GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS:

- circular needles 60-100 cm 3,5 mm (24 in-40 in US 4)
- double-pointed needles 3,5 mm (US 4);
- markers;
- tape measure;
- tapestry needle
- crochet hook;
- button or ribbon.

DENSITY:

21 stitches x 28 rows = 10x10 cm (4x4 in) in stockinette stitch on 3,5 mm (US 4) needles after blocking.

YARN:

100-150 m (110-165 yds) on 50 g (1.75 oz) for cotton yarn or for merino wool yarn (example: DROPS Cotton Light, Drops Cotton Merino);

170-190 m (185-210 yds) on 50 g (1.75 oz) for yarn with alpaca (example: DROPS Sky)

I recommend using DROPS Sky yarn.

KNITTING PROCESS

1. KNIT A FRILL WITH LEAVES

We start knitting a dress by knitting a frill with leaves. For knitting frills we will use double-pointed needles 3,5 mm (US 4) and a crochet hook.

First use a contrast colour yarn to crochet a chain. With a small piece of yarn (30 cm (12 in)) chain 8-10 stitches. Watch this [VIDEO](#) to learn how to do it.

Then use the working yarn and needle to knit (leave a tail end of the working yarn about 30 cm (12 in) long – we are going to need this later to join the frill in a circle) and pick up 6 stitches from the chain. If you hold the chain in your hands, you will see a ridge of bumps

Let's work on this pattern row by row:

Row 1: Edge st (Sl), P1, K1, YO, K1, YO, K2.

Row 2: P6, K1, M1, Edge st (P1).

Row 3: Edge st (Sl), P2, K2, YO, K1, YO, K3.

Row 6: P10, K1, M1, K2, Edge st (P1).

Row 7: Edge st (Sl), P4, K4, YO, K1, YO, K5.

Row 8: P12, K1, M1, K3, Edge st (P1).

Row 9: Edge st (Sl), mb, P2, mb, P1, Ssk, K7, K2tog, K1.

Row 10: P10, K1, M1, K4, Edge st (P1).

Row 11: Edge st (Sl), P6, Ssk, K5, K2tog, K1.

Row 12: P8, K1, M1, K2, P1, K2, Edge st (P1).

Row 13: Edge st (Sl), P2, K1, P4, Ssk, K3, K2tog, K1.

Row 14: P6, K4, P1, K2, Edge st (P1).

Row 15: Edge st (Sl), mb, P1, K1, P4, Ssk, K1, K2tog, K1.

Row 16: P4, K4, P1, K2, Edge st (P1).

Watch [VIDEO: Row 16.](#)

Row 17: Edge st (Sl), P2, K1, P4, K3tog, K1.

Watch [VIDEO: Row 17.](#)

Row 18: BO4, K1, P1, K2, Edge st (P1). Now 6 stitches should remain on your needles.

Then start again from Row 1 working all the way through.

Don't cut the yarn.




2. JOINING LIVE STITCHES OF THE FRILL IN A ROUND.

Remove the crocheted chain. Insert your needle into live stitches (Watch this [VIDEO](#) to learn how to do it).

Next we join frill edge using the Kitchener stitch.

The kitchener stitch is a way to graft live stitches together creating a seamless join.



Lay two edges of the frill together with right sides facing up. Insert into the needle the end of the yarn, which we left when we picked up stitches from the chain. Join edges of the frill.

Note: don't be intimidated by the length of the resulting frill, because when knitting a yoke, the frill is pulled together to the required size.

3. PICK UP THE STITCHES FROM THE FRILL

Take the circular knitting needles and pick up the stitches from the edge stitches on the inner edge of the frill. We lift one stitch from each edge stitch.

Place marker – the beginning of the row.



4. KNITTING TOP PART OF THE YOKE

Size 62 (0-3M, 0/3)

Knit round:

1 round: knit all stitches in the round (K117)

2 round: knit all stitches in the round (K117)

3 round: knit with decreases:

K3, ***(K2tog, K4) rep from * to end of round.**

You should have 98 stitches on the needles.

From row 4 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

4 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches to end of row.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

7 row: (turn knitting) knit with decreases:

Sl, K2, ***(K2tog, K3) rep from * to last 5 sts,** K2tog, K2, P1.

You should have 79 stitches on the needles.

8 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

9 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

10 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

11 row: (turn knitting) knit with decreases:

Sl, K2, ***(K2tog, K2) rep from * to last 4 sts,** K2tog, K1, P1.

You should have 60 stitches on the needles.

12 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

Size 68 (3-6M, 3/6)

Knit round:

1 round: knit all stitches in the round (K117)

2 round: knit all stitches in the round (K117)

3 round: knit with decreases:

K3, ***(K2tog, K4) rep from * to** end of round.

You should have 98 stitches on the needles.

From row 4 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

4 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches **to** end of row.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches **to** end of row.

7 row: (turn knitting) knit with decreases:

Sl, K2, ***(K2tog, K3) rep from * to** last 5 sts, K2tog, K2, P1.

You should have 79 stitches on the needles.

Size 74 (6-9M, 6/9):

1 round: knit all stitches in the round (K126)

K1, ***(K2tog, K4) rep from * to** last 5 sts **to** end of round, K2tog, K3.

You should have 105 stitches on the needles.

From row 4 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

4 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches **to** end of row.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: (turn knitting)

You should have 113 stitches on the needle.

From row 4 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

4 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches to end of row.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

7 row: (turn knitting)

Size 104 (4T)

Knit round:

1 round: knit all stitches in the round (K135)

2 round: knit all stitches in the round (K135)

3 round: knit all stitches in the round (K135)

4 round: knit with decreases:

K3, *(K2tog, K4) rep from * to end of round.

You should have 113 stitches on the needles.

From row 5 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches to end of row.

6 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

7 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

8 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

9 row: (turn knitting)

You should have 120 stitches on the needles.

From row 4 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

4 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches **to** end of row.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches **to** end of row.

K1, ***(K2tog, K4) rep from * to** last 5 sts, K2tog, K3.

You should have 120 stitches on the needles.

From row 4 go to Back-and-forth knitting.

4 row: (turn knitting)

Slip off the first stitch (Sl), purl stitches **to** end of row.

5 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches **to** end of row.

7 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

8 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, purl stitches **to** end of row.

9 row: (turn knitting)

Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

10 row: (turn knitting)

22 row: (turn knitting)
Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

Finished yoke:



5. KNITTING OF THE NECKLINE

The knitting algorithm is the same for all sizes.

1 row: Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

2 row: Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

3 row: Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

4 row: Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

5 row: Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

6 row: Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

7 row: *(K2tog, YO) rep from * to end of row.

8 row: Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

9 row: Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

10 row: Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

11 row: Sl, knit all stitches in the row to last 1 st, P1.

12 row: Sl, purl stitches to end of row.

Cut the working yarn (leave the end of the working yarn about 80-100 cm (35-40 in) long).

Next make the hem of the neckline.

Place the project with the wrong side facing you, and fold it.

Now you can start joining the stitches on the needle with the row of stitches on the wrong side. We will be joining the edge with the help of a tapestry needle.


Step 1: Insert the tapestry needle through the first stitch (as shown in the photo below). Slip this stitch from the needle.



Step 2: Insert the tapestry needle through the next stitch (as shown in the photo below). Slip this stitch from the needle.



Step 3: Now pass the tapestry needle through the purlled stitch bottom to top (the row with which we will join the edge is marked in the photo in white).



Step 4: Insert the tapestry needle through the next purlled stitch, this time top to bottom.



Step 5: Insert the tapestry needle through the stitch which we slip from the needle in step 2. Next insert the tapestry needle through the

next stitch (as shown in the photo below). Slip this stitch from the needle.



Repeat steps from step 3 to step 5 to the end of the row. Watch this [VIDEO](#) to learn how to do it.

Don't cut the end of yarn.



6. MAKE THE BUTTON LOOP

With the help of the crochet hook crochet a chain of 5-7 stitches using the tail end of yarn.



Knit a button loop and attach it.



Sew a button on the other side of the neckline.



It is also possible to thread a ribbon through the neckline.

7. KNIT THE EDGE OF THE FRILL

To knit the edge grab your circular knitting needles. Pick up the stitches from the edge stitches of the frill (from each edge stitch pick up 1 stitch, hooking only one loop of the stitch, watch [VIDEO](#)).

Next knit a round purl-wise, then a round knitwise.

In the next round bind off stitches purl-wise. You can watch this [VIDEO](#) to learn how to do it.



8. KNITTING THE BOTTOM PART OF THE YOKE

Turn the project with the wrong side facing you. Take circular knitting needles and working yarn.

Pick up the stitches from the edge stitches between the frill and the top of the yoke. Pick up one stitch from each edge stitch.



The number of stitches on the needles should be as follows:

Place a marker – the beginning of the row (middle of the back).

Knit round:

Size 62 (0-3M, 0/3)

1 round: knit all stitches in the round

2 round: knit all stitches in the round

3 round: knit the row with increase (inc). This [VIDEO](#) shows how to make increase.

K5, ***(inc 1 st, K6) rep from * to last 4 sts, inc 1 st, K4.**

You should have 136 stitches on the needles.

From 4 to 14 rounds: knit all stitches in the round.

Size 74 (6-9M, 6/9)

Size 80 (9-12M, 9/12)

Size 86 (12-24M, 12/24)

1 round: knit all stitches in the round

2 round: knit all stitches in the round

3 round: knit all stitches in the round

K3, ***(inc 1 st, K6) rep from * to last 3 sts, inc 1 st, K3.**

You should have 147 stitches on the needles.

From 5 to 16 rounds: knit all stitches in the round.

From 5 to 17 rounds: knit all stitches in the round.

Size 110 (4, 5T)

9. LENGTHENING THE BACK OF THE DRESS

For sizes **62 (0-3M, 0/3)**, **68 (3-6M, 3/6)** lengthening the back is 4 additional rows.

For sizes **74 (6-9M, 6/9)**, **80 (9-12M, 9/12)**, **86 (12-24M, 12/24)**, **92 (2T)**, **98 (3T)**, **104 (4T)** lengthening the back is 6 additional rows.

For sizes **110 (4, 5T)**, **116 (5, XXS)**, **122 (6, XS)** lengthening the back is 8 additional rows.

Knit from the marker (middle of the back) half of the back stitches:

20 knit stitches – for sizes 62 (0-3M, 0/3), 68 (3-6M, 3/6)

22 knit stitches – for sizes 74 (6-9M, 6/9), 80 (9-12M, 9/12), 86 (12-24M, 12/24)

24 knit stitches – for sizes 92 (2T), 98 (3T), 104 (4T)

25 knit stitches – for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS)



Turn knitting.

For sizes **62 (0-3M, 0/3)**, **68 (3-6M, 3/6)**

1 row: Sl, P39

2 row: (turn knitting) Sl, K38, P1.

3 row: (turn knitting) Sl, P39.

6 row: (turn knitting) Sl, Knit 21 sts to marker (middle of the back).

For sizes **92 (2T)**, **98 (3T)**, **104 (4T)**

1 row: Sl, P47.

2 row: (turn knitting) Sl, K46, P1.

3 row: (turn knitting) Sl, P47.

4 row: (turn knitting) Sl, K46, P1.

5 row: (turn knitting) Sl, P47.

6 row: (turn knitting) Sl, Knit 23 sts to marker (middle of the back).

For sizes **110 (4, 5T)**, **116 (5, XXS)**, **122 (6, XS)**

1 row: Sl, P49.

2 row: (turn knitting) Sl, K48, P1.

3 row: (turn knitting) Sl, P49.

4 row: (turn knitting) Sl, K48, P1.

5 row: (turn knitting) Sl, P49.

6 row: (turn knitting) Sl, K48, P1.

7 row: (turn knitting) Sl, P49.

8 row: (turn knitting) Sl, Knit 24 sts to marker (middle of the back).



10. SEPARATE BODY AND SLEEVES

Knit from the marker (middle of the back) half of the back stitches:

20 knit stitches – for sizes 62 (0-3M, 0/3), 68 (3-6M, 3/6);

22 knit stitches – for sizes 74 (6-9M, 6/9), 80 (9-12M, 9/12), 86 (12-24M, 12/24);

24 knit stitches – for sizes 92 (2T), 98 (3T), 104 (4T);

25 knit stitches – for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS).



With the help of the tapestry needle transfer sleeve sts to waste yarn:

28 stitches – for sizes 62 (0-3M, 0/3), 68 (3-6M, 3/6);

30 stitches – for sizes 74 (6-9M, 6/9), 80 (9-12M, 9/12), 86 (12-24M, 12/24);

31 stitches – for sizes 92 (2T), 98 (3T), 104 (4T);

34 stitches – for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS).



Cast on underarm sts:

3 sts – for sizes **62** (0-3M, 0/3), **74** (6-9M, 6/9);

5 sts – for sizes **68** (3-6M, 3/6), **80** (9-12M, 9/12), **86** (12-24M, 12/24), **92** (2T), **110** (4, 5T);

7 sts - for sizes **98** (3T), **104** (4T), **116** (5, XXS), **122** (6, XS).

Knit the stitches of the front of the dress:

40 knit stitches – for sizes 62 (0-3M, 0/3), 68 (3-6M, 3/6);

43 knit stitches – for sizes 74 (6-9M, 6/9), 80 (9-12M, 9/12), 86 (12-24M, 12/24);

47 knit stitches – for sizes 92 (2T), 98 (3T), 104 (4T);

50 knit stitches – for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS).

With the help of the tapestry needle transfer second sleeve sts to waste yarn:

28 stitches – for sizes 62 (0-3M, 0/3), 68 (3-6M, 3/6);

30 stitches – for sizes 74 (6-9M, 6/9), 80 (9-12M, 9/12), 86 (12-24M, 12/24);

31 stitches – for sizes 92 (2T), 98 (3T), 104 (4T);

34 stitches – for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS).

Cast on underarm sts:

3 sts – for sizes **62** (0-3M, 0/3), **74** (6-9M, 6/9);

5 sts – for sizes **68** (3-6M, 3/6), **80** (9-12M, 9/12), **86** (12-24M, 12/24), **92** (2T), **110** (4, 5T);

7 sts - for sizes **98** (3T), **104** (4T), **116** (5, XXS), **122** (6, XS).

Knit the stitches of the second half of the back:

20 knit stitches – for sizes 62 (0-3M, 0/3), 68 (3-6M, 3/6);

22 knit stitches – for sizes 74 (6-9M, 6/9), 80 (9-12M, 9/12), 86 (12-24M, 12/24);

24 knit stitches – for sizes 92 (2T), 98 (3T), 104 (4T);

25 knit stitches – for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS).

11. KNIT THE SKIRT OF THE DRESS

1 round: Knit all sts in the round for all sizes.

2 round: knit the round with increase:

K1, *(YO, K2) rep from * to end of round.

How to make YO:



If you want to make the skirt wider knit 2 round as follows: *(K1, YO) rep from * to end of round.

The number of stitches on the needles should be as follows:

If the number of stitches on the needles is odd, increase 1 stitch in front of the marker to make the number of stitches on the needles even.

Next knit the skirt of the dress, until the length of the dress from the shoulder to the last row reaches the required **value n**.

Note: in the next round after the round with increases (YO) we knit YO through front loop of YO=> [VIDEO](#).

MAKE THE HEM OF THE SKIRT

The knitting algorithm is the same for all sizes.

From 1 to 6 round: knit all stitches in the round.

7 round: *(K2tog, YO) rep from * to end of round.

From 8 to 12 round: knit all stitches in the round.

Next make the hem of the the edge of the skirt. Place the project with the wrong side facing you, and fold it. Next attach the edge with the help of the tapestry needle.

11. KNITTING SLEEVES

LEFT SLEEVE:


You can use circular or double-pointed needles to knit the sleeves.

Return stitches from waste yarn to needle. Attach the yarn between underarm sts and sleeve sts.


Step 1: The stitch has formed between underarm sts and sleeve sts ↓



Pick up this stitch with the right needle and transfer it to the left needle (the left loop of this stitch should be in front). The left loop of the next stitch should be at the back (shown with a red arrow) ↓



Knit these two stitches together (K2tog):

(first YO make immediately after step 1)

Transfer the last stitch to the right needle without knitting.

Pick up the stitch between the sleeve stitches and the edge stitches of the lengthening the back of the dress ↓




Transfer these two stitches to the left needle.

(The left loop of stitch 1 should be at the back. The left loop of stitch 2 should be in front) ↓

4 sts - for sizes **110** (4, 5T), **116** (5, XXS), **122** (6, XS)



4 sts (2 sts, marker, 2 sts) - for sizes **62** (0-3M, 0/3), **74** (6-9M, 6/9).

6 sts (3 sts, marker, 3 sts) - for sizes **68** (3-6M, 3/6), **80** (9-12M, 9/12), **86** (12-24M, 12/24), **92** (2T), **110** (4, 5T).

8 sts (4 sts, marker, 4 sts) - for sizes **98** (3T), **104** (4T), **116** (5, XXS), **122** (6, XS).

Knit the sleeve in a round to the required length - value Y.

Next knit the wrist of the sleeve. Use a garter stitch to knit the wrist.

When we knit in a round garter stitch we alternate knit and purl rounds.

1 round of the wrist: *(P1, P2tog) rep from * to end of round.

Next knit without decreases.

Total rounds of garter stitch:

for sizes **62** (0-3M, 0/3), **68** (3-6M, 3/6) – 8 rounds;

for sizes **74** (6-9M, 6/9), **80** (9-12M, 9/12), **86** (12-24M, 12/24) – 10 rounds

for sizes **92** (2T), **98** (3T), **98** (3T), **104** (4T), **110** (4, 5T) – 12 rounds.

for sizes **116** (5, XXS), **122** (6, XS) – 14 rounds.

Bind off stitches purl-wise.



RIGHT SLEEVE:

Return stitches from waste yarn to needle.

Attach the yarn between sleeve sts and the edge stitches of the lengthening the back of the dress.

Step 1: This stitch has formed between the sleeve sts and the edge stitches of the lengthening the back of the dress ↓



2 sts - for sizes **62** (0-3M, 0/3), **68** (3-6M, 3/6),

4 sts - for sizes 110 (4, 5T), 116 (5, XXS), 122 (6, XS)
