

Flowers and Diamonds -1

Size: woman's medium
Yarn: Palette by Knit Picks
Needles: 2.25 mm
Gauge: 38.5 sts & 42 rows to 4"

INSTRUCTIONS

designer presumes that you have the basic knowledge and capability of knitting a mitten

Cast on 80
Join to knit in round.
Begin chart (if using long tail co begin on purl rnd).
TIP: work the slip stitch rounds tightly or go down a needle size

Thumb


When working the rnd that is in the red box, put those stitches on a piece of waste yarn. The rnds in the red box are worked separately.

Closing Top of Hand

I use a 3-needle bind off to close the top except on the edge color, those I put to the public side, then thread the cut end of that color onto a needle and make a joining st between them.

Thumb

Slide the stitches on the waste yarn onto the needles and work in the round the pattern contained in the red box.
Finish off by running cut end of yarn through live stitches and pulling tight.

Stitch Glossary

k

Knit.

k2tog

Knit 2 stitches together.

M1L

From the front, lift the horizontal strand between stitches with the left needle. Knit through the back loop.

M1R

From the back, lift the horizontal strand between stitches with the left needle. Knit through the front loop.

p

Purl.

ssk

Slip 2 stitches knitwise, then knit slipped stitches together.

s1

With the working yarn in back, insert the right needle into the next stitch as if to purl and transfer the stitch from the left needle to the right.
