



# FALLEN

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*VectorKnits* on Ravelry

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Thanks for checking out the Fallen shawl! This leaf-shaped pattern comes in one size and is a great Autumn-themed project that can be draped as a shawl or worn as a scarf when folded down the middle. Comprised mostly of stockinette, this shawl gets its characteristic leaf shape by controlling the rate of increases & decreases along the outer mock i-cord edges. An optional stem is knit separately and grafted onto the finished leaf, giving the shawl a built-in loop to secure the other end when worn. Whether you are knitting it for yourself, a friend, or a family member, the future recipient is bound to love it!

## SIZE

This pattern contains instructions for one leaf size:

- Length (without stem): 50 inches (127 cm)
- Length (with stem): 56 inches (142 cm)
- Width (at widest point): 20 inches (51 cm)

## YARN

The pattern calls for approximately 750 yards of DK-weight yarn or 1500 yards of light-fingering-weight yarn (held double). Details of the yarns used in the samples shown are as follows:

- Yellow Sample: 3 skeins of The Loving Path Griffin DK in Persimmon (each 115 grams, 280 yards, DK-weight)
- Red Sample: 3 skeins of The Loving Path High Twist Sock in Last Goodbye (each 100 grams, 464 yards, light-fingering-weight)

The skeins I used in the red, light-fingering sample were each a little more than 100 grams. The sample used closer to 1450 yards total. The 1500-yard recommendation above is a conservative estimate to ensure you don't run out of yarn.

**Tip:** Are you using an ombre / gradient yarn? If so, knit the Stem first so that the color of the stem matches the round edge of the leaf.

## NEEDLES

3.5 mm / US 4 circular or straight needles

## GAUGE

The gauge for the sample shown is 20 sts by 34 rows for a 4-inch square after washing and blocking lightly. Some deviation from this gauge is perfectly acceptable.

## OTHER MATERIALS

- Tapestry needle to weave in ends
- Cable needle (optional)
- Scrap yarn for provisional cast-on
- Blocking materials

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


## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

The leaf is worked flat in one piece, and the optional stem is knit separately and grafted on to the cast-on edge after knitting the leaf itself. The pattern begins with a 3-stitch provisional cast-on, followed by a few quick rows that will establish the mock i-cord edge on either side of the leaf. You'll then pick up a few stitches that establish the body of the leaf, then you'll pick up the stitches from the provisional cast-on.

After that, you'll be ready to knit the body of the leaf. Yarnovers are used to increase along the center (spine) of the leaf as well as the two outer edges. As the leaf gains length, you will reduce the frequency of the yarnovers on the outer edges, and eventually you'll be working decreases instead. Finally, when the leaf has reached its widest point, you'll start working double decreases on the outer edges to reduce the overall stitch count and give the leaf its pointy end. A quick set of Kitchener stitches is used to join and bind off your last 6 stitches.

The optional stem is a simple rectangle that is folded in half. The short edges of this rectangle are then grafted to the cast-on edge of the leaf. Because the stem is folded, it provides a convenient loop to tuck the pointy end of your leaf into when wearing after washing, blocking, and weaving in your ends.



## Things to Keep in Mind

- The written instructions may look intimidating, but they're not. I promise. In a regular pattern, I'd be able to use instructions like, "Repeat Rows A through B 5 times." However, each row in this pattern is unique, which prevents me from using instructions like that; hence, the instructions are lengthy. The actual construction of the shawl is very formulaic, so I am hoping that knitters will be able to make use of the intuition and/or charted instructions instead. Regardless, all three options are available.
- All slips are performed with the yarn held in the front of your work. This will be the WS, as all slips occur on WS rows.
- A mock i-cord is used to give the shawl a nice crisp edge. Don't knit these edges too tightly. The extra stretch will come in handy when blocking the shawl.
- For yarnovers, the direction in which the working yarn is wrapped around the right needle is usually dependent upon the last stitch you worked and the next stitch you're about to work (i.e., whether they are knits or purls). For the samples

I knit, I deviated from this slightly to give the yarnovers a little more consistency & neatness. You are more than welcome to follow the technique you already use today, but I recommend the following:

- For yarnovers performed on the right half of the shawl, start with your yarn in the front of your work and wrap over the righthand needle, ending in the back of your work (note that if the next stitch is a purl stitch, simply continue the motion to bring your yarn to the front of your work after wrapping around the needle).
- For yarnovers performed on the left half of the shawl, start with your yarn in the back of your work and wrap over the righthand needle ending in the front of your work (note that if the next stitch is a knit stitch, simply continue the motion to bring your yarn to the back of the work after wrapping around the needle).
- Yarnovers always occur on RS rows. On WS rows, these yarnovers will always be worked by knitting / purling through the furthest (leftmost) leg of the yarnover stitch. This will twist the yarnover and prevent a hole from appearing.
- Two stitches form the spine that will run down the center of the shawl. These two center stitches will always be purl on the RS and knit on the WS. These two stitches can be found in **bold** text in the written instructions.
- Repeats will follow the following format: *[instr.]* x*N*, where the instructions within brackets are repeated *N* times (*N* will be a number).



## INTUITION INSTRUCTIONS

What kind of instructions are these? Let me explain. This pattern isn't very complex. If you don't believe me, then take a look at the number of unique stitch types there are defined in the Abbreviations. There aren't many, yet the written and charted instructions are absurdly long. Like I mentioned on the previous page, that's because each row is unique, which makes it difficult to use shortcut instructions like, "Repeat Rows A through B 5 times." But the shawl itself is very formulaic and has relatively simple geometry. So my goal with these instructions is to teach you the structure of the shawl so that you understand what's going on and *hopefully* don't have to look down at the written or charted instructions for all 356 rows. And I'm going to try to do this in 1 page.

**Tip:** If these instructions don't make much sense at first, I recommend casting on and knitting a couple of sections of the shawl using the written instructions to get an idea for the structure. Then revisit these instructions and see if they make more sense.

The first thing that you need to know is that 16 is a very important number in this pattern. The repeating columns that run the diagonal length of the leaf are 16 stitches wide (14 knits and 2 purls). Each section has an interval of 16 stitches (although Section M has a few extra rows to finish the leaf, but that's not important right now). Why? Because 16 is a great number to work with.

Second, the shawl gets its leaf-like shape by varying the rate of increases & decreases along the right and left edge of the leaf. You will always perform increases (yarnovers) in the middle of the shawl, along either side of the leaf's spine. But the edge is a different story. The pattern starts by increasing along the edges, and it slowly transitions to decreasing. The table below illustrates this, as you can see the numbers in the fourth row going from positive to negative as the sections progress. The last 8 rows in the table below indicate the pattern of increases / decreases to use in the RS rows. For example, in Section A, all 8 of the RS rows will have increases along the edge. Section B, however, will have increases in only 6 of the 8 RS rows.

\* The end of Section M differs slightly from this model. I recommend using this model until the last 8 rows, then switch to the written instructions.

Now let's talk about the structure of each row. Your edges will always follow the same format, with slight differences for increases & decreases, but the spine stitches will always follow the same format and never deviate. The table below outlines this basic structure. Note that details regarding the diagonal columns that occur between the edge and center stitches can be found in the next paragraph.

\* Yarnovers will either be knit or purled on WS rows depending on where they land within the leaf's column pattern. See the below for details.

The last thing you need to know is the structure of the stitches between the edges and the spine. The diagonal columns that run the length of the leaf follow the same format: k14, p2 on RS rows and k2, s1, p12, s1 on WS rows. In other words, the first and last knit stitches on the RS rows get slipped on the WS. This creates a cleaner, more defined edge between the knit and purl columns. As demonstrated in the previous table, yarnovers are part of the edges & the increases along the spine of the leaf, but how those yarnovers are worked on the WS rows depends on this k2, s1, p12, s1 structure. If the yarnover falls where a knit stitch should be, knit it. If it falls where a purl stitch should be, purl it. If it falls where a slipped stitch is, purl it, too.

Note that there is one exception to the k14, p2 rule. All of the stitches that result from the increases along the edges of the leaf in Sections A through D will be worked in stockinette (20 stitches on each side). You won't be purling any of these stitches on RS rows or knitting any of them on WS rows. This is because the veins of the leaf (the diagonal purled columns) should only stem from the spine of the leaf, not the edges of the leaf.

## WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS

### Cast-On & Set-Up

Using your scrap yarn, create a chain of stitches for your 3-stitch provisional cast-on. Pick up three stitches with your left needle. Don't knit all three stitches, yet. Instead, using your working yarn, work the three stitches as follows: k1, p1, k1. You'll be purling the middle stitch you picked up from your scrap yarn chain. Then turn your work around and work the three stitches as follows: s1, k1, s1. Turn your work again. You've now completed the first two rows of your mock i-cord cast-on. Now work Rows A & B 7 times:

A-RS: k1, p1, k1

B-WS: s1, k1, s1

You should now have a small mock i-cord chain. Knit Row A once more, but don't turn your work afterward. Instead, use your left needle to pick up 6 stitches along the edge of your mock i-cord chain. Purl each of those 6 stitches. One complete, your working yarn should now be quite close to your provisional cast-on edge. Remove your scrap yarn from the provisional cast-on edge, being careful to pick up the 3 stitches on your left needle: a knit stitch, a purl stitch, and another knit stitch. Work those stitches as follows: k1, p1, k1. You should now have 12 stitches on your needles: 3 stitches on either side that form the mock i-cord edges, and 6 stitches between them. Turn your work and knit back across the WS as follows: s1, k1, s1, k6, s1, k1, s1

### Section A

Now you're ready to start knitting the body of the leaf. Each RS row in this section will increase your stitch count by 4. Knit Rows 1-16 one time. When finished, you should have 44 sts on your needles.

## Finishing

You should only have 6 sts left on your needles at this point. Slip the first 3 of those stitches purlwise to your right needle. Cut your working yarn, leaving at least 8 inches or so to seam the last few stitches together and weave in your ends. Using a darning needle, seam the 3 stitches from the left needle to the 3 stitches from the right needle using the Kitchener technique.

Once you have finished binding off the body of your leaf, you can choose if you'd like to knit the looped stem (see instructions on the next page), but you will likely need to block your shawl for it to lie flat. For each of the samples shown, I chose to wet block the shawl and let it dry while knitting the stem. The stem can be grafted on after blocking as it already lies flat.

Once wet, pin down your shawl in the shape of a leaf to your blocking mats. In order to ensure the rounded edges of your leaf have a smooth curve, I recommend placing blocking pins about 0.5 inches apart from one another (or use blocking wires). Once dry, remove your blocking pins, weave in your ends, and enjoy your new shawl!

**Tip:** Your mock i-cord is essentially a very small 1x1 rib. You can either look up the Kitchener method for 1x1 ribbing and use it, or you can twist the purl stitches around and move them to the innermost position of your needles (using a cable needle). This essentially converts your mock i-cord into a true i-cord, allowing you to use the regular Kitchener method for stockinette.

## Stem (Optional)

The stem of the leaf is a simple rectangle that's folded in half and grafted onto the cast-on edge of the leaf. This loop can be used to secure the shawl when it is being worn. A different kind of stem was knit for each of the two samples shown.



### Yellow Leaf Stem (Garter):

Cast on 75 stitches using the long-tail cast-on method. Knit 14 rows of garter stitch, then bind off on the 15<sup>th</sup> row using a stretchy bind off: k1, [slip the stitch from the right needle back to the left needle purlwise, k2togtbl] to end, cut your yarn leaving a tail of approximately 12 inches and pull it through the last stitch to complete the bind-off. Fold the rectangle in half. Using a darning needle and the tail you just cut, seam together the short sides of the rectangle with the cast-on edge of the leaf, being sure to center the stem as you seam it on. When finished, weave in the end of your working yarn into the back of the leaf to secure the seam.

### Red Leaf Stem (Slipped-Stitch Ribbing):

Cast on 13 stitches using the long-tail cast-on method. Work the following two rows 49 times, then work Row 1 one additional time.

**1-WS:** s1, [k1, s1] to end

**2-RS:** k1, [p1, k1] to end

Bind off using your preferred technique. Note that this bind-off edge isn't as important as the bind-off edge of the Yellow Leaf Stem because this edge is not visible after seaming. Cut your yarn leaving a tail of approximately 12 inches and pull it through the last stitch to complete the bind-off. Fold the rectangle in half such that the side with the slipped stitches is facing out. Using a darning needle and the tail you just cut, seam together the short sides of the rectangle with the cast-on edge of the leaf, being sure to center the stem on the leaf. When finished, weave in the end of your working yarn into the back of the leaf to secure the seam.

## CHARTED INSTRUCTIONS

The charted instructions for the shawl have been included here and on the following pages. Sections A, B, C, & D can be found on this page. Row numbers in the charts correspond to the row numbers in the written instructions.


The shawl is symmetrical, so only one side of the chart is shown in order to save space. As such, all rows are read from right to left, then again from left to right. The leftmost stitch in the chart represents the middle two stitches that form the center spine of the leaf (p2 on the RS and k2 on the WS).

The chart legend below indicates which stitch to perform depending on the chart symbol. Note that all of the instructions are the same for both the right side and left side of the shawl, with the exception of the single decrease (ssk / k2tog) and double decrease (pkdd / kpdd).


Grey boxes can be ignored, as these do not represent stitches. They merely help display increases & decreases. Bracketed repeats in the written instructions are represented in the charted instructions with a lighter color and a darker border (see next page for an example).
