



EZ Tank



I knit this tank in a cotton blend yarn (60% cotton 40% acrylic) to be worn as summery top. The armholes are generous to say the least, but are easily adjustable to make them smaller and more modest.

Materials

770m Yarn used: Scheepjes Whirl Liquorice Yummy, Color 75 I
3.5mm circular needles
Tapestry needle

Gauge

27 sts = 4 inches
31 rows = 4 inches

Pattern size: Men's Large

Width 23 inches
length 30 inches

Cast on 260 sts

Join in the round

Knit in the round for 11.5 inches (90 rows)

Shape armholes

Place stitch marker half way on your work at 130 sts

Front

Row 1 (rs): Cast-off 4 sts, k to stitch marker, turn work
Row 2 (ws): Cast-off 4 sts, p to end
Row 3: Cast-off 4 sts, k to end
Row 4: repeat row 2
Row 5: Cast-off 2 sts, k to end
Row 6: Cast-off 2 sts, p to end
Row 7-8: repeat rows 5 & 6

Back

Row 1-6: work same as front

Body

Work front for 77 rows (106 sts)

Work back for 100 rows (110 sts)

*slip the first stitch of every row

Shape neckline

Start each section at the arm hole edge

Place stitch marker at 53 sts (half-way) on the front, and at 55 sts on the back

Left Front

Row 1 (rs): slip first stitch, k to 4 sts before stitch marker, k3tog, k1

Row 2 (ws): slip first stitch, p to end

*Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 23 sts remain

Right Front

Row 1 (ws): slip first stitch, p to the end

Row 2 (rs): slip first stitch, k3tog tbl, knit to end

*Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 23 sts remain

Left back

Row 1 (rs): slip first stitch, k to last 4 sts before stitch marker, k3tog, k1

Row 2 (ws): slip first stitch, p to end

Row 3: slip first stitch, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1

Row 4: repeat row 2

*repeat rows 3 & 4 until 23 stitches remain

Right back

Row 1 (ws): slip first stitch, p to end
Row 2 (rs): slip first stitch, k3tog tbl, k to end
Row 3: repeat row 1
Row 4: slip first stitch, k2tog tbl, k to end
*repeat rows 3 & 4 until 23 stitches remain

Close arm holes by joining the front to back using the Kitchener stitch.
