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Construction:

The Felia Cardigan is knitted by starting at the back from the top down to the base of the armholes. Then, both fronts are picked up and knitted separately to the armhole, and then the front and back are joined and knitted in flat down to the hem. Pick up and knit for the sleeves.

Gauge / With 7 mm (US 10.75) needle :

12 sts x 18 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4" in stockinette stitch after blocking.

Recommended ease : 0~80 cm / 0~31.5"

To pick your size, I recommend making a swatch with your yarn, checking your gauge and adjusting needle size accordingly, measure around your full bust, then add your desired ease. Pick the closest size from the finished bust circumference.

Yarn:

Cardiff Cashmere Brushmere, 100% cashmere, 25g=45m/49yds.

Sample photo shown in Size 1 with Color No.113

13 (20, 28) Balls. Approx. 585 (900, 1260) m/640 (984, 1378) yds.

The yarn amount is based on the length of the sample piece. If you choose to knit the extended version, you'll need to add 4~6 balls of yarn. (Approx. 180~270 m/197~295 yds)

The length of the extended version of the garment will be increased by 8.5cm/3.5".

Needles:

7 mm (US 10.75) for the body and sleeves. 6 mm (US 10) for the front band, hem and cuffs. (Use circular needles ranging from 40 to 120 cm according to the requirements of each section)

Other Materials:

Stitch markers, stitch holder cord or waste yarn.

German Short-Rows techniques:

- 1, (RS): Knit to the instructed stitch of the pattern, turn work to WS.
- 2, (WS): With yarn in front, slip the first stitch purlwise, bring yarn over the needle towards the back and pull tight, creating two loops out of the same stitch, so that double stitch (DS) has been made. Purl to the instructed stitch of the pattern, turn work to RS.
- 3, (RS): With yarn in front, slip the first stitch purlwise, bring yarn over the needle towards the back and pull tight, create a double stitch (DS) as before, knit the next stitch as usual.
- 4, When working over double stitch (DS), treat them as a single stitch, knit both loops together on a RS row (kDS), or purl both loops together on a WS row (pDS).

Note: When a row description does not specify a size, it applies to all sizes.

Instructions**Back**

With 7 mm (US 10.75) needle, long tail cast on 89 (105, 121) sts.

Next Row (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Section 1: Short Rows

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, k57 (65, 73), turn.

Row 2 (WS): DS, p30, turn.

Row 3 (RS): DS, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 4 (WS): DS, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 5 (RS): **Size 1:** DS, k8, [k2tog, k1, yo, k5] 4 times, k1, kDS, k6, turn.

Sizes 2, 3: DS, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 6 (WS): DS, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

- Row 7 (RS): **Size 1:** DS, k5, [k2tog, k2, yo, k4] rep to DS, kDS, k6, turn.
Sizes 2, 3: DS, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.
- Row 8 (WS): DS, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.
- Row 9 (RS): **Size 1:** DS, k2, k2tog, k3, yo, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to 2 sts before DS, k2, kDS, k6, turn.
Size 2: DS, k13, [k2tog, yo, k6] rep to 4 sts before DS, k4, kDS, k6, turn.
Size 3: DS, k7, [k3, yo, k3, ssk] rep to 2 sts before DS, k2, kDS, k6, turn.
- Row 10 (WS): DS, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.
- Row 11 (RS): **Size 1:** DS, k7, [k2tog, k4, yo, k2] rep to 6 sts before DS, k6, kDS, k2, p1, k2.
Size 2: DS, k2, [k2tog, k1, yo, k5] rep to 3 sts before DS, k3, kDS, k6, turn.
Size 3: DS, k8, [yo, k4, ssk, k2] rep to 5 sts before DS, k5, kDS, k6, turn.
- Row 12 (WS): **Size 1:** p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p2, k1, p2.
Size 2, 3: DS, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.
- Row 13 (RS): **Size 1:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
Size 2: DS, k7, [k2tog, k2, yo, k4] rep to 2 sts before DS, k2, kDS, k4, p1, k2.
Size 3: DS, k6, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to 3 sts before DS, k3, kDS, k6, turn.
- Row 14 (WS): **Size 1:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.
Size 2: p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p4, k1, p2.
Size 3: DS, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.
- Row 15 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, k3, [k2tog, k3, yo, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.
Size 3: DS, k7, k2tog, yo, [k2, ssk, yo, k2, k2tog, yo] rep to 4 sts before DS, k4, kDS, k6, p1, k2.
- Row 16 (WS): **Size 2:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.
Size 3: p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, k1, p2.
- Row 17 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, k2, [k2tog, k4, yo, k2] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.
Size 3: k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
- Row 18 (WS): **Sizes 2, 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.
- Row 19 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
Size 3: k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
- Row 20 (WS): **Sizes 2, 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.
For Size 2 only, proceed to **Section 2**.
- Row 21 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, k3, [k2tog, k3, yo, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.
- Row 22 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.
- Row 23 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, k2, [k2tog, k4, yo, k2] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Row 24 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 25 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, k1, [k2tog, k5, yo, k1] rep to last 5 sts, k2, p1, k2.

Row 26 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Section 2: Continue knitting the back piece

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, [k2tog, k2, yo, ssk, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

The following even-numbered rows will all be the same as Row 2.

Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k1, ssk, k5] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 5 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, ssk, k4] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k3, ssk, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 9 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k4, ssk, k2] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 11 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 13 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, ssk] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 15 (RS): k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 17 (RS): k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 19 (RS): k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.


Row 21 (RS): k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 23 (RS): k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 24 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1~10 once, until you have completed Row 34 (WS).

Cut the working yarn, leave the sts on hold, then proceed to the Right Front.



Right Front

With 7 mm (US 10.75) needle and right side facing, as shown in the schematic above, pick up and knit 33 (41, 49) sts from the right side of the CO edge of the Back piece.

Next Row (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Section 1: Short Rows

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, k to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, p1, turn.

Row 3 (RS): DS, p1, k2.

Row 4 (WS): p2, k1, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 5 (RS): DS, k to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 6 (WS): p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 7 (RS): DS, k to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 8 (WS): p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 9 (RS): **Size 1:** DS, k2, [k2tog, k3, yo, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Size 2: DS, k13, k2tog, yo, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: DS, k10, yo, k3, ssk, k3, p1, k2.

Row 10 (WS): p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 11 (RS): **Size 1:** DS, k7, [k2tog, k4, yo, k2] 2 times, k1, p1, k2.

Size 2: DS, k2, k2tog, k1, yo, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] 2 times, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: DS, k8, [yo, k4, ssk, k2] 2 times, p1, k2.

Row 12 (WS): **Size 1:** p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p2, k1, p2.

Sizes 2, 3: p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 13 (RS): **Size 1:** k2, p1, k1, [k2tog, k5, yo, k1] rep to last 5 sts, k2, p1, k2.

Size 2: DS, k3, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: DS, k6, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 14 (WS): **Size 1:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Size 2: p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p4, k1, p2.

Size 3: p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, turn.

Row 15 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, k3, [k2tog, k3, yo, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Size 3: DS, k7, k2tog, yo, [k2, ssk, yo, k2, k2tog, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 16 (WS): **Size 2:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Size 3: p2, k1, p to DS, pDS, p6, k1, p2.

Row 17 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, k2, [k2tog, k4, yo, k2] rep to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k2.

Size 3: k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 18 (WS): **Sizes 2, 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 19 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 20 (WS): **Size 2:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Size 3: p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 21 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 22 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 23 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 24 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 25 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 26 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Section 2: Continue knitting the Right Front piece

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, [k2tog, k2, yo, ssk, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

The following even-numbered rows will all be the same as Row 2.

Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k1, ssk, k5] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 5 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, ssk, k4] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k3, ssk, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 9 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k4, ssk, k2] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 11 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 13 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, ssk] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 15 (RS): k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 17 (RS): k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 19 (RS): k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 21 (RS): k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 23 (RS): k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 24 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1~10 once, until you have completed Row 34 (WS).

Cut the working yarn and leave the sts on hold, then proceed to do the Left Front.

Left Front

With 7 mm (US 10.75) needles and right side facing, as shown in the schematic on page 6, pick up and knit 33 (41, 49) sts from the left side of the CO edge of the Back piece.

Next Row (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Section 1: Short Rows

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, k1, turn.

Row 2 (WS): DS, k1, p2.

Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 4 (WS): DS, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 5 (RS): k2, p1, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 6 (WS): DS, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 8 (WS): DS, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 9 (RS): **Size 1:** k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] 2 times, k2, kDS, k6, turn.

Size 2: k2, p1, k6, k2tog, yo, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Size 3: k2, p1, [k3, yo, k3, ssk] 2 times, k2, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 10 (WS): DS, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 11 (RS): **Size 1:** k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] 2 times, k to DS, kDS, k2, p1, k2.

Size 2: k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] 2 times, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Size 3: k2, p1, k1, [k2, yo, k4, ssk] 2 times, k to DS, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 12 (WS): **Size 1:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Sizes 2, 3: DS, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 13 (RS): **Size 1:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] 3 times, k3, p1, k2.

Size 2: k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] 3 times, k6, kDS, k4, p1, k2.

Size 3: k2, p1, k3, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] 3 times, k3, kDS, k6, turn.

Row 14 (WS): **Size 1:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Size 2: p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Size 3: DS, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 15 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: k2, p1, [k2, ssk, yo, k2, k2tog, yo] rep to 4 sts before DS, k4, kDS, k6, p1, k2.

Row 16 (WS): **Sizes 2, 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 17 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 18 (WS): **Sizes 2, 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 19 (RS): **Size 2:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Size 3: k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 20 (WS): **Size 2:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Size 3: p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 21 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 22 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 23 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 24 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 25 (RS): **Size 3:** k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 26 (WS): **Size 3:** p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2. Then proceed to **Section 2**.

Section 2: Continue knitting the Left Front piece

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, [k2tog, k2, yo, ssk, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.
The following even-numbered rows will all be the same as Row 2.

Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k1, ssk, k5] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 5 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, ssk, k4] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k3, ssk, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 9 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k4, ssk, k2] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 11 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 13 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, ssk] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 15 (RS): k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
 Row 17 (RS): k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
 Row 19 (RS): k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
 Row 21 (RS): k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
 Row 23 (RS): k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.
 Row 24 (WS): Same as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1~10 once, until you have completed Row 34 (WS). Don't need to cut the working yarn.

Continue to the next row of the Left Front then join the Back and the Right Front:

Joining Row(RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, k3, **PM**, use backwards loop cast on method CO 7 sts, then join the Back: k6, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, k3, **PM**, use backwards loop cast on method CO 7 sts, then join the Right Front: k6, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

TS: 169 (201, 233)

Next Row(WS): p2, k1, [p to M, **SM**] 2 times, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Body

Row 1 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, ssk] rep to 3 sts before M, k3, **SM**, k8, k2tog, yo, k3, [yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, ssk] rep to 3 sts before M, k3, **SM**, k8, k2tog, yo, k3, [yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k2, ssk] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 2 (WS): p2, k1, [p to M, **RM**] 2 times, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Row 3 (RS): k2, p1, [k5, k2tog, k1, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 4 (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

The following even-numbered rows will all be the same as Row 4.

Row 5 (RS): k2, p1, [k4, k2tog, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 7 (RS): k2, p1, [k3, k2tog, k3, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 9 (RS): k2, p1, [k2, k2tog, k4, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 11 (RS): k2, p1, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 13 (RS): **Sample version:** k2, p1, [k2tog, k6, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Note: Based on the demonstrated length in the photo, proceed to knit the hem after completing the Row 14. If you want to increase the length of the garment, work the extended version for the Row 13 then continue knitting Rows 14~26 as described below.

Extended version: k2, p1, [k2tog, k2, yo, ssk, k2, yo] rep to last 6 sts, k3, p1, k2.

Row 15 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k1, ssk, k5] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 17 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k2, ssk, k4] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 19 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k3, ssk, k3] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 21 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k4, ssk, k2] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 23 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k5, ssk, k1] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 25 (RS): k2, p1, k3, [yo, k6, ssk] rep to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Row 26 (WS): p2, k1, p to last 3 sts, k1, p2.

Hem

Switch to 6 mm (US 10) needle:

Row 1 (RS): k2, k2tog, [p2, k2] rep to last 1 st, k1. TS: 168 (200, 232)

Row 2 (WS): p3, [k2, p2] rep to last 1 st, p1.

Row 3 (RS): k3, [p2, k2] rep to last 1 st, k1.

Row 4 (WS): p3, [k2, p2] rep to last 1 st, p1.

Rep Rows 3~4, 6 more times, until you have completed Row 16 (WS). BO with I-cord bind off method.

Front band

With 6 mm (US 10) needles and the right side facing, beginning at the bottom of the right-front, pick up and knit 3 sts from 4 rows evenly along the right-front edge, pick up and knit 23 sts from the back neck CO edge, pick up and knit 3 sts from 4 rows evenly along the left-front edge. Adjust the stitch count as follows to match the ribbing pattern:

Sample version: Pick up and knit 65 (69, 73) sts along the right-front edge, 23 sts from the back neck CO edge, 64 (68, 72) sts along the left-front edge. TS: 152 (160, 168)

Extended version: Pick up and knit 73 (79, 83) sts along the right-front edge, 23 sts from the back neck CO edge, 72 (78, 82) sts along the left-front edge. TS: 168 (180, 188)

Next Row (WS): sl1-wyif, k1, sl1-wyif, k2, [p2, k2] rep to last 3 sts, sl1-wyif, k1, sl1-wyif.

Row 1 (RS): k1, sl1-wyif, k1, p2, [k2, p2] rep to last 3 sts, k1, sl1-wyif, k1

Row 2 (WS): sl1-wyif, k1, sl1-wyif, k2, [p2, k2] rep to last 3 sts, sl1-wyif, k1, sl1-wyif.

Rep Rows 1~2, 6 more times, until you have completed Row 14 (WS). BO with I-cord bind off method.

Sleeve (Both alike)

With 7 mm (US 10.75) needle and right side facing, beginning at the center underarm, pick up and knit 4 sts from the CO edge of the underarm, then pick up and knit 60 (66, 72) sts (3 sts for every 4 rows) around the armhole edge, pick up and knit 3 sts from the leftover CO edge of the underarm, PM for BOR. TS: 67 (73, 79)

Next Rnd: k to M.

Rnd 1: **Size 1:** k9, k2tog, [k4, yo, k2, k2tog] rep to M. TS: 66

Size 2: k5, k2tog, [k4, yo, k2, k2tog] rep to 2 sts before M, k2. TS: 72

Size 3: k5, k2tog, [k4, yo, k2, k2tog] rep to M. TS: 78

Rnd 2: k to M.

Rnd 3: **Size 1:** k8, k2tog, [k5, yo, k1, k2tog] rep to M. TS: 65

Size 2: k3, [k1, k2tog, k5, yo] rep to last 5 sts, k5.

Size 3: k4, k2tog, [k5, yo, k1, k2tog] rep to M. TS: 77

Rnd 4: Same as Rnd 2.

Rnd 5: **Size 1:** k7, k2tog, [k6, yo, k2tog] rep to M. TS: 64

Size 2: k3, [k2tog, k6, yo] rep to last 5 sts, k5.

Size 3: k3, k2tog, [k6, yo, k2tog] rep to M. TS: 76

Rnd 6: Same as Rnd 2.

Cuff (Both alike)

Switch to 6 mm (US 10) needle, working on [p2, k2] for a total of 16 Rnds.

BO with I-cord bind off method in the round and grafting.

Finishing

Weave in the ends and wet block to measurements.
