

Work with Pica Pau Cotton color (09)

Rnd 1: start 8 sc in a mr [8]

Rnd 2: inc in all 8 st [16]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) 8 times [24]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) 8 times [32]

Rnd 5: BLO sc in next 32 st [32]

Rnd 6-8: sc in all 32 st [32]

Rnd 9: (sc in next 6 st, dec) 4 times [28]

Rnd 10: inc in next 13 st, ch 4, skip 2 st, inc in next 13 st [56].

Rnd 11: sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 12: FLO slst in next 56 st [56]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn ends.
