

Embrace Skulls collar

**Embrace skulls crochet
collar Designed by
LunarStill**

Skill level: intermediate

Materials: Size 1.25 mm crochet hook.

Half a ball of Maxi Sugar Rush yarn (info on Ravelry:

<https://www.ravelry.com/yarns/library/scheepjes-maxi-sugar-rush>) or any similar lace weight yarn.

Satin ribbon for closure.

Measurements. Length of the choker without the corset part: from 35 cm (13.7 in). If the choker is too long, try using a smaller hook. Width of the piece: 15 cm (5.9 in).

Measurements are taken before blocking.

Please note that blocking is strongly recommended.

Crochet stitch notes:

Ch – crochet chain stitch

St – stitch

Sl st – slip stitch

Sk st – skip stitch

Sc – single crochet stitch

Dc – double crochet stitch

Dc2tog – double crochet two together

tr – treble crochet stitch

Shell – 2dc-ch2-2dc, crochet together in one stitch of gap

Sshell – ch2-dc-ch2-2dc, crochet together in one stitch of gap

sp – space

pr – previous row

You will start at the collar part.

Start: crochet a chain of 105 + 2 (counts as the 1st dc).



Row 1: Dc in the 3rd from the hook and continue crocheting dc until the end of the row. Ch 1, turn.



Row 2: Sshell, ch14, sk 9 st, shell, in next st *ch6, sk 8 st, shell in next st, ch14, sk 9 st, shell in next st (from * repeat 4 timesmore), ch1, turn.



Row 3: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch4, sk 5 ch, sc in 4 following ch, ch4, shell in shell sp, *ch5, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch4, sk 5 ch, sc in 4 following ch, ch4, shell in the shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 4: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch4, sc on ch, sc in 4 following st, sc on ch, (6 sc in total), ch4, shell in shell sp, *ch4, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch4, sc on ch, sc in 4 following st, sc on ch, ch4, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 5: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch4, 2 sc on ch, sc in 6 following st, 2 sc on ch, (10 sc in total), ch4, shell in shell sp, *ch2, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch4, 2 sc on ch, sc in 6 following st, 2 sc on ch, ch4, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



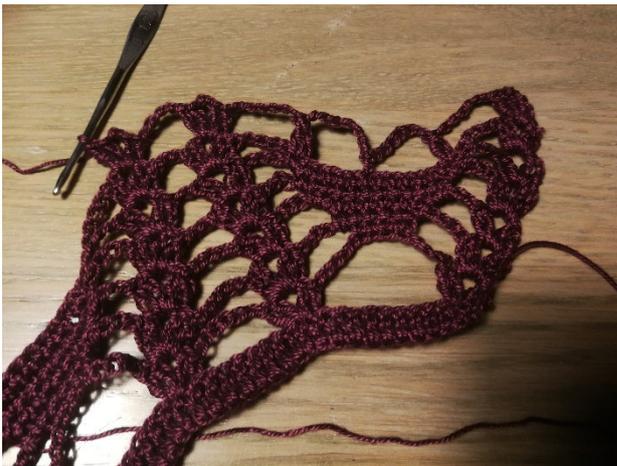
Row 6: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch4, sc on ch, sc in 10 following st, sc on ch, (12 sc in total), ch4, shell in shell sp, *ch1, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch4, sc on ch, sc in 10 following st, sc on ch, ch4, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 7: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch4, sc on ch, sc in 12 following st, sc on ch, (14 sc in total), ch4, shell in shell sp, *ch2, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch4, sc on ch, sc in 12 followingst, sc on ch, ch4, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 8 (here you will be making the eyes and the nose of the skull): Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch5, sk ch, dc2tog in the 1st sc of pr, ch7, sk 5 st, sc in next st, ch7, sk 6 st, dc2tog in next st, ch5, sk ch, shell in shell sp,*ch4, shell in shell sp, ch5, sk ch, dc2tog in the 1st sc of pr, ch7, sk 5 st, sc in next st, ch7, sk 6 st, dc2tog in next st, ch5, sk ch, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 9: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch6, sk ch, 4 sc on ch, ch3, 4 sc on ch, ch6,sk ch, shell in shell sp, *ch6, shell in shell sp, ch6, sk ch, 4 sc on ch, ch3, 4 sc onch, ch6, sk ch, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 10: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch7, sk ch and 1 sc, sc in 3 following st, 3 sc on ch, sc in 3 following st (9 sc in total), ch7, sk ch and 1 sc, shell in shell sp, *ch3, sk 3 ch, shell in the 4th ch, ch3, shell in shell sp, ch7, sk ch and 1 sc, sc in 3 following st, 3 sc on ch, sc in 3 following st (9 sc in total), ch7, sk ch and 1 sc, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 11: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch7, sk ch and 1 sc, dc2tog, ch1, sk st, dc, ch1, sk st, dc, ch1, sk st, dc2tog, sk st and ch, ch7, shell in shell sp, *ch3, shell in next shell sp, ch4, shell in the same shell sp, ch3, sk ch, shell in next shell sp, ch7, sk ch and 1 sc, dc2tog, ch1, sk st, dc, ch1, sk st, dc, ch1, sk st, dc2tog, sk st and ch, ch7, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 12: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch7, sc in next 7 st, sk ch, ch7, shell in shell sp, *ch3, shell in next shell sp, ch4, shell in nextshell sp, ch3, shell in next shell sp, ch7, sc in next 7 st, skch, ch7, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch1, turn.



Row 13: Sl st to shell sp, sshell, ch8, sk ch and 3 sc, sc in next st, ch8, shell in shell sp, *ch3, shell in next shell sp, ch6, shell in the next shell sp, ch3, shell in next shell sp, ch8, sk ch and 3 sc, sc in next st, ch8, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more).

Break yarn, fasten off.



CHOKER PART

Row 1. Join thread to the 1st dc of the pr and work a row in sc. Turn.



Row 2. Ch3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in next st, ch2, sk 2 st, dc in 2 following st, ch2 (these will be the holes to insert the ribbon in), sk 3 st, shell in next st, *ch5, sk 7 st, shell in next st, ch8, sk 9 st, shell in next st (from * repeat 4 times more), ch5, sk 7 st, shell in next st, ch2, sk 3 st, dc in 2 following st, sk 2 st, 2 dc in next st. Turn.



Rows 3-6. Ch3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in next st, ch2, sk ch, dc in 2 following st, ch2, shell in shell sp, *ch5, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch8, sk ch, shell in shell sp (from * repeat 4 times more), ch5, sk ch, shell in shell sp, ch2, sk ch, dc in next 2 st, ch2, sk ch, dc in next 2 st. Break yarn, fasten off.



Insert the ribbon into the holes in a corset-like manner.



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
