- %100 combed and mercerised cotton Schachenmayr Catania Originals (50 g and 125 m)

- Two pairs of 6 mm safety eyes
- Polyester Fiberfill
- 2,20 mm and 2,50 mm hooks
- Five tiny buttons
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle for sewing
- 12 cotton buds to support the neck
- Scissors
- Black and white embroidery thread
- Two tiny bell

## ARMS (With 2.20 mm hook)

With cream color;

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6sc)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12sc)

Rnd 3) (3sc, 1inc)- 3 times (15sc)

Rnd 4) Sc in each st around (15sc)

Rnd 5) 1B, 14sc (15sc)

Rnd 6) 1sc, 1dec, 10sc, 1dec (13sc)

Rnd 7) 1dec, 11sc (12sc)

Rnd 8) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 9) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 10) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 11) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 12) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 13) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 14) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 15) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 16) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 17) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 18) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 19) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 20) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 21) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 22) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 23) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 24) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 25) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 26) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 27) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 28) Sc in each st around (12sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 29) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (12sc)

Rnd 30) (1sc, 1dec) - 4 times (8sc)

Rnd 31) Flatten the piece and close the opening by making sc stitches through both layers of remaining sts.

**\*\* Crochet the second arm.    \*\* Do not stuff the arms!**

**\*\* Sew the arms between Round 29 and 30 of the body.**



## BOOTS AND LEGS (With 2.20 mm hook)

**\*\*** After finishing the soles of the boots, cut the yarn and change to the other color.

**\*\*** Or switch to the other yarn without crocheting the fifth row. After filling the boots with fiber, finish crocheting the fifth row of the sole. In this way, the stance of the sole of the boots will be much smoother. Please check the pictures for guidance.

**With green color; (Boot sole)**

**Rnd 1)** Ch9, starting from the 2nd st from your hook; 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc

**Rnd 2)** 2inc, 5sc, 5inc, 6sc, 2inc (29sc)

**Rnd 3)** 10sc, 9inc, 10sc (38sc)

**Rnd 4) WORK FLO ;** Sc in each st around (38sc)

**Rnd 5) WORK BLO ;** Sc in each st around (38sc)



**\*\* If you want to crochet the fifth row on the sole of the boots later, leave the yarn uncut in this way and crochet the last row after filling the boot with fiber.**



**With brown color;**

**Rnd 1) WORK BLO ; Sc in each st around (38sc)**

**Rnd 2-6) (5 rnds) Sc in all sts around (38sc)**

**Rnd 7) 11sc,8dec,11sc (30sc)**

**Rnd 8) 10sc,5dec,10sc (25sc)**

**Rnd 9) 11sc,2dec,10sc (23sc)**

**\*\* Now move on to the mustard yarn, but don't cut the brown yarn. When finish the leg we will continue to crochet the boots. Please check the pictures for guidance.**

**Rnd 10) WORK BLO ; 1sc,1dec,2sc,1dec,2sc,3dec,2sc,1dec,2sc,1dec (16sc)**

**Rnd 11) 7sc,2dec,5sc (14sc)**

**Rnd 12) 1dec,10sc,1dec (12sc)**

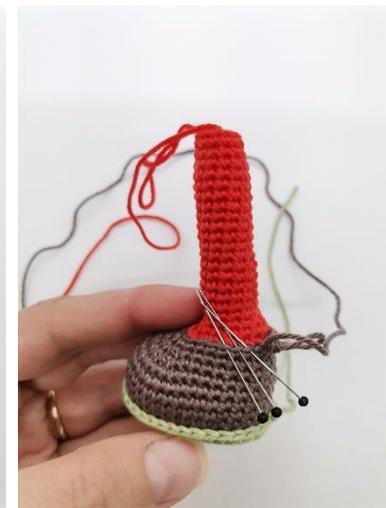
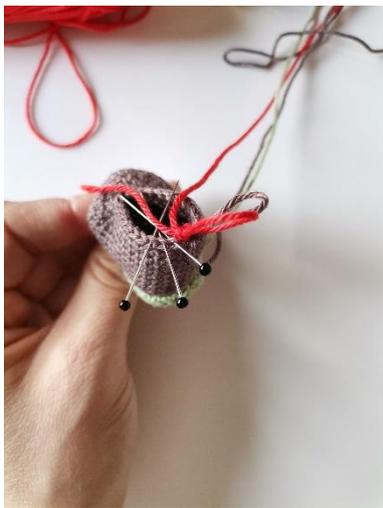
**Rnd 13-30) (18 rnds) Sc in all sts around (12sc)**

**\*\* Make a plus 6sc,sl st ,cut the yarn and now the first leg finished.**

**\*\* Now go back to the brown yarn and finish crocheting the boots.**

**With brown color; 5 rnds sc in all sts around (23sc)**

**\*\* In the same way,let's crochet second leg and don't make a plus sc and move on to the body without cutting our yarn.**





## BODY (With 2.20 mm hook)

**\*\* Ch9 and join the legs by making 1 sc into the first leg. Please check the pictures for guidance**

**Rnd 1) Sc in all sts around including the ch sts we made while joining the legs (42sc)**

**Rnd 2) (6sc,1inc) - 6 times (48sc)**

**Rnd 3) (7sc,1inc) - 6 times (54sc)**

**Rnd 3-10) (8 rnds) Sc in all sts around (54sc)**

**Rnd 11) (7sc,1dec) - 6 times (48sc)**

**Rnd 12-13) (2 rnds) Sc in all sts around (48sc)**

**Rnd 14) (6sc,1dec) - 6 times (42sc) NOW make a plus 18sc and new starting point is here.**

**With ivory color;**

**Rnd 15) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (42sc)**

**Rnd 16) Sc in each st around (42sc)**

With brown color;

Rnd 17) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (42sc)

Rnd 18) Sc in each st around (42sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 19) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (42sc)

Rnd 20) Sc in each st around (42sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 21) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (42sc)

Rnd 22) Sc in each st around (42sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 23) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (42sc)

Rnd 24) (5sc, 1dec) - 6 times (36sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 25) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (36sc)

Rnd 26) Sc in each st around (36sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 27) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (36sc)

Rnd 28) 2sc,1dec, (4sc, 1dec x 5 times) , 2sc (30sc)

With brown color;

Rnd 29) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (30sc)

Rnd 30) (3sc, 1dec) - 6 times (24sc)

With ivory color;

Rnd 31) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (24sc)

Rnd 32) (2sc, 1dec) - 6 times (18sc)



## HEAD (With 2.20 mm hook)

With cream color:

Rnd 33) WORK BLO ; Sc in all sts (18sc)

Rnd 34) (1sc, 1dec) - 6 times (12sc)

Rnd 35-38) (4 rnds) Sc in all sts around (12 sc)

Rnd 39) 2 sc in each st around (24sc)

Rnd 40) (1sc, 1inc) - 12 times (36sc)

Rnd 41) (2sc, 1inc) - 12 times (48sc)

**Rnd 42) Sc in all sts around (48sc)**

**Rnd 43) (3sc, 1inc) - 12 times (60sc)**

**Rnd 44) Sc in all sts around (60sc)**

**Rnd 45) (9sc, 1inc) - 6 times (66sc)**

**Rnd 46-53) (8 rnds) Sc in all sts around (66sc)**

**Rnd 54) 29sc,1dec, (2sc,1dec x 8 times ) , 3sc (57sc)**

**Rnd 55) Sc in all sts around (57sc)**

**NOTE:** Insert the safety eyes between Round 54 and 55 with a 11 sts distance between them. Let's embroider eyebrows with hear yarn. Embroider under the eyes with white embroidery thread and over the eyes with black thread.

**NOTE:** I used cotton buds to hold the doll's neck straight and prevent the neck section from flopping down after attaching the hair strands. I tied 6 pieces of cotton buds together with a piece of yarn and placed it into the neck section. Please check the pictures for guidance.

**Rnd 56) 1dec,10sc,1dec,10sc,1dec,31sc (54sc)**

**Rnd 57-64) (8 rnds) Sc in all sts around (54sc)**

**Rnd 65) (7sc, 1dec) - 6 times (48sc)**

**Rnd 66) 3sc,1dec, (6sc,1dec x 5 times ) , 3sc (42sc)**

**Rnd 67) (5sc, 1dec) - 6 times (36sc)**

**Rnd 68) 2sc,1dec, (4sc,1dec x 5 times ) , 2sc (30sc)**

**Rnd 69) (3sc, 1dec) - 6 times (24sc)**

**Rnd 70) 1sc,1dec, (2sc,1dec x 5 times ) , 1sc (18sc)**

**Rnd 71) (1sc, 1dec) - 6 times (12sc)**

**Rnd 72) 6dec (6sc)**

**\*\* Finish with a slip stitch and fasten off.**





## FLOWER FOR COLLAR (With 2.20 mm hook)

\*\* Let's turn our baby so that its feet are in the air, and from the back side, put a new yarn in the BLO loops made in the 33rd row of the head. Repeat the pattern so that there are 5 flowers in total until end of the row.

\*\* Flower : (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 5 times this flower)



## EARS (With 2.20 mm hook)

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6sc)

Rnd 2) Sc in each st around (6sc)

Rnd 3) (2sc, 1inc)- 2 times (8sc)

Rnd 4) (3sc, 1inc)- 2 times (10sc)

Rnd 5) (4sc, 1inc)- 2 times (12sc)

Rnd 6-8) (3 rnds) Sc in all sts around (12sc)

Rnd 9) (4sc, 1dec)- 2 times (10sc)

Rnd 10) Flatten the piece and close the opening by making sc stitches through both layers of remaining sts.

\*\* Crochet the second ear.

\*\* Do not stuff the ears!

\*\* Sew the ears between Round 50 and 51 of the head.



## GIRL'S HAIR (With 2.50 mm hook)

**\*\* We'll crochet a base for hair and later sew on the head.**

Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6sc)

Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12sc)

Rnd 3) (1sc,1inc) - 6 times (18sc)

Rnd 4) 1sc,1inc ,(2sc,1inc x 5 times) ,1sc (24sc)

Rnd 5) (3sc,1inc) - 6 times (30sc)

Rnd 6) 2sc,1inc ,(4sc,1inc x 5 times) ,2si (36sc)

Rnd 7) (5sc,1inc) - 6 times (42sc)

Rnd 8) 3sc,1inc ,(6sc,1inc x 5 times) ,3si (48sc)

Rnd 9) (7sc,1inc) - 6 times (54sc)

Rnd 10) 4sc,1inc ,(8sc,1inc x 5 times) ,4si (60sc)

Rnd 11-16) (6 rnds) Sc in all sts around (60sc)

**\*\* Now don't cut the yarn and starting crochet the hair strands.**

## HAIR STRANDS (With 2.50 mm hook)

Working in the back bumps of the chain will give you a neater look. Please check the pictures for guidance.

**Strands 1-10)** Ch36, starting from the 2nd st from your hook; 35sc, sk 1sc,

sl st into next sc

**Strands 11-19)** Ch7, starting from the 2nd st from your hook; 6sc, sk 1sc, sl st into next sc

**Strands 20-30)** Ch36, starting from the 2nd st from your hook; 35sc, sk 1sc,

sl st into next sc

**\*\* Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off. Sew the piece on the head as in the photo.**



## BOY'S HAIR (With 2.50 mm hook)

**\*\* We'll crochet a base for hair and later sew on the head.**

**Rnd 1) 6sc in a mr (6sc)**

**Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12sc)**

**Rnd 3) (1sc,1inc) - 6 times (18sc)**

**Rnd 4) 1sc,1inc ,(2sc,1inc x 5 times) ,1sc (24sc)**

**Rnd 5) (3sc,1inc) - 6 times (30sc)**

Rnd 6) 2sc,1inc ,(4sc,1inc x 5 times) ,2si (36sc)

Rnd 7) (5sc,1inc) - 6 times (42sc)

Rnd 8) 3sc,1inc ,(6sc,1inc x 5 times ,3si (48sc)

Rnd 9) (7sc,1inc) - 6 times (54sc)

Rnd 10) 4sc,1inc ,(8sc,1inc x 5 times) ,4si (60sc)

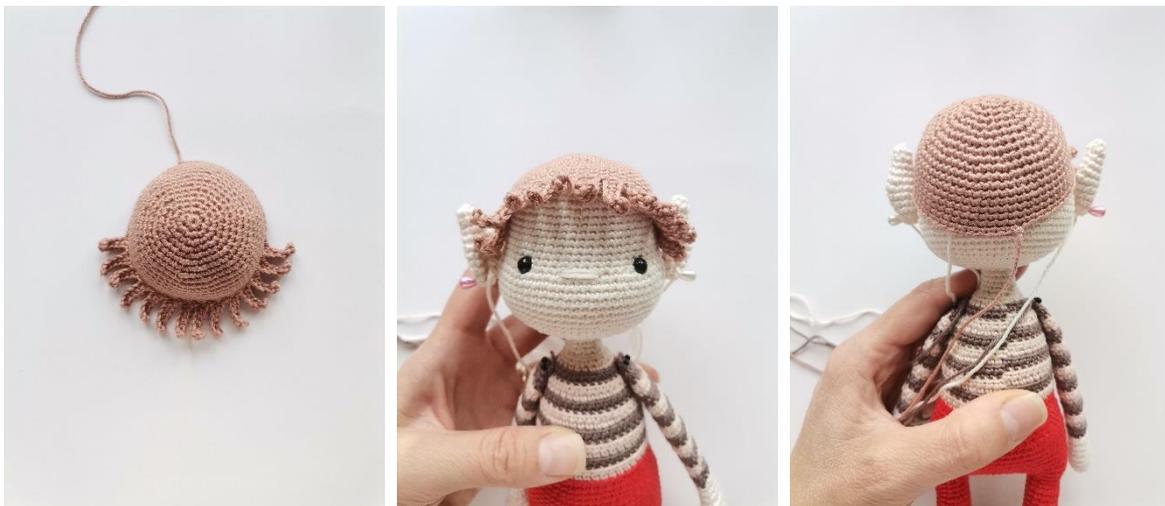
Rnd 11-16) (6 rnds) Sc in all sts around (60sc)

**\*\*** Now don't cut the yarn and starting crochet the hair strands.

### HAIR STRANDS (With 2.50 mm hook)

Rnd 17) 14sc , ( ch7 and starting from the 2nd st from your hook ; 6sc, sk 1sc, sl st into next sc x 14 times ) , 18sc

**\*\*** Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off. Sew the piece on the head as in the photo.



## GIRL'S DRESS (With 2.20 mm hook)

**Row 1)** Ch56, sl st into the 9th st from your hook (we formed our first buttonhole with first ch8), starting from the sl st into and make 48hdc

**Row 2)** Ch1, turn and 1sc in each st of the row (48sc)

**Row 3)** Ch2, turn; WORK FLO; (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 12 times this flower), 1sc (total 12 flowers)

**Row 4)** Ch2, turn; 1hdc in all sts (work the back loops in the row 3) (48hdc)

**Row 5)** Ch1, turn; WORK FLO; 1sc, (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 12 times this flower) (total 12 flowers)

**Row 6)** Ch2, turn; 1hdc in all sts (work the back loops in the row 5) (48hdc)

**Row 7)** Ch2, turn; WORK FLO; (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 12 times this flower), 1sc (total 12 flowers)

**Row 8)** Ch2, turn; 1hdc in all sts (work the back loops in the row 7) (48hdc)

**Row 9)** Ch1, turn; WORK FLO; 1sc, (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 12 times this flower) (total 12 flowers)

**Row 10)** Ch2, turn; 1hdc in all sts (work the back loops in the row 9) (48hdc)

**Row 11)** Ch2, turn; WORK FLO; (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 12 times this flower), 1sc (total 12 flowers)

**Row 12)** Ch2, turn; 1hdc in all sts (work the back loops in the row 11) (48hdc)

**Row 13)** Ch1, turn; WORK FLO; 1sc, (in the same loop 1hdc,1dc,1t,ch3 and sl st in the first loop,1dc,1hdc) ,sk 1sc and sl st in the next loop ,sk 1sc and repeat 12 times this flower) (total 12 flowers)

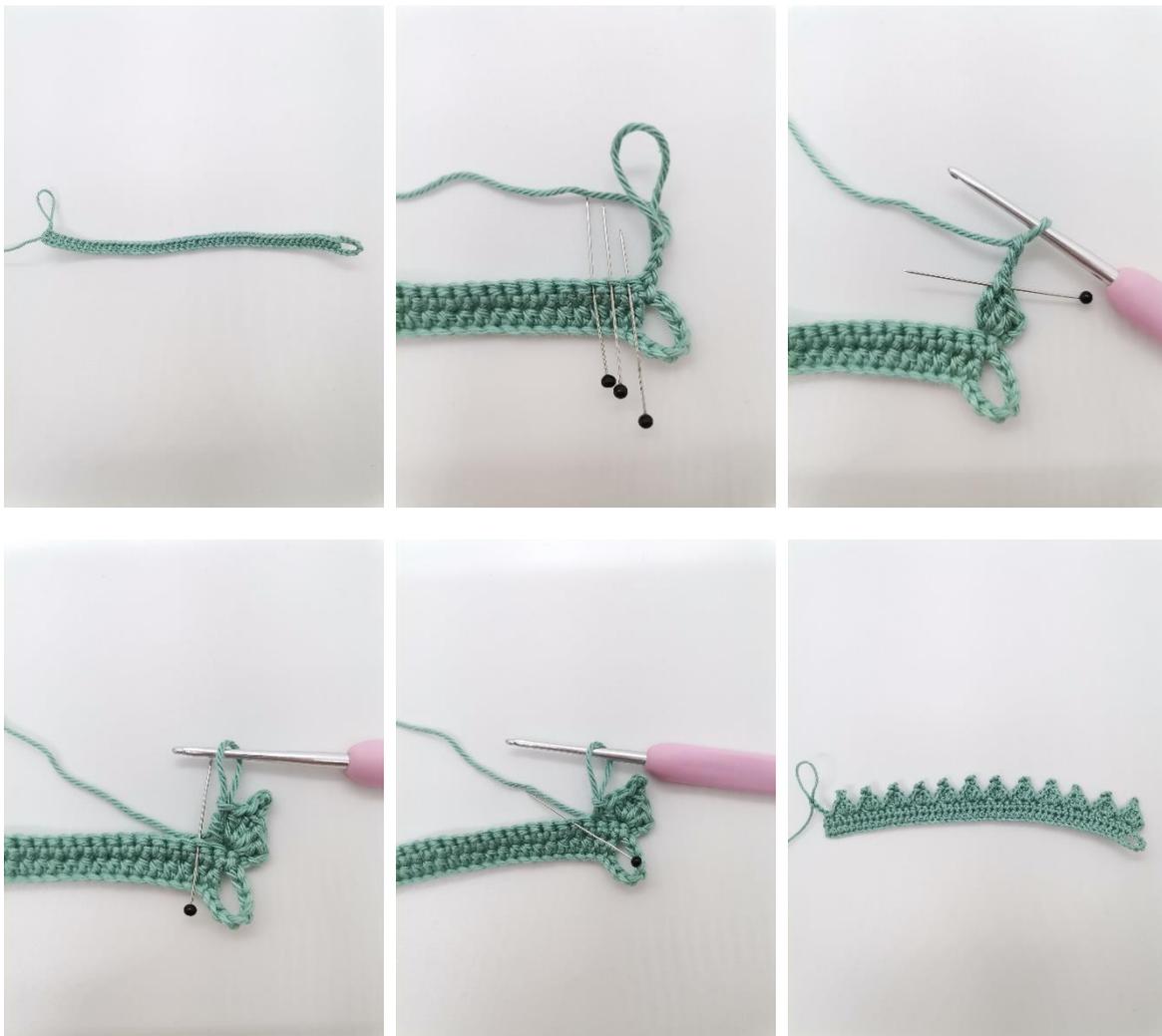
**\*\*** Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

## DRESS HANGERS (With 2.20 mm hook)

**\*\*** Let's put new yarn in the loops we made in the first row of the dress, as in the photo. And ch38, 1sc into the 9th st from your hook (we formed a buttonhole with first ch8), and make 1sc in all sts the all in to the each loop. Last time in the next loop 1sl st and cut the yarn.

**\*\*** Now for second hanger let's put new yarn in the loops we made in the first row of the dress, as in the photo. And ch38, 1sc into the 9th st from your hook (we formed a buttonhole with first ch8), and make 1sc in all sts the all in to the each loop. Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

**\*\*** Sew the three buttons as in the photo.







## BOY'S ROMPERS (With 2.20 mm hook)

- 1) Ch48 and sl st in the first loop.
- 2) Ch2 and starting from the st we slip stitched into : 1hdc in all sts ,sl st in to the first hdc (48hdc)
- 3) Ch2 and starting from the st we slip stitched into : (7hdc,1hdcinc x 6 times) sl st in to the first hdc (54hdc)
- 4) Ch2 and starting from the st we slip stitched into : (8hdc,1hdcinc x 6 times) sl st in to the first hdc (60hdc)
- 5-11) (7 rnds) Ch2 and starting from the st we slip stitched into : 1hdc in all sts (60hdc)

**\*\*** Don't cut the yarn. Start crochet the legs. First calculate 30 stitches for the one leg. Crochet 30hdc and finish with a slip stitch, fasten off

**\*\*** Now start crochet the second leg. Put on the new yarn and crochet 30hdc and finish with a slip stitch, fasten off

## ROMPERS HANGERS (With 2.20 mm hook)

**\*\*** Let's put new yarn in the loops we made in the first row of the rompers, as in the photo. And first crochet 40sc. After Ch38 1sc into the 9th st from your hook (we formed a buttonhole with first ch8), and make 1sc in all sts the all in to the each loop. Last time crochet 8sc. Finally Ch38 1sc into the 9th st from your hook (we formed a buttonhole with first ch8), and make 1sc in all sts the all in to the each loop. Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

**\*\*** Sew the three buttons as in the photo.





## HAT (With 2.20 mm hook)

Rnd 1) 6dc in a mr (6dc)

Rnd 2) (2dc,1DCinc) - 2 times (8dc)

Rnd 3) 1Dc in all sts around (8dc)

Rnd 4) (3dc,1DCinc)- 2 times (10dc)

Rnd 5) 1Dc in all sts around (10dc)

Rnd 6) (4dc,1DCinc)- 2 times (12dc)

Rnd 7) 1Dc in all sts around (12dc)

Rnd 8) (5dc,1DCinc)- 2 times (14dc)

Rnd 9) 1Dc in all sts around (14dc)

Rnd 10) (1dc,1DCinc)- 7 times (21dc)

Rnd 11) 1Dc in all sts around (21dc)

Rnd 12) (2dc,1DCinc)- 7 times (28dc)

Rnd 13) 1Dc in all sts around (28dc)

Rnd 14) (1dc,1DCinc)- 14 times (42dc)

Rnd 15) 1Dc in all sts around (42dc)

Rnd 16) (2dc,1DCinc)- 14 times (56dc)

Rnd 17) 1Dc in all sts around (56dc)

Rnd 18) (3dc,1DCinc)- 14 times (70dc)

Rnd 15) 1Dc in all sts around (42dc)

Rnd 19-23) (5 rnds) 1Dc in all sts around (70dc)

Rnd 24) 12dc, ch7 and sk 7dc ,26dc, ch7 and sk 7dc,18dc (here we crochet blanks for the ears)

Rnd 25) 1sc in all sts around (70sc)

\*\* Finish with a slip stitch, fasten off.

**\*\*If you want, sew a tiny bell to the tip of the hat.**
