Finished Bust Circumference: 31 (33, 35, 37, 39)(41.5, 44, 46.5, 49)[52, 55, 58, 61][62.5, 64, 66, 69.5, 73] inches/78.5 (84, 89, 94, 99)(105.5, 112, 118, 124.5)[132, 139.5, 147.5, 155][159, 162.5, 167.5, 176.5, 185.5] cm *Intended to be worn with -2 to +2"/-5 to + 5 cm positive ease. Modeled with 1"/2.5 cm negative ease.*

Gauge: 16 stitches and 20 rows = 4 inches/10 cm in stockinette

Needles: US 10/6 mm circulars or long straight needles; coordinating DPNs if not magic looping

Yarn: Quince & Co Kestrel [100% linen; 76 yds/70 m per 50 g skein]; shown in colorways Urchin (deep gray-turquoise) and Clay (rosy clay-pink).

Yardage: 380 (415, 450, 480, 510)(550, 595, 640, 685)[735, 790, 850, 905][945, 980, 1045, 1100, 1170] yards/350 (380, 410, 440, 465)(505, 540, 580, 625)[675, 725, 775, 830][865, 900, 955, 1005, 1070] meters

Notions: 2 stitch markers, stitch holders or scrap yarn, darning needle

Notes: Front and back are knit flat, joined at the shoulders with a three-needle bind off, then seamed at the sides. Neckline and optional armhole finishing are picked up and knit in the round.

[Working with Kestrel](#)

Strong and steadfast, the coastal bedrock sprawls and juts out over the ocean from beneath the evergreens. It is worn with glacial striations, anchored to the shoreline. Darkening violet-grey skies and strong waves send warning signals to the unmoving ledge. Ribbons of rain whip across the water's surface, and the diving Osprey has found shelter for the interim. Tree branches bend fluidly in response to the strong winds. Though the surf swells and crashes, the rock is unmoved.

Front

With US 10/6mm needles and the long-tail method, co 88 (92, 96, 100, 104)(109, 114, 119, 124)[130, 136, 142, 148][151, 154, 158, 165, 172] sts.

Setup Row [WS]: P2, pm, p 84 (88, 92, 96, 100)(105, 110, 115, 120)[126, 132, 138, 144][147, 150, 154, 161, 168], pm, p2. Your two markers will frame the lace portion, with two edge stitches on each side for seaming later.

Fernwood RS Rows: K2, sm, work chart 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 6, 7, 7, 7] times total over 84 (88, 92, 96, 100)(105, 110, 115, 120)[126, 132, 138, 144][147, 150, 154, 161, 168] sts, sm, k2.

Fernwood WS Rows: P2, sm, work chart 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 6, 7, 7, 7] times total over 84 (88, 92, 96, 100)(105, 110, 115, 120)[126, 132, 138, 144][147, 150, 154, 161, 168], sm, p2.

Work Fernwood (charted or written, found at end of pattern) A (B, C, D, E)(A, B, C, D)[A, B, C, D][A, E, B, C, D] three times through for a total of 18 charted rows.

Front A-Line Shaping

You will now be working in stockinette and can remove the edge markers.

Work Rows C and D once, then Rows A-D a total of 12 times, ending on Row D: 64 (68, 72, 76, 80)(85, 90, 95, 100)[106, 112, 118, 124][127, 130, 134, 141, 148] sts remain.

Row A [RS]: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2. 2 sts decreased.

Row B [WS]: P to end.

Row C: K to end.

Row D: P to end.

Side length from underarm should be approximately 13.5 inches / 34.5 cm. If you wish to add more length to your garment, continue in stockinette at this point. please note your yardage will differ from suggested yardage above.

Front Armhole Shaping

Row 1 [RS]: BO 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 7, 7, 7, 7] sts, k to end. 60 (64, 68, 72, 76)(80, 85, 90, 95)[100, 106, 112, 118][120, 123, 127, 134, 141] sts remain.

Row 2 [WS]: BO 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 7, 7, 7, 7] sts, p to end. 56 (60, 64, 68, 72)(75, 80, 85, 90)[94, 100, 106, 112][113, 116, 120, 127, 134] sts remain.

Row 3: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3, 3] sts, k to end. 54 (58, 62, 66, 70)(73, 78, 83, 88)[91, 97, 103, 109][110, 113, 117, 124, 131] sts remain.

Row 4: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3, 3] sts, p to end. 52 (56, 60, 64, 68)(71, 76, 81, 86)[88, 94, 100, 106][107, 110, 114, 121, 128] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 3-4 0 (0, 1, 1, 1)(1, 2, 2, 2)[1, 2, 3, 3][2, 2, 2, 3, 3] more times: 52 (56, 56, 60, 64)(67, 68, 73, 78)[82, 82, 82, 88][95, 98, 102, 103, 110] sts remain.

Row 5: K2, k2tog, k to end. 51 (55, 55, 59, 63)(66, 67, 72, 77)[81, 81, 81, 87][94, 97, 101, 102, 109] sts remain.

Row 6: P2, p2tog tbl, p to end. 50 (54, 54, 58, 62)(65, 66, 71, 76)[80, 80, 80, 86][93, 96, 100, 101, 108] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 5-6 0 (1, 0, 1, 1)(1, 1, 2, 3)[5, 5, 5, 6][8, 9, 11, 10, 11] more times: 50 (52, 54, 56, 60)(63, 64, 67, 70)[70, 70, 70, 74][77, 78, 78, 81, 86] sts remain.

Split for Front Neckline

RS Row: K 21 (22, 23, 23, 25)(26, 25, 26, 27)[27, 27, 27, 28][29, 38, 40, 40, 42], BO center 8 (8, 8, 10, 10)(11, 14, 15, 16)[16, 16, 16, 18][19, 20, 20, 21, 24] sts, k to end.

Right Front

Row 1 [WS]: P to end. 21 (22, 23, 23, 25)(26, 25, 26, 27)[27, 27, 27, 28][29, 38, 40, 40, 42] sts.

Row 2 [RS]: BO 3 (3, 3, 3, 3)(3, 4, 4, 4)[5, 5, 5, 5][6, 6, 6, 6, 6] sts, k to end. 18 (19, 20, 20, 22)(23, 21, 22, 23)[22, 22, 22, 23][23, 32, 34, 34, 36] sts remain.

Row 3: P2, p2tog, p to end. 1 st decreased.

Row 4: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3] sts, k to end. 15 (16, 17, 17, 19)(20, 18, 19, 20)[19, 19, 19, 20][20, 29, 31, 31, 33] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 3-4 0 (0, 0, 0, 1)(0, 0, 0, 0)[0, 0, 0, 0][0, 2, 2, 2, 2] times more: 15 (16, 17, 17, 16)(20, 18, 19, 20)[19, 19, 19, 20][20, 19, 19, 19, 21] sts remain.

Row 5: P to end.

Row 6: K to end.

Row 7: P2, p2tog, p to end. 14 (15, 16, 16, 15)(19, 17, 18, 19)[18, 18, 18, 19][19, 18, 18, 18, 20] sts remain.

Row 8: K2, k2tog, k to end. 13 (14, 15, 15, 14)(18, 16, 17, 18)[17, 17, 17, 18][18, 17, 17, 17, 19] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 5-8 once more: 11 (12, 13, 13, 12)(16, 14, 15, 16)[15, 15, 15, 16][16, 15, 15, 15, 17] sts remain.

Row 9: P to end.

Row 10: K to end.

Row 11: P to end.

Row 12: K2, k2tog, k to end. 10 (11, 12, 12, 11)(15, 16, 14, 15)[14, 14, 14, 15][15, 14, 14, 14, 16] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 9-12 twice more: 8 (9, 10, 10, 9)(13, 11, 12, 13)[12, 12, 12, 13][13, 12, 12, 12, 14] sts remain.

Row 13: P to end.

Row 14: K to end.

Row 15: P to end.

Row 16: K2, k2tog, k to end. 7 (8, 9, 9, 8,)(12, 10, 11, 12)[11, 11, 11, 12][12, 11, 11, 11, 13] sts remain.

Row 17: P to end.

Repeat Rows 16-17 0 (0, 1, 1, 0)(2, 0, 1, 2)[1, 1, 1, 2][1, 0, 0, 0, 0] times more: 7 (8, 8, 8, 8)(10, 10, 10, 10)[10, 10, 10, 10][11, 11, 11, 11, 13] sts remain.

Work even in stockinette for 2 (0, 0, 0, 0)(0, 4, 2, 0)[2, 2, 2, 0][2, 0, 0, 0, 0] additional rows.

Break yarn leaving 8"/20 cm tail and place sts on hold.

Left Front

Row 1 [RS]: Rejoin yarn with RS facing and knit to end. 21 (22, 23, 23, 25)(26, 25, 26, 27)[27, 27, 27, 28][29, 38, 40, 40, 42] sts remain.

Row 2 [WS]: BO 3 (3, 3, 3, 3)(3, 4, 4, 4)[5, 5, 5, 5][6, 6, 6, 6, 6] sts, p to end. 18 (19, 20, 20, 22)(23, 21, 22, 23)[22, 22, 22, 23][23, 32, 34, 34, 36] sts remain.

Row 3: K2, k2tog, k to end. 1 st decreased.

Row 4: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3, 3] sts, p to end. 15 (16, 17, 17, 19)(20, 18, 19, 20)[19, 19, 19, 20][20, 29, 31, 31, 33] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 3-4 0 (0, 0, 0, 1)(0, 0, 0, 0)[0, 0, 0, 0][0, 2, 2, 2] times more: 15 (16, 17, 17, 16)(20, 18, 19, 20)[19, 19, 19, 20][20, 19, 19, 19, 21] sts remain.

Row 5: K to end.

Row 6: P to end.

Row 7: K2, k2tog, k to end. 14 (15, 16, 16, 15)(19, 17, 18, 19)[18, 18, 18, 19][19, 18, 18, 18, 20] sts remain.

Row 8: P2, p2tog, p to end. 13 (14, 15, 15, 14)(18, 16, 17, 18)[17, 17, 17, 18][18, 17, 17, 17, 19] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 5-8 once more: 11 (12, 13, 13, 12)(16, 14, 15, 16)[15, 15, 15, 16][16, 15, 15, 15, 17] sts remain.

Row 9: K to end.

Row 10: P to end.

Row 11: K to end.

Row 12: P2, p2tog, p to end. 10 (11, 12, 12, 11)(15, 16, 14, 15)[14, 14, 14, 15][15, 14, 14, 14, 16] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 9-12 twice more: 8 (9, 10, 10, 9)(13, 11, 12, 13)[12, 12, 12, 13][13, 12, 12, 12, 14] sts remain.

Row 13: K to end.

Row 14: P to end.

Row 15: K to end.

Row 16: P2, P2tog, p to end. 7 (8, 9, 9, 8,)(12, 10, 11, 12)[11, 11, 11, 12][12, 11, 11, 11, 13] sts remain.

Row 17: K to end.

Repeat Rows 16-17 0 (0, 1, 1, 0)(2, 0, 1, 2)[1, 1, 1, 2][1, 0, 0, 0, 0] times more: 7 (8, 8, 8, 8)(10, 10, 10, 10)[10, 10, 10, 10][11, 11, 11, 11, 13] sts remain.

Work even in stockinette for 2 (0, 0, 0, 0)(0, 4, 2, 0)[2, 2, 2, 0][2, 0, 0, 0, 0] additional rows.

Break yarn leaving 8"/20 cm tail and place sts on hold.

Back

With US 10/6mm needles and the long-tail method, co 88 (92, 96, 100, 104)(109, 114, 119, 124)[130, 136, 142, 148][151, 154, 158, 165, 172] sts.

Setup Row [WS]: P2, pm, p 84 (88, 92, 96, 100)(105, 110, 115, 120)[126, 132, 138, 144][147, 150, 154, 161, 168], pm, p2.

Work Fernwood (charted or written) A (B, C, D, E)(A, B, C, D)[A, B, C, D][A, E, B, C, D] three times through for a total of 18 charted rows.

Fernwood RS Rows: K2, sm, work chart 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 6, 7, 7, 7] times, sm, k2.

Fernwood WS Rows: P2, sm, work chart 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 6, 7, 7, 7] times, sm, p2.

Back A-Line Shaping

You will now be working in stockinette and can remove the edge markers.

Work Rows C and D once, then Rows A-D a total of 12 times, ending on Row D: 64 (68, 72, 76, 80)(85, 90, 95, 100)[106, 112, 118, 124][127, 130, 134, 141, 148] sts remain.

Row A [RS]: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2. 2 sts decreased.

Row B [WS]: P to end.

Row C: K to end.

Row D: P to end.

If you wish to add more length to your garment, continue in stockinette at this point to match your front. Please note your yardage will differ from suggested yardage above.

Back Armhole Shaping

Row 1 [RS]: BO 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 7, 7, 7, 7] sts, k to end. 60 (64, 68, 72, 76)(80, 85, 90, 95)[100, 106, 112, 118][120, 123, 127, 134, 141] sts remain.

Row 2 [WS]: BO 4 (4, 4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 5, 5)[6, 6, 6, 6][7, 7, 7, 7, 7] sts, p to end. 56 (60, 64, 68, 72)(75, 80, 85, 90)[94, 100, 106, 112][113, 116, 120, 127, 134] sts remain.

Row 3: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3, 3] sts, k to end. 54 (58, 62, 66, 70)(73, 78, 83, 88)[91, 97, 103, 109][110, 113, 117, 124, 131] sts remain.

Row 4: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3] sts, p to end. 52 (56, 60, 64, 68)(71, 76, 81, 86)[88, 94, 100, 106][107, 110, 114, 121, 128] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 3-4 0 (0, 0, 0, 0)(0, 0, 0, 1)[1, 1, 2, 3][3, 3, 3, 4, 4] times more: 52 (56, 60, 64, 68)(71, 76, 81, 82)[82, 88, 88, 88][89, 92, 96, 97, 104] sts remain.

Row 5: K2, k2tog, k to end. 51 (55, 59, 63, 67)(70, 75, 80, 81)[81, 87, 87, 87][88, 91, 95, 96, 103] sts remain.

Row 6: P2, p2tog tbl, p to end. 50 (54, 58, 62, 66)(69, 74, 79, 80)[80, 86, 86, 86][87, 90, 94, 95, 102] sts remain.

Repeat Rows 5-6 0 (1, 1, 1, 1)(1, 2, 2, 2)[1, 3, 3, 3][4, 4, 5, 5, 5] more times: 50 (52, 56, 60, 64)(67, 70, 75, 76)[78, 80, 80, 80][79, 82, 84, 85, 92] sts.

Row 7: K to end.

Row 8: P to end.

Row 9: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2. 2 sts decreased.

Row 10: P to end.

Repeat Rows 7-10 2 (2, 3, 4, 4)(3, 4, 5, 5)[5, 6, 6, 6][4, 5, 6, 6, 7] more times: 44 (46, 48, 50, 54)(59, 60, 63, 64)[66, 66, 66, 66][69, 70, 70, 71, 76] sts remain.

Work 6 (4, 4, 2, 2)(8, 4, 0, 2)[6, 0, 0, 0][8, 6, 2, 2, 0] rows in stockinette, ending on a WS row.

Split for Back Neck

RS Row: K 12 (13, 13, 13, 13)(15, 15, 15, 15)[16, 16, 16, 16][17, 17, 17, 17, 19], BO center 20 (20, 22, 24, 28)(29, 30, 33, 34)[34, 34, 34, 34][35, 36, 36, 37, 38] sts, k to end.

Left Back Strap

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 [WS]: P to end.

Row 2 [RS]: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3, 3], k to end. 10 (11, 11, 11, 11)(13, 13, 13, 13)[13, 13, 13, 13][14, 14, 14, 14, 16] sts remain

Row 4: K2, ssk, k to end. 9 (10, 10, 10, 10)(12, 12, 12, 12)[12, 12, 12, 12][13, 13, 13, 13, 15] sts remain.

Row 6: K2, ssk, k to end. 8 (9, 9, 9, 9)(11, 11, 11, 11)[11, 11, 11, 11][12, 12, 12, 12, 14] sts remain.

Row 8: K2, ssk, k to end. 7 (8, 8, 8, 8)(10, 10, 10, 10)[10, 10, 10, 10][11, 11, 11, 11, 13] sts remain.

Row 10: K to end.

Break yarn leaving 8"/20 cm tail and place sts on hold.

Right Back Strap: Rejoin yarn with RS facing

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 [RS]: K to end.

Row 2 [WS]: BO 2 (2, 2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2, 2)[3, 3, 3, 3][3, 3, 3, 3, 3], p to end. 10 (11, 11, 11, 11)(13, 13, 13, 13)[13, 13, 13, 13][14, 14, 14, 16] sts remain

Row 4: P2, p2tog, p to end. 9 (10, 10, 10, 10)(12, 12, 12, 12)[12, 12, 12, 12][13, 13, 13, 15] sts remain.

Row 6: P2, p2tog, p to end. 8 (9, 9, 9, 9)(11, 11, 11, 11)[11, 11, 11, 11][12, 12, 12, 14] sts remain.

Row 8: P2, p2tog, p to end. 7 (8, 8, 8, 8)(10, 10, 10, 10)[10, 10, 10, 10][11, 11, 11, 13] sts remain.

Row 10: P to end.

Place sts on hold.

Join Shoulders (work both the same)

Align shoulder sts with RS facing each other, and work a three-needle bind off across held sts.

Seam Sides (work both the same)

With WS facing each other, seam up each side using mattress stitch. I highly recommend using duplicate stitch both for weaving in ends and anchoring working yarn as you seam.

Neckline

With RS facing and starting at back right shoulder seam, pick up and knit 3 of every 4 stitches along shoulder strap, all across flat bound off portions, 3 of every 4 along left shoulder strap, all across flat bound off front neck portion, and 3 of every 4 up right shoulder strap. Join for working in the round and bind off loosely.

Armholes (optional)

Armholes are shown without edging in sample. If you prefer to add edging to armholes and slightly widen your straps, then work as below:

With RS facing & starting at center underarm, pick up and knit all sts across flat bound off portion, 3 of every 4 along armhole edge, and all across flat bound off portion. Join for working in the round and bind off.

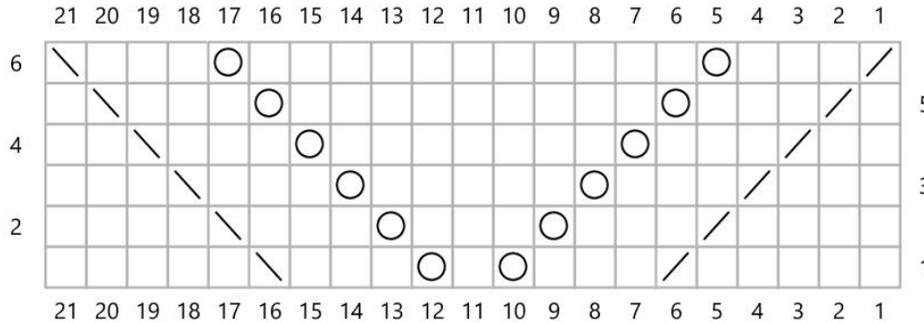
Finishing

Weave in all ends with tapestry needle and block gently.

- Row 1 (RS): K5, k2tog, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, ssk, k5.
- Row 2 (WS): P4, p2tog tbl, p3, yo, p3, yo, p3, p2tog, p4.
- Row 3: K3, k2tog, k3, yo, k5, yo, k3, ssk, k3.
- Row 4: P2, p2tog tbl, p3, yo, p7, yo, p3, p2tog, p2.
- Row 5: K1, k2tog, k3, yo, k9, yo, k3, ssk, k1.
- Row 6: P2tog tbl, p3, yo, p11, yo, p3, p2tog.

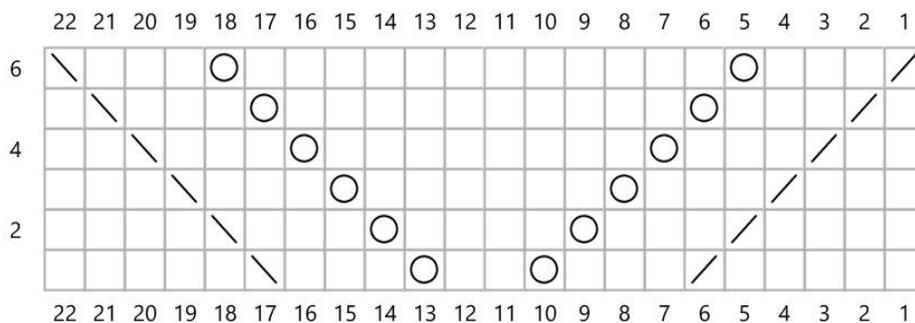

- Row 3: *K3, k2tog, k3, yo, k6, yo, k3, ssk, k3, repeat from *.
- Row 4: *P2, p2tog tbl, p3, yo, p8, yo, p3, p2tog, p2, repeat from *.
- Row 5: *K1, k2tog, k3, yo, k10, yo, k3, ssk, k1, repeat from *.
- Row 6: *P2tog tbl, p3, yo, p12, yo, p3, p2tog, repeat from *.

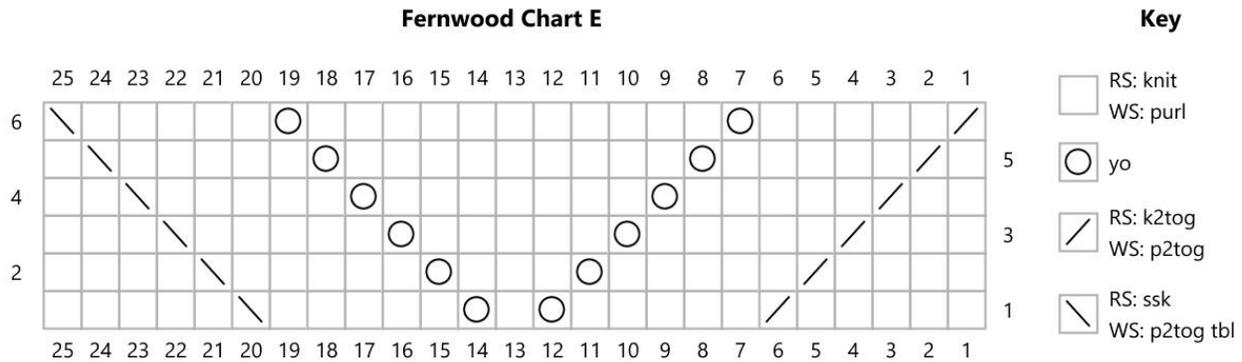
Row 2: *P4, p2tog tbl, p5, yo, p3, yo, p5, p2tog, p4, repeat from *.

Row 3: *K3, k2tog, k5, yo, k5, yo, k5, ssk, k3, repeat from *.

Row 4: *P2, p2tog tbl, p5, yo, p7, yo, p5, p2tog, p2, repeat from *.

Row 5: *K1, k2tog, k5, yo, k9, yo, k5, ssk, k1, repeat from *.

Row 6: *P2tog tbl, p5, yo, p11, yo, p5, p2tog, repeat from *.

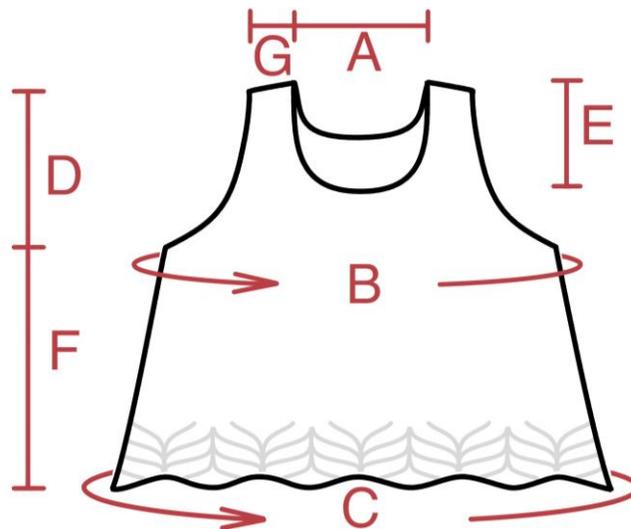
