### DETAILS

During the past few cold months, I found myself reaching for cozy sweaters that I could tug on over warm flannels and found my wardrobe a bit lacking! The moment I saw Brooklyn Tweed's new yarn, Imbue, with its round, bouncy nature, I knew it was destined for texture, cables and a new raglan to keep me cozy! This sweater is named with love for the #1 fan of my knitting blog so many years ago - my Grandpa Gib.



#### SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5)(6, 7, 8, 9)



#### FINISHED BUST CIRCUMFERENCE

32 (35.25, 40, 43.25, 48)(51.25, 56, 59.25, 64)"

81.5 (89.5, 101.5, 110, 122)(130, 142, 150.5, 162.5) cm

*Intended to be worn with 2 to 6"/5 to 15 cm of positive ease. To pick your best size, measure your full bust and add or subtract your desired ease, then pick the finished bust circumference closest to that number. Sample shown in size 3 with 5"/13 cm positive ease on a woman who is 5'5" tall.*



#### YARN

Worsted Weight

430 (484, 534, 584, 640)(687, 768, 825, 893) g

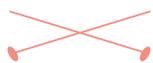

#### SUGGESTED YARN

Brooklyn Tweed - Imbue American Merino Wool (approx. 50 g/104 yds/95 m)

9 (10, 11, 12, 13)(14, 16, 17, 18) skeins in Carbon



#### SUGGESTED NEEDLES

Main Fabric: US 7/4.5 mm - 32"/80 cm to 40"/100 cm circular and preferred needles for small circumference knitting (such as Magic Loop or DPNs)

Ribbing: US 5/3.75 mm - 32"/80 cm to 40"/100 cm circular and preferred needles for small circumference knitting.

*(Use the needle size you need to achieve gauge, and size down 2 needle sizes for ribbing.)*



#### NOTIONS

Stitch markers (8 - with 1 of them being unique from the others for the BOR M), cable needle (optional), tapestry needle, stitch holders or waste yarn



#### GAUGE

20 sts & 32 rows = 4"/10 cm

*Measured over texture stitch pattern in the round after blocking. (See pg. 4 for stitch pattern.)*

### NOTES

- This sweater is worked from the top down, seamlessly. The sleeve sts are put on hold while the body is finished and then returned to the needle. You can, of course, modify it to have any length body or sleeves. Do take into account that modifications will affect the yardage required.
- Keep an eye on your sleeve gauge! A lot of knitters tighten up when knitting smaller circumferences (as opposed to the body of the sweater) and may need to go up a needle size to keep their gauge consistent.
- This sweater utilizes a simple knit purl pattern as the overall texture, that is easy to memorize. Here is a video that chats about staying in the established pattern as you work sleeve shaping:

- If you do not care for the Long Tail Tubular Cast On and Bind Off, you can sub in your favorites - such as the Long Tail Cast On or Twisted German Cast On and a regular Bind Off or Jeny's Surprisingly Stretchy Bind Off.
- The 8-st cabled raglans are part of the front and back, and thus they include the 16 sts that make up the raglans in their stitch counts throughout the pattern.
- The yoke is separated into two different sections due to different rates of increasing to achieve the best fit for all the different sizes. You may notice you are working more or less increases in one of these sections compared to other sizes, but rest assured you will achieve the correct stitch count for your size by the end of the yoke shaping.
- To resolve a wrapped PURL stitch on the RIGHT Side: Slip wrapped stitch to RHN, insert LHN into wrap, pull it up onto RHN, slip stitch and wrap back to LHN, purl them together.
- To resolve a wrapped KNIT stitch on the RIGHT Side: Insert RHN into wrap and then into the wrapped stitch, knit them together.
- To resolve a wrapped PURL stitch on the WRONG Side: Insert RHN from behind, under wrap, and lift wrap onto LHN, purl wrap and wrapped stitch together.
- To resolve a wrapped KNIT stitch on the WRONG Side: With the LHN tilted down, lift the back of the wrap onto the needle, knit the wrap and wrapped stitch together.

### — GLOSSARY —

{ } - Repeat

**1/1 LPC** - Left purl cross: sl st to a CN and hold to front, p1; k1 from CN.

**1/1 RPC** - Right purl cross: sl st to a CN and hold to back, k1; p1 from CN.

**2/2 LC** - Left cable cross: sl 2 sts to a CN and hold to front, k2; k2 from CN.

**2/2 RC** - Right cable cross: sl 2 sts to a CN and hold to back, k2; k2 from CN.

**BO** - Bind off

**BOR** - Beginning of round

**CN** - Cable needle

**CO** - Cast on

**CONT** - Continue

**DEC/D** - Decrease/d

**DPN/S** - Double pointed needle/s

**EST** - Established

**INC/D** - Increase/d

**K** - Knit

**K2TOG** - Knit 2 stitches together as one. [1 st dec'd]

**M** - Marker

**M1L (P)** - Pick up the bar between the stitch you worked and the one you're about to work, bringing the needle from front to back. Knit (purl) thru the back of this stitch. [1 st inc'd]

**M1R (P)** - Pick up the bar between the you worked and the one you're about to work, bringing the needle from the back to the front. Knit (purl) thru the front of this stitch. [1 st inc'd]

**P** - Purl

**P2TOG** - Purl two stitches together. [1 st dec'd]

**PM** - Place marker

**PREV** - Previously

**REM** - Remain/ing

**REP** - Repeat

**RHN** - Right hand needle

**RM** - Remove marker

**RND/S** - Round/s

**RS** - Right side

**SEP** - Separate

**SL** - Slip stitch purlwise

**SM** - Slip marker

**ST/S** - Stitch/es

**SSK** - Slip 2 sts knit-wise to the RHN, knit them together as one thru the back loops. [1 st dec'd]

**TBL** - Thru the back loop

**W&T** - Wrap and turn: Knit Row (Purl Row) Slip next stitch to RHN, pass yarn from back (front) to front (back), slip stitch back to LHN. Turn to work other side, passing yarn to front (back) of work. It is a good practice to give the yarn a little tug to keep your wraps snug.

**WS** - Wrong side

**WYIF** - With yarn in front

**WYIB** - With yarn in back

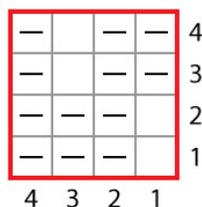
## TEXTURE STITCH PATTERN

**Worked in the round over a multiple of 4 sts:**

**Rnds 1 & 2:** {K1, p3} to end.

**Rnds 3 & 4:** {P2, k1, p1} to end.

Rep these 4 rnds for desired length.

#### **COLLAR**

Using Ribbing needle, CO 100 (100, 108, 108, 108)(108, 116, 116, 116) sts using the 2x2 Long Tail Tubular Cast On method. Do NOT join to work in the rnd. (See Notes, pg. 3, for a video tutorial.)

*If you choose to use a different cast on method, place the unique marker for the BOR, join to work in the round and proceed to Rib Pattern.*

**Tubular Row 1:** {K1-tbl, sl 1 wyif} to end of row.

**Tubular Row 2:** {K1, sl 1 wyif} to end of row.

Place the unique marker for the BOR and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist the sts. *The BOR marker is located at the center back of the sweater.*

**Ribbing Setup Rnd:** \*K1, 1/1 RPC, p1; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rib Pattern:** {K2, p2} to end of rnd.  
Cont working in the est rib pattern for 2"/5 cm.

#### **SHORT ROW BACK NECK SHAPING**

*The short row shaping will be worked flat, back and forth in rows.*

**Short Row 1 (RS):** K2, {p2, k2} 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) (3, 5, 5, 5) times, W&T.

**Short Row 2 (WS):** P2, {k2, p2} to BOR M, SM, k2, {p2, k2} 2 (2, 3, 3, 3)(3, 5, 5, 5) times, W&T.

**Short Row 3 (RS):** {P2, k2} to prev wrapped st, resolve by purling the wrapped st with its wrap, p1, k2, p2, W&T.

**Short Row 4 (WS):** K2, {p2, k2} to prev wrapped st, resolve by purling the wrapped st with its wrap, p1, k2, p2, W&T.

**Short Row 5 (RS):** {K2, p2} to prev wrapped st, resolve by knitting the wrapped st with its wrap, k1, p2, k2, W&T.

**Short Row 6 (WS):** P2, {k2, p2} to prev wrapped st, resolve by knitting the wrapped st with its wrap, k1, p2, k2, W&T.

**Short Row 7 (RS):** {P2, k2} to prev wrapped st, resolve by purling the wrapped st with its wrap, p1, k2, p2, W&T.

**Short Row 8 (WS):** K2, {p2, k2} to prev wrapped st, resolve by purling the wrapped st with its wrap, p1, k2, p2, W&T.

**Short Row 9 (RS):** {K2, p2} to BOR m.

#### **YOKE SECTION ONE**

*Resolve all wrapped sts as they are encountered in the Setup Rnd by knitting or purling the wrapped st with its wrap. See pg. 3 for resolving the final wrapped purl st created on Short Row 8.*

**Move BOR:** RM, {k2, p2} 2 (3, 3, 3, 4)(4, 4, 4, 4) times, k2 (0, 2, 2, 0)(0, 2, 2, 2), replace BOR M. *The beginning of rnd is now located just before the back right raglan as worn on the body.*

#### **Change to Main Fabric needle.**

**Setup Rnd:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, pm, p3, {k1, p3} 3 (2, 2, 2, 1)(1, 1, 1, 1) time/s, pm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, pm, p3, {k1, p3} 4 (5, 6, 6, 7)(7, 8, 8, 8) times, pm; rep from \* once more.

[15 (11, 11, 11, 7)(7, 7, 7, 7) sts for each sleeve;

35 (39, 43, 43, 47)(47, 51, 51, 51) sts each for Front and Back (including 16 raglan sts)]

#### **RAGLAN SHAPING (Chart A - pg. 14)**

**Rnd 1 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 2 (Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm ; rep from \* once more.

**Rnd 3 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 4:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Rnd 5 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L, {p3, k1} to 3 sts before m, p3, m1R, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 6 (Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rnd 7 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 8:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p3, {k1, p3} to m, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Rep [Rnds 1-8]** 3 (4, 4, 5, 6)(6, 7, 7, 7) more times. [128 (160, 160, 192, 224)(224, 256, 256, 256) sts inc'd; 228 (260, 268, 300, 332)(332, 372, 372, 372) sts on needle]

**Sizes 1(-, -, -, 5)(-, 7, -, -) ONLY - Rep [Rnds 1-2]** once more. [8 sts inc'd]

**Sizes -(-, 3, 4, -)(-, -, -, -) ONLY - Rep [Rnds 1-6]** once more. [24 sts inc'd]

236 (260, 292, 324, 340)(332, 380, 372, 372) total sts:

69 (79, 89, 97, 105)(103, 117, 115, 115) per Front/Back (including raglans);

49 (51, 57, 65, 65)(63, 73, 71, 71) per Sleeve

#### **YOKE SECTION TWO**

*For Yoke Section 2, charts are available on pg. 14 & 15 ending at the separation of sleeves & body, or cont with the written instructions. Return to the section specific to your size for directions on separating the sleeves & body.*

#### **SIZE 1 ONLY (Chart B - pg. 14)**

**Rnds 1 & 2:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Rnd 3:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Rnd 4 (Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rep [Rnds 1-4]** twice more.

**Rep [Rnd 1]** once more.

**Sep Sleeves & Body:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, place 49 sleeve sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, CO 11 underarm sts using the Backwards Loop CO method, rm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, rm; rep from \* once more, remove BOR M, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, place new BOR M. Proceed to BODY Section. [160 sts rem on needle for body]

**Rnd 1 (SLEEVE INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, m1R-P, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more. [4 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 2 (Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rnds 3 & 4:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, {p3, k1} to 3 sts before m, p3, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rnd 5:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rnd 6 (Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rep [Rnds 3-6]** twice more.

**Rep [Rnd 3]** once more.

264 total sts:

79 per Front/Back (including raglans)

53 per Sleeve

**Sep Sleeves & Body:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, place 53 sleeve sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, CO 9 underarm sts using the Backwards Loop CO method, rm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, {p3, k1} to 3 sts before m, p3, rm; rep from \* once more, remove BOR M, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, place new BOR M. Proceed to BODY Section. [176 sts rem on needle for body]

#### SIZE 3 ONLY (Chart D - pg. 14)

**Rnds 1 & 2:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2 {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Rnd 3:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Rnd 4 (Cross Cable):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rep [Rnds 1-4]** once more.

**Rep [Rnd 1]** once more.

**Sep Sleeves & Body:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, place 57 sleeve sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, CO 11 underarm sts using the Backwards Loop CO method, rm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, rm; rep from \* once more, remove BOR M, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, place new BOR M. Proceed to BODY Section. [200 sts rem on needle for body]

#### SIZE 4 ONLY (Chart E - pg. 15)

**Rnd 1 (BODY INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* once more. [4 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 2:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p3, {k1, p3} to m, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rnd 3:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more.



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### — DIRECTIONS —

**Rnd 4 (Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more.

**Rnd 5:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p3, {k1, p3} to m, sm; rep from \* once more.

328 total sts:

99 per Front/Back (including raglans);

65 per Sleeve

**Sep Sleeves & Body:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, place 65 sleeve sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, CO 9 underarm sts using the Backwards Loop CO method, rm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, p3, {k1, p3} to m, rm; rep from \* once more, remove BOR M, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, place new BOR M. Proceed to BODY Section. [216 sts rem on needle for body]

#### SIZE 5 ONLY (Not Charted)

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm; rep from \* 3 more times.

**Sep Sleeves & Body:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, place 65 sleeve sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, CO 15 underarm sts using the Backwards Loop CO method, rm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, rm; rep from \* once more, remove BOR M, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, place new BOR M. Proceed to BODY Section. [240 sts rem on needle for body]

#### SIZE 6 ONLY (Chart F - pg. 15)

**Rnd 1 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 2 (BODY INC/Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* once more. [4 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 3 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, m1R-P, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* once more. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 4 (BODY INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* once more. [4 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 5 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L, {p3, k1} to 3 sts before m, p3, m1R, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* once more. [8 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 6 (BODY INC/Cable Cross):** \*K1, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, k1, sm, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* once more. [4 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 7:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p2, {k1, p3} to 3 sts before m, k1, p2, sm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, p1, {k1, p3} to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, sm; rep from \* once more.

368 total sts:

115 per Front/Back (including raglans);

69 per Sleeve

**Sep Sleeves & Body:** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, place 69 sleeve sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, CO 13 underarm sts using the Backwards Loop CO method, rm, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, rm, p1, {k1, p3}, to 2 sts before m, k1, p1, rm; rep from \* once more, remove BOR M, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, place new BOR M. Proceed to BODY Section. [256 sts rem on needle for body]

#### **SIZE 7 ONLY (Chart G - pg. 15)**

**Rnd 1 (INC):** \*K1, p1, k4, p1, k1, sm, m1L-P, {k1, p3} to 1 st before m, k1, m1R-P, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. [8 sts inc'd]

The body will continue on in just the knit purl stitch pattern, with the cables ending with the raglans.

**Rnds 1 & 2:** {K1, p3} to end.

**Rnds 3 & 4:** P2, k1, {p3, k1} to the last st, p1.

**All sizes - rep [Rnds 1-4]** for your size until the body of the sweater measures 10"/25.5 cm from the underarm, or 2.5"/6.5 cm less than your desired body length.

**Rearranging Sts for BO:** \*K1, 1/1 LPC, p1; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Tubular BO Rnd 1:** {K1, sl 1 wyif} to the end of the rnd.

**Tubular BO Rnd 2:** {Sl 1 wyib, p1} to the end of the rnd.

Sl each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 3 x the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.

#### SLEEVES (same for both)

*Sizes 2, 4, 6, & 8 will pick up 2 sts more than the CO at separation.*

Place the 49 (53, 57, 65, 65)(69, 77, 81, 85) sts of one sleeve onto Main Fabric needle for your preferred method of small circumference knitting (such as Magic Loop or DPNs). Starting from the middle of the cast-on underarm sts, attach yarn and pick up and knit 5 (5, 5, 5, 7)(7, 7, 7, 7) sts, work across the live sleeve sts - knitting the knit sts and purling the purl sts so this rnd matches the separation rnd, pick up and knit 6 (6, 6, 6, 8)(8, 8, 8, 8) sts, PM and join for working in the round. [60 (64, 68, 76, 80)(84, 92, 96, 100) sts on needle.]

#### SIZES 1 (2, -, -,-)(6, 7, -, 9)

**Rnds 1 & 2:** {P3, k1} to end of rnd.

**Rnds 3 & 4:** P1, {k1, p3} to the last 3 sts, k1, p2.

#### SIZES - (-, 3, 4, 5)(-, -, 8, -)

**Rnds 1 & 2:** P1, {k1, p3} to the last 3 sts, k1, p2.

**Rnds 3 & 4:** {P3, k1} to end of rnd.

#### SLEEVE DECREASES

*To stay in pattern while shaping the sleeves: If the second stitch from the BOR should be a knit stitch (according to the stitch pattern), then k2tog for the first decrease of that rnd or ssk for the final decrease of that rnd. If it should be a purl stitch, then p2tog.*

**DEC RND:** K2tog or p2tog to stay in the est pattern, work even to the last 2 sts, ssk or p2tog. [2 sts dec'd]

Shape the sleeve by cont in the est stitch pattern while working a DEC RND every 1.75 (1.75, 1.5, 1, 1)(0.75, 0.75, 0.75, 0.5)"/4.5 (4.5, 4, 2.5, 2.5)(2, 2, 2, 1) cm - 8 (8, 10, 14, 14)(16, 20, 20, 22) times. 16 (16, 20, 28, 28)(32, 40, 40, 44) sts dec'd; 44 (48, 48, 48, 52)(52, 52, 56, 56) sts rem

Cont in the est pattern until the sleeve measures 15"/38 cm, or 2"/5 cm less than your desired sleeve length, from the underarm.

**Sizes 8 & 9 ONLY:** \*K12, k2tog\* to end of rnd. [4 sts dec'd; 52 sts rem]

**Rearranging Sts for BO:** \*K1, 1/1 LPC, p1; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Tubular BO Rnd 1:** {K1, sl 1 wyif} to the end of the rnd.

**Tubular BO Rnd 2:** {Sl 1 wyib, p1} to the end of the rnd.

Sl each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 3 x the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in loose ends.

Wet block sweater by letting it soak in lukewarm bath with wool wash for at least 15 minutes.

Gently squeeze the excess water from your sweater. Sandwich sweater between clean towels and step on top to remove as much moisture as possible without distorting your sweater. Repeat with fresh towels if necessary.

Lay sweater flat to dry using the Schematic to help achieve the desired shape and measurements.

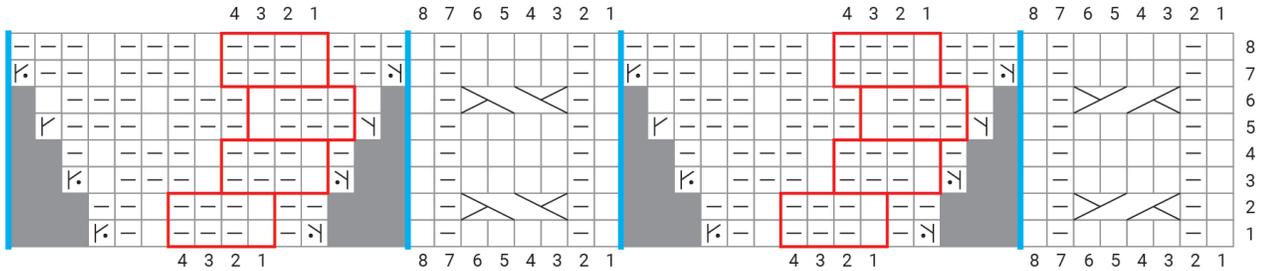

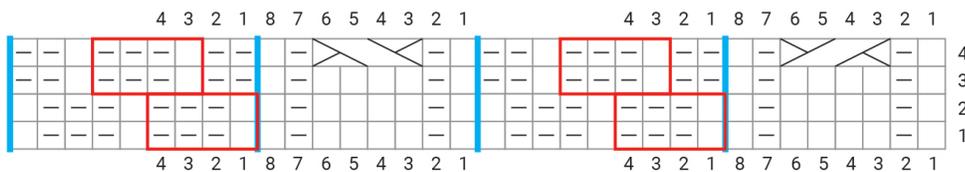

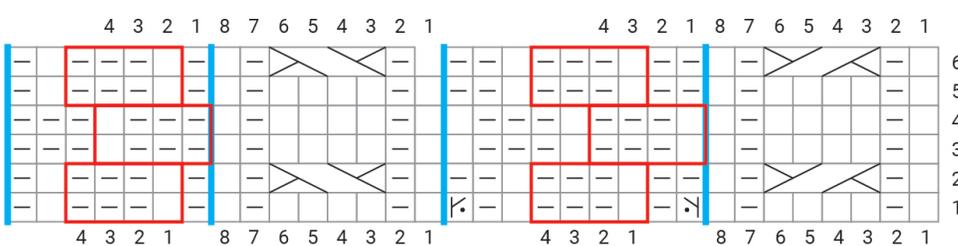

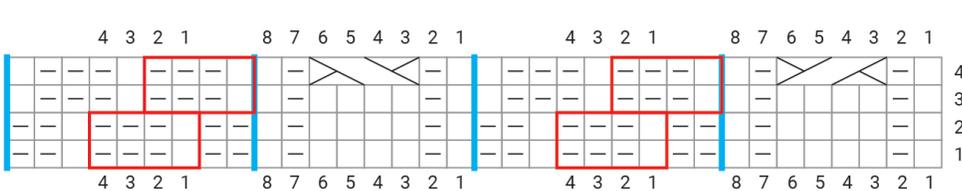

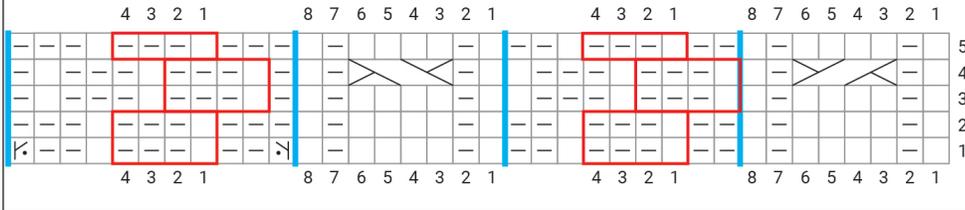

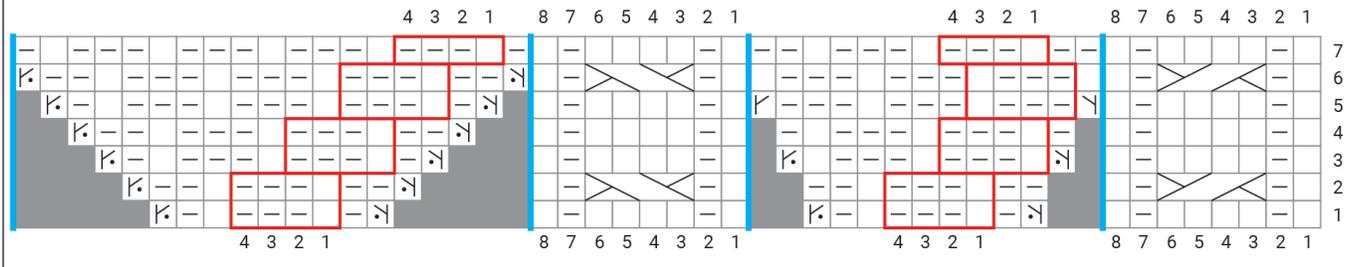


CHART G - YOKE SECTION TWO: SIZE 7 ONLY **Work [Rnds 1-5]** once.

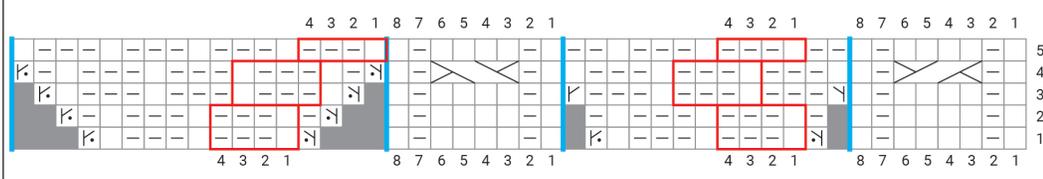


CHART H - YOKE SECTION TWO: SIZE 8 ONLY **Work [Rnds 1-11]** once.

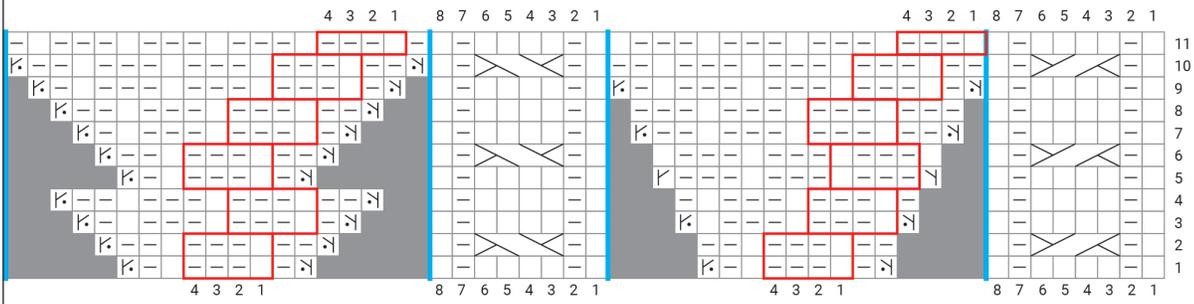
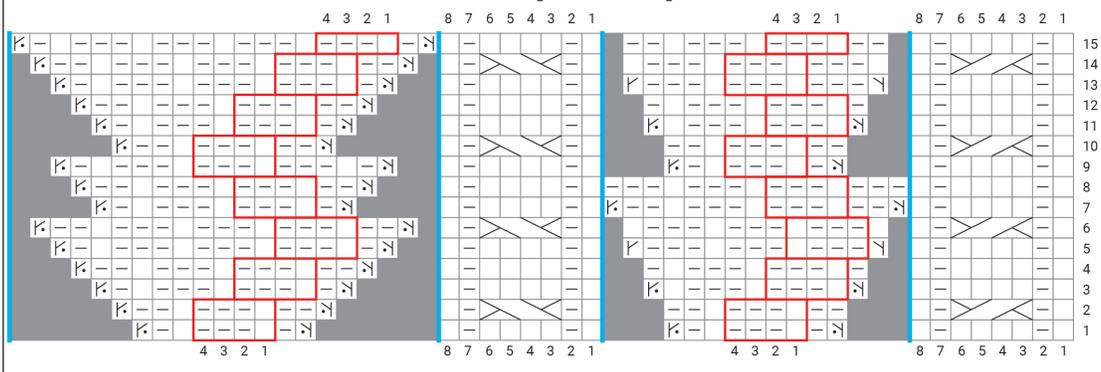


CHART I - YOKE SECTION TWO: SIZE 9 ONLY **Work [Rnds 1-15]** once.

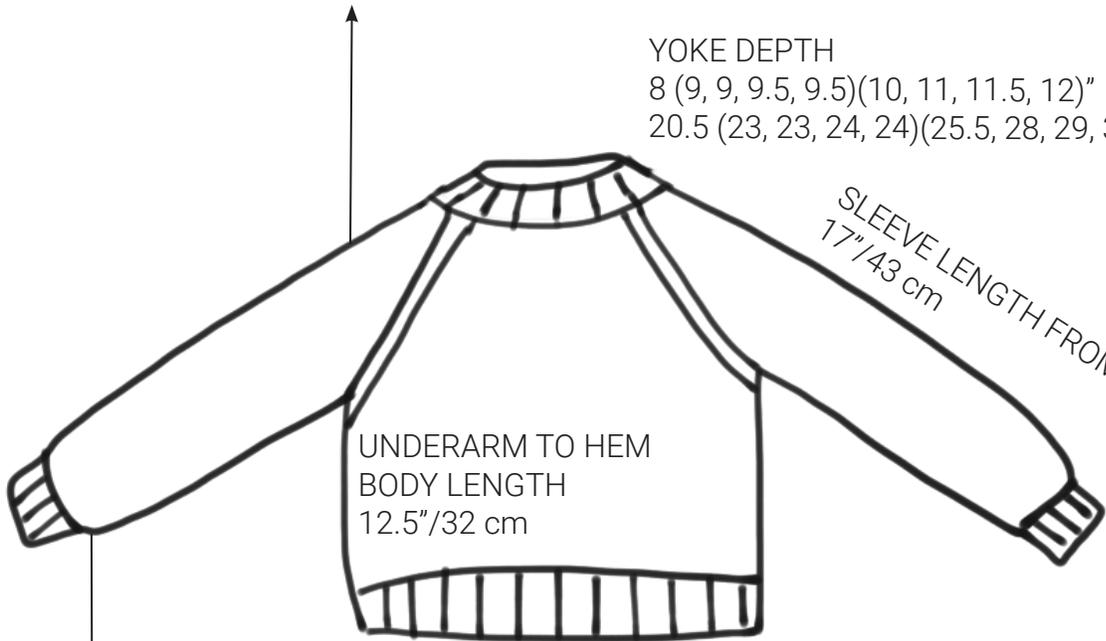
