Level: Intermediate



Material

- Circulo yarns - Clea - 2 balls color #6029
- Crochet hook 1.25 mm
- Tapestry needle measuring tape & scissors

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st
make: mk
skip: sk
chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
half double crochet: hdc
double crochet: dc
2 dc cluster: 2 dc closed together in the same base st.
picot: ch 3, 1 sl st in the first chain
Increase: inc
decrease: dec
round: rnd
end of row/rnd: eor.
Pattern A - follow chart 1
Back neckline - follow chart 2
Front neckline - follow chart 3
Sleeves - follow chart 4
Crochet edge - follow chart 5

Gauge

33 S x 20 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern A - chart 1 using hook 1.25 mm.

Top

Part 1

Crochet in the round.
Start at waistline.
Ch 300, close ring with 1 sl st.
R1 - 68: follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts.

Part 2

Front and back continuation
Crochet back and forth.
Fold piece into front and back.
Back continuation
R69 - 93: Follow Back neckline - chart 2.
Front continuation
R69 - 93: Follow Front neckline - chart 3.

Body assembly

Use tapestry needle to sew shoulders (3.25").






Sleeves (mk 2)

Crochet in the round.
Join yarn at armhole.
R1 - 20: follow chart 4 and rep sts (16 motifs).
Fasten off.


Finishing

Follow chart 5 - crochet edge (35 motifs) around neckline. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Level: advanced

Material

- Circulo yarns - Anne - 1 ball color #3951
- Crochet hook 1.75 mm
- Tapestry needle measuring tape & scissors

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st
make: mk
skip: sk
chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
double crochet: dc
Increase: inc
decrease: dec
round: rnd
end of row/rnd: eor.
Pattern 1/2 and 3- follow respective charts
Bands - follow chart
Crochet edge - follow chart
Mesh - follow chart

Gauge

25 dc x 11 R = 4"/10 cm using hook 1.75 mm.

Top

Start at bands. Make 2.

Ch 7 + 3 to turn. Follow chart up to 35.5".

Join edges forming a ring.

Work on one side of one band and leave the other band aside.

Crochet in the round. Follow Pattern 1 chart, rep from * to * 36x. Once chart is completed, fasten off.

Sew the second band in the last round of Pattern 1.

Work on top of this band. Follow crochet edge chart, rep from * to * 33x. Once chart is completed, fasten off.

Crochet in the round on the first band again.

Follow Pattern 2 chart, rep from * to * 14x. At 2.5" from the beginning of Pattern 2 start armhole shaping. Divide work in two equal parts and work sides separately. Stop making 3 sts on each side in every row (5x). Once chart is completed, follow Pattern 3 chart, rep from * to * (11x) plus borders. In the last row of Pattern 3, work in dc on each side (2.75"). Do not work on the central sts = neckline.

Straps (mk 2)

Continue working on sides. Follow Mesh chart up to 2.5". Fasten off.

Finishing

Work around neckline and armholes.


Crochet in the round.

R1: sc until eor.


R2: 1 sc, *ch 2, 1 sc* rep from * to * until the eor.

Fasten off and weave in ends.








Material

- Circulo yarns - Anne - 4 balls color #6133
- Crochet hook D-3/3.25 mm
- Tapestry needle measuring tape & scissors
- Fabric to line dress
- Sewing machine

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st
make: mk
skip: sk
chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
half double crochet: hdc
double crochet: dc
dc2tog: 2 dc closed together in different base st.
dc4tog: 4 dc closed together in different base st.
Increase: inc
decrease: dec
round: rnd
end of row/rnd: eor.
Pattern A - follow chart 1
Skirt foundation chain for back. - follow chart 2
Pattern B - follow chart 3

Gauge

24 S x 14 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern A -3 motifs using hook D-3.

Dress

Part 1 - top

Start at waistline. Crochet back and forth.
Front and both backs are worked simultaneously.
Ch 104.
R1 - 30: Follow Pattern A - chart 1 - 13 motifs.
Fasten off.

Part 2

Follow Skirt Foundation chain for back chart.
Join yarn 2 motifs from the side of back right.
Follow chart 2 and rep sts - 34 motifs, end cord on the left back with sc. Note: see red stars on chart 1 - Part 1. Crochet in the round.
R1: sc until eor.
R2: 1 sc, *ch 2, 1 sc* rep from * to * until the eor.
Fasten off and weave in ends.

Part 3

Skirt
Crochet in the round.
Work in the foundation chain (Part 2) and in the 15" of front (part 1).
Follow pattern B - chart 3, rep sts and the number of motifs in each tier:
Tier 1 = 30 motifs
Tiers 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6: 33 motifs
Tiers 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13: 49 motifs.

Straps (mk 2)

Join yarn in the top of front cup. Make a 12.25"

chain cord. Join onto back, 2.5" from back right side. Turn and mk 1 row in sc.

Cords

Top

Make a 47.25" chain cord. Turn and mk 1 sc in each chain. Insert this cord into both back sides, tie at the center of back as shown in the picture.

Waist

Make a 59" chain cord. Turn and mk 1 sc in each chain. Insert this cord into R1 of skirt (Part 3), tie at the center of back.

Lining

Use crochet dress as a template to make slip to wear underneath. Use sewing machine to make slip and sewing thread and needle to sew slip onto dress.

Material

- Circulo yarns - Charme - 3 balls color #3526
- Crochet hook D-3/3.25 mm
- Hairpin lace loom
- Tapestry needle measuring tape & scissors

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st
make: mk
skip: sk
chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
half double crochet: hdc
double crochet: dc
Increase: inc
decrease: dec
round: rnd
end of row/rnd: eor
Hairpin lace crochet strips - follow chart 1
How to interlace strips in groups of 4 - follow chart 2
Crochet strips - follow chart 3
Chain Arches st - follow chart 4
Crochet edge - follow chart 5

Gauge

1 strip x 16 loops = 3.25" x 4" using hook D-3.

Top

Hairpin lace strips

Use Charme and crochet hook D-3 to make 4 strips with 200 loops to the right and 200 loops to the left. Join at center with sc.

How to interlace strips in groups of 4:

Use crochet hook D-3 to interlace 4 in 4 in each strip as shown on chart 2 = 50 motifs on each side.

Crochet strip

To form front and back, join 2 strips on each side with this crochet strip - chart 3 = 50 motifs.

Crochet arches st

Work on both sides of strip in Chain Arches st = 15 motifs on each side.

R1 - 5: follow chart 4 and rep sts. Join the sc of first row in the interlace of right strip, end with sc in the interlace of left strip.

Sides

Fold piece in half, shaping front and back. Join sides with crochet strips (17 motifs), follow chart 3 and rep sts. Leave 15" open for arms.

Crochet edge

Follow chart 5 around armholes (19 motifs) and neckline (46 motifs).

- Circulo yarns - Clea - 1 ball color #1074
- Crochet hook 1.25 mm
- Tapestry needle
- Measuring tape & scissors
- Fabric to line top

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

stitch: st
make: mk

chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
half double crochet: hdc
double crochet: dc
treble crochet: tr
3 tr cluster: 3 tr in the same base st closed together.
picot: ch 3, 1 sl st in the first chain
Increase: inc

Gauge

47 S x 10 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern using hook 1.25 mm.

Top

Front

Crochet back and forth.

Ch 215 + 3 to turn.

Follow Pattern chart from * to * (horizontally) 27x.

At 13.5" from the beginning start armhole and neckline shaping. Armhole shaping: stop making on each side in each row: 38 sts, 3 sts (2x) and 4 sts (8x). Neckline shaping: divide piece into 2 identical parts and work sides separately. Stop making on the neckline side in every row: 2 sts (2x) and 3 sts (8x). Fasten off.

Back

Start at lower part from top-down.

Ch 163 + 3 to turn. Follow Lower part chart starting at the *, rep from * to * (4x) more 20 sts beyond the *. Once chart is completed, fasten off.

Central part

Join yarn in the foundation chain of lower part. Follow Pattern chart, start with 3 tr cluster (central st on chart). Inc 4 sts on each side (13x). Once these increases are finished, divide work in two equal parts and work sides separately. Stop making on the neckline side in every row: 5 sts (2x), and 6 sts (7x). Fasten off.

Sides

Work on both sides of central part. Follow Side - chart. Start at dc row joining the side in the lower part with 1 sl st. Once chart is completed, fasten off.

Finishing



Sew sides. Use fabric to line top. Mk 1 rnd in sc around neckline and armholes.

Straps (mk 2)



Join yarn into front edge, ch 50 and join back (see picture), turn and follow chart. Fasten off.







Material

- Circulo Yarns - Jeans Lite - 4 balls color #8739
- Circular knitting needles 4 & 6 (29")
- Tapestry needle
- Paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Measuring tape

Stitch glossary and abbreviations

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

rep: repeat

dec: decreases

inc: increases

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

3x3 Rib st (back & forth): chart 1

Pattern A: chart 2

Pattern B: chart 3

3x3 Rib st (knit in the round): chart 4

skp: slip 1, k1, pass sl st over

sk2p: slip 1 st, k2tog, pass sl st over k2tog.

Gauge

20 S x 26 R = 4"/10 cm over Pattern A (chart 1) using circular needles 6.

Back

CO 90 sts onto needles 4. Follow chart 1 - 3x3 Rib st and rep sts for 3.25". On the last row of 3x3 Rib inc 18 sts evenly spaced = 108 sts. Switch to circular needles 6. Follow Pattern A - 18 motifs, chart 2 and rep sts. At 8" start armhole shaping: BO 6 sts on each side (1x) = 96 sts. At 17" BO all sts and set piece aside.

Front

CO 90 sts onto needles 4. Follow chart 1 - 3x3 Rib st and rep sts for 3.25". On the last row of 3x3 Rib inc 18 sts evenly spaced = 108 sts. Switch to circular needles 6. Follow Pattern A - 18 motifs, chart 2 and rep sts. At 8" start armhole shaping: BO 6 sts on each side (1x) = 96 sts. At 13" start neckline shaping: BO the central 36 sts and work 30 sts of each side separately. Dec on the neckline side every 2 rows: 3 sts (1x), 2 sts (1x) and 1 st (1x). At 17" BO the remaining 24 sts of each shoulder and set piece aside.

Sleeves (mk 2)

Use circular needles 6 and Jeans Lite to pick up 130 sts around armhole. Follow Pattern B chart - 13 motifs. On the last row of Pattern B, dec 40 sts evenly spaced = 90 sts. Switch to circular needles 4 and follow chart 1 - 3x3 Rib st and rep sts for 3.25".

BO all sts and make other sleeve.

Assembly and finishing

Use tapestry needle and Jeans Lite to close sides (8") and sleeves bottom (8.25").

Collar (knit in the round): use needles 4 to pick up 129 sts around neckline and follow chart 4 - 3x3 Rib st and rep sts for 1.5". BO all sts.




Chart 2- Pattern A




Chart 3 - Pattern B





Chart 4 - 3x3 Rib st


