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## MATERIALS

- Crochet hook size 2.2mm - 2.5mm
- Yarn sewing needle, thread needle
- Stitch markers
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Plastic-coated wire for shaping
- Safety eyes size 9mm
- Brown and dark brown sewing thread
- Hot glue or other types of adhesive
- Blush
- Small buttons (size 1cm) and decor buttons




- Use Velvet Yarn, size 2.5mm. You can substitute with similar types of yarn to achieve a comparable finished size, or use other types of yarn to create larger or smaller products depending on your preference.
- Crochet hook: 2.2mm
- Finished size: 16cm (ears not included)

## SKILLS

- The instructions are written in rounds and rows. Mark the first stitch of each round to track the starting point, and only finish off a row when specifically instructed.
- Use invisible decreases for better results.
- Apply the "X" single crochet stitch instead of the "V" single crochet stitch to achieve neater stitches without gaps.
- Technique for attaching eyes and creating eye sockets for plush animals without safety fasteners—refer to this guide here:


# Abbreviations

# Outfit 1





## HEAD

Use cream yarn and **cream white yarn**

**Rnd 1.** 7 sc in the magic ring (7)

**Rnd 2.** 7 inc (14)

**Rnd 3.** [sc, inc] x 7 (21)

**Rnd 4.** [inc, 2 sc] x 7 (28)

**Rnd 5.** [3 sc, inc] x 7 (35)

**Rnd 6.** [2 sc, inc, 2 sc] x 7 (42)

**Rnd 7.** [5 sc, inc] x 7 (49)

**Rnd 8- 11.** (4 rows) 49 sc (49)

**Rnd 12.** [5 sc, dec] x 7 (42)

**Rnd 13.** 42 sc (42)

**Rnd 14.** 10 sc, 4 inc, **4 inc, 2 sc**, 2 sc, **2 sc, 4 inc**, 4 inc, 10 sc (58)

**Rnd 15.** 17 sc, **24 sc**, 17 sc (58)

**Rnd 16- 17.** (2 rows) 16 sc, **26 sc**, 16 sc (58)

**Rnd 18.** 10 sc, 3 dec, **5 dec, 6 sc, 5 dec**, 3 dec, 10 sc (42)

**Rnd 19.** 2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 3 sc, **sc, dec, [4 sc, dec] x 2, sc**, 3 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc (35)

**Rnd 20.** [3 sc, dec] x 2, sc, **2 sc, dec, [3 sc, dec] x 2**, [3 sc, dec] x 2 (28)

**Rnd 21.** [2 sc, dec] x 2, sc, **sc, dec, [2 sc, dec] x 2**, [2 sc, dec] x 2 (21)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the head with fiberfill.

Use cream white yarn, sew a straight line from Rnd 15 to Rnd 19 (fig 2), then tighten it (fig 3).

Use dark brown yarn, embroider the nose from Rnd 14 to Rnd 19 (fig 14).

Pull the eye sockets (video tutorial on page 3), then attach the eyes between Rnd 13 and Rnd 14, with a 2 sc gap from the nose.

Use white yarn to sew the eye whites and dark brown yarn to sew the eyelids.

Apply blush to the nose and cheeks.





## EAR


Use cream white yarn, crochet two ears


**Rnd 1.** Chain 13, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, start from the second stitch from the hook, 11 sc, 5 sc in the same stitch, continue on the other side of the chain, 11 sc, ch, turn (27)

**Rnd 2.** 11 sc, 5 inc, 11 sc, slst (32)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Fold the ears in half and sew them between Rnd 11 and Rnd 12.





## ARM

Crochet two ears, begin with cream yarn

**Rnd 1.** 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

**Rnd 2.** [sc, inc] x 3 (9)


**Rnd 3.** [2 sc, inc] x 3 (12)


**Rnd 4.** 12 sc (12)

**Rnd 5.** 2 dec, 8 sc (10)

**Rnd 6- 10.** (5 rows) 10 sc (10)

Cut the yarn.





## LEG

Use cream yarn, crochet two legs

**Rnd 1.** Chain 5, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, start from the second stitch from the hook, 3 sc, 4 sc in the same stitch, continue on the other side of the chain, 3 sc (10)

**Rnd 2.** inc, 2 sc, 4 inc, 2 sc, inc (16)

**Rnd 3.** sc, inc, 2 sc, [sc, inc] x 4, 3 sc, inc (22)

**Rnd 4- 5.** (2 rows) 22 sc (22)

**Rnd 6.** sc, dec, 4 sc, 4 dec, 4 sc, dec, sc (16)

**Rnd 7- 9.** (3 rows) 16 sc (16)

**For the first leg:**

**Rnd 10.** 12 sc, skip 4 stitches, cut the yarn

**For the second leg:**


**Rnd 10.** 16 sc, crochet 5 sc more

Do not cut the yarn, continue crocheting into the body

Stuff both legs.

**NOTE:** If you use the join-round method, in Rnd 10 you don't need to add or skip stitches, just crochet the full round as usual. But at the joining point between the legs, you must find the position yourself—it's located between the inner sides of the legs.





## BODY

From the second leg, ch 2 to join with the first leg (fig 12)

**Rnd 1.** 16 sc on the first leg, 2 sc on the chain, 16 sc on the second leg, 2 sc on the remaining chain (fig 13) (36)

**Rnd 2.** [sc, inc] x 2, 26 sc, [inc, sc] x 2, 2 sc (40)

**Rnd 3- 6.** (4 rows) 40 sc (40)

**Rnd 7.** [3 sc, dec, 3 sc] x 5 (35)

**Rnd 8.** 35 sc (35)

**Rnd 9.** [5 sc, dec] x 5 (30)

**Rnd 10.** 30 sc (30)

**Rnd 11.** 6 sc, join arm 3 sc (crochet through both arm and body) (fig 14), 12 sc, join arm 3 sc (crochet through both arm and body), 6 sc (fig 15)

**Rnd 12.** 6 sc, crochet remaining stitches on left arm 7 sc, crochet on body 12 sc, crochet remaining stitches on right arm 7 sc, continue on body 6 sc (fig 16) (38)

**Rnd 13.** sc, [2 sc, dec, 2 sc] x 6, sc (32)

**Rnd 14.** 32 sc (32)



**Rnd 15.** [2 sc, dec] x 8 (24)


**Rnd 16.** [3 sc, dec, 3 sc] x 3 (21)

Cut the yarn.

Insert wire into the arms. Arms do not need stuffing.

Stuff the body, then attach the head to the body.





## DRESS

Use cobalt blue yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 39, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the 6 stitches, start from the 7th stitch from the hook, 33 sc, ch, turn (33)

**Rnd 2.** 33 sc, ch 2, turn (33)



**Rnd 3.** [BLO] [dc, dc-inc, dc] x 11, slst on the first stitch of the row (fig 19) (44)

From this row onward, begin crocheting in the round

**Rnd 4.** ch 2, 2 dc, dc-inc, [3 dc, dc-inc] x 10, dc, slst (55)

**Rnd 5.** ch 2, 55 dc, slst (55)

**Rnd 6.** ch, [sc, ch] x 55, slst. Cut the yarn.



Use cobalt blue yarn, crochet into the foundation chain of Rnd 1 (fig 21):

ch, 11 sc, ch 12, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the 2 stitches, start from the 3rd stitch from the hook, 10 hdc on the chain, hdc into the base of sc, continue on the current row, skip 1 stitch, 9 sc, ch 12, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the 2 stitches, start from the 3rd stitch from the hook, 10 hdc on the chain, hdc into the base of sc, continue on the current row, skip 1 stitch, 11 sc, slst, cut the yarn.



Use cobalt blue yarn to sew two straps to the back of the dress evenly (fig 24, 25).


Sew one button to the back of the dress.





- Use cream white yarn, crochet to the FLO of Rnd 2 (fig 26):  
**Rnd 1.** 33 slst, ch 2, turn (fig 27) (33)  
**Rnd 2.** [dc, dc-inc, dc] x 11, ch 2, turn (44)  
**Rnd 3.** [3 dc, dc-inc] x 11, ch, turn (55)  
**Rnd 4.** [sc, ch 2] x 55, slst into the first stitch of the row to finish, cut the yarn (fig 28).
- Use cream white yarn, crochet into the remaining chain stitches of Rnd 1 (fig 29):  
 ch, [sc, ch 2] x 32, slst. Cut the yarn.





## NECK SCARF

Use yellow yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 7, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, start from the second stitch from the hook, 3 sc, 3 hdc, ch 2, turn (6)

**Rnd 2.** [BLO] 3 hdc, 3 sc, ch, turn (6)


**Rnd 3.** [BLO] 3 sc, 3 hdc, ch 2, turn (6)

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until row 21.

**Rnd 22.** [BLO] 3 hdc, 3 sc, ch 20 for tie, cut the yarn.

Join yarn on the other side (fig 32), chain 20, cut the yarn.





## HEADBAND

Use yellow cotton yarn and 1.8mm crochet hook

**Rnd 1.** Chain 4, turn back along the foundation chain, skip 3 stitches, crochet into the first chain: 4 dc, ch 2, turn (4)

**Rnd 2.** 4 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (8)

**Rnd 3.** 2 dc-inc, 4 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (12)

**Rnd 4.** 2 dc-inc, 8 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (16)

**Rnd 5.** 2 dc-inc, 12 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (20)

**Rnd 6.** 2dc-inc, 16 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (24)

**Rnd 7.** 2 dc-inc, 20 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (28)

**Rnd 8.** 2 dc-inc, 24 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (32)

**Rnd 9.** 2 dc-inc, 28 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (36)

**Rnd 10.** 2 dc-inc, 32 dc, 2 dc-inc, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 11.** 2 dc-inc, 36 dc, 2 dc-inc, chain 30, cut the yarn.

### Scarf Edging

Use yellow yarn, crochet from the left edge to the right edge of the scarf, 2 sc per row (rows 11 to 1), total 22 sc; crochet 3 sc at the pointed corner; continue along the right edge (rows 1 to 11), total 22 sc; ch 30, cut the yarn.


### Ruffle Edging

Use light yellow yarn, crochet around the scarf edge just made: (BLO) (sc, ch 2) repeat to end of the row, slst. Cut the yarn.



# Outfit 2





## PANTS

Use blue yarn

Ch 20, slst into the first chain to form a ring (fig 37).

**Rnd 1.** ch, 20 sc, slst (20)

**Rnd 2.** [BLO] ch 2, [3 dc, dc-inc] x 5, slst (25) Cut the yarn.

Make the second pant leg the same as the first. At the final slst of Rnd 2, join in the round and connect to the first leg (fig 38).

**Rnd 3.** ch 2, 25 dc on the first leg, 25 dc on the second leg, slst (50)




**Rnd 4.** ch 2, [3 dc, dc-dec] x 10, slst (40)

**Rnd 5.** ch, [3 sc, dec, 3 sc] x 5, slst (35)

**Rnd 6.** ch, 35 sc, slst (35)


**Rnd 7.** ch, 12 slst, ch 2, dc-dec, ch 15, turn back to the chain just made, start from the 2nd chain from hook: 14 slst, ch 3, continue on Rnd 7: 5 slst, ch 2, dc-dec, ch 15, turn back to the chain just made, start from the 2nd chain from hook: 14 slst, ch 3, continue on Rnd 7: 13 slst. Cut the yarn.

Use blue yarn to sew two straps to the back of the pants evenly (fig 41).



Use purple yarn, crochet into FLO of Rnd 1 (fig 43): [ch 2, slst] repeat to end of the row, cut the yarn.

Use purple yarn, crochet into the two shoulder straps (fig 45, 46): [ch 2, slst] repeat to end of the row, cut the yarn.



## HAT

Use dark yellow yarn

**Rnd 1.** MR ch 2, 12 dc, slst (12)

**Rnd 2.** ch 2, 12 dc-inc, slst (24)

**Rnd 3.** ch 2, [dc, dc-inc] x 12, slst (36)

**Rnd 4.** ch 2, [2dc, dc-inc] x 12, slst (48)

**Rnd 5.** ch 2, 40 dc, skip 8 stitches, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 6.** 40 dc, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 7.** 4 dc, ch 4, skip 4 stitches, 24 dc, ch 4, skip 4 stitches, 4 dc, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 8.** 4 dc, 4 dc on the 4 chains, 24 dc, 4 dc on the 4 chains, 4 dc, ch, turn (40)

**Rnd 9.** [BLO] 40 sc, ch, turn (40)

**Rnd 10.** [BLO] hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to green yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to rose purple yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to blue yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to purple yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to dark yellow yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to green yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc; switch to rose purple yarn: hdc, 2 dc-inc, hdc, sc, ch 25 for tie, cut the yarn.

On the opposite side of the hat, join dark yellow yarn, ch 25, cut the yarn.

## LEAF

Use green yarn

**Rnd 1.** MR 6 sc, slst (6)


**Rnd 2- 3.** (2 rows) ch, 6 sc, slst (6)

**Rnd 4.** Make 3 leaves: [Ch 7, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, crochet into the second stitches, slst, sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, skip 1 stitch in Rnd 3, slst into next stitch] x 3.

Glue the leaves to the back of the hat.



# Outfit 3





## HAT

Use red yarn

**Rnd 1.** MR ch 2, 14 dc, slst (14)

**Rnd 2.** ch 2, 14 dc-inc, slst (28)

**Rnd 3.** ch 2, [dc, dc-inc] x 14, slst (42)

**Rnd 4.** ch 2, [2 dc, dc-inc] x 14, slst (56)

**Rnd 5.** ch 2, 56 dc, slst (56)

**Rnd 6.** ch 2, [2 dc, dc-dec] x 14, slst (42)

**Rnd 7.** ch, 42 sc, slst (42)

Cut the yarn.





## TOP

Use dark yellow yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 40, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the 6 stitches, start from the 7th stitch from the hook, [5 sc, inc] x 2, 10 sc, [inc, 5 sc] x 2, ch, turn (38)

**Rnd 2.** [6 sc, inc] x 2, 11 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 5 sc, ch, turn (42)

**Rnd 3.** 6 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 12sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 6 sc, ch, turn (46)

**Rnd 4.** 7 sc, inc, 8 sc, inc, 13 sc, 8 sc, inc, 6 sc, ch, turn (50)


**Rnd 5.** 7 sc, inc, [FLO (hdc, hdc-inc, hdc) x 3], inc, 14 sc, inc, [FLO (hdc, hdc-inc, hdc) x 3], inc, 7 sc, ch, turn (60)

**Rnd 6.** 8 sc, ch 3, skip 13 stitches, 18 sc, ch 3, skip 13 stitches, 8 sc, ch, turn (40)

**Rnd 7.** [BLO] 8 sc, 3 sc on the 3 chains, 18 sc, 3 sc on the 3 chains, 8 sc, slst.

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.





## PANTS

Start with white yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 10, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, start from the second stitch from the hook, 9 sc, ch, turn (9)

Switch to red yarn

**Rnd 2.** ch 2, turn, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 3 sc, ch, turn (9)

**Rnd 3.** 3 sc, 2 hdc, 4 dc (9)

Switch to white yarn

**Rnd 4.** ch, turn, 9 sc, ch, turn (9)

**Rnd 5.** [BLO] 9 sc (9)

Repeat rows 2 to 5 five times

Switch to cobalt blue yarn

**Rnd 22.** ch 2, turn, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 3 sc, ch, turn (9)

**Rnd 23.** 3 sc, 2 hdc, 4 dc (9)

Switch to white yarn

**Rnd 24.** ch, turn, 9 sc, ch, turn (9)

**Rnd 25.** [BLO] 9 sc (9)

Repeat rows 22 to 25 four times

**Rnd 38- 39** same as Rnd 22-23

**Rnd 40.** ch, turn, 9 sc, slst (9)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew Rnd 40 to Rnd 1 (fig 58).



## PANT LEGS

Use white yarn to crochet the edge (fig 60) (each blue or red row: 2 sc, each white row: sc): ch, 60 sc, slst, ch 2, skip 30 stitches, slst to form two pant legs (fig 62).

Switch to dark yellow yarn, begin pant leg (fig 61):

**Rnd 1.** ch, turn and crochet 2 sc into the chain, continue on left leg: [3 sc, dec] x 6, slst (26)

**Rnd 2.** ch, 2 sc, [sc, dec, sc] x 6, slst (20) Cut the yarn.


Make the second pant leg the same as the first (fig 64).

Sew 40 stitches from the top to 40 rows of the pants (fig 66).

Use light yellow yarn, crochet into FLO of Rnd 6 (fig 68): ch, [sc, ch 2] x 40, slst. Cut the yarn.

Sew one button to the back of the top.





## SCARF

Use white yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 5, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, start from the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, hdc, dc, ch 2, turn (4)

**Rnd 2.** [BLO] dc, hdc, 2 sc, ch, turn (4)

**Rnd 3.** [BLO] 2 sc, hdc, dc, ch 2, turn (4)

Repeat Rnd 2 and Rnd 3 until Rnd 23

**Rnd 24.** [BLO] dc, hdc, 2 sc, ch 5, turn (4)


**Rnd 25.** [BLO] skip 1 stitch, 3 sc, slst (3) Cut the yarn.

Sew one button to the scarf.



# Outfit 4





## EAR

Use milk brown yarn, crochet two ears

**Rnd 1.** MR ch 2, 10 dc, slst (10)

**Rnd 2.** ch 2, [dc, dc-inc] x 5, slst (15)

**Rnd 3.** ch 2, 15 dc, slst (15)

**Rnd 4.** ch 2, [3 dc, dc-dec] x 3, slst (12)


**Rnd 5.** ch 2, [2 dc, dc-dec] x 3, slst (9)

**Rnd 6.** ch 2, 9 dc, slst (9)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing

Insert wire into the ears and sew them between rows 2 and 4 of the head.





## DRESS

Start with green yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 44, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the 6 stitches, start from the 7th stitch from the hook, 38 sc, ch, turn (38)

**Rnd 2.** [BLO] 6 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 6 sc, ch, turn (42)

**Rnd 3.** 7 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 13 sc, [inc, 6 sc] x 2, ch, turn (46)

**Rnd 4.** [7 sc, inc] x 2, 14 sc, [inc, 7 sc] x 2, ch 6, turn (50)

**Rnd 5.** 8 sc, ch 4, skip 9 stitches, 16 sc, ch 4, skip 9 stitches, 8 sc, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 6.** [BLO] dc, dc-inc, [3 dc, dc-inc] x 9, 2 dc, slst (50)

From this row onward, begin crocheting in the round

**Rnd 7- 8.** (2 rows) ch 2, 50 dc, slst (50)

Switch to white yarn

**Rnd 9.** ch, 50 sc, slst (50)

**Rnd 10.** ch, sc, [skip 1 stitch, (3 hdc in the same stitch), skip 1 stitch, sc] x 12, sc, slst.


Cut the yarn.

- Use orange yarn, crochet into 16 FLO stitches of Rnd 5:

**Rnd 1.** ch 2, 16 dc, ch 2, turn (16)

**Rnd 2.** 16 dc, ch 2, turn (16)

**Rnd 3.** 16 sc, slst (16) Cut the yarn.



- Crochet around the edge:

**Rnd 1.** 2 sc into dc stitch of Rnd 1, 2 sc into dc stitch of Rnd 2, 2 sc into dc stitch of Rnd 3 (fig 78); next edge: inc, 14 sc, inc (fig 79); final edge: 2 sc into dc stitch of Rnd 3, 2 sc into dc stitch of Rnd 2, 2 sc into dc stitch of Rnd 1 (fig 80), slst, ch, turn

**Rnd 2.** [ch 2, slst] repeat to end of the row, cut the yarn.





- Use white yarn, crochet into the foundation chain of Rnd 1 (fig 83)

**Rnd 1.** 38 slst, ch, turn (38)


**Rnd 2.** [ch, skip 1 stitch, slst] repeat to end of the row, then remove this row, leaving only Rnd 1. Cut the yarn.

- Use white yarn, crochet into FLO of Rnd 1 (fig 85): [ch 2, skip 1 stitch, slst] repeat to end of the row.

Cut the yarn. Sew two buttons to the back of the dress

Use glue to attach decorative buttons or accessories to the dress






## TURBAN

Start with orange yarn

**Rnd 1.** Chain 31, turn back along the foundation chain, skip the first stitch, start from the second stitch from the hook, 28 sc, 4 sc in the same stitch, continue along remaining chain, 28 sc, inc, slst (64)


Switch to 1mm rice white cotton yarn

**Rnd 2.** Crochet into the back side of Rnd 1 (fig 89): [BLO] [ch 6, slst] repeat to end of the row, cut the yarn.



# Outfit 5





## HAT

Use pink yarn

**Rnd 1.** MR ch 2, 12 dc, slst (13)

**Rnd 2.** ch 2, 12 dc-inc, slst (24)

**Rnd 3.** ch 2, [dc, dc-inc] x 12, slst (36)

**Rnd 4.** ch 2, [2 dc, dc-inc] x 12, slst (48)

**Rnd 5.** ch 2, 40 dc, skip 8 stitches, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 6.** 40F, ch 2, turn (40)

**Rnd 7.** [3 dc, dc-dec, 3 dc] x 5, ch, turn (35)

**Rnd 8.** 35 sc, slst (35) Cut the yarn.


Use white yarn, chain 25, continue with Rnd 9 (fig 93):

**Rnd 9.** [BLO] [(slst, ch, dc in the same stitch), skip 1 stitch] x 17, slst, ch 25, cut the yarn.

## EAR

Use white yarn to crochet two ears (same as Outfit 4), then sew them onto Rnd 4 of the hat.





## PANTS

Start with pink yarn

Chain 20, slst into the first chain to form a ring (fig 100).

**Rnd 1.** ch, 20 sc, slst (20) Cut the yarn.

Make the second pant leg the same way. After finishing the second leg, do not cut the yarn. Chain 2 and join with the first leg (fig 102).

**Rnd 2.** [BLO] ch 2, 20 dc on the first leg, 2 dc on the chain, 20 dc on the second leg, 2 dc on the remaining chain, slst (44)

**Rnd 3- 4.** (2 rows) ch 2, 44 dc, slst (44)

**Rnd 5.** ch 2, [9 dc, dc-dec] x 4, slst (40)

**Rnd 6.** [BLO] ch, [3 sc, dec] x 8, slst (32) Cut the yarn.


### BIB

Use stitch markers to mark 10 stitches in the center front of the pants (fig 103). Use dark pink yarn to crochet the bib onto those 10 stitches.

**Rnd 1.** [BLO] ch, 10 sc, ch, turn (10)


**Rnd 2- 3.** (2 rows) 10 sc, ch, turn (10)

**Rnd 4.** dec, 6 sc, dec, slst (8) Cut the yarn.



## Bib Border

Use pink yarn, attach to the back of the pants to make the strap. Chain 13, crochet along the right edge of the bib (fig 107): [sc, ch 3] x 4, continue down 10 FLO stitches of Rnd 6 (fig 108): [sc, ch 3] x 10, continue along the left edge of the bib (fig 109): [sc, ch 3] x 3, sc, chain 13, slst to the back of the pants, making sure it's symmetrica (fig 111).



Yeah! And now our chubby-cheeked Mochi Bunny is complete!
