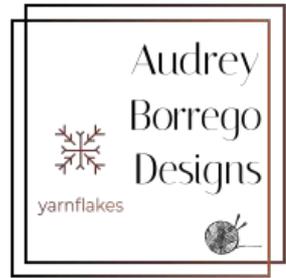


Felise



Notes

Felise is a drop shoulder sweater knitted from the bottom up with a texture panel on the side. Its simple and customizable construction allows lightweight drapery yarns to shine. The panel, worked in twisted ribbing, right and left twist and cables, remains simple. The pattern provides charted and written instructions for it.

Yarn :

You will need

870 (**950** / 1050 / **1150** / 1270), **1380** (1450 / **1600** / 1720 / **1850**) meters
950 (**1040** / 1150 / **1260** / 1390), **1510** (1585 / **1750** / 1880 / **2025**) yards
of fingering or sport weight yarn.

The sample is knit with Katia Concept Tencel Merino (135 m – 148 yds / 50 g) in 56.

Needles :

Main Fabric : 3 mm (US 2.5) circular needles with appropriate length to knit in the round and magic loop or DPNs.

Ribbing : 2.75 mm (US 2) circular needles with appropriate length to knit in the round and magic loop or DPNs.

or size required to get gauge

Gauge :

22 sts x 36 rnds per 10 cm – 4" with larger needles in stockinette after blocking

Texture panel width : Sizes 1 to 3 : 12 cm / Sizes 4 to 6 : 14 cm / Sizes 7 to 10 : 16.5 cm

Notions :

Stitch markers, tapestry needle and scissors

Scrap yarn to place sts on hold

Cable needle (optional)

Row counter recommended

Techniques used :

Bottom up drop shoulder sweater

Body worked straight in the round until the armholes

Front and Back worked flat separately

Shoulders shaped with German short rows and joined with a 3 needle bind-off

Sleeves picked up and worked in the round, tapered with simple decreases

Texture panel on the front left, width adjusted according to size

Twisted ribbing, Right and Left Twists, Simple 4 st cable

2/2 ribbing

Folded collar

Pattern includes charted and written instructions

Notes :

Left and Right parts refer to the sweater when worn.

Reading the Chart

When knitting in the round, always read the Charts from right to left.

When knitting flat, read the Charts back and forth : RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

You will find the Chart on pages 10 to 12 and written instructions on pages 13 to 18.


Sizes :

1 (2 / 3 / 4 / 5), 6 (7 / 8 / 9 / 10)

All measurements are those of the finished sweater.

Choose a size with about 20 cm – 7 ¾" positive ease at bust.

Shown in size 3 on a 90 cm – 35 ½" bust.

Abbreviations :

- st(s) : stitch(es) / rnd(s) : round(s)
- m : marker / pm : place marker / sm : slip marker
- BOR : beginning of round
- RS : right side / WS : wrong side
- inc : increase / dec : decrease
- k : knit stitch / p : purl stitch
- m1L : make 1 left, lift the bar between the stitches onto the left needle from front to back, knit through the back loop (1 inc)
- m1R : make 1 right, lift the bar between the stitches onto the left needle from back to front, knit through the front loop (1 inc)
- ktbl : knit the st through its back loop
- ptbl : purl the st through its back loop
- RT (see tutorial below) : right twist, k2tog without dropping the sts off the needle, then knit into the first stitch again
- LT (see tutorial below) : left twist, ignoring the first st ktbl the second st on the left needle from the back of work, then k2tog through the back loop the first and second sts of the left needle
- 1/2 RC : slip the next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in back, k1 from left needle then k2 from cable needle
- 1/2 LC : slip the next st onto a cable needle and hold in front, k2 from left needle then k1 from cable needle
- 2/2 LC (3/3 LC) : slip the next 2 (3) sts onto a cable needle and hold in front, k2(3) from left needle then k2(3) from cable needle
- k2tog : knit the next 2 sts together (1 dec)
- p2tog : purl the next 2 sts together (1 dec)
- ssk : slip the next two sts knitwise separately then knit them together through their back loop (1 dec)
- ssp : slip the next two sts knitwise separately then purl them together through their back loop (1 dec)
- k2togtbl : knit the next 2 sts together through their back loop (1 dec)
- DS : double stitch for German short rows (counts as only 1 st)
- *-* : repeat instructions between asterisks

Hem

With smaller needles, cast-on 204 (**224** / 248 / **268** / 292), **312** (336 / **360** / 380 / **404**) sts using a stretchy [German Twisted Cast-on](#).

(German Twisted Cast-on tutorial by Very Pink Knits)

Being careful not to twist the sts, join to work in the rnd and PM for BOR.

PM also after the first 110 (**116** / 128 / **140** / 154), **164** (180 / **192** / 204 / **216**) sts to mark the side.

Note : there are more sts on the front to accomodate for bust and gauge difference in the future left front texture panel. This will also be reflected in the shoulders st counts.

ribbing rnd : *k2, p2* to end

Work the ribbing rnd until the hem measures 5 cm – 2" or desired length.

Sizes 2, 4, 6, 7, 9 ONLY :

next rnd : work ribbing in pattern (knitting the knit sts and purling the purl sts) to m, sm, m1L, work ribbing in pattern to end, m1R (2 inc)

- (**226** / - / **270** / -), **314** (338 / - / 382 / -) sts

Body

You have 110 (**116** / 128 / **140** / 154), **164** (180 / **192** / 204 / **216**) sts on the front and 94 (**110** / 120 / **130** / 138), **144** (158 / **168** / 178 / **188**) sts on the back.

You will place markers to position the texture panel on the left of the front.

The texture panel consists of : 32 sts (Sizes 1 to 3) / 38 sts (Sizes 4 to 6) / 44 sts (Sizes 7 to 10).

set-up rnd : k12 (**13** / 18 / **19** / 25), **30** (32 / **36** / 40 / **45**), pm, k32 (**32** / 32 / **38** / 38), **38** (44 / **44** / 44 / **44**), pm, knit to end

Switch to larger needles.

Work the Chart for your size continuously from now on, starting with rnd 1.

body rnd : knit to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, knit to end

Work the body rnd until the body measures about 30 cm – 11 3/4" from cast-on edge or desired length to underarm, ending with an odd rnd of the Chart.

Separate Front and Back

You will bind off sts at each side for the underarms, separating the upper front and upper back to work them flat separately.

next rnd : knit to m, sm Chart to m, sm, knit to 1 (**3** / 4 / **5** / 6), 7 (8 / **10** / 11 / **12**) sts before m, bind-off the next 2 (**6** / 8 / **10** / 12), **14** (16 / **20** / 22 / **24**) sts removing side m, knit to last 1 (**3** / 4 / **5** / 6), 7 (8 / **10** / 11 / **12**) sts, bind-off the next 2 (**6** / 8 / **10** / 12), **14** (16 / **20** / 22 / **24**) sts removing BOR m

Leave the 92 (**104** / 112 / **120** / 126), **130** (142 / **148** / 156 / **164**) upper back sts on hold.

You are now at the front, ready to work a RS row (odd rnd of the Chart).

108 (**110** / 120 / **130** / 142), **150** (164 / **172** / 182 / **192**) upper front sts

Front

front row 1 (RS) : knit to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, knit to end

front row 2 (WS) : purl to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, purl to end

Work front rows 1-2, until the upper front measures 9 (**10** / 11 / **12** / 13), **14** (15 / **15** / 16 / **17**) cm – 3 1/2 (**4** / 4 1/4 / **4** 3/4 / 5), **5** 1/2 (6 / **6** / 6 1/4 / **6** 3/4)" from the underarm, ending with a WS row.

You will bind off sts on the center front to start the neckline shaping and work each shoulder separately.

next row (RS) : knit to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, k7 (**9** / 9 / **8** / 9), **9** (9 / **10** / 12 / **12**), bind-off the next 14 (**14** / 16 / **16** / 16), **18** (18 / **20** / 20 / **22**) sts, knit to end

Note down which row of the Chart you just worked to continue it later.

Leave the 50 (**51** / 55 / **60** / 66), **70** (77 / **80** / 85 / **89**) front left shoulder sts on hold.

44 (**45** / 49 / **54** / 60), **62** (69 / **72** / 77 / **81**) front right shoulder sts

Front Right Shoulder

Neck Shaping :

row 1 (WS) : purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 (*1 dec*)

row 2 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (*1 dec*)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 1 (**2** / 2 / **2** / 2), **2** (2 / **2** / 3 / **3**) times.

42 (**41** / 45 / **50** / 56), **58** (65 / **68** / 71 / **75**) sts

row 3 (WS) : purl

row 4 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (*1 dec*)

Work rows 3-4 a total of 4 (**3** / 3 / **2** / 3), **3** (3 / **4** / 4 / **4**) times.

38 (**38** / 42 / **48** / 53), **55** (62 / **64** / 67 / **71**) sts

Continue in stockinette, knitting RS rows and purling WS rows, until the front right shoulder measures 15 (**16** / 17 / **18** / 19), **20** (21 / **22** / 23 / **25**) cm – 6 (**6** ¼ / 6 ¾ / 7 / 7 ½), 7 ¾ (8 ¼ / **8** ¾ / 9 / **9** ¾)" from the underarm, measuring along the armhole and ending with a WS row.

Note down how many rows you worked to replicate them on the other front shoulder.

Shoulder Shaping :

Here is a [helpful tutorial](#) on how to make Double Stitches.

(German short-rows tutorial by Very Pink Knits)

short-row 1 (RS) : knit to last 5 sts, turn

short-row 2 (WS) : DS, purl to end

short-row 3 : knit to 4 sts before last DS, turn

short-row 4 : DS, purl to end

Work short-rows 3-4 a total of 6 times.

next row (RS) : knit to end, knitting the DS normally as one st

Cut yarn and put sts on hold.

Front Left Shoulder

Rejoin yarn on the WS of the front left shoulder sts. Resume Chart where you stopped.

Neck Shaping :

row 1 (WS) : p2, p2tog, purl to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, purl to end (*1 dec*)

row 2 (RS) : knit to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 1 (**2** / 2 / **2** / 2), **2** (2 / **2** / 3 / **3**) times.

48 (**47** / 51 / **56** / 62), **66** (73 / **76** / 79 / **83**) sts

row 3 (WS) : purl to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, purl to end

row 4 (RS) : knit to m, sm, Chart to m, sm, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 3-4 a total of 3 (**2** / 2 / **1** / 2), **2** (2 / **3** / 3 / **3**) times, then work row 3 once more.

next row (RS) : knit to m, sm, Chart to 1 st before m, k2togtbl removing marker and replacing it after the dec, k2 (*1 dec*)

44 (**44** / 48 / **54** / 59), **63** (70 / **72** / 75 / **79**) sts

Continue straight as established, working the Chart between the markers and the rest in stockinette (knitting RS rows and purling WS rows), like you did for the Front Right Shoulder, reaching the same length and ending with a RS row.

Shoulder Shaping :

You will stop following the Chart as you work short rows. Instead, work the sts in pattern : knit the knit sts, purl the purl sts, twist (ktbl on RS, ptbl on WS) the twisted sts and work the garter squares in garter (knit every row).

short-row 1 (WS) : work in pattern to last 5 sts, turn

short-row 2 (RS) : DS, work in pattern to end

short-row 3 : work in pattern to 5 sts before last DS, turn

short-row 4 : DS, work in pattern to end

Work short-rows 3-4 a total of 6 times.

next row (WS) : purl to end, purling the DS normally as one st

Remove markers, cut yarn and put sts on hold.

Back

Rejoin yarn on the WS of the 92 (**104** / 112 / **120** / 126), **130** (142 / **148** / 156 / **164**) back sts.

back row 1 (WS) : purl

back row 2 (RS) : knit

Work back rows 1-2, until the upper back measures 13 (**14** / 15 / **16** / 17), **18** (19 / **20** / 20 / **22**) cm – 5 (5 1/2 / 6 / **6 1/4** / 6 3/4), 7 (7 1/2 / 7 3/4 / 7 3/4 / **8 3/4**)" from the underarm, ending with a WS row.

next row (RS) : k41 (**45** / 49 / **53** / 58), **60** (65 / **69** / 73 / 77), bind off the next 10 (**14** / 14 / **14** / 10), **10** (12 / **10** / 10 / **10**) sts, knit to end

Leave the 41 (**45** / 49 / **53** / 58), **60** (65 / **69** / 73 / 77) back right shoulder sts on hold.

41 (**45** / 49 / **53** / 58), **60** (65 / **69** / 73 / 77) back left shoulder sts

Back Left Shoulder

Neck Shaping :

Sizes 1, 7 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : purl

row 2 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (1 dec)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 3 times, then row 1 once more.

38 (- / - / - / -), - (62 / - / - / -) sts

Sizes 2, 3 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 (1 dec)

row 2 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (1 dec)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 3 times, then row 1 once more.

- (**38** / 42 / - / -), - (- / - / - / -) sts

Sizes 4, 5, 6, 8 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 (1 dec)

row 2 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (1 dec)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 2 times.

- (- / - / **49** / 54), **56** (- / **65** / - / -) sts

row 3 (WS) : purl

row 4 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (1 dec)

Work rows 3-4 once, then row 3 once more.

- (- / - / **48** / 53), **55** (- / **64** / - / -) sts

Sizes 9, 10 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 (1 dec)

row 2 (RS) : k2, ssk, knit to end (1 dec)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 3 times.

next row (WS) : purl

- (- / - / - / -), - (- / - / 67 / **71**) sts

Continue in stockinette until the back left shoulder's length matches the front left shoulder's along the underarm, ending with a WS row.

Note down how many rows you worked to replicate them on the other back shoulder.

Shoulder Shaping :

Work like for Front Right Shoulder.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail to seam the shoulder later and put sts on hold.

Back Right Shoulder

Rejoin yarn on the WS of the 41 (**45** / 49 / **53** / 58), **60** (65 / **69** / 73 / **77**) back right shoulder sts.

Neck Shaping :

Sizes 1, 7 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : purl

row 2 (RS) : knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 3 times, then row 1 once more.

38 (- / - / - / -), - (**62** / - / - / -) sts

Sizes 2, 3 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : p2, p2tog, purl to end (*1 dec*)

row 2 (RS) : knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 3 times, then row 1 once more.

- (**38** / **42** / - / -), - (- / - / - / -) sts

Sizes 4, 5, 6, 8 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : p2, p2tog, purl to end (*1 dec*)

row 2 (RS) : knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 2 times.

- (- / - / **49** / **54**), **56** (- / **65** / - / -) sts

row 3 (WS) : purl

row 4 (RS) : knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 3-4 once, then row 3 once more.

- (- / - / **48** / **53**), **55** (- / **64** / - / -) sts

Sizes 9, 10 ONLY :

row 1 (WS) : p2, p2tog, purl to end (*1 dec*)

row 2 (RS) : knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 (*1 dec*)

Work rows 1-2 a total of 3 times.

next row (WS) : purl

- (- / - / - / -), - (- / - / **67** / **71**) sts

Continue in stockinette like you did for the back left shoulder, reaching the same length and ending with a RS row.

Shoulder Shaping :

short-row 1 (WS) : purl to last 5 sts, turn

short-row 2 (RS) : DS, knit to end

short-row 3 : purl to 4 sts before last DS, turn

short-row 4 : DS, knit to end

Work short-rows 3-4 a total of 6 times.

next row (WS) : purl to end, purling the DS normally as one st

Joining Shoulders

Flip the sweater inside out so you are looking at the WS.

With the yarn still attached to the right back shoulder, place the corresponding front shoulder sts on another needle. Using the [three-needle bind-off method](#), starting on the armhole edge, join front and back shoulders together.

(3-needle bind-off tutorial by Very Pink Knits)

When you have 1 st left, thread working yarn through it and fasten off.

Place the sts from the left shoulders back on two needles.

With the long tail you left attached to the left back shoulder, repeat the three-needle bind-off for this side, starting on the armhole edge and resolving the extra sts on the Left Front Shoulder as follows :

- Bind-off 1 back st with 1 front st normally until 6 (**6** / 6 / **6** / 6), **8** (8 / **8** / 8 / **8**) sts remain on the back shoulder and twice that on the front shoulder,
- Bind-off 1 back st with 2 front sts to end.

When you have 1 st left, thread working yarn through it and fasten off.

Collar

With smaller needles, starting at the right shoulder seam, pick up and knit 100 (**104** / 104 / **108** / 112), **116** (120 / **120** / 124 / **128**) sts around the neckline.

Join to work in the rnd and PM for BOR.

ribbing rnd : *k2, p2* to end

Work the ribbing rnd until the collar measures 9 cm – 3 1/2" or twice the desired length.

You will now fold the collar on the inside and seam it down. Cut yarn, leaving a tail about three times the circumference of the collar.

Fold the collar WS together. Attach the live stitches to the pick up line, as shown on this [video tutorial](#). Use the columns of the ribbing to track and keep the collar aligned. (*Sewn Hem for Top-down Knitting tutorial by WEBS*)

Sleeves

With larger needles and starting at the center of the underarm, pick up and knit 1 (**3** / 4 / **5** / 6), 7 (8 / **10** / 11 / **12**) sts from the underarm bind-off, 60 (**62** / 68 / **74** / 76), **82** (84 / **86** / 88 / **90**) sts evenly around the armhole, then 1 (**3** / 4 / **5** / 6), 7 (8 / **10** / 11 / **12**) sts from the rest of the underarm bind-off.

Join to work in the rnd and PM for BOR.

62 (**68** / 76 / **84** / 88), **96** (100 / **106** / 110 / **114**) sts

Continue in stockinette, knitting every rnd, until the sleeve measures 5 (**4** / 4 / **5** / 0), **4** (0 / **5** / 5 / **5**) cm – 2 (**1 1/2** / 1 1/2 / **2** / 0), **1 1/2** (0 / **2** / 2 / **2**)" from the underarm.

dec rnd : k1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 (2 dec)

Continue in stockinette, repeating the dec rnd every

5 (**4.5** / 3 / **2.5** / 2.5), **2** (2 / **1.5** / 1.5 / **1.5**) cm

2 (**1 3/4** / 1 1/4 / **1** / 1), **3/4** (3/4 / 1/2 / 1/2 / 1/2)"

6 (7 / 11 / **13** / 15), **17** (19 / **20** / 20 / **22**) more times.

48 (**52** / 52 / **56** / 56), **60** (60 / **64** / 68 / **68**) sts

Continue in stockinette until the sleeve measures about 42 cm – 16 1/2" from the underarm or 5 cm – 2" less than desired length.

Cuff :

Switch to smaller needles.

ribbing rnd : *k2, p2* to end

Work the ribbing rnd until the cuff measures 5 cm – 2" or desired length.

Loosely bind-off all sts in pattern.

Repeat for second sleeve.

Finishing

Weave in all ends and gently block the sweater.


