



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
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## Introduction

Easy Knits is a collection of simple hand knits for adults and children: easy knitting, easy wearing, easy living. From soft, draped cardigans to crisp cotton styles, the accent here is on the detailing – a flash of bright colour in a Fair Isle band or neat moss stitch collar and cuffs. Most of the designs in Easy Knits are within the grasp of the fairly inexperienced knitter, even the colourwork is kept as uncomplicated as possible and I have used good quality yarns that show and emphasize stitch detail in a variety of beautiful shades from neutrals to brights. For the perfect antidote to the stresses of modern life, first choose your style, then pick up your needles and relax.

## Basic information

### FOLLOWING PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Figures for larger sizes are given in round ( ) brackets. Where only one figure appears, this applies to all sizes. Work figures given in square [ ] brackets the number of times stated afterwards. Where 0 appears, no stitches or rows are worked for this size. As you follow the pattern, make sure that you are consistently using the right stitches for your size – it is only too easy to switch sizes inside the brackets. One way to avoid this is to go through the instructions first and mark the size you are knitting with a coloured pen or highlighter.

The quantities of yarn quoted in the instructions are based on the yarn used by the knitter for the original garment and amounts should therefore be considered approximate. A slight variation in tension can make the difference between using less or more yarn than that stated in the pattern. Before buying yarn, look at the measurements on the knitting instructions to be sure what size you want to knit. My patterns quote the actual finished knitted size of the garment rather than just the bust/chest measurements of the wearer. The actual measurements will tell you the width around the whole garment and this will tell you how much ease a garment has; whether it is a generous, baggy style or slim fitting. If you wish to make up the design with less or more ease, you may just need to knit the size smaller or larger size quoted. If you are unsure, measure an existing garment. The length of the garment is usually taken from the shoulder shaping to the cast-on edge.

### TENSION

Each pattern in this book specifies a tension – the number of stitches and rows per centimetre/inch that should be obtained with the given needles, yarn and stitch pattern. Check your tension carefully before commencing work.

Use the same yarn, needles and stitch pattern as those to be used for the main work and knit a sample at least 12.5cm/5in square. Smooth out the finished sample on a flat surface, but do

not stretch it. To check the tension, place a ruler horizontally on the sample and mark 10cm/4in across with pins. Count the number of stitches between the pins. To check the row tension, place a ruler vertically on the sample and mark 10cm/4in with pins. Count the number of rows between the pins. If the number of stitches and rows is greater than specified, try again using larger needles; if less, use smaller needles. The stitch tension is the most important element to get right.

### BUYING YARN FOR A KNITTING PATTERN

Always try to buy the yarn specified in your knitting pattern; however, if you use a substitute, buy a yarn that is the same weight and has the same tension and, where possible, the same fibre content. If you use a synthetic yarn instead of a natural fibre, or even wool where cotton had been originally used, the stitch patterns may appear softer and less delineated. Synthetics can also appear limp, which means that the crispness of the original garment will have been lost. It is essential to check metreage or yardage. Yarn that weighs the same may have different lengths, and you may need to buy more or less yarn.

Check the ball band on the yarn. Most yarn labels now carry all the information you need about fibre content, washing instructions, weight and metreage or yardage. Some of them will tell you the knitting needle sizes to use and the standard tension (or stitch size) these create.

It is essential to check the dye lot number on the yarn label. Yarns are dyed in batches or lots, which can sometimes vary quite considerably. Your retailer may not have the same dye lot later on, so try and buy all your yarn for a project at the same time. If you know that sometimes you require extra yarn to that quoted in a pattern, buy more. If it is not possible to buy the amount you need all in one dye lot, work the borders on the lower edges or the neckband in the odd one, since the colour change is less likely to show here.

The following descriptions of the yarns used in the book are guides to the yarn weights and types:

*Debbie Bliss merino double knitting*: a 100% merino wool in a double knitting weight. Approximately 110m/50g ball.

*Debbie Bliss merino aran*: a 100% merino wool in an aran or fisherman yarn. Approximately 78m/50g ball.

*Debbie Bliss wool/cotton*: a 50% merino wool, 50% cotton lightweight yarn. Approximately 107m/50g ball.

*Novita Mohair*: an 80% kid mohair, 20% polyamide double knitting yarn. Approximately 200m/50g ball.

*Novita Isoveli*: a 75% wool, 25% polyamide chunky weight yarn. Approximately 130m/100g ball.

*Novita Alpaca*: a 100% alpaca double knitting weight yarn. Approximately 103m/50g ball.

*Jaeger Cashmina 4 ply*: a 4-ply, 80% cashmere, 20% extra-fine merino. Approximately 125m/25g ball.

*Jaeger Silk 4 ply*: a 4-ply, 100% silk yarn. Approximately 180m/50g ball.

*Rowan Spun Double Knitting*: a 100% wool double knitting weight. Approximately 200m/50g hank.

### WASHING AND DRYING YOUR KNITTING

Check the ball band on your yarn for washing instructions. Many yarns can now be machine washed on a delicate wool cycle. You may find it helpful to make a note of the measurements of the garment, such as the width and length, prior to washing. After washing, lay the garment flat and check the measurements again to see if they are the same. If not, smooth and pat it back into shape.

Natural fibres are usually best hand washed, even if the ball band says otherwise. I find that after successive machine washes, cotton in particular can become rather hard. Use soap flakes specially created for hand knits, and warm rather than hot water. Handle the knits gently in the water – do not rub or wring because this can felt the fabric. Rinse well to get rid of any soap, and squeeze out excess water. You may need to get rid of more water by rolling the garment in a towel, or you can use the delicate spin cycle of the washing machine. Dry the garment by laying it out flat on top of a towel to absorb moisture, smooth and pat into shape. Do not dry knits near direct heat such as a radiator.

Store your knits loosely folded to allow the air to circulate.

## Baby's Cotton Jacket with Tie Bow and Bootees

### MATERIALS

Jacket 4(4:5) 50g balls of Debbie Bliss wool/cotton.  
 Bootees One 50g ball of Debbie Bliss wool/cotton.  
 Pair each of 3mm (No 11/US 2) and 3½mm (No 10/US 3) knitting needles.  
 1 button.

### MEASUREMENTS

To fit age	3-6	6-9	9-12	months
Actual chest measurement	60	63	66	cm
	23½	25	26	in
Length	24	26	28	cm
	9½	10¼	11	in
Sleeve length	14	16	18	cm
	5½	6¼	7	in

### TENSION

25 sts and 34 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st on 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

### Jacket

#### BACK AND FRONTS

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 153(161:169) sts.

Moss st row K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep last row 5 times more.

Change to 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Next row Moss st 5, k to last 5 sts, moss st 5.

Next row Moss st 5, p to last 5 sts, moss st 5.

Cont in st st with moss st borders until work measures 13(14:15)cm/5¼(5½:5¾)in from beg, ending with a k row.

#### Left Front

Next row Moss st 5, p34(36:38), turn.

Work on this set of sts only until left front measures 20(22:23)cm/8(8¾:9)in from beg, ending at front edge.

#### Shape Neck

Next row Moss st 5, p4, leave these sts on a safety pin, p to end. 30(32:34) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 22(23:24) sts rem. Cont straight until work measures 24(26:28)cm/9½(10¼:11)in from beg, ending at armhole edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 11(11:12) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 11(12:12) sts.

### BACK

With wrong side facing, join on yarn, p75(79:83), turn. Work on this set of sts only until back measures same as left front to shoulder shaping, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 11(11:12) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 11(12:12) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem 31(33:35) sts on a holder.

#### Right Front

With wrong side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, p to last 5 sts, moss st 5. 39(41:43) sts.

Complete to match left front.

### SLEEVES

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 33(37:41) sts.

Moss st 6 rows as given for Back and Fronts.

Change to 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st, inc one st at each end of the next and every foll 4th row until there are 53(57:61) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 14(16:18)cm/5½(6¼:7)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles and right side facing, slip 9 sts from right front safety pin onto a needle, pick up and k15 sts up right side of front neck, k31(33:35) sts from back neck, pick up and k15 sts down left side of front neck, k4, moss st 5 sts on left front safety pin. 79(81:83) sts.

Moss st 2 rows.

Buttonhole row Moss st 2, work 2tog, yf, moss st to end.

Moss st 2 rows.

Next row Moss st 5, cast off rem sts.

With wrong side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, moss st to end.

Moss st a further 5 rows.

Cast off.

### BOWS (make 2)

With 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 6 sts.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Next row K1, [m1, k1] 5 times. 11 sts.

Work 24 rows moss st.

Cast off.

### TO MAKE UP

Join together cast-on edges of bows. Sew bow to neckband at centre of right front. Fold neckband extension over centre of bow and sew cast-off edge in place. Sew button on back of right front neckband to match buttonhole. Sew on sleeves. Join sleeve seams.





### Bootees (make 2)

#### TO MAKE

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 40 sts.

K 1 row.

Inc row P twice in first st, p18, p twice in each of next 2 sts, p18, p twice in last st.

K 1 row.

Inc row P twice in first st, p20, p twice in each of next 2 sts, p20, p twice in last st.

K 1 row.

Inc row P twice in first st, p22, p twice in each of next 2 sts, p22, p twice in last st.

K 1 row. 52 sts.

Work 6 rows in st st.

#### Shape Instep

Next row K30, skpo, turn.

Next row P9, p2tog, turn.

Next row K9, skpo, turn.

Rep last 2 rows 7 times more, then the first of the 2 rows again.

Next row K to end. 34 sts.

Work 6 rows moss st.

Next row Cast off 15 sts, moss st next 3 sts, cast off rem 15 sts.

With wrong side facing, rejoin yarn to rem 4 sts, moss st to end.

Moss st a further 5 rows.

Cast off.

#### BOWS (make 4)

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 5 sts.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 2 rows.

Next row K1, [m1, k1] 4 times. 9 sts.

Work 12 rows moss st.

Cast off.

#### TO MAKE UP

Join together cast-on edges of bows. Sew bow to moss st band at centre. Fold extension over centre of bow and sew cast-off edge in place. Join back heel and sole seam.



## Double-breasted Moss Stitch Jacket and Hat

### MATERIALS

Jacket 8(8:9) 50g balls of Debbie Bliss merino aran.

Hat Two 50g balls of Debbie Bliss merino/aran.

Pair each of 3½mm (No 9/US 4), 4½mm (No 7/US 7) and 5mm (No 6/US 8) knitting needles.

8 buttons.

### MEASUREMENTS

#### Jacket

To fit ages	1	2	3	years
Actual chest measurement	70	74	79	cm
	27½	29	31	in
Length	35	39	43	cm
	13¾	15½	17	in
Sleeve length	20	22	25	cm
(with cuff turned back)	8	8½	9½	in

#### Hat

To fit 1-3 years

### TENSION

18 sts and 32 rows to 10cm/4in square over moss st on 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

### Jacket

#### BACK

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 65(69:73) sts.

1st row (right side) K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

This row forms the moss st patt.

Cont in moss st until back measures 35(39:43)cm/13¾(15½:17)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 11(12:13) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 12(12:13) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 19(21:21) sts.

#### POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 15(17:19) sts.

Work 11(12:13)cm/4¼(4¾:5¼)in in moss st.

Leave sts on a spare needle.

#### LEFT FRONT

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 43(45:47) sts.

Cont in moss st until front measures 13(14:15)cm/5(5½:6)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.



**Place Pocket**

**Next row** Moss st 6, cast off next 15(17:19) sts, moss st to end.

**Next row** Moss st 22, work across sts of one pocket lining, moss st to end.

Cont in moss st until front measures 30(34:38)cm/11½(13½:15)in from beg, ending with a right-side row.

**Shape Neck**

Cast off 15(16:17) sts at beg of next row.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 23(24:26) sts rem.

Cont straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 11(12:13) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 12(12:13) sts.

**RIGHT FRONT**

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 43(45:47) sts.

Cont in moss st until front measures 13(14:15)cm/5(5½:6)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

**Place Pocket**

**Next row** Moss st 22, cast off next 15(17:19) sts, moss st to end.

**Next row** Moss st 6, work across sts of one pocket lining, moss st to end.

Cont in patt until front measures 14(15:16)cm/5½(6:6½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

**Buttonhole row** Moss st 3, yf, work 2tog, moss st 10, yf, work 2tog, moss st to end.

Cont in patt until front measures 21.5(24:26.5)cm/8½(9½:10½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Work the buttonhole row again.

Cont in patt until front measures 29(33:37)cm/11½(13:14½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Work the buttonhole row again.

Cont in moss st until front measures 30(34:38)cm/11½(13½:15)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

**Shape Neck**

Cast off 15(16:17) sts at beg of next row.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 23(24:26) sts rem.

Cont straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 11(12:13) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 12(12:13) sts.

**SLEEVES**

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 35(39:43) sts.

Work 5(6:7)cm/2(2½:2¾)in in moss st.

Change to 4½mm (No 7/US 7) needles.

Work 5(6:7)cm/2(2½:2¾)in in moss st.

Change to 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles.

Cont in moss st and inc one st at each end of the 3rd and every

4th row until there are 55(61:67) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 25(28:32)cm/10(11:12½)in from beg.

Cast off.

**COLLAR**

Join shoulder seams.

With 3½mm (No 9/US 4) needles and right side facing, miss first cast-off 10 sts, pick up and k5(6:7) sts from rem cast-off sts, 18 sts up left side of front, 19(21:21) sts across back neck, 18 sts down right side of front neck, 5(6:7) sts from first cast-off sts. 65(69:71) sts.

**Next row** Moss st to end.

**Next 2 rows** Moss st to last 5(6:7) sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Moss st to last 8(9:10) sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Moss st to last 11(12:13) sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Moss st to last 14(15:16) sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Moss st to last 17(18:19) sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Moss st to last 20(21:22) sts, turn.

Moss st to end.

Work 18 rows moss st. Cast off.

**BACK BELT**

With 3½mm (No 9/US 4) needles cast on 49(53:55) sts.

Work 2.5cm/1in in moss st. Cast off.

**TO MAKE UP**

Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams reversing seam on last 7(8:9)cm/2¾(3:3½)in of cuff. Sew down pocket linings. Sew on buttons. Secure belt in place with buttons.

**Hat****TO MAKE**

Using 4½mm (No 7/US 7) needles cast on 80 sts.

**Rib row** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep the last row 4 times more.

**Inc row** K2, \* m1, k3, m1, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, m1, k3. 111 sts.

Change to 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles.

Cont in moss st until work measures 10cm/4in from beg.

**Shape Top**

**Dec row** K1, \* work 3tog, moss st 19; rep from \* to end. Moss st 1 row.

**Dec row** K1, \* work 3tog, moss st 17; rep from \* to end. Moss st 1 row.

**Dec row** K1, \* work 3tog, moss st 15; rep from \* to end. Moss st 1 row.

Cont in this way dec 10 sts on every alt row until 11 sts rem. Moss st 1 row.

Break off yarn thread through rem sts, pull up and secure. Join seam.

**Striped Scarf****MATERIALS**

Two 50g balls each of Debbie Bliss merino double knitting in Brown (A) and Light Pink (B).

One ball each of same in Rust (C) and Fuchsia Pink (D).

Pair of 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needles.

Long circular 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needle.

**MEASUREMENTS**

Scarf measures 14cm x 109cm/5½in x 43in.

**TENSION**

41 sts and 28 rows to 10cm/4in square over rib patt on 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

**ABBREVIATIONS**

See page 7.

**TO MAKE**

With 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and A, cast on 58 sts.

**1st rib row** K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

**2nd rib row** P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form the rib patt.

Cont in rib and stripe patt as follows:

9 rows A, 2 rows D, 2 rows A, 2 rows C, 1 row A, 4 rows B, 1 row D, 1 row C, 9 rows B, 1 row D, 2 rows B, 2 rows A, 1 row D, 1 row A, 2 rows C, 1 row A, 1 row D, 10 rows A, 11 rows B, 1 row D, 1 row C, 1 row B, 1 row D, 3 rows B, 4 rows A, [1 row C, 1 row A] twice, 2 rows D, 8 rows A, 6 rows B, 1 row C, 1 row B, 2 rows D, 1 row B, 1 row C, 6 rows B, 2 rows A, 2 rows C, 10 rows A, 2 rows D, 2 rows A, 5 rows B, 1 row C, 1 row D, 2 rows B, 1 row D, 8 rows B, 5 rows A, 1 row D, 2 rows A, 1 row C – the last row is the centre of the scarf, now work stripe patt in reverse order.

Using A, work 2 more rows, cast off.

**EDGINGS (both sides alike)**

With wrong side facing and using circular 4mm (No 8/US 6) needle, pick up and k224 sts along side edge.

Beg with a p row, work 3 rows st st.

Cast off.

**TO COMPLETE**

Fold edgings to right side, stitch cast-off edge in place, encasing ends. Make 2 pompoms each in B and D and 1 each A and C. Sew 3 pompoms to each short end.



## Dress with Fair Isle Border

## MATERIALS

4(4) 50g balls Rowan Spun Double Knitting in Main Colour (M)  
 1 ball each of Rowan Wool Cotton in Blue (B), Cream (C), Red (D),  
 Pink (E) and Oatmeal (F).  
 Pair of 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needles.  
 1 short 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) circular knitting needle.  
 1 button.

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit	18-24	24-36	months
Actual chest measurement	62	67	cm
	24½	26½	in
Length	40	45	cm
	15½	17½	in
Sleeve length	22	24	cm
	8½	9½	in

## TENSION

21 sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st on 4mm  
 (No 8/US 6) needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

## NOTE

Read chart from right to left on right side rows and from left to right  
 on wrong side rows. When working in pattern, strand yarn not in  
 use loosely across wrong side to keep fabric elastic.

## BACK

With 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and M, cast on 87(87) sts.  
 Beg with a k row, work 6 rows in st st.  
 Join on B.  
 Using B, k 2 rows to form hemline.  
 Cut off B. Cont in M.  
 Beg with a k row, work 10 rows in st st.  
 Work in patt from Chart until 13 rows of Chart have been worked.  
 Cont in M and st st, at the same time dec one st at each end of  
 the next and every foll 5th(6th) row until 67(73) sts rem.  
 Work straight until back measures 28(32)cm/11(12½)in from  
 hemline, ending with a p row.

## Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.  
 Dec one st at each end of the next and every foll alt row until  
 45(49) sts rem, ending with a p row.

## Back Opening

Next row K21(23) sts, turn and work on these sts for first side of  
 back opening.

Next row Cast on 3 sts, p to end.

Beg with a k row, work 12(14) rows in st st.

## Shape Neck

Next row K to last 8(9) sts, leave these sts on a holder, turn.

Next row Cast off 3 sts, p to end.

K 1 row.

Next row Cast off 2 sts, p to end.


Beg with a k row, work 2 rows in st st.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off 5(6) sts at beg of next row.

P 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 sts.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, k to end.

Beg with a p row, work 9(11) rows in st st.

**Shape Neck**

Next row K 8(9) sts, leave these sts on a holder, k to end.

P 1 row.

Next row Cast off 3 sts, k to end.

P 1 row.

Next row Cast off 2 sts, k to end.

Beg with a p row, work 2 rows in st st.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 5(6) sts at beg of next row.

K 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 sts.

#### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures 36(41)cm/14¼(16 ½)in from hemline, ending with a p row.

**Shape Neck**

Next row K16(18) sts, turn and work on these sts for first side of neck shaping.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Dec one st at neck edge on every foll alt row until 11(12) sts rem.

Cont without further shaping until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 5(6) sts at beg of next row.

P 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 13 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn, k to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shaping.

#### SLEEVES

With 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and M, cast on 34(36) sts.

Beg with a k row, work 6 rows in st st.

Join on B.

Using B, k 2 rows to form hemline.

Cut off B. Cont in M.

Beg with a k row, work 10 rows in st st.

Working in st st, inc one st at each end of the next and every foll 5th row until there are 50(54) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 22(24)cm/8¾(9½)in from hemline, ending with a p row.

**Shape Top**

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec one st at each end of the next 5 rows, then on 3(4) foll alt rows. Dec one st at each end of every row until 10(12) sts rem.

Cast off.

#### NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.

With right side facing and using 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) circular knitting needle and M, slip 8(9) sts from left back onto needle, pick up and k10(11) sts up left back to shoulder, 16(18) sts down left front neck, k across 13 sts from front neck holder, pick up and k16(18) sts up right front neck to shoulder, 10(11) sts from right back neck, k across 8(9) sts on back neck holder. 81(89) sts.

Work backwards and forwards in rows as follows:

Beg with a p row, work 3 rows in st st.

Join on B.

Using B, k 2 rows to form hemline.

Cut off B. Cont in M.

Beg with a k row, work 4 rows in st st.

Cast off in rib

#### TO MAKE UP

Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams. Fold all hems to wrong side and slip stitch in place. Sew on button.



Work in patt from Chart at the same time inc and work into patt one st at each end of the 3rd and every foll 4th row until there are 73(79:83) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 20(23:26)cm/8(9:10¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Cast off.

**RIGHT COLLAR**

Join shoulder seams.

With right side facing and using 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles and M, slip 3 sts from holder onto a needle, turn, moss st 3.

Cont in moss st at the same time inc one st at inside edge, on next and every foll alt row until there are 19 sts. Cont straight until shaped edge fits along shaped edge of jacket to shoulder, ending at straight edge.

**Shape Collar**

**Next 2 rows** Moss st 11, turn, sl 1, moss st to end.

Moss st 6 rows.

Rep last 8 rows until the shorter edge fits halfway across back neck sts. Cast off.

**LEFT COLLAR**

With right side facing and using 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles and M, moss st 3 sts from holder.

Complete to match right collar.

**TO MAKE UP**

Sew on sleeves. Join sleeve seams. Sew in zip.

2nd row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Both sizes**

Rep last 2 rows 13(15) times more.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 72(84) rows.

**Shape Shoulders**

Cast off 12(13) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 13(14) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 24(24) sts.

1st row \* P2, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

2nd row K1, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

Both sizes

Rep last 2 rows 12(14) times more and 1st row again.

2nd row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Both sizes

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Buttonhole row K3, p2tog, yrn, rib to end of row.

Rib a further 7(9) rows.

Rep buttonhole row once more.

Rib a further 7(9) rows.

Rep buttonhole row once more.

Rib a further 6(6) rows.

Next row Rib 8(10), cast off next 22 sts, rib next 5 sts, inc in next st, leave rem 7 sts on a holder.

Next row K7, k across sts of pocket lining, k8(10). 37(39) sts.

Beg with a p row, work in st st for 63(71) rows.

**Shape Neck**

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next row.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 25(27) sts rem.

Work straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 12(13) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 13(14) sts.

**SLEEVES**

With 6mm (No 4/US 10) needles cast on 30(34) sts.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3(4) times more.

Change to 5½mm (No 5/US 9) needles.

Work a further 8(10) rows in rib, inc 6 sts on last row. 36(40) sts.

Change to 6mm (No 4/US 10) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st, inc one st at each end of the 3rd and every foll 4th row until there are 56(64) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 28(34)cm/11(13½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Cast off.

**BUTTON BAND**

Join shoulder seams.

With 5½mm (No 5/US 9) needles and right side facing, k3, p2, k3 across sts on left front holder.

Next row K1, p2, k2, p2, k1.

Next row K3, p2, k3.

These 2 rows set the rib.

Work a further 59(67) rows.

Leave sts on a holder.

**BUTTONHOLE BAND**

With 5½mm (No 5/US 9) needles and wrong side facing, inc in first st, p2, k2, p2, k1 across sts on right front holder.

Next row K3, p2, k3.

Next row K1, p2, k2, p2, k1.

These 2 rows set the rib.

Work a further 60(68) rows, working 4 more buttonholes, as before, but now with 15(17) rows between.

Leave sts on a holder, do not break yarn.

**COLLAR**

Join shoulder seams.

Sew front bands in place.

With 5½mm (No 5/US 9) needles and right side facing, cast off 5 sts, then k rem 2 sts on buttonhole band, pick up and k16(18) sts up right front neck, 21(23) sts from back neck, 16(18) sts down left front neck, k3, p2, k3 from button band. 64(70) sts.



Next row Cast off 5 sts, p1, k1, \* p2, k1; rep from \* to end. 59(65) sts.

This row sets the rib patt with garter st edge sts.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 20 sts, turn.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 16 sts, turn.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 12 sts, turn.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 8 sts, turn.

Rib to end.

Next row K1, p2, \* inc in next st, p2; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Next row K3, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

Next row K1, p2, \* k2, p2, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more.

Cast off in rib.

#### BELT

With 5/8mm (No 5/US 9) needles cast on 8 sts.

1st row K3, p2, k3.

2nd row K1, p2, k2, p2, k1.

Rep last 2 rows until belt measures 120cm/47 1/2 in from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Cast off in rib.

#### TO MAKE UP

Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams reversing seam for cuff for 4cm/1 1/2 in. Sew on buttons. Sew down pocket linings.

Make 2 belt carriers on side seam at waist level

#### Hat

##### TO MAKE

With 6mm (No 4/US 10) needles cast on 74(78) sts.

1st rib row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd rib row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows for 4cm/1 1/2 in, ending with a 1st rib row.

Change to 5/8mm (No 5/US 9) needles.

Beg with 1st rib row, work in rib for a further 4cm/1 1/2 in.

Change to 6mm (No 4/US 10) needles and cont in rib until hat measures 20(24)cm/8(9 1/2) in from beg, ending with a 2nd rib row.

1st row K2, \* p2tog, k2; rep from \* to end.

5th row K2tog, \* p1, k2tog; rep from \* to end.

6th row P1, \* k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

7th row K1, \* k2tog; rep from \* to end.

8th row P1(0), \* p2tog; rep from \* to end.

Break off yarn, thread end through rem sts, pull up and secure.

Join seam reversing seam on last 4cm/1 1/2 in.

Rep last 2 rows 3(5:5) times more and the first row again.

##### Shape Neck

Next 2 rows K1, sl 1, turn, sl 1, k1.

Next 2 rows K2, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k2.

Next 2 rows K1, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k1.

Next row K5 sts and slip these sts onto a safety pin, p to end.

Next row K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Next row P1, p2tog, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows until 20(22:24) sts rem.

Work 5(7:5) rows straight.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 10(11:12) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 10(11:12) sts.

#### RIGHT FRONT

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 78(82:92) sts.

K 9 rows.

Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Next row K to end.

Next row P to last 5 sts, k5.

Rep last 2 rows 4(6:6) times more.

#### Shape Neck

Next 2 rows K1, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k1.

Next 2 rows K2, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k2.

Next 2 rows K3, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k3.

Next 2 rows K2, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k2.

Next 2 rows K1, sl 1, tum, sl 1, k1.

Next row K6, sl 1, k1, pssso, k to end.

Next row P to last 8 sts, p2tog tbl, p1, slip last 5 sts on a safety pin.

Next row K1, sl 1, k1, pssso, k to end.

Next row P to last 3 sts, p2tog tbl, p1.

Rep last 2 rows until 20(22:24) sts rem.

Work 5(7:5) rows straight.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 10(11:12) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 10(11:12) sts.

#### SLEEVES

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 38(42:46) sts.

K 9 rows.

Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Beg with a k row, cont in st st at the same time inc one st at each

end of the 3rd and every foll 6th row until there are 56(64:70) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 18(22:24)cm/7(8½:9½)in from

beg, ending with a p row. Cast off.

#### RIGHT COLLAR

Join shoulder seams.

Position right front over left front and place a marker thread on both fronts where they cross.

With right side facing and using 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles, slip 5 sts from safety pin onto a needle, turn, k5.

Cont in garter st (every row k) until band is long enough to fit along neck edge to marker, now inc one st at inside edge, on next and every foll alt row until there are 24 sts. Cont straight until shaped edge fits along shaped edge to shoulder, ending at straight edge.

#### Shape Collar

Next 2 rows K13, tum, sl 1, k to end.

K 6 rows.

Rep last 8 rows until the shorter edge fits halfway across back neck sts. Cast off.

#### LEFT COLLAR

With right side facing and using 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles, k5 sts from safety pin, tum k5.

Complete to match right collar.

#### TIES

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles needles cast on 5 sts.

Cont in garter st until tie measures 36(42:48)cm/14¼(16½:19)in. Cast off.

#### TO MAKE UP

Sew on sleeves. Sew ties to fronts level with neck shaping. Join side and sleeve seams, leaving small opening in right seam level with neck shaping. Join collar seam and sew to neck edge.

### Bootees (make 2)

#### TO MAKE

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles for first size or 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles for second size cast on 36 sts.

K 21 rows.

#### Shape Instep

Next row K24, tum.

Next row K12, tum.

Work 24 rows in garter st (every row k) on centre 12 sts for instep. Break off yarn.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn at base of instep and pick up and k12 sts along side of instep, k across centre 12 sts then pick up and k12 sts along other side of instep, k rem 12 sts. 60 sts.

K 12 rows. Break off yarn.

#### Shape Sole

Next row Slip first 24 sts onto right-hand needle, rejoin yarn and k12 sts, tum.

Next row K11, k2tog, tum.

Rep last row until 12 sts rem.

Next row [K2tog] to end.

Cut off yarn, thread through rem sts and fasten off.

Join back seam.

Inc row (right side) K2, \* m1, k1, p2, k1, rep from \* to last 2 sts, m1, k2. 145(155:165) sts.

Next row P4, \* k2, p3; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k2, p4.

Next row K4, \* p2, k3; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p2, k4.

Rep last 2 rows until work measures 64(66:68) cm/25¼(26:26½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

### Shape Neck

Next row Rib 56(61:66) sts, turn and work on these sts for first side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge on next 5 rows. 51(56:61) sts.

Next row K2, k2tog, \* p2, k1, k2tog, rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2. 41(45:49) sts.

Cast off.

With right side facing, slip centre 33 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

Dec one st at neck edge on next 5 rows. 51(56:61) sts.

Next row \* P2, k1, k2tog, rep from \* to last 6 sts, p2, k1, k2tog, k1. 41(45:49) sts.

Cast off.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures 58(60:62)cm/22¼(23¼:24½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

### Shape Neck

Next row Rib 61(66:71) sts, turn and work on these sts for first side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge on next 5 rows and 5 foll alt rows.

51(56:61) sts.

Cont straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending with a wrong-side row.

Next row K2, k2tog, \* p2, k1, k2tog, rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2. 41(45:49) sts.

Cast off.

With right side facing, slip centre 23 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and patt to end.

Dec one st at neck edge on next 5 rows and 5 foll alt rows.

51(56:61) sts.

Cont straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending with a wrong-side row.

Next row \* P2, k1, k2tog, rep from \* to last 6 sts, p2, k1, k2tog, k1. 41(45:49) sts.

Cast off.

### SLEEVES

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 54(58:62) sts.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 6cm/2½in, ending with a 2nd row.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 4 rows.

Next row K2, m1, k to last 2 sts, m1, k2.

Inc one st at each end of row, as set, on every foll 4th row until there are 88(92:96) sts.

P 1 row.

Inc row K2, \* m1, k1, p2, k1, rep from \* to last 2 sts, m1, k2. 110(115:120) sts.

Next row [P3, k2] 22(23:24) times.

Next row [P2, k3] 22(23:24) times.

These 2 rows set the rib patt.

Cont in rib patt, inc one st at each end of the 2nd and every foll 4th row until there are 136(141:146) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 46(48:49)cm/18(19:19¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Cast off in rib.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and right side facing, pick up and k26 sts down left side of front neck, k1, k2tog, [p2, k1, k2tog]

4 times across sts on front neck holder, pick up and k25 sts up right side of front neck, k5 sts down right side of back neck, k1,

k2tog, [p2, k1, k2tog] 6 times across sts on back neck holder, pick up and k6 sts up left side of back neck. 106 sts.

Next row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Next row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.


Rep last 2 rows for 8cm/3in then change to 4mm(No 8/US 6)

needles and work a further 10cm/4in in rib.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seam, reversing seam on last 10cm/4in. Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams, leaving garter st edging free.





## Mohair Cushion

### MATERIALS

Two 50g balls of Novita Mohair.  
Pair of 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needles.  
40cm x 40cm/15½in x 15½in cushion pad.

### MEASUREMENTS

Cushion cover measures 40cm x 40cm/15½in x 15½in.

### TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st on 4mm  
(No 8/US 6) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

### TO MAKE

Using 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles cast on 90 sts.  
Cont in st st until piece measures 100cm/39½in from beg.  
Cast off.

### TO MAKE UP

Leaving last 20cm/8in free, with right sides together, join side seams. Turn to right side, fold last 20cm/8in to inside.

## Mohair Throw

### MATERIALS

Six 50g balls of Novita Mohair.  
Pair of 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needles.  
4.6m/5yd of 5cm/2in wide satin ribbon if required.

### MEASUREMENTS

Throw measures approximately 80cm x 145cm/31½in x 57in  
(excluding edging).

### TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st on 4mm  
(No 8/US 6) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

### MAIN PART

With 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles cast on 160 sts.  
1st row \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.  
2nd row \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end.  
Rep last 2 rows twice more.  
Next row Moss st 4, k to last 4 sts, moss st 4.  
Next row Moss st 4, p to last 4 sts, moss st 4.  
Rep last 2 rows until work measures 143cm/56½in from beg,  
ending with a wrong-side row.  
1st row \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.  
2nd row \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end.  
Rep last 2 rows once more and the first row again.  
Cast off in patt.

### TO COMPLETE

If you would like to make your throw more decorative cover moss st border with ribbon as follows: with right side facing, hand stitch the edge of the ribbon to the inner edge of the moss st border, **at the same time** mitre the ribbon to fit the corners of throw. Fold the ribbon over the edge and stitch the opposite edge of the ribbon to the inner edge of the moss st border on the wrong side of the throw.

Pair of 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) knitting needles.

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 113(119:129) sts.

**1st row (right side)** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

This row forms the moss st patt.

Moss st 15(17:19) rows.

Dec one st at each end of the next and every foll 6th row until 101(107:119) sts rem.

Work straight until back measures 15(16:17)cm/6(6½:6¾)in from beg, ending with a right-side row.

Inc one st at each end of the next and every foll 6th row until there are 101(107:119) sts.

Work straight until back measures 32(34:36)cm/12½(13½:14½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Armholes

Cast off 5(6:7) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec one st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 83(87:91) sts rem.

Work straight until back measures 50(53:56)cm/19½(21:22)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Back Neck

**Next row** Patt 32(34:35) sts, turn and work on these sts for first side of neck shaping.

**Next row** Cast off 4 sts, patt to end.

#### Shape Shoulder

**Next row** Cast off 9 sts, patt to end.

**Next row** Cast off 2 sts, patt to end.

**Next row** Cast off 9(10:10) sts, patt to end.

**Next row** Patt to end.

**Next row** Cast off rem 8(9:10) sts.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off 19(19:21) sts, patt to end. Complete to match first side.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures 37(39:41)cm/14½(15½:16)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Front Opening

**Next row** Moss st 50(53:59), turn and work on these sts for first side of neck. Work 21 rows.

#### Shape Neck

**Next row** Patt to last 8 sts, leave these sts on a holder.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 26(28:29) sts rem.

Work straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at armhole edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

**Next row** Cast off 9 sts, patt to end.

**Next row** Patt to end.

**Next row** Cast off 9(10:10) sts, patt to end.

**Next row** Patt to end.

**Next row** Cast off rem 8(9:10) sts.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off one st, patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

### SLEEVES

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 49(53:55) sts.

Moss st 10 rows as given for Back.

Cont in moss st **at the same time** inc and work into patt one st at each end of the next and every foll 7th row until there are 85(91:97) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 38(40:42)cm/15(15½:16½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 5(6:7) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec one st at each end of every foll alt row until 57(59:61) sts rem.

Work 3 rows.

Dec one st at each end of the next and every foll 6th row until 51(53:55) sts rem, then on every foll alt row until 45(45:47) sts rem.

Dec one st at each end of the next 4 rows.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 29(29:31) sts.

### NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.


With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) circular needle and right side facing, pick up and k15 sts along straight front edge, k8 sts from holder, pick up and k15 sts to shoulder, 6 sts down right back, 19(19:21) sts across back neck, 6 sts up left back neck, 15 sts down left front neck, 8 sts from front neck holder, pick up and k15 sts along straight front edge. 107(107:109) sts.

K 1 row.

Cast off.

### TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves.

 Pair of 5mm (No 6/US 8) knitting needles.  
 Cable needle.

**C4B** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle, hold at back, k2, k2 from cable needle.

### BACK and FRONT (both alike)

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 84(89:96) sts.

Beg with a k row, work 10 rows in st st.

**Dec row** K3, skpo, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

Beg with a p row, work 11 rows in st st.

Rep last 12 rows once more and the dec row again, 78(83:90) sts.

Beg with a p row, work 15 rows in st st.

**Inc row** K3, m1, k to last 3 sts, m1, k3.

Rep last 16 rows once more, 82(87:94) sts.

Beg with a p row, cont in st st until work measures  
 37(37:38)cm/14½(14½:15)in from beg, ending with a p row.

### Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 3(3:4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

**1st row** K3, skpo, C4F, k to last 9 sts, C4B, k2tog, k3.

**2nd row** P to end.

**3rd row** K3, skpo, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

**4th row** P to end.

Rep last 4 rows until 30(31:32) sts rem, ending with a p row.

Beg with a k row, work 12 rows st st.

Cast off.

### SLEEVES

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 44(47:52) sts.

Beg with a k row, work 10 rows in st st.

**Inc row** K3, m1, k to last 3 sts, m1, k3.

Beg with a p row, work 7 rows in st st.

Rep last 8 rows until there are 68(73:80) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 43(44:45)cm/17(17½:17¾)in  
 from beg, ending with a p row.

### Shape Raglan Top

Cast off 3(3:4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

**1st row** K3, skpo, C4F, k to last 9 sts, C4B, k2tog, k3.

**2nd row** P to end.

**3rd row** K3, skpo, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

**4th row** P to end.

Rep last 4 rows until 16(17:18) sts rem, ending with a p row.

Beg with a k row, work 12 rows st st.

Cast off.

### TO MAKE UP

Join raglan seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Press edges flat  
 to prevent rolling.



## Ribbed Sweater

8(10) 50g balls of Debbie Bliss merino double knitting in Main Colour (M).  
1(2) balls of same in Contrast Colour (C).  
\*Pair each of 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) and 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needles.

### TENSION

36 sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in square over rib patt (slightly stretched) on 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

### BACK

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and C, cast on 146(162) sts.  
1st row (right side) K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.



2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib patt.

Cont in patt until back measures 4(5)cm/1½(2)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and M.

Cont in patt until back measures 40(45)cm/15¾(17¾)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 24(27) sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Leave rem 50(54) sts on a holder.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures 35(39)cm/13¾(15¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

### Shape Neck

Next row Patt 58(64), turn and work on these sts for first side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 48(54) sts rem.

Work straight until front matches Back to shoulder shaping, ending at armhole edge.

### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 24(27) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 24(27) sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 30(34) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

### SLEEVES

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and C, cast on 68(70) sts.

Work 4(5)cm/1½(2)in in rib as given for Back, ending with a wrong-side row.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and M.

Cont in patt, inc one st at each end of every alt row until there are 96(84) sts, then on every foll 3rd row until there are 108(116) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 25(31)cm/10(12¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder.

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M and with right side facing, pick up and k18 sts down left side of front neck, rib across sts on front neck holder, pick up and k16(20) sts up right side of front neck, then rib back neck sts. 114(126) sts.

Cont in rib across all sts for 12cm/4¾in.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder seam and neckband, reversing seam on last 6cm/2¼in. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seam. Join side and sleeve seams.

12(13:14) 50g balls of Debbie Bliss wool/cotton.  
Pair each of 3mm (No 11/US 2) and 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) knitting needles.  
8 buttons.

### RIGHT BACK

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 61(67:73) sts.  
Moss st row K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.  
Rep last row 6 times more.  
Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.  
1st row (right side) K to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice.  
2nd row [K1, p1] twice, k1, p to end.  
These 2 rows set the st st with moss st border.  
Rep last 2 rows 17 times more.  
37th row Patt to last 5 sts, cast off these 5 sts.  
Leave rem 56(62:68) sts on a needle.

38th row P to end, then p across sts of Right Back. 117(129:141) sts.  
1st dec row K28(31:34), dec 2tog, k55(61:67), dec 2tog,

k28(31:34), 113(125:137) sts.  
St st 3 rows straight.  
2nd dec row K27(30:33), dec 2tog, k53(59:65), dec 2tog, k27(30:33), 109(121:133) sts.  
St st 3 rows straight.  
Cont to dec in this way on the next and every foll 4th row until 85(97:109) sts rem.  
St st 3(5:7) rows straight.  
1st inc row K21(24:27), m1, k1, m1, k41(47:53), m1, k1, m1, k21(24:27), 89(101:113) sts.  
St st 3 rows straight.  
2nd inc row K22(25:28), m1, k1, m1, k43(49:55), m1, k1, m1, k22(25:28), 93(105:117) sts.  
St st 3 rows straight.  
Cont to inc in this way on the next and every foll 4th row until there are 117(129:141) sts.  
Cont straight until back measures 36(37:38)cm/14¼(14½:15)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.  
**Shape Armholes**  
Cast off 6(7:8) sts at beg of next 2 rows.  
Dec one st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 93(99:105) sts rem.  
Cont straight until back measures 56(58:60)cm/22(23:23¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.  
**Shape Shoulders**  
Cast off 10(11:11) sts at beg of next 4 rows and 9(9:11) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.  
Cast off rem 35(37:39) sts.

### LEFT FRONT

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 61(67:73) sts.  
Moss st row K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.  
Rep last row 6 times more.  
Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.  
1st row (right side) K to last 4 sts, [p1, k1] twice.  
2nd row [K1, p1] twice, k1, p to end.  
These 2 rows set the st st with moss st border.  
Work a further 36 rows.  
1st dec row K28(31:34), dec 2tog, k26(29:32), [p1, k1] twice, 59(65:71) sts.  
Work 3 rows straight.  
2nd dec row K27(30:33), dec 2tog, k25(28:31), [p1, k1] twice, 57(63:69) sts.  
Work 3 rows straight.  
Cont to dec in this way on the next and every foll 4th row until 45(51:57) sts rem.  
Work 3(5:7) rows straight.  
1st inc row K21(24:27), m1, k1, m1, k19(22:25), [p1, k1] twice, 47(53:59) sts.  
Work 3 rows straight.  
2nd inc row K22(25:28), m1, k1, m1, k20(23:26), [p1, k1] twice, 49(55:61) sts.



Work 3 rows straight.

Cont to inc in this way on the next and every foll 4th row until there are 61(67:73) sts.

Cont straight until front measures 36(37:38)cm/14¼(14½:15)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Armhole

Cast off 6(7:8) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Dec one st at beg of next and every foll alt row until 49(52:55) sts rem.

Cont straight until front measures 51(52:53)cm/20(20½:21)in from beg, ending with a right-side row.

#### Shape Neck

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 29(31:33) sts rem.

Work straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at armhole edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 10(11:11) sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row

Cast off rem 9(9:11) sts.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Mark position for buttons: the 1st 2cm/¾in from beg, the 8th 1cm/½in from beg of neck shaping, and the rem 6 spaced evenly between.

Work buttonholes to match markers as folls:

**Buttonhole row (right side)** K1, p1, k2tog, yf, k1, patt to end.

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 61(67:73) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep the last row 6 times more.

Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

**1st row (right side)** [K1, p1] twice, k to end.

**2nd row** P to last 5 sts, k1, [p1, k1] twice.

These 2 rows set the st st with moss st border.

Work a further 36 rows.

**1st dec row** [K1, p1] twice, k26(29:32), dec 2tog, k28(31:34). 59(65:71) sts.

Work 3 rows straight.

**2nd dec row** [K1, p1] twice, k25(28:31), dec 2tog, k27(30:33). 57(63:69) sts.

Work 3 rows straight.

Complete to match left front, reversing all shapings.

#### SLEEVES

##### Cuffs

**First Half** With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 25(27:29) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep last row 24 times more.

Leave these sts on a spare needle.

**Second Half** With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 25(27:29) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.



Rep last row 24 times more.

**Next row** Moss st 24(26:28), work last st of second half tog with first st of first half, moss st 24(26:28). 49(53:57) sts.

Work a further 23 rows in moss st.

Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Cont in st st, inc one st at each end of the next and every foll 7th row until there are 81(87:93) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 47(49:51)cm/18½(19¼:20)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 6(7:8) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec one st at each end of next 3 rows and every foll alt row until 47(49:51) sts rem.

Now dec one st each end of every foll 4th row until 35 sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Dec one st at each end of next and 2 foll alt rows.

Dec one st at each end of next 5 rows.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 13 sts.

Cast off.

#### COLLAR

With 3mm (No 11/US 2) needles cast on 33(37:41) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Working in moss st, cast on 10 sts at beg of next 4 rows.

**Next row** Cast on 10 sts, k1, p2, k1, [k1, p1] 3 times across these sts, then moss st to end.

**Next row** Cast on 10 sts, k3, p1, [k1, p1] 3 times across these sts, moss st to last 4 sts, p1, k3. 93(97:101) sts.

Work in patt as folls:

**1st row** K1, p2, k2, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k1, p2, k1.

**2nd row (inc row)** K3, p1, m1, moss st to last 4 sts, m1, p1, k3.

**3rd row** K1, p2, k1, moss st to last 4 sts, k1, p2, k1.

**4th row** K3, p1, moss st to last 4 sts, p1, k3.

**5th row (inc row)** K1, p2, k1, m1, moss st to last 4 sts, m1, k1, p2, k1.

**6th row** As 4th row.

**7th row** As 3rd row.

Rep 2nd to 7th rows twice more, then 2nd and 3rd rows again.

Cast off in patt.



#### TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams reversing seam on halves of cuff to fold back. Sew on buttons. Sew cast-off sts on back vent to wrong side. Sew cast-on edge of collar to neck edge, placing edges of collar halfway across front bands. Secure cuff turn backs on sleeve seam.

Rep last row once more.

Cut off C.

Join on M.

Rib a further 6(8:10) rows.

Change to 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Beg with a k row, cont in st st until back measures

25(30:35)cm/10(12:13¾)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 9(10:11) sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 30(32:36) sts.

#### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures 17(20:23)cm/6¾(8:9)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Front Opening

Next row K30(33:37), turn and work on these sts for first side of

neck.

Work straight for 4(5:6)cm/1½(2:2½)in, ending at side edge.

#### Shape Neck

Next row K to last 5(6:7) sts, leave these sts on a safety pin.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 18(20:22) sts rem.

Work straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 9(10:11) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 9(10:11) sts.

With right side facing, cast off centre 6 sts, k to end.

With right side facing and using 2½mm (No 12/US 2) needles and

M, pick up and k3 sts from second half of buttonhole band, k5(6:7)

sts from safety pin, pick up and k16(18:20) sts up right side of front

neck, k30(32:36) sts from back neck, pick up and k17(19:21) sts

down left side of front neck, 5(6:7) sts from safety pin, k3 sts from

first half of button band. 79(87:97) sts.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 20(24:28) sts, turn.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 16(20:24) sts, turn.

Next 2 rows Rib to last 12(16:20) sts, turn.

Cont in this way, working 4 more sts at end of every row, work 2(4:6) rows.

Rib a further 6(8) rows.

Beg with a k row, cont in st st.

Work 2(4) rows.

Dec row K5, k2tog, k to last 7 sts, skpo, k5.

Work 5(7) rows.

Dec row K4, k2tog, k to last 6 sts, skpo, k4.

Work 1(3) rows.

Dec row K3, [k2tog, k6(7)] 3 times, k2tog, k3(4). 28(32) sts.

#### Shape Heel

Next row P8(9) sts only, turn.

Work 9 rows in st st on these 8(9) sts only.

Dec row P2(3), p2tog, p1, turn.

Next row Sl 1, k3(4).

Dec row P3(4), p2tog, p1, turn.

Next row Sl 1, k4(5).

Dec row P4(5), p2tog.

Leave rem 5(6) sts on a holder.

With wrong side facing, slip centre 12(14) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem 8(9) sts, p to end.

Work 8 rows in st st on these 8(9) sts.

Dec row K2(3), k2tog tbl, k1, turn.

Next row Sl 1, p3(4).

Dec row K3(4), k2tog tbl, k1, turn.

Next row Sl 1, p4(5).

Dec row K4(5), k2tog tbl, turn.

Next row Sl 1, p4(5).

#### Shape Instep

Next row K5(6), pick up and k8 sts evenly along inside edge of heel, k12(14) sts from holder, pick up and k8 sts along inside edge of heel and k5(6) sts from holder. 38(42) sts.

P 1 row.

Dec row K11(12), k2tog, k12(14), k2tog tbl, k11(12).

P 1 row.

Dec row K10(11), k2tog, k12(14), k2tog tbl, k10(11).

P 1 row.

Dec row K9(10), k2tog, k12(14), k2tog tbl, k9(10).

P 1 row.

Dec row K8(9), k2tog, k12(14), k2tog tbl, k8(9). 30(34) sts.

Work 13(17) rows straight.

#### Shape Toe

Dec row K1, [k2tog tbl, k5(6)] 4 times, k1.

P 1 row.

Dec row K1, [k2tog tbl, k4(5)] 4 times, k1.

P 1 row.

Cut off M.

Join on C.

Dec row K1, [k2tog tbl, k3(4)] 4 times, k1.

P 1 row.

Dec row K1, [k2tog tbl, k2(3)] 4 times, k1.

#### 2nd size only

P 1 row.

Dec row K1, [k2tog tbl, k2] 4 times, k1.

#### Both sizes

Dec row [P2tog tbl] 7 times.

Break off yarn, thread through rem sts and fasten off. Join seam.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3(4:5) times more.

Beg with a k row, work in st st until back measures  
20(22:24)cm/8(8¾:9½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 5(6:7) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

1st row K3, skpo, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

2nd row P3, p2tog, p to last 5 sts, p2togtbl, p3.

3rd–5th rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows, then 1st row again.

6th row P to end.

Rep 5th–6th rows until 20(22:24) sts rem, ending with a p row.

Leave sts on a holder.

### POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 18(22:26) sts.

Beg with a k row work 19(21:23) rows in st st, ending with a k row.

### FRONT

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 66(74:82) sts.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3(4:5) times more.

Beg with a k row, work 18(20:22) rows in st st, ending with a p row.

#### Place Pocket

Next row K7 sts, k next 18(22:26) sts and leave these sts on a holder, k16, k next 18(22:26) sts and leave these sts on a holder, k last 7 sts.

Next row P7 sts, p across 18(22:26) sts of one pocket lining,

p16, p across 18(22:26) sts of second pocket lining, p7.

Cont in st st until front measures 20(22:24)cm/8(8¾:9½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 5(6:7) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

1st row K3, skpo, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

2nd row P3, p2tog, p to last 5 sts, p2togtbl, p3.

3rd–5th rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows, then 1st row again.

6th row P to end.

Rep 5th–6th rows until 20(22:24) sts rem, ending with a p row.

Leave sts on a holder.

Work in st st, inc one st at each end of every foll 3rd and 4th row alternately until there are 60(66:72) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 22(25:28)cm/8¾(10:11)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Raglan Top

Cast off 5(6:7) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

**1st row** K3, skpo, k to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

**2nd row** P to end.

Rep last 2 rows until 14 sts rem, ending with a p row.

Leave sts on a holder.

#### COLLAR

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles and right side facing, k7, m1, k7 across sts of one sleeve, k across 20(24:28) sts from front neck holder, k7, m1, k7 across sts of second sleeve, k across 20(24:28) sts from from back neck holder. 70(78:86) sts.

**Next row** K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Next row** P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows until collar measures 10(12:14) cm/4(4¼:5½)in, ending with a wrong-side row.

Cast off loosely in rib.

#### POCKET TOPS

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles and right side facing, work across pocket tops as folls:

**1st row** K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Cast off in rib.

#### TO MAKE UP

Join raglan seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew down pocket linings and tops.

## Woman's Alpaca Wrap-around Cardigan

15(16) 50g balls of Novita Alpaca.  
 Pair each of 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) and 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) knitting needles.  
 Long 3⅜mm (No 10/US 3) circular knitting needle.

### BACK

With 3⅜mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 142(154) sts.  
 1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.  
 2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.  
 Rep last 2 rows for 4cm/1½in.  
 Change to 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) needles.  
 Beg with a k row, cont in st st until work measures 62(66)cm/24½(26)in from beg, ending with a p row.  
**Shape Shoulders**  
 Cast off 17(18) sts at beg of next 6 rows.  
 Cast off rem 40(46) sts.

### POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) needles cast on 34 sts.  
 Beg with a k row, cont in st st until work measures 15cm/6in from beg, ending with a p row.  
 Leave these sts on a holder.

### LEFT FRONT

 2nd row K1, p2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.  
 Rep last 2 rows for 4cm/1½in.  
 Change to 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st until left front measures 15cm/6in from beg, ending with a p row.

### Place Pocket

Next row K18(20), slip next 34 sts onto a holder, k across sts on one pocket lining, k15(17).  
 Cont in st st until work measures 46(49)cm/18(19½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

### Shape Neck

Dec one st at neck edge on every foll alt row until 51(54) sts rem.  
 Work straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

 1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p2, k3.  
 2nd row K1, p2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.  
 Rep last 2 rows for 4cm/1½in.  
 Change to 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) needles.  
 Beg with a k row, work in st st until right front measures 15cm/6in from beg, ending with a p row.  
**Place Pocket**  
 Next row K15(17), slip next 34 sts onto a holder, k across sts on second pocket lining, k18(20).  
 Complete to match Left Front, reversing shapings.

### SLEEVES

With 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) needles cast on 62(66) sts.  
 1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.  
 2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.  
 Rep last 2 rows for 8cm/3in, ending with a 2nd row.  
 Change to 3⅜mm (No 10/US 3) needles.  
 Work a further 8cm/3in in rib, ending with a 2nd row.  
 Change to 3⅜mm (No 9/US 5) needles.  
 Beg with a k row, work in st st, inc one st at each end of the 3rd and every foll 4th row until there are 110(118) sts.  
 Cont straight until sleeve measures 46(48)cm/18(18½)in from beg, ending with a p row.  
 Cast off.


### POCKET TOPS

With right side facing and using 3⅜mm (No 10/US 3) needles, work 2cm/¾in in k2, p2 rib as given for Back across pocket top.  
 Cast off in rib.

### FRONTBAND AND COLLAR

Join shoulder seams.  
 With right side facing and using 3⅜mm (No 10/US 3) circular needle, pick up and k106(112) sts evenly along straight right front edge to beg of neck shaping, 49(51) sts along shaped edge to





right shoulder, 36(40) sts across back, 49(51) sts along shaped edge to beg of neck shaping, 106(112) sts along straight left front edge to cast-on edge, 346(366) sts.

Work backwards and forwards in rows as follows:

Beg with the 2nd row, work 1 row rib as given for Back.

#### Shape Collar

1st row Rib 197(209) sts, turn.

2nd row Rib 48(52), turn.

3rd row Rib 54(58), turn.

4th row Rib 60(64), turn.

Cont in this way for a further 16 turning rows, taking an extra 6 sts, as before, on each row.

Next row Rib to end.

Rib 13 rows across all sts.

Cast off in rib.

#### BELT

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles cast on 14 sts.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row K1, p1, k2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep last 2 rows until belt measures 160cm/63in from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Cast off in rib.

#### TO MAKE UP

Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams, reversing seam on cuff for 8cm/3in. Sew down pocket linings and pocket tops. Make a belt carrier at waist level on each side seam.

## Hooded Jacket

#### MATERIALS

10(11:12:13:14) 50g balls of Debbie Bliss merino aran.  
Pair each of 5mm (No 6/US 8) and 4¼mm (No 7 /US 7) knitting needles.  
6 buttons.

#### MEASUREMENTS

Beg with a k row, cont in st st until back measures 51(56:59:68:71)cm/20(22:23¼:26¼:28)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 31(33:35:39:43) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Leave rem 25(26:29:30:31) sts on a holder.

#### POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 21(23:25:27:29) sts.

Beg with a k row, work 10(12:14:16:18)cm/4(4¼:5¼:6¼:7)in in st st, ending with a k row.

#### LEFT FRONT

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 45(48:51:56:60) sts.

1st row (right side) K to end.

2nd row K4, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows until front measures 14(16:18:20:22)cm/ 5¼ (6¼:7:8:8¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Next row K12(12:13:14:15), cast off 21(23:25:27:29) sts, k12(13:13:15:16).

Next row K4, p8(9:9:11:12), p across sts of one pocket lining, p12(12:13:14:15).

Cont straight until front measures 51(56:59:68:71)cm/20 (22:23¼:26¼:28)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.



**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 31(33:35:39:43) sts at beg of next row.

Next row K4, p to end.

Leave rem 14(15:16:17:17) sts on a holder.

Mark position for buttons: the 1st 13(15:17:19:21)cm/5 (6:6½:7½:8½)in from beg, the 6th 4(5:5:6:6)cm/1½(2:2:2½:2½)in from shoulder edge, the rem 4 spaced evenly between.

**RIGHT FRONT**

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 45(48:51:56:60) sts.

1st row (right side) K to end.

2nd row P to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep last 2 rows until front measures 14(16:18:20:22)cm/5½ (6½:7:8:8½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row, at the same time work buttonholes to match markers as follows:

Buttonhole row (right side) K1, k2tog, yf, k to end.

Next row K12(13:13:15:16), cast off 21(23:25:27:29) sts, k12(12:13:14:15).

Next row P12(12:13:14:15), p across sts of one pocket lining, p8(9:9:11:12), k4.

Cont straight until front measures 51(56:59:68:71)cm/20(22:23½:26½:28)in from beg, ending with a right-side row.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 31(33:35:39:43) sts at beg of next row.

Leave rem 14(15:16:17:17) sts on a holder.

Do not break off yarn.

**SLEEVES**

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles cast on 50(52:54:56:58) sts.

K 5 rows.

Beg with a k row, cont in st st until sleeve measures

5(6:6:7:7)cm/2(2¼:2½:2½:2½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Change to 4mm (No 7/US 7) needles.

Work a further 5(6:6:7:7)cm/2(2¼:2½:2½:2½)in st st.

Change to 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles.

Cont in st st at the same time inc one st at each end of the next and every foll 3rd row until there are 74(82:86:90:96) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 27(32:36:40:42)cm/10½ (12½:14½:15½:16½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Cast off.

**HOOD**

Join shoulder seams.

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles and right side facing, k across 14(15:16:17:17) sts from right front holder, k1(2:1:2:1), [m1, k2]

12(12:14:14:15) times across back neck sts, k across

14(15:16:17:17) sts from left front holder. 65(68:75:78:80) sts.

Next row K4, p to last 4 sts, k4.

Next row K to end.

Next row K4, p to last 4 sts, k4.

Inc row K4, m1, k to last 4 sts, m1, k4.

Keeping 4 sts at front edge in garter st (every row k), work 5 rows straight. Rep last 6 rows twice more, then the inc row again. Work 7 rows straight.

Rep last 8 rows 4 times more and the inc row again.

Work 1(3:5:7:9) rows straight.

Cast off.

**TO MAKE UP**

Join top seam of hood. Sew down pocket linings. Sew on sleeves.

Join side and sleeve seams, reversing seam on cuff for

5(6:6:7:7)cm/2(2¼:2½:2½:2½)in. Sew on buttons.





## Striped Bag

### MATERIALS

One 50g ball each of Debbie Bliss merino double knitting in Red (A), Light Pink (B), Rust (C) and Grey (D).  
 Pair of 3½mm (No 10/US 3) knitting needles.  
 18cm/7in lightweight zip.

### MEASUREMENTS

Bag measures 21cm x 25cm/8½in x 9¾in.

### TENSION

28 sts and 32 rows to 10cm/4in square over rib patt on 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

See page 7.

### BACK

With 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles and A, cast on 61 sts.

Beg with a k row, work 6 rows st st.

1st rib row K6, \* p1, k5; rep from \* last 7 sts, p1, k6.

2nd rib row P6, \* k1, p5; rep from \* last 7 sts, k1, p6.

These 2 rows form the rib patt.

Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Cont in rib and stripe patt as folls:

2 rows C, 2 rows B, 2 rows A, 6 rows B, 2 rows C, 1 row B, 1 row A, 1 row D, 2 rows A, 2 rows D, 2 rows A, 2 rows B, 1 row C, 1 row B, 1 row A, 1 row C, 4 rows B, 1 row D, 2 rows B, 2 rows D, 2 rows B, 1 row D, 4 rows B, 1 row C, 1 row A, 1 row B, 1 row C, 2 rows B, 2 rows A, 1 row B.

Cont in B only.

### Shape Top

Next row Patt 19, turn and work on these sts only.

Next row Patt to end.

Dec one st at inner edge on every row until 3 sts rem.

Cast off.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 23 sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back.

### EDGINGS (both sides alike)

With right side facing and using 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles and B, pick up and k64 sts along shaped edge.

Beg with a p row, work 5 rows st st.

Cast off.

### STRAP

With 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles and B, cast on 118 sts.

Beg with a k row, work 5 rows in st st.

Cast off.

### TO COMPLETE

Leaving edgings free and centre 18cm/7in open, sew top edges together. Sew in zip. Join side and lower edges. Make 3 pompoms in assorted colours and sew to lower edge. Sew on buttons to decorate. Sew ends of strap to top of side seams.

## Striped Garter Stitch Jacket

### MATERIALS

2(2:2) 50g balls each of Debbie Bliss merino double knitting in Light Pink (B) and Blue (F).

1(1:1) ball each of same in Brown (A), Red (C), Fuchsia Pink (D) and Cream (E).

Pair each of 3½mm (No10/US 3) and 3¼mm (No9/US 5) knitting needles.

6(6:7) buttons.

### MEASUREMENTS

Length	26	30	33 cm

Sleeve length	16	18	20 cm

22 sts and 44 rows to 10cm/4in square over garter st (every row k) on 3¼mm (No9/US 5) needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS



With 3¼mm (No 9/US 5) needles and A cast on 124(136:154) sts.  
 K 3 rows.

Cont in stripe patt as folls:

K 4 rows D, 4 rows C, 8 rows B, 2 rows E, 6 rows F and 2 rows A.

Cont straight in garter st until work measures 15(17:19)cm/6 (6¼:7½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.



**Divide for Back and Fronts**

Next row K31(34:39), leave these sts on a holder for right front, k next 62(68:76), leave these sts on a holder for back, k to end.

**Left Front**

Work straight on last set of 31(34:39) sts until front measures 22(25:27)cm/8 $\frac{3}{4}$ (9 $\frac{1}{2}$ :10 $\frac{1}{2}$ )in from beg, ending at neck edge.

**Shape Neck**

Next row K7(8:9) sts, leave these sts on a safety pin, k to end. Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 15(17:19) sts rem. Work straight until front measures 26(30:33)cm/10 $\frac{1}{4}$ (11 $\frac{1}{4}$ :13)in from beg, ending at armhole edge.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off.

**Back**

With wrong side facing, rejoin yarn to next st. Work straight until back measures same as left front to shoulder, ending with a wrong-side row.

**Shape Shoulders**

Cast off 15(17:19) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Leave rem 32(34:38) sts on a spare needle.

**Right Front**

With wrong side facing, rejoin yarn to next st, work to match left front.

**SLEEVES**

Using 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ mm (No9/US 5) needles and B cast on 35(38:41) sts.

K 7 rows B, 4 rows C, 4 rows D.

K 5 rows A to reverse stripe patt.

Cont in stripes of 4 rows D, 4 rows C, 8 rows B, 2 rows E, 6 rows F and 2 rows A, at the same time inc and work into patt one st at each end of the 15th and every foll 6th row until there are 51(56:63) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 20(22:24)cm/8(8 $\frac{3}{4}$ :9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Cast off.

**NECKBAND**

Join shoulder seams.

With right side facing, using 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ mm (No10/US 3) needles slip 7(8:9) sts from safety pin, join in A, pick up and k12(14:16) sts up right front neck edge, k across 32(34:38) sts on back neck, pick up and k12(14:16) sts down left side of front neck, k7(8:9) sts from safety pin. 70(78:88) sts.

K 3 rows.

Cast off.

**BUTTON BAND**

K 3 rows.

Cast off.

**BUTTONHOLE BAND**

With right side facing, using 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ mm (No10/US 3) needles and A, pick up and k54(60:66) sts along right front edge.

K 1 row.

Buttonhole row K1(1:2) sts, [k2tog, yf, k8(9:8) sts] 5(5:6) times, k2tog, yf, k1(2:2).

K 1 row.

Cast off.

**TO MAKE UP**

Join sleeve seams, reversing seam on cuff for 4cm/1 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. Sew in sleeves. Sew on buttons.



## Striped Sweater

### MATERIALS

8(8-9-9-10) 50g balls of Debbie Bliss merino aran in Main Colour (M).

1 ball each of same in Red (A), Pink (B), Lime Green (C), Sea Green (D) and Oatmeal (E).

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles and M, cast on 73(79:85:91:97) sts.

1st row (right side) K6, \* p1, k5; rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k6.

2nd row P to end.

These 2 rows form rib patt.

Work 2 more rows.

Cont in rib and stripe patt as folls:

1 row A, 1 row B, 2 rows M, 1 row C, 1 row D, 1 row E, 2 rows M,

1 row E, 1 row B, 1 row A, 1 row B, 1 row E, 2 rows M, 1 row C,

1 row D, 1 row C, 1 row E, 6 rows M.

These 26 rows form the stripe patt.

Cont in patt until back measures 26(28:30:33:36)cm/10 ¼(11:

11¼:13:14)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

### Shape Armholes

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 61(67:73:79:85) sts.

Cont in patt until back measures 43(46:49:53:57) cm/17(18:

### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 17(19:21:23:25) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 27(29:31:33:35) sts.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures

38(40:43:46:50)cm/15(15¼:17:18¼:19¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

### Shape Neck

Next row Patt 25(28:30:33:35), turn and work on these sts for first side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 17(19:21:23:25) sts rem.

Work straight until front matches Back to shoulder shaping, ending at armhole edge.

### Shape Shoulder

Cast off rem 17(19:21:23:25) sts.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre

11(11:13:13:15) sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

### SLEEVES

With 5mm (No 6/US 8) needles and E, cast on 33(33:35:37:37) sts.

1st row (right side) K1(1:2:3:3), \* p1, k5; rep from \* to last 2(2:3:4:4) sts, p1, k1(1:2:3:3).

2nd row P to end.

These 2 rows set the rib patt.

Cont in rib and stripe patt as folls at the same time inc one st at each end of the 7th and every foll 4th row until there are

61(63:67:73:77) sts:

2 rows M, 1 row E, 1 row C, 1 row D, 1 row C, 2 rows M, 1 row E,

1 row B, 1 row A, 1 row B, 1 row E, then cont in M only.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 28(30:32:37:40)cm/11(11¼:

12½:14½:15¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

Mark each end of last row.

Work a further 8 rows.

Cast off.

### COLLAR

With 3½mm (No 9/US 4) needles and M, cast on

30(30:30:34:34) sts.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

3rd row Cast on 4 sts, k2, p2 across these 4 sts, then rib to end.

4th row Cast on 4 sts, p2, k2 across these sts, then rib to end.

Rep last 2 rows 4(4:4:5:5) times more.

Next row Cast on 5 sts, k3, p2 across these 5 sts, then rib to end.

Next row Cast on 5 sts, k1, p2, k2 across these sts, then rib to

last st, k1.

Cont in rib as set, work 6(6:6:8:8) rows straight.

Cut off M.

Join on E.

Rib 1 row.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seam and last 8 rows to cast-off sts at underarm. Join side and sleeve seams.



## Woman's Alpaca Polo Neck

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 7cm/2¾in.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 4(6:8) rows.

Inc row K3, m1, k to last 3 sts, m1, k3.

Inc one st at each end of row, as set, on every foll 10th row until there are 98(108:118) sts.

Cont straight until back measures 32(35:38)cm/12½(14:15)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Armholes

Next row K3, k2tog, k to last 5 sts, sl 1, k1, pss0, k3.

Next row P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 7(8:9) times more. 82(90:98) sts.

Work straight until back measures 49(54:59)cm/19¼(21¼:23¼)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Neck

Next row K30(33:36), turn and work on these sts for first side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge on next 4 rows. 26(29:32) sts.

P 1 row.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 13(14:16) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 13(15:16) sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 22(24:26) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts, k to end.

Complete to match first side.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back until front measures 43(48:53)cm/17(19:21)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Neck

Next row K33(36:39), turn and work on these sts for first side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge on every foll alt row until 26(29:32) sts rem.

Work straight until front matches Back to shoulder shaping, ending at armhole edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 13(14:16) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 13(15:16) sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 16(18:20) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts, k to end.

Complete to match first side.

### SLEEVES

With 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles cast on 46(50:54) sts.

1st row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 5cm/2in.

Change to 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Work a further 5cm/2in rib.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 4 rows.

Inc row K3, m1, k to last 3 sts, m1, k3.

Inc one st at each end of row, as set, on every foll 6th row until there are 76(82:88) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 51(52:53)cm/20(20½:21)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Sleeve Top

Next row K3, k2tog, k to last 5 sts, sl 1, k1, pss0, k3.

Next row P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 7(8:9) times more. 60(64:68) sts.

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder.

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and right side facing, pick up and k23 sts down left side of front neck, k16(18:20) sts on front neck holder, pick up and k23 sts up right side of front neck, 9 sts down right side of back neck, k22(24:26) sts on back neck holder, pick up and k9 sts up left side of back neck. 102(106:110) sts.

Next row P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Next row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 8cm/3in then change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and work a further 10cm/4in in rib.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder seam and neckband, reversing seam on last 12cm/4¾in. Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams, reversing seam on last 5cm/2in.



## Jacket with Fair Isle Border

### MATERIALS

6(8) balls of Debbie Bliss merino double knitting in Brown (M).  
1(1) ball each of same in Fuchsia Pink, Light Pink, Red, Pale Blue, Stone and Cream.  
Pair each of 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) and 4mm (No 8/US 6) knitting needles.  
35(40)cm/14(15½)in open-ended zip.

### MEASUREMENTS

### NOTE

Read chart from right to left on right side rows and from left to right on wrong side rows. When working in pattern, strand yarn not in use loosely across wrong side to keep fabric elastic.

### BACK

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M cast on 91(101) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep this row 5 times more.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st until back measures 23(26)cm/9(10½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Work in patt from Chart until 17 rows of Chart have been worked.

Cont in M and st st until back measures 40(45)cm/15½(17½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

#### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 16(18) sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 27(29) sts.

### POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles and M cast on 21 sts.

Beg with a k row, work in st st for 30 rows. Leave sts on a holder.

### LEFT FRONT

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M cast on 45(49) sts.

Work 6 rows moss st as given for Back.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

**Next row** K to last 4 sts, moss st 4.

**Next row** Moss st 4, p to end.

Working moss st border at front edge, work a further 25 rows.

**Next row** Moss st 4, p10(12), [k1, p1] 10 times, k1, p10(12).

**Next row** K11(13), [p1, k1] 10 times, k10(12), moss st 4.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

#### Place Pocket

**Next row** Moss st 4, p10(12), cast off 21 sts in moss st, p to end.

**Next row** K10(12), k across pocket lining, k to last 4 sts, moss st 4.

Cont in st st with moss st border until front measures

23(26)cm/9(10½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

**Next row** Work in patt from Chart to last 4 sts, moss st 4 in M.

**Next row** Moss st 4 in M, work in patt from Chart to end.

Work as set until 17 rows of Chart have been worked.

Cont in M as before until front measures 36(41)cm/14¼(16¼)in

from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Neck

**Next row** K to last 6 sts, k2tog, turn, leaving rem 4 sts on a safety pin

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 32(36) sts rem.

Cont without further shaping until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 16(18) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 16(18) sts.

### RIGHT FRONT

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M cast on 45(49) sts.

Work 6 rows moss st as given for Back.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

**Next row** Moss st 4, k to end.

**Next row** P to last 4 sts, moss st 4.

Working moss st border at front edge, work a further 25 rows.

**Next row** P10(12), k1, [p1, k1] 10 times, p10(12), moss st 4.

**Next row** Moss st 4, k10(12), [k1, p1] 10 times, k11(13).

Rep last 2 rows once more.

#### Place Pocket

**Next row** P10(12), cast off 21 sts in moss st, p10(12), moss st 4.

**Next row** Moss st 4, k10(12), k across pocket lining, k to last 4

sts, moss st 4.

Cont in st st with moss st border until front measures

23(26)cm/9(10½)in from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

**Next row** Work in patt from Chart to last 4 sts, moss st 4 in M.

**Next row** Moss st 4 in M, work in patt from Chart to end.

Work as set until 17 rows of Chart have been worked.

Cont in M as before until front measures 36(41)cm/14¼(16¼)in

from beg, ending with a wrong-side row.

#### Shape Neck

**Next row** Moss st 4, leave these sts on a safety pin, k2tog, k to end.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 32(36) sts rem.

Cont without further shaping until front measures same as Back to



shoulder, ending at side edge.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 16(18) sts at beg of next row.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off rem 16(18) sts.

#### SLEEVES

With 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M cast on 33(37) sts.

Work 6 rows moss st as given for Back.

Change to 4mm (No 8/US 6) needles.

Working in st st, inc one st at each end of 3rd and every foll 4th row until there are 61(69) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 23(27)cm/9(10½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Cast off.

#### RIGHT COLLAR

Join shoulder seams.

With right side facing, using 3¼mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, slip 4 sts from right front holder onto a needle, turn, moss st 4.

Cont in moss st at the same time inc one st at inside edge on next 7 rows then every foll alt row until there are 21 sts. Cont straight until shaped edge fits along shaped edge of front to shoulder, ending at straight edge.

#### Shape Collar

Next 2 rows Moss st 12, turn, sl 1, moss st to end.

Moss st 6 rows.

Rep last 8 rows until the shorter edge fits halfway across back neck.

Cast off.

#### LEFT COLLAR



1st row K5, p2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

2nd row K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

#### 2nd size only

1st row K5, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.





## Striped Silk Top

2(3:3) 50g balls Jaeger Silk 4 ply in Cream (A).  
1 ball each of same in Grey (B) and Red (C).  
Pair each of 2½mm (No 12/US 2) and 3½mm (No 10/US 3) knitting needles.

With 2½mm (No 12/US 2) needles and B, cast on 79(86:97) sts.  
K 9 rows.  
Change to 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.  
Using a separate length of B at each end and twisting yarns tog on wrong side when changing colour, work as follows:  
1st row K3B, with A, k to last 3 sts, k3B.  
2nd row K3B, with A, p to last 3 sts, k3B.  
3rd row K3B, with C, k to last 3 sts, k3B.  
4th row K3B, with C, p to last 3 sts, k3B.  
5th row K3B, with A, k to last 3 sts, k3B.  
6th row K3B, with A, p to last 3 sts, k3B.  
Beg with a k row, work in st st and stripe patt of 2 rows B, 2 rows A, 2 rows C and 2 rows A until back measures 23(25:29)cm/9(10:11½)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Work 11 rows in patt, ending with a p row.

### Shape Shoulder

Change to 2½mm (No 12/US 2) needles.  
With A, k 5 rows.  
Cast off.

### FRONT

Work as given for Back until 6 rows less have been worked to neck shaping.

### Shape Neck

Next row K23(25:30) sts, turn and work on this set of sts only.  
Work 17 rows in patt, ending with a p row.

### Shape Shoulder

Change to 2½mm (No 12/US 2) needles.  
With A, k 2 rows.

**Buttonhole row** K4(5:7), k2tog, yf, k9(10:12), yf, k2tog, k6(6:7).  
K 2 rows.

Cast off.

With right side facing, slip centre 35(36:37) sts onto a holder, join on yarn, patt to end.

Work 17 rows in patt, ending with a p row.

With A, k 3 rows.

Cast off.

### SLEEVES

With 2½mm (No 12/US 2) needles and B, cast on 34(37:40) sts.  
K 9 rows.

Change to 3½mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

Beg with a k row, work in st st and stripe patt of 2 rows A, 2 rows C, 2 rows A and 2 rows B, at the same time inc 1 st at each end of every foll 3rd row until there are 60(69:76) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 14(16:18)cm/5½(6¼:7)in from beg, ending with a p row.

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With right side facing, using 2½mm (No 12/US 2) needles and A, pick up and k16 sts down left side of front neck, k35(36:37) sts from front neck, pick up and k14 sts up right side of front neck, k8 sts down right side of back neck, k35(36:37) sts from back neck, pick up and k10 sts up left side of back neck. 118(120:122) sts.  
K 1 row.

**Buttonhole row** K2, k2tog, yf, k10, skpo, k2tog, k31(32:33), skpo, k2tog, k18, skpo, k2tog, k31(32:33), skpo, k2tog, k8.  
K 1 row.

**Dec row** K13, skpo, k2tog, k29(30:31), skpo, k2tog, k16, skpo, k2tog, k29(30:31), skpo, k2tog, k7.  
K 1 row.

**Dec row** K12, skpo, k2tog, k27(28:29), skpo, k2tog, k14, skpo, k2tog, k27(28:29), skpo, k2tog, k6.

K 1 row.

Cast off, dec at corners as before.



### TO MAKE UP

Lap buttonhole band over right back button band and catch side edges together. Sew on sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams to top of side slit. Sew on buttons.

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
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
