This pattern is part of a collection celebrating Romi's online knitting friends. 

Eiregal is a long time member of my Ravelry group, and an inveterate lace knitter. Originally from the US, she lives in Ireland now (hence her Ravelry name—which I love). Of course a shawl by the name of "Eiregal" had to be green, but it's a softer, more muted green in honor of her roots in the US. The motifs in this über lacy shawl (it had to be lacy for Pam!) are leafy and branchy and treesy. Eiregal Pam is a landscape photographer, and I know we share a love of all things green and growy.

The top of this shawl is worked down in short rows from the cast on. The stitches along the edges of the top triangle are then worked outwards to the bottom, through a leafy border and into edging picots. A perfect spring wrap!

SIZE One

MEASUREMENTS Width, tip to tip: 60 inches after blocking
Depth: 30 inches after blocking

MATERIALS Shown: A Verb for Keeping Warm Floating [70% superfine alpaca, 20% silk, 10% cashmere; 430yd (393m)/4oz(113g) skein]; color: Limelight, 1 skein

Note: because of its fiber content, this yarn is difficult to substitute; if a different fingering weight yarn is used, at least 525 yards will be necessary to complete shawl as written

OR Lost City Knits Pathways Sock [100% superwash merino; 385yd (352m)/4oz(110g) skein]; color: Extra Virgin, 2 skeins

1 - set US #4/3.5 mm circular knitting needles
Stitch Markers; Tapestry Needle; T-pins


GAUGE 20 sts/24 rows = 4"/10cm in Chart E lace pattern after blocking

Every knitter's gauge is different; please check gauge! Exact gauge is not important. However, a looser gauge will result in the use of more yardage.



PATTERN

CO 147 sts using knitted method. Knit 2 rows.
Note that the pattern uses short rows to shape the upper triangle (charts A, B and C); each row is lessened by 1 st at the end. Stitches are also decreased within some rows so that the edge of the triangle follows the structure of the lace patterning. Each WS row begins by slipping a stitch of the previous row's t2r combination, and ends by leaving a stitch of the previous row's t2l combination unworked. This decreases the working stitches, thereby shaping the triangle. You may find it helpful to mark your place with a clip-on marker that can be removed and replaced at each turn.

Mark center stitch and break yarn. With RS facing, reattach yarn at side of triangle to work sts alongside of triangle. Work **Chart D** a total of 1 time. **NOTE: Rows 3-8 may be omitted (as shown in sample).**

Finishing

After completing Chart G, row 3, bind off on WS of shawl as follows: [CO 2 sts using knitted CO; k2tog tbl, k1 tbl, BO 1; (k1, BO1) 3 times, slip st back onto left needle] to last stitch on right hand needle, CO 2 sts using knitted CO; k2tog tbl 2 times, BO 1 fasten off.

Soak using wool wash. Remove excess water from shawl and block using T-pins and blocking wires. Stretch shawl tight, and pin out bottom into scallops. Pin each loop separately. To assist the shawl in keeping its shape, add a small amount of dissolved corn starch (approximately one half teaspoon of powder per quart of water) to spray bottle and lightly spray pinned shawl. When thoroughly dry, unpin and enjoy!





Chart A: Work a total of 1 time.: 143 working sts




Chart B: Work a total of 7 times: 31 working sts.





Chart C: Work a total of 1 time.

Chart D: Work a total of 1 time: 221 sts. *NOTE: Rows 3-8 may be omitted (as shown in sample).*







Chart E: Work a total of 1 time: 311 sts.



Note: Chart is shown in two pieces.




Chart F: Work a total of 1 time: 335 sts




Chart G: Work a total of 1 time: 349 sts.

k: knit

kfb: k1, k1 tbl into 1 st

kfbf: k1, k1 tbl, k1 into 1 st

k2tog: (right leaning decrease) knit 2 stitches together

k2tog tbl: (left leaning decrease) knit 2 stitches together tbl

k tbl: knit through back loop to twist stitch

k3tog: knit 3 together

k3tog tbl: knit 3 together tbl

M1: make stitch by lifting bar between sts in previous row; twist lifted bar; knit into resulting loop

M1p: make stitch by lifting bar between sts in previous row; twist lifted bar; purl into resulting loop

p tbl: purl through back loop to twist stitch

p2tog: purl two stitches together

p2tog tbl: purl two stitches together tbl

pb: place bead with crochet hook and then purl stitch; if not using beads, purl stitch

pfb: p1, p1 tbl into 1 st

pssso: pass slipped st(s) over

p: purl

PUk: pick up and knit stitch

RS: right side

ss: stockinette stitch

ssk: [slip 1 stitch knitwise] 2 times, slip both stitches back onto left needle, knit stitches together

s2k2p: sl 2 sts knitwise (one at a time), k2 tog, pass both slipped sts over (pssso)

sk2p: sl 1 st knitwise, k2 tog, pssso

st(s): stitch(es)

t2l: sl 1 st to cable needle, hold in front, k1, k1 tbl from cable needle

t2r: sl 1 st to cable needle, hold in back, k1 tbl, k1 from cable needle

tbl: work st through back loop to twist

w&t: (short row) wrap next stitch with working yarn and turn without completing current row

WS: wrong side

WEP: (work edge picot) CO 3 sts using knitted CO, k2tog tbl 2 times, pass 1st st over 2nd st, k1 tbl, pass 1st st over 2nd st: 1 st reduction

WP: (work picot) CO 2 sts using knitted CO, k2tog tbl, k1 tbl, pass 1st st over 2nd st

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn held to back of work

wyif: with yarn held to front of work

YO: yarn over

STRETCHY BIND-OFF

Work 2 sts in pattern, [replace both sts on left needle, k2tog tbl, work 1 st in pattern] to end. When binding off in the round, pick up and knit 1 st at end of round, then finish bind off by passing existing st over picked up st. Fasten off.
