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Introduction

Hello there! I'm Shelley and I love designing crochet patterns. This collection has 20 new flower patterns I've designed for you. There are some very 3D flowers that really stand up, all the way down to very flat flowers.



All the patterns are named the word “Flower” in different languages so you’ll travel the world from Europe to Asia to India to Australia with each new pattern. Well, the Australian one isn’t really in a language other than English – it’s more a funny pronunciation thing.

All blocks measure 6” (15 cm) so you can mix and match them to your heart’s content.



I want you to be able to successfully make every pattern in this book, so I've included the [tips and tricks](#) I use to make it very hard to see where rounds begin and end, as well as an extensive [stitch dictionary](#) with links to videos I've made so you can see exactly what stitch is what. Every round of every pattern has a stitch count so you can make sure you are on track easily.

Each pattern is written for a specific colour way, but I also suggest other options so you can make the same flower pattern in lots of different ways. It's amazing how this can change the look of a pattern.



I have come up with a border pattern which I think suits the floral blocks well – a [picket fence](#). It's pretty easy, but effective.

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Yarn Ideas

I have made each pattern with a few different yarns. I love working in cotton, but you can of course use any yarn you like. Each pattern lists the approximate metreage/yardage in total, not for each colour.



I used Cascade Ultra Pima Cotton in the following colours to make the blues and cream versions :

- Centre Blue = Turquoise - Number 3733
- Middle Blue = Aqua - Number 3732
- Outer Blue/green = Ice - Number 3736
- Cream = Natural - Number 3718

Using the Cascade, the blocks all measured 6” (15 cm) when I used a 5 mm hook. Please note that I do tend to crochet tighter than most and a 4 mm hook is recommended for this yarn.

In some of the pictured patterns, I’ve used Bendigo Woollen Mills 8 ply cotton in various colours. All measured 6” (15 cm) using a 5 mm hook, but again, a 4 mm hook is recommended.

I used King Cole Cottonsoft for the red flowers in the following colours :

Centre Yellow = Buttercup – Number 1600

Red Petals = Cherry – Number 719

Green Leaves = Lime – Number 1601

Cream Edges = Ecrú – Number 711

Using the King Cole, the blocks all measured 6.25” (just under 16 cm) as it is slightly thicker than the Cascade and Bendigo Woollen Mills yarns. Again, I used a 5 mm hook where a 4 mm is recommended.



No matter what yarn and hook combination you use, as long as you use the same throughout, your blocks will all be the same size.



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Tips for Seamless Crochet

I'm a bit pedantic about seamless crochet. I really don't like seeing where rounds begin and end. So I use a few little tricks to help hide those beginnings and ends.

False Double

Where patterns say “ch 3”, which counts as the first double traditionally, there are a couple of options you can do instead. I like to use a false double instead. It is a bit fiddly when you first try it, but I think the result is worth persevering for. You can find my video showing how it's done [here](#). It's not compulsory though, so please don't feel you have to do it. If the ch 3 starts don't bother you, that's totally fine. Honest.



Changing colours

When I recommend a colour change in a round that begins with a sc, you will notice I say “Attach yarn with a standing sc”, instead of the more traditional “attach yarn, ch 1, sc in sp”. It’s really easy to do and looks much better than joining your yarn with a ss and then making a sc – there is less bulk and no confusion about where to join to once you finish the round.

All you do is make a slip knot on your hook, then make a sc in the space indicated. You can watch my video showing how it’s done [here](#).



While you can use this method to make a standing dc and tr, I prefer to attach the new yarn with a ss and use the false dc method I spoke about above, especially when you are only doing 1 round in that colour, as it’s easier to deal with the ends if they are in different spots. The standing stitch means both ends from a single round are in the same spot which can make it trickier to hide them. I also find the standing dc to be a bit loose at the top. It’s up to you though. Use whatever you prefer.

Ending Rounds in the Middle of a Corner

I begin almost all rounds with the second half of a corner. It helps make the beginning and end of rounds practically invisible. Using a traditional

granny square as an example, the needle is pointing to where I begin the round.



To help make this look even better, another trick I use in conjunction with where I start rounds, is the way I end rounds if the colour is going to be continued for the next round. Instead of telling you to end with a slip stitch, I'll tell you to join with a stitch. That stitch could be a sc, hdc or even a dc.

It means you will end in the middle of a corner. So taking a traditional granny square as an example, you will end in the middle of a (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) corner – ie about the middle of the 2 ch space. To do this, I will instruct you to “ch 1, join with sc” instead of “ch 2, join with a slip stitch”.

It's not a new technique, in fact it's been used as long as crocheting has been around – particularly in lacy doilies.



Here's an example of how it works.

In this pattern of mine (not from this book) the round ends with the instruction to “ch 1, join with dc to 4th ch of st ch”. All other corners of the round have 6 ch as the corner. Can you see how I'd have to work backwards to begin the next round's corner if I did ch 6 and join with ss in the picture on the left? On the right is the ch 1, join with dc. Can you see how I'm in the right spot to begin the next round's corner? The corners of the next round are (5 tr, ch 3, 5 tr) so the next round's instructions say to begin with “ch 4 (st ch), 4 tr over joining dc”. This means I am not working backward and so the corner is not going to be skewed. Think of the “joining dc” as the second half of a 6 ch sp.

Blocking

The last trick I use is to block my work as I go. It's really quick and easy. All I do is pin my blocks out on a foam mat and squirt it with steam from my iron, taking care not to touch the pins or crochet with the iron.



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Colour Changes

Each pattern is written for a particular colour way as you see in the pictures that accompany each pattern.

However, the patterns are very versatile and I suggest lots of other colour changing options for each one. It can really change the look of a pattern.

They are only suggestions though, so do whatever you want. There are many other colour choices you could make that I haven't listed. The only limit is your imagination.



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The Patterns

Let's get started! Here's a quick way to go to the patterns you want to try. Just click on the picture of the one you want and you'll be taken straight to that pattern.





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Blomst

Blomst is the word flower in Norwegian and Danish.



Yardage

Approximately 43 metres or 47 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could change to a second petal colour from Round 4, use just one petal colour beginning with Round 1, or use 3 petal colours – Round 1, Rounds 2 & 3, & Round 4.

Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
htr = half triple crochet

Instructions

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 3 (st ch), 11 dc, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{12 dc}

Round 2

Attach petal colour with a standing sc to any st, *ch 2, skip 1 st, sc in next st*, repeat from * to* 4 times, ch 2, join with a ss to first st.

{6 sc & 6 x 2 ch sps}

Round 3

sc in same sp as ss, *(hdc, dc, ch 2, dc, hdc) in 2 ch sp**, sc in next st* repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first st.

{6 half-formed petals}

Round 4

sc in same sp as ss, *hdc in next st, dc in next st, (dc, ch 2, dc) in 2 ch sp, dc in next st, hdc in next st**, sc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{6 petals}

Round 5

Flip flower so back is face up, attach leaf colour around the post of any Round 2 sc with a standing sc, *ch 2, sc around next Round 2 sc from back*, repeat from * to * 4 times, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Flip back to the right side.

{6 sc & 6 x 2 ch sps}

Round 6

ch 3 (st ch), *3 dc in 2 ch sp**, dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{24 sts}

Round 7

ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp as ss, *hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts**, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{9 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 8

ch 3 (st ch), 4 dc over joining sc, *skip 3 sts, sc in next st, ch 2, skip 1 st, sc in next st, skip 3 sts**, (5 dc, ch 2, 5 dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 5 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{12 sts, 1 x 2 ch sp along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 9

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 6 sts, (dc, htr, ch 1, htr, dc) in 2 ch sp, sc in next 6 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{18 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 10

Attach border colour to any 2 ch sp, ch 3 (st ch), *ch 2, skip 2 sts, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 3, skip 4 sts, sc in 1 ch sp, ch 3, skip 4 sts, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 2, skip 2 sts**, (dc, ch 2, dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{7 sts, 2 x 1 ch sps, 2 x 2 ch sps, 2 x 3 ch sps along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 11

ch 3 (st ch), dc over joining sc, *dc in next st, 2 dc in 2 ch sp, dc in next st, dc in 1 ch sp, dc in next st, 3 dc in 3 ch sp, dc in next st, 3 dc in 3 ch sp, dc in next st, dc in 1 ch sp, dc in next st, 2 dc in 2 ch sp, dc in next st**, (2 dc,

ch 2, 2 dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 12

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 23 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{25 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}



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Kukka

Kukka is the word flower in Finnish.



Yardage

Approximately 35 metres or 38 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could do just one round in your centre colour, or do 2 or 3 petal colours if you begin at Round 2 for your flower and change at Rounds 3 & 4.

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
htr = half triple crochet
tr = triple crochet

Instructions

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 3 (st ch), 11 dc, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{12 sts}

Round 2

ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp as ss, *ch 2, skip 1 st**, 2 dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, ch 2, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{12 sts & 6 x 2 ch sps}

Round 3

Attach petal colour to any 2 ch sp, ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp, *ch 3, skip 2 sts**, 3 dc in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 4 times and * to ** once, dc in same sp as first sts, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{18 sts & 6 x 3 ch sps}

Round 4

ch 1, sc in same sp as ss, sc in next st, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in 3 ch sp**, sc in next 3 sts*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, sc in next st, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{6 petals with 2 ch points}

Round 5

Attach leaf colour to the middle sc of any 3 sc group, ch 3 (st ch), *ch 5, skip 4 sts, sc in 2 ch sp, ch 5, skip 4 sts**, dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{12 sts & 12 x 5 ch sps}

Round 6

ch 1, sc in same sp as ss, *5 sc in 5 ch sp**, sc in next st*, repeat from * to * 10 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc.

{72 sts}

Round 7

ch 4 (st ch), *tr in next st, htr in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, htr in next 2 sts, tr in next st**, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, tr in same sp as first st, ch 3, join with ss to 4th ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{19 sts along each side and 4 x 3 ch corner sps}

Round 8

Attach border colour to any 3 ch corner sp with a standing sc, sc in same sp, *sc in next 19 sts**, (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) in 3 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 sc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to first sc.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 9

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 23 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{25 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}



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Hana

Hana is Japanese for Flower.



Yardage

Approximately 45 metres or 49 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could do Rounds 3 & 4 in different petal colours, or extend the centre to include Round 3.

Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
htr = half triple crochet
tr = triple crochet
begpc = beginning popcorn,
pc = popcorn
begtrpc = beginning triple popcorn
trpc = triple popcorn

Instructions

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 1, 8 sc, join with ss to first sc.

{8 sts}

Round 2

ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp as ss, 2 dc in next 7 sts, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{16 sts}

Round 3

Attach petal colour to any st, begpc in same st, *ch 2, skip 1 st, pc in next st*, repeat from * to * 6 times, ch 2, join with ss to top of begpc.

{8 pc & 8 x 2 ch sps}

Round 4

begtrpc in same sp as ss, *ch 2, trpc in 2 ch sp**, ch 2, trpc in top of pc*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, ch 2, join with ss to top of begtrpc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{16 trpc & 16 x 2 ch sps}

Round 5

Attach leaf colour to the top of any trpc with a standing sc, *3 sc in 2 ch sp**, sc in top of trpc*, repeat from * to * 14 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc.

{64 sts}

Round 6

ch 4 (st ch), tr in same sp as ss, *ch 1, skip 1 st, htr in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, htr in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st**, (2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 tr in same sp as first sts, ch 2, join with ss to 4th ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{11 sts, 8 x 1 ch sps along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 7

Attach border colour to any 2 ch corner sp, ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp, *dc in next 2 sts, 7 x [dc in 1 ch sp, dc in next st], dc in 1 ch sp, dc in next 2 sts**, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 8

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 23 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{25 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}





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Blodyn

Blodyn is Welsh for Flower.



Yardage

Approximately 41 metres or 44 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could have 2 different petal colours changing at Round 3, or continue the centre colour to include Round 2.

Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet

sc2tog = single crochet 2 together

hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
dc6tog = double crochet 6 together
htr = half triple crochet
tr = triple crochet
blo = back loop only

Instructions

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 2 (st ch), 11 hdc, join with ss to 2nd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{12 sts}

Round 2

Attach petal colour to any st, ch 3 (st ch), *6 dc in next st**, dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. NOTE : don't be concerned about the ruffled look.

{42 sts}

Round 3

ch 3 (st ch), *ch 3, dc6tog, ch 3**, dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{6 petals, 6 single sts & 12 x 3 ch sps}

Round 4

Attach leaf colour to the middle of any 3 ch sp with a standing sc, sc in same 3 ch sp, *skip 1 st, 3 sc in 3 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 10 times, skip 1 st, sc in same sp as first sts, join with ss to first sc.

{36 sts}

Round 5

ch 3 (st ch), 5 dc in same st as ss, *skip 2 sts, 6 dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 10 times, skip 2 sts, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{12 leaves}

Round 6

Attach border colour between any 2 groups of 6 dc, ch 3 (st ch), *ch 2, skip 2 sts, sc2tog in blo of next 2 sts, ch 2, skip 2 sts**, dc between last and next st*, repeat from * to * 10 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{24 sts & 24 x 2 ch sps}

Round 7

ch 4 (st ch), *(tr, htr) in 2 ch sp, htr in next st, 2 dc in 2 ch sp, hdc in next st, (hdc, sc) in 2 ch sp, sc in next st, (sc, hdc) in 2 ch sp, hdc in next st, 2 dc in 2 ch sp, htr in next st, (htr, tr) in 2 ch sp**, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, tr in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to 4th ch of st ch.

{19 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 8

ch 1, 2 sc over joining sc, *sc in next 19 sts**, (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 sc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to first sc.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 9

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 23 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{25 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}



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Fiore

Fiore is Italian for flower.



Yardage

Approximately 39 metres or 42 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could change to the petal colour at Round 2, or use 2 different petal colours for Rounds 2 & 3.

Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
2dccl = 2 double crochet cluster
htr = half triple crochet
tr = triple crochet
blo = back loop only

Instructions

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 3 (st ch), *ch 1, dc*, repeat from * to * 6 times, ch 1, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{8 sts & 8 x 1 ch sps}

Round 2

ch 1, sc in same sp as ss, *ch 2, 2dccl in 2 ch sp, ch 2**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first sc. NOTE : may be ruffled - don't worry. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{8 clusters, 8 x (sc, ch 2, sc) & 16 x 2 ch sps}

Round 3

Attach petal colour to a 2 ch sp between 2 sc, ch 3 (st ch), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, *skip all sts and ch sps up to the next 2 ch sp between 2 sc**, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends. Push Round 2 clusters up to pop them up between the petals. NOTE : it will still be a little ruffled at this point. It will straighten out soon.

{8 petals}

Round 4

Attach leaf colour to any 2 ch sp with a standing sc, *ch 3, skip 3 sts, dc between last and next sts, ch 3, skip 3 sts**, sc in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc.

{16 sts & 16 x 3 ch sps}

Round 5

sc in same sp as ss, *skip 3 ch sp, 5 dc in next st, skip 3 ch sp**, sc in next st*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{8 leaves & 8 sts}

Round 6

Attach border colour to the blo of any sc, ch 3 (st ch), *hdc in blo of next st, sc in blo of next 3 sts, hdc in blo of next st**, dc in blo of next st*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{48 sts}

Round 7

ch 4 (st ch), htr in same sp as ss, *htr in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, htr in next st**, (htr, tr, ch 2, tr, htr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, (htr, tr) in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 4th ch of st ch.

{15 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 8

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 15 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to first st.

Attach petal colour with a standing sc to any st, *(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in 1 ch sp, ** sc in next st*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc. NOTE : it will be ruffled - don't worry.

{32 dc, 8 sc & 8 x 2 ch sps}

Round 3

fpdc around st below from round 1, skip sc behind fpdc just made, sc in next 2 sts, (dc, htr, ch 1, htr, dc) in 2 ch sp, sc in next 2 sts, repeat from * to * 7 times, join with ss to first fpdc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{8 petals & 8 front post sts}

Round 4

Attach leaf colour to the front post of any fpdc, *fpdc around same st, ch 3, skip the petal*, repeat from * to * 7 times, join with ss to first fpdc. Pull each petal through the 3 ch loops to the front.

{8 sts & 8 x 3 ch sps}

Round 5

ch 3 (st ch), 3 dc in same sp as ss, *skip 3 ch sp**, (4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in next st*, repeat from * to * 6 time and from * to ** once, 4 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{64 sts & 8 x 2 ch sps}

Round 6

NOTE : skip the stiches either side of the dc.

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in blo of next 2 sts, hdc in blo of next st, dc between next 2 sts, hdc in blo of next st, sc in blo of next 2 sts**, sc in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 6 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{64 sts}

Round 7

Attach border colour to any sc, ch 4 (st ch), *ch 1, skip 1 st, htr in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, sc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, htr in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st**, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, tr in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with hdc to 4th ch of st ch.

{9 sts, 8 x 1 ch sps along each side and 4 x 3 ch corner sps}

Round 8

ch 3 (st ch), dc over hdc join, *8 x [dc in next st, dc in 1 ch sp], dc in next st**, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in 3 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{21 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 9

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 21 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}



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Fleur

Fleur is French for flower.



Yardage

Approximately 39 metres or 42 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could have 4 different petal colours for Rounds 2, 3, 4 & 5, or have 2 different petal colours changing at Round 4, or you could extend the centre colour to the end of Round 2.

Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet
spike sc = spike single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
htr = half triple crochet
tr = triple crochet
blo = back loop only

Instructions

NOTE : it will tend to cup in the first few rounds but don't be concerned as that's necessary to get the puffy petals later on.

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 3 (st ch), dc, *ch 1, 2 dc*, repeat from * to * 4 times, ch 1, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{12 sts & 6 x 1 ch sps}

Round 2

Attach petal colour to any 1 ch sp, ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp, *ch 1, skip 2 sts, 3 dc in 1 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 4 times, ch 1, dc in same sp as first sts, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{18 sts & 6 x 1 ch sps}

Round 3

ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp as ss, *ch 1, skip (1 st, 1 ch sp & 1 st)**, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times, and from * to ** once, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{24 sts, 6 x 2 ch sps & 6 x 1 ch sps}

Round 4

ch 3 (st ch), 2 dc over joining sc, *ch 1, skip (2 sts, 1 ch sp & 2 sts)**, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, 3 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

{36 sts, 6 x 2 ch sps & 6 x 1 ch sps}

Round 5

ch 3 (st ch), 2 dc over joining sc, *ch 2, skip 3 sts, spike sc over all 3 x 1 ch sps below, ch 2, skip 3 sts**, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, 3 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 2, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. The petals will puff up at this stage - that's what we want. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{42 sts & 12 x 2 ch sps}

Round 6

Attach leaf colour to any 2 ch sp with a standing sc, *sc in blo of next st, hdc in blo of next st, dc in blo of next st, ch 3, skip (2 ch sp, 1 st & 2 ch sp), dc in blo of next st, hdc in blo of next st, sc in blo of next st**, sc in 2 ch sp, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc.

{42 sts & 6 x 3 ch sps}

Round 7

ch 1, sc in same sp as ss, sc in next 3 sts, *5 sc in 3 ch sp**, sc in next 7 sts*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, sc in next 3 sts, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{72 sts}

Round 8

Attach border colour to a sc above a petal tip, ch 4 (st ch), *tr in next st, htr in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, htr in next 2 sts, tr in next st**, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, tr in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with hdc to 4th ch of st ch.

{19 sts along each side and 4 x 3 ch corner sps}

Round 9

ch 1, 2 sc over joining hdc, *sc in next 19 sts**, (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}



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Flor

Flor is the word flower in Spanish and Portuguese.



Yardage

Approximately 39 metres or 42 yards.

Colour Options

The pattern is written for colour changes shown in the above picture. Alternatively, you could change to a petal colour from Round 2, or have 2 different petal colours – one for Round 2 and then change to the second for Rounds 3 & 4.

Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet

bpsc = back post single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

htr = half triple crochet

tr = triple crochet

Instructions

Using centre colour, ch 4 and join first st to last with a ss to form a loop, or begin with a magic circle.

Round 1

ch 1, 12 sc, join with ss to first sc.

{12 sts}

Round 2

NOTE : although I say join with the traditional ss, I recommend using the invisible join method for a more seamless look.

ch 3 (st ch), dc in same sp as ss, 2 dc in next 11 sts, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{24 sts}

Round 3

Attach petal colour with a standing sc to the back post of any st, *ch 2, skip 1 st, bpsc around next st*, repeat from * to * 10 times, ch 2, join with ss to first bpsc.

{12 sts & 12 x 2 ch sps}

Round 4

ss into 2 ch sp, ch 3 (st ch), (htr, ch 2, htr, dc) in same sp, *skip 1 st, (dc, htr, ch 2, htr, dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 10 times, skip 1 st, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{12 petals}

Round 5

Flip flower to back. Attach leaf colour around the post of any Round 3 st with a standing sc, *ch 2, sc around next Round 3 st*, repeat from * to * 10 times, ch 2, join with ss to first sc. Flip back to front.

{12 sts & 12 x 2 ch sps}

Round 6

ch 3 (st ch), *2 dc in 2 ch sp**, dc in next st*, repeat from * to * 10 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to 3rd ch of st ch.

{36 sts}

Round 7

sc in same sp as ss, *hdc in next st, dc in next st, (htr, tr, ch 2, tr, htr) in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st**, sc in next st*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{6 leaves}

Round 8

Attach border colour to any 2 ch sp with a standing sc, *ch 4, skip 4 sts, tr in next st, ch 4, skip 4 sts**, sc in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * 4 times and from * to ** once, join with ss to first sc.

{12 sts & 12 x 4 ch sps}

Round 9

ch 4 (st ch), *(tr, 2 htr, 2 dc) in 4 ch sp, hdc in next st, (hdc, 3 sc, hdc) in 4 ch sp, hdc in next st, (2 dc, 2 htr, tr) in 4 ch sp**, (tr, ch 3, tr) in next st*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, tr in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with hdc to 4th ch of st ch.

{19 sts along each side and 4 x 3 ch corner sps}

Round 10

ch 1, 2 sc over joining hdc, *sc in next 19 sts**, (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) in 3 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 sc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to first st.

{23 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}

Round 11

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 23 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first st. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.

{25 sts along each side and 4 x 2 ch corner sps}



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Joining

As the flower blocks have so much going on, I have used my favourite join to make my blanket.

It's simple, easy and it accommodates the slightly different stitch counts between some blocks well. The biggest variation you'll find is 4 stitches.

All I do is hold the blocks right sides facing together and work a standing sc in the 2 ch corner space of both blocks, then sc in every stitch along. If there are stitch count differences, all you do is work into the same stitch twice on the shorter block while working into 2 consecutive stitches on the longer block. Spread these double stitches out along the whole edge and you won't be able to see the difference at all.



I like to join my blocks into strips, then join those strips. When you get to the intersections, simply work a sc into the 2 ch sps either side of the join and it creates a cool little square where the corners meet on the front.



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Picket Fence Border

Once you've made all the squares you want and have joined them up into a pretty garden, why not border your garden with a picket fence.



Abbreviations

Check the [stitch dictionary](#) if you are unfamiliar with any stitches

ss = slip stitch

sp/s = space/s

st/s = stitch/es

ch = chain

st ch = starting chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

dc2tog = double crochet 2 together

dc3tog = double crochet 3 together

fpdc = front post double crochet

fptr = front post triple crochet

Instructions

Round 1

Attach your yarn with a standing sc to any 2 ch corner space, *work a sc in each stitch along the side, working a stitch either side of the joins**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch corner sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to first sc.

Round 2

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in each st along side**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first sc, ch 1, join with sc to first sc.

Round 3

NOTE : depending on your layout, you may need to fudge a little with this round. All you need to do is check how many stitches are left when you're approaching the end of a side. You might need to skip 2 sts instead of 1 st a couple of times at the end of the sides. After this round, you won't have to fudge anymore.

ch 3 (st ch), dc over joining sc, *(ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next 2 sts) as many times as you need along side ending with a ch 1, skip 1 st**, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in 2 ch corner sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

Round 4

ch 3 (st ch), *(fpdc around next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 ch sp) as many times as you need along side, fpdc around last 2 sts**, (dc, ch 2, dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, dc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

Round 5

ch 4 (st ch), *fptr around next 3 sts, (ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, fptr around next 2 sts) as many times as you need along side ending with a ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, fptr around last 3 sts**, (tr, ch 2, tr) in 2 ch sp* repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, tr in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to 4th ch of st ch.

Round 6

ch 3 (st ch), *fpdc around next 4 sts, (ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, fpdc around next 2 sts) as many times as you need along side ending with ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, fpdc around last 4 sts**, (dc, ch 2, dc) in 2 ch sp* repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, dc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

Round 7

ch 3 (st ch), *dc in next st, 2 x [ch 1,dc2tog], skip 1 ch sp, (ch 2, dc3tog with the last leg in the 1 ch sp) as many times as needed along side until last 5 sts, ch 2, 2 x [dc2tog, ch 1], dc in next st**, (dc, ch 2, dc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, dc in same sp as first st, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of st ch.

Round 8

ch 1, sc over joining sc, *sc in next 2 sts, 2 x [sc in 1 ch sp, skip 1 st], (2 sc in 2 ch sp, skip 1 st) as many times as needed along side ending with 2 sc in 2 ch sp, until 4 sts from end, 2 x [skip 1 st, sc in 1 ch sp], sc in next 2 sts**, (sc, ch 2, sc) in 2 ch sp*, repeat from * to * twice and from * to ** once, sc in same sp as first st, ch 2, join with ss to first sc. Fasten off yarn and weave in ends.





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Stitch Dictionary

This is where you'll find a brief description of all terms used in this book. I have also included links to short and to the point videos showing what you need to know. I aim to have each video go for less than a minute, so it won't take long to check them out.

Please let me know if you need anything explained in more detail and I'll help you understand as much as I can. Here goes :

yo - yarn over - wrap yarn around hook from back to front of hook

ss - slip stitch - insert hook in st or sp, pull yarn through to front and through loop on hook

ch - chain - yo, pull yarn through the loop on the hook

st ch - starting chain - a number of ch sts that take the place of the first st in a round

sc - single crochet - insert hook in st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through both loops on hook

spike sc - spike single crochet - insert hook into sp indicated and pull up a long leg before completing the st as normal

hdc - half double crochet - yo, insert hook in st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook

dc - double crochet - yo, insert hook in st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook

blo - back loop only - insert hook into the back loop of the v on top of the stitch to be worked

bpdc - back post double crochet - work a double crochet around the post of the stitch to be worked. - yo, insert hook around the post of the stitch to be

worked from the back, pull yarn to back, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook

NOTE : can also be other sts, such as bpsc.

fpdc - front post double crochet - work a double crochet around the post of the stitch to be worked. - yo, insert hook around the post of the stitch to be worked from the front, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook

NOTE : can also be other sts, such as fptr.

dc3tog - double crochet 3 together - begin working 3 double crochets in 3 consecutive sts/sps, but do not do the last yo and pull through 2 until the last stitch. - yo, insert hook in st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yo, insert hook in next st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops (3 loops on hook), yo, insert hook in next st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops (4 loops on hook),yo, pull through all 4 loops on hook

NOTE : can also be other numbers of sts or different types of sts worked together such as sc5tog or hdc4tog.

pc - popcorn - work 5 double crochet stitches into the same sp or st, remove hook from last st, insert hook in first st, insert hook into the last stitch, yo and pull through all sts

begpc - beginning popcorn - ch 3, work 4 double crochet sts in the same sp or st, remove hook from last st, insert hook into 3rd ch of st ch, insert hook into the last stitch, yo and pull through all sts

2dccl - 2 double crochet cluster - yo, insert hook into st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, insert into same st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull though 2 loops, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook

NOTE : can also be other numbers of sts eg 5dccl or other stitches eg 5trcl.

htr - half triple crochet - yo twice, insert hook in st or sp, pull yarn to front, yo, pull through 2 loops (3 loops on hook), yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook
